## Bahrain greets Chinese president on National Day

### World Teachers' Day

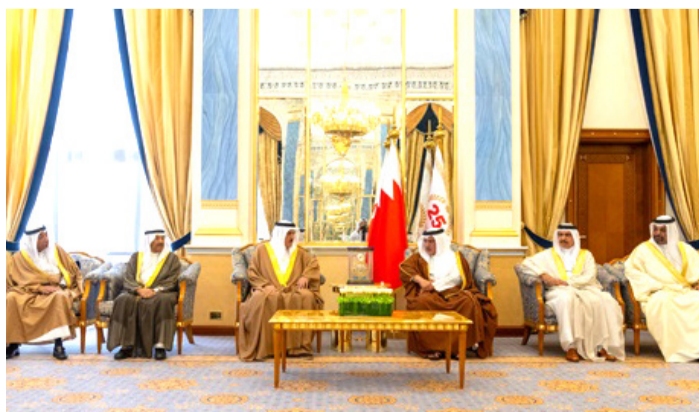

# Subsidised flour prices 'stable'

Bahrain's food sector, valued at BD1.2 billion, is sufficient to meet local demand

The food sector in Bahrain is valued at approximately BD1.2 billion, encompassing all food-related sectors, according to Bassem Al Saei, chairman of Bahrain Food Holding Company (Ghitha).

He also confirmed that the prices of subsidised flour will not be affected.

In a recent press statement, Al Saei highlighted the direct correlation between population and economic growth and the increasing demand for food.

"This trend has prompted Ghitha to focus its initiatives on meeting Bahrain's food security needs and providing essential commodities, as part of a short- to medium-term plan," he stated.

Regarding the companies under the Ghitha umbrella, Al Saei



noted that they include the General Poultry Company, Delmon Poultry Company, and Bahrain Flour Mills.

## Expansion

He indicated that efforts are underway to expedite expansion across these companies, with investment plans for a new milling factory already in motion, alongside completed expansions at the General Poultry Company.

Al Saei emphasised that Delmon Poultry currently meets 20% of the market's meat needs, with significant potential to in-

crease this share and contribute to local self-sufficiency.

Looking ahead, he explained that the current plan necessitates some projects to target regional and international markets due to Bahrain's limited water and arable land resources, which hinder the establishment of large-scale projects.

He also highlighted the focus on utilizing technology in various agricultural practices.

Al Saei spoke about a recent visit by Ghitha to "Salic" in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, where discussions were held with company representatives to explore collaboration opportunities, given their extensive experience in the food sector and food security.

He also announced an upcoming visit in October to Oman to learn about "Nitaj," which focuses on the food sector, as well as a trip to Kuwait to gain insights from Kuwait Mills (KDD). Al Saei mentioned that meetings with the Arab Organisation for Agricultural Investment have been held to strengthen collaboration in this sector.

He stated, "These visits aim to learn from successful experiences, benefit from expertise, and build cooperation with these companies and institutions."

## New strategy to raise revenue

The Legislative and Legal Opinion Commission has confirmed the issuance of Law Decree No. 11 of 2024, which regulates taxation for multinational enterprises, is part of urgent measures aimed at enhancing the Kingdom's ongoing efforts to sustain its public revenue system and explore new sources of financial funding.

"The goal is to address the rising public expenditure driven by the expansion of various public projects and to mitigate the budget deficit," the Commission stated.

### Structure of the law

The proposed law consists of 44 articles divided into seven chapters.

The first chapter outlines the preliminary provisions and objectives of the law.

The second chapter addresses the scope of the tax and its imposition, while the third chapter details the calculation and payment methods.

The fourth chapter covers tax procedures and obligations, and the fifth chapter deals with administrative accountability and dispute resolution.

The sixth chapter addresses criminal liability, and the final chapter provides concluding provisions.

### Economic stability and growth

The Commission stated that this law would contribute to the financial and economic stability of the Kingdom, which is fundamental for the nation's resilience. It aims to build upon previous financial, economic, and structural reforms to achieve fiscal stability and balance.

"This framework is expected to bolster confidence in the Bahraini economy, stimulate

economic activity, and support the government's goal of achieving high and sustainable economic growth. Furthermore, it seeks to ensure equitable distribution of the benefits of this growth, addressing social and tax justice requirements, and providing the necessary financial space to fund developmental projects and social programs," the Commission pointed out.

"The law also aligns with international standards requiring all economic activities to be subject to taxation.

It emphasizes the necessity of implementing a minimum global tax and local taxes on multinational enterprises operating in Bahrain.

These measures will be applied in accordance with the guidelines set forth by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), particularly regarding the Base Erosion and Profit Shifting (BEPS) framework," the Commission stressed.

The Commission pointed out that without imposing and collecting taxes in Bahrain, multinational enterprises would continue to fulfill their tax obligations in other countries for activities conducted in the Kingdom.

## Shura Council reviews timeshare draft law

Shura Council's Services Committee met yesterday to examine a draft law aimed at regulating timeshare in residential units, following Decree No. (33) of 2023.

Under the chairmanship of Dr Ebtesam Mohammed Al Dallal, the meeting was attended by Sarah Buhiji, the CEO of the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority (BTEA), along with representatives from Sur-

vay and Land Registration Bureau (SLRB) and Real Estate Regulatory Authority (RERA).

### Investment

During the meeting, the committee reviewed feedback from various stakeholders regarding the draft law, which aims to clarify the rights and responsibilities of all parties involved.

The legislation also seeks to encourage investment in Bahrain's tourism and real estate sectors.

## LMRA campaigns in full swing

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) has announced the implementation of 2,179 inspection campaigns and visits, during the period of 22 - 28 September 2024, which resulted in the detention of 40 violating and irregular workers, while 151 violators were deported.

The inspection campaigns and visits also resulted in monitoring a number of violations related to the provisions of a number of regulating laws, especially the Labour Market Regulatory Authority and the Residency Laws in the Kingdom of Bahrain, noting that legal measures were taken regarding the observed violations.

The authority pointed out that 2,147 inspection visits were carried out on various shops in all governorates, in addition to 32 joint inspection campaigns, that included 18 campaigns in the Capital Governorate; 4 campaigns in the Muharraq Governorate; 4 campaigns in the Northern Governorate, and 6 campaigns in the Southern Governorate.

The government entity that participated in the campaigns is the Ministry of Interior, represented by the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA), the Governorate's respective Police Directorate, the General Directorate of Crime Detection and Forensic Evidence and the General Directorate of Verdict Enforcement and Alternative Sentencing.

## Court temporarily frees accused Hajj scam trio

### ● Permit forgery case

The Lower Criminal Court has ordered the temporary release of a Hajj campaign operator, his son, and a staff member, who were accused of defrauding pilgrims by issuing 12 forged Hajj permits.

The court has scheduled October 7 for a hearing to present arguments from one of the defense attorneys.

During the session yesterday, the three detained defendants appeared in court alongside their legal representatives, including Shaikh Rashid bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, attorney Intisar Al Asfoor, and attorney Noor Mohammed, who was representing attorney Mansour Adraboh.

### Guarantees

After their defense statements, the court decided to release the three defendants on the condition that they provide guarantees of their residence, but they have been barred from traveling.

Shaikh Rashid bin Ahmed argued that the court lacked jurisdiction since the alleged incident occurred in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, where the permits were handed over and used by individuals affil-

ated with the Saudi police for entry into the holy sites, which are outside Bahrain's jurisdiction.

Additionally, he noted that Saudi authorities had initiated an investigation into the matter, leading to the conviction of another individual for the crime, thereby severing any connection to the defendants in the current case.

### Prior ruling

Shaikh Rashid bin Ahmed further argued that the case should not be heard again, as it had already been adjudicated, with a prior ruling against the campaign manager resulting in a one-year prison sentence and a fine of 3,000 Saudi Riyals.

He emphasised that the defendants had been cleared by public prosecution, which had issued a dismissal order against them.

On her part, Al Asfoor clarified that her client had no official connection to the campaign beyond volunteering as a staff member for the pilgrims in exchange for a salary as a reception worker.

She added that he was merely a receptionist and a helper for the pilgrims, working alongside other staff members such as media personnel and religious advisors. He had no authority to issue permits or handle any financial transactions related to the Hajj.

# Victims vindicated

## Bahraini teacher's appeal fails; 15-year sentence for sexual assault stands

The High Appeals Court has upheld the 15-year prison sentence of a 27-year-old Bahraini teacher convicted of sexually assaulting two young students.

The September 30th hearing concluded with a rejection of the teacher's appeal, leaving the original sentence unchanged.

The teacher was initially



convicted by the High Criminal Court for separate incidents involving a 12-year-old and a seven-year-old boy, receiving a 10-year sentence for one assault and a five-year sentence for the other.

He confessed to the crimes during the initial trial, expressing remorse and apologising to the community.

### Report

The case came to light after

a report to the Ministry of Interior's Northern Governorate Police Directorate.

Subsequent investigations revealed that the teacher had also assaulted four other students at the same school, although these incidents went unreported initially.

The Appeals Court's decision to uphold the 15-year sentence underscores the seriousness of the crimes and the court's commitment to protecting children.

## Alarming 'child abuse' case

### ● Autistic student suffers severe burns inflicted by guardian

In a concerning incident at a primary school, severe burn marks were discovered on a student with special needs, specifically one diagnosed with autism.

The Ministry of Education strongly warns against child abuse, both physical and psychological, stressing the serious harm it can cause to a child's mental development, health, and future well-being.

The local educational authority promptly dispatched a team to investigate the situation.

Upon further examination, it was revealed that the burns were inflicted by the child's

guardian using a hair styling tool.

In light of these findings, the Ministry of Education has initiated legal proceedings, referring the matter to the public prose-

cution for further investigation.

The Ministry reiterated its commitment to ensuring the safety of all children and emphasises its ongoing policy to report any suspicions of abuse or mistreatment.

Furthermore, the Ministry of Education strongly warns against any form of child abuse, whether physical or psychological, highlighting the severe negative impacts such actions can have on children's mental development, health, and future well-being.

## Two convicted of mobile banking fraud

### ● Victim lost BD373

A Bahraini woman lost BD373 to a sophisticated mobile banking scam in 2021, leading to the conviction of two individuals involved in the fraudulent activity.

The woman, who believed she was simply updating her personal information for the Benefit app, was unknowingly targeted in a phishing scheme.

According to court documents, the victim received a text message from what she believed the Benefit Pay application, the national payment gateway, instructing her to update her personal details via a provided link to maintain access to the app.

Unskilled with technology, she asked her son for assistance.

Upon entering their details on the fraudulent link, a verification code was received and entered.

Immediately afterward, they discovered BD373 had been transferred from her bank account to an unknown recipient.

Attempts to contact the recipient to recover the funds proved unsuccessful.

The individual initially claimed to have returned the money but later denied any involvement.

The money was transferred to a mobile wallet registered under a second suspect.

## Convicted man loses murder case appeal

The High Appeals Court has upheld the life imprisonment sentence of a 40-year-old man convicted of the premeditated murder of a European woman, rejecting his appeal.

The defendant, who initially confessed to the crime but later recanted his statement, remains silent regarding the victim's whereabouts. Her body has never been found.

The court's decision concludes a tumultuous legal battle that began over a year after the woman's disappearance.

The defendant's initial confession, detailed in the original High Criminal Court trial, described meeting the victim on Facebook, inviting her to his home, and subsequently suffocating her after a night of drug use and alcohol.

He claimed to have disposed of her body by burning it in a remote location.

### Testimony

This confession, along with testimony from the victim's mother in Kazakhstan (provided via video link), formed the cornerstone of the prosecution's case.

However, the defendant's

subsequent recantation, claiming the victim left his home alive the following morning, cast significant doubt on the murder charge.

His defense lawyer argued that the lack of a body raised serious questions about the prosecution's case.

Despite the recantation and the absence of the victim's body, the Appeals Court found the prosecution's evidence, including the initial confession and other forensic evidence, sufficient to uphold the conviction.

### Narcotics

The defendant's separate convictions for providing narcotics for a fee (resulting in a 10-year sentence and a BD3,000) and violating the sanctity of the victim's body (a six-month sentence) also remain in effect.

The case will now proceed to the Court of Cassation, Bahrain's highest court of appeal, where the defendant will have a final opportunity to challenge his conviction.

The mystery surrounding the victim's disappearance, and the lack of a body, remain central to the ongoing legal proceedings.

# United front for funding

Northern Council seeks MPs' support for improved budgets, infrastructure and fire-hit home renovations

The Northern Municipal Council held its third regular meeting yesterday, chaired by Sayyed Shubbar Al Wedai, as it prepares for the upcoming parliamentary sessions, focusing on the approval of the 2025-2026 fiscal budgets, part of the state's second financial package.

Al Wedai stated, "We have placed this within our upcoming work priorities," emphasising the need to align with Parliament.

He announced plans for a joint meeting with MPs from the Northern Governorate to "work

together with MPs in shaping a guided course and drafting a roadmap to advocate for financial support."

The council prioritises infrastructure improvements and road rehabilitation, as well as renovating homes for families in need or affected by fires.

In addition, Mohammed Saad Al Doseri proposed establishing a centre for issuing house and shop number plates in the Northern Governorate, citing complaints about the distance of the factory responsible for these signs. He suggested that a local branch would alleviate the burden.

Lamia Al Fadhala, Direc-



tor-General of the Northern Governorate Municipality, responded, "The entity responsible for issuance is a private company that obtained the pro-

ject through a tender; therefore, we cannot compel it to open another branch."

Member Bassim Abu Idris proposed a request for a special

discussion with the company.

The council also voted on a proposal submitted by council member Zainab Aldurazi to designate parking spaces near a local mosque in Karzakkan's residential area.

The proposal was made in response to residents' complaints about severe congestion and a lack of parking, with mosque attendees' cars often blocking access to homes.

The meeting also included discussions on session protocols, a time limit for interventions, and a joint programme for field visits to assess municipal needs, with reviews of recent visits to various departments and plans for further assessments.

## Financial literacy sessions held for Filipinos

The GoBayani Roadshow conducted financial literacy sessions for Bahrain's Filipino community and Philippine Embassy personnel.

Hosted by a team of bank representatives from 16-18 September 2024, the event included a Financial Caravan at the Embassy's Migrant Workers Office on 17-18 September.

On 17 September, a financial literacy session was held at the Embassy's Sentro Rizal from 6pm to 7:30pm, focusing on the importance of saving, practical spending tips, and strategies for achieving financial stability.

The session also addressed safeguarding bank accounts against scams, stressing the shared responsibility of digital security.

## Thumbs up for artificial reefs

Plans to build artificial reefs off Bahrain's coastline to boost fish stocks and slash fishing costs have received cautious approval from the Supreme Council for the Environment (SCE), which is calling for a feasibility study and expressed a preference for concrete over earthenware materials.

The SCE expressed its support, in principle, for the North Municipal Council's proposal.

"This support aligns with the council's ongoing efforts to safeguard and preserve the marine ecosystem," said the SCE in writing, noting that the initiative would contribute to the sustainability of Bahrain's natural biodiversity and further the Kingdom's strategic objectives.

The Northern Municipal Council initially approved the proposal in March, recommending the installation of artificial clay reefs within Bahraini waters to help reduce operational costs for local fishermen.

The council submitted the plan to the SCE, hoping it would also help lower fish prices in local markets.

Municipal council member Abdullah Al Thawadi told The Daily Tribune: "Creating these reefs near Bahrain's coastline would not only increase fish stocks in the area but also shorten the distances fishermen need to travel, easing the financial burden of their trips."

He added: "These artificial clay reefs would provide a breeding ground for various fish species, offering a refuge for marine life to thrive."

While supporting the concept, the Supreme Council

"It is crucial to consider all factors, including cost-effectiveness and available alternatives for reef construction, such as concrete or similar materials," the SCE stated.

The SCE also noted the success of concrete reefs, stating: "Concrete has been extensively tested and has proven to be more reliable due to its durability and longevity, whereas earthenware reefs have been used sparingly and primarily for experimental purposes."

## Council approves plan for new key road access in West Riffa

A proposal to create new entrances and exits on Road 1713 in Bukuwara, West Riffa, has received unanimous approval from the Southern Municipal Council.

Councilmember Ahmed Al Abdullah, representing the sixth constituency, championed the initiative, made possible by the recent removal of old, adjacent oil pipelines.

The project now awaits the Minister of Municipalities' approval following coordination with relevant authorities.

This project directly addresses the increasing traffic congestion affecting the area.

Councilmember Al Abdullah explained in a memorandum that adding new access points to Road 1713 — a key thoroughfare serving numerous shops and commercial establishments — will significantly improve traffic flow and accessibility for residents and road users, particularly during peak hours.

"The area's rapid development, with a surge in new buildings and businesses, has dramatically increased traffic

volume, making this infrastructure upgrade essential. The removal of the old oil pipelines conveniently provides the necessary space for construction, further enhancing the project's feasibility," the memorandum stated.

"Moreover, this initiative aligns perfectly with Bahrain's Economic Vision 2030, contributing to improved infrastructure, enhanced road networks, and a more aesthetically pleasing urban environment. The improved traffic flow will undoubtedly contribute to a more modern and attractive Bukuwara West Riffa."

## Sigh of relief as Labour Ministry secures settlement for dismissed bank employees

A settlement has been reached regarding the termination of contracts at an Islamic bank, the Ministry of Labour announced yesterday.

Under the agreement, the bank will reinstate some dismissed workers and provide compensation following a restructuring aimed at improving productivity.

The settlement, achieved through collaboration among all parties, ensures that the

rights of both the bank and its employees are upheld in accordance with Bahrain's Labour Law.

Each worker will receive one month's pay for every year of service, with a minimum payment of six months' salary for those dismissed.

The Ministry of Labour is also assisting affected Bahraini workers in securing new employment.

Unemployment benefits, set at 60% of their insured wage, will be provided for up to nine

months or until they find new work, as outlined in the Unemployment Insurance Law.

Earlier, the bank's decision to dismiss 40 employees sparked public outrage, prompting swift action from MPs.

This led to a reduction in the number of dismissals to 26.

Emergency meetings led by Second Deputy Speaker Ahmed Qarata focused on key labour concerns and emphasised the need to protect workers' rights amid rising uncertainty in the job market.

## Epic Games sues Google, Samsung over app store

Fortnite-maker Epic Games is suing tech giants Google and Samsung, it announced Monday, accusing them of illegally colluding to block competition on Samsung devices.

CEO Tim Sweeney said his company would file a claim in a US federal court in California, the same jurisdiction where the company won a years-long legal battle with Google in 2023.

He said he would take the fight to authorities in Europe and Asia if necessary, amid his long-running battle to force Apple and Google to open up their smartphone to other app stores. "This is a major global fight, which is ultimately for the right of consumers to get all the benefits of competition and choose freely who they want to do business with," Sweeney told reporters.

The latest lawsuit focuses on Samsung's Auto Blocker feature.

Epic claims that feature was

implemented in coordination with Google to undermine a recent US court decision against Google's app store practices.

Following that decision, Epic in August launched its own app store, which allows users to bypass the Google-run store and offer content directly to smartphone users.

Epic alleges that Auto Blocker surreptitiously blocks the new app store and others like it by obstructing the ability to install apps from sources other than the Google Play Store and Samsung Galaxy Store.

Epic said that in July 2024, Samsung changed Auto Blocker from an "opt-in" feature to the default setting, forcing users to navigate a cumbersome 21-step process to download apps from third-party stores or the web.

Epic argues that this move cements Google Play Store's monopoly and violates the jury verdict in Epic's court victory against Google.

In that case, a jury found Google's app-store practices, including agreements with phone manufacturers, to be illegal.

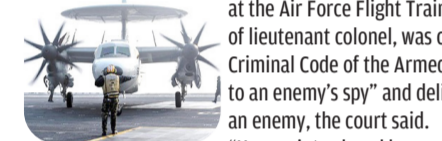
News in brief

Russian President Vladimir Putin vowed yesterday to achieve all his "goals" in Ukraine and celebrated the second anniversary of annexing four Ukrainian regions, as his army claimed fresh advances in the conflict. Moscow has captured dozens of Ukrainian towns and villages this year, pressing forward even as Kyiv mounts a cross-border offensive into Russian territory. "The truth is on our side. All goals set will be achieved," Putin said in a video address marking what he calls "Reunification Day" -- when Moscow annexed four southern and eastern Ukrainian regions in 2022. He also repeated his justification for sending troops into Ukraine, saying he was protecting Russian speakers against a "neo-Nazi dictatorship" that aimed to "cut them off forever from Russia, their historic homeland." "Together we are defending a safe, prosperous future for our children and grandchildren," Putin said.



Putin vows to reach all 'goals' in Ukraine as army claims new ground

Taiwan's High Court yesterday sentenced a former air force officer and instructor to 17 years in prison for "aiding the enemy" over espionage activities carried out on behalf of China. Beijing claims self-ruled Taiwan as its territory and has ramped up military and political pressure on the democratic island in recent years. The two sides split in 1949 after a civil war and have been spying on each other since. Lou Wen-ching, a former instructor at the Air Force Flight Training Command with the rank of lieutenant colonel, was convicted of violating the Criminal Code of the Armed Forces for "rendering aid to an enemy's spy" and delivering "military secrets" to an enemy, the court said. "He was introduced by a Chinese Communist Party (CCP) spy surnamed Liu (a retired Air Force lieutenant colonel) to meet with CCP officials abroad," it said in a statement.



Taiwan ex-air force instructor jailed 17 years for China spying

Assange to highlight British detention in first comments since release



WikiLeaks founder Julian Assange will today make his first public address since his release from a British prison, speaking about his detention at the Council of Europe rights body. Assange will be at a hearing in Strasbourg from 0630 GMT at the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE) which issued a report expressing alarm at the whistleblower's treatment. The hearing would explore the 53-year-old Australian's "detention and conviction and their chilling effect on human rights," PACE said.

'Billions of birds' killed for fashion says designer McCartney

British designer Stella McCartney lamented the "billions of birds" that have been killed to make people look good after her Paris show on Monday in which she appealed for the fashion world to change its ways. Lebanon PM calls for ceasefire with Israel

Lebanon's Prime Minister Najib Mikati on Monday called for a ceasefire in the fighting between Israel and Hezbollah during a meeting with French Foreign Minister Jean-Noel Barrot in Beirut.

"The key to the solution is to put an end to the Israeli aggression against Lebanon and to revive the appeal launched by the United States and France... in favour of a ceasefire," Mikati said, according to a statement from his office. Barrot arrived in Beirut Sunday, the first foreign diplomat to visit Lebanon since Israel escalated its strikes against Hezbollah strongholds.

Mikati added that the "priority is applying resolution 1701" of the United Nations Security Council, which ended the 2006 war between Israel and Hezbollah.

The French envoy's visit came as a deadly strike hit a building in the centre of the Lebanese capital.

Israeli strikes have been largely concentrated on Hezbollah's strongholds in the south and east of the country, and in south Beirut.

China's Xi calls for Taiwan reunification in national day speech

President Xi Jinping reiterated his call for China to "reunite" with Taiwan during an address on the eve of national holiday celebrations.

Xi also used his speech to thousands of people gathered for a banquet celebrating 75 years of the People's Republic to call for opposition to the "separatist activities" of supporters of Taiwanese independence.

"Achieving complete national reunification is the common aspiration of the Chinese people," Xi said.

"It is an irreversible trend, a matter of justice, and it is in accordance with the popular will. No one can stop the march of history," he said.

Beijing has said it will never renounce the use of force to bring Taiwan under its control and has also stepped up rhetoric about "unification".

The People's Republic of China was founded on October 1, 1949, after the Communist army defeated nationalist Kuomintang forces at the end of a civil war lasting two decades.

The defeated nationalists fled to Taiwan.

"Taiwan is sacred territory for China. People on both sides of the Taiwan Strait have blood ties, and these family ties will always be stronger than others," Xi said.

Israel's Defence Minister Yoav Gallant said ground forces could be used against Hezbollah in Lebanon, adding military operations will go on despite the killing of the group's leader Hassan Nasrallah

Two-thirds of the buildings in the Gaza Strip have been damaged or destroyed since the Gaza war began in October 2023, the United Nations said yesterday.

Updating its damage assessment, the UN Satellite Centre (UNOSAT) said very high-resolution imagery collected on September 3 and 6 showed a clear deterioration.

"This analysis... shows that two-thirds of the total structures in the Gaza Strip have sustained damage," UNOSAT said.

"Those 66 percent of damaged buildings in the Gaza Strip account for 163,778 structures in total," it said. The last assessment, based on images from early July, determined that 63 percent of structures in the Palestinian territory had been damaged.

Monday's update said the damage now included "52,564 structures that have been destroyed; 18,913 severely damaged; 35,591 possibly damaged structures; and 56,710 moderately affected".

Gaza City has been notably affected, with 36,611 structures destroyed, it added.

UNOSAT and the UN's Food and

Iran says will not send forces to confront Israel

Iran will not deploy forces to Lebanon or Gaza to confront Israel, its foreign ministry said yesterday, as Israeli strikes target its allies in the region.

"There is no need to send extra or volunteer forces of the Islamic Republic of Iran," said foreign ministry spokesman Nasser Kanani, adding that Lebanon and fighters in the Palestinian territories "have the capability and strength to defend themselves

against the aggression". Israel has in recent days been mounting heavy air strikes in Lebanon against the so-called "axis of resistance", a network of Iran-aligned militant groups in the region, including in Syria, Yemen and Iraq.

Netanyahu tells Iranians 'nowhere in the Middle East Israel cannot reach'

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu issued a fresh warning to Iran, saying there was no place in the Middle East beyond Israel's reach. In a video statement Netanyahu addressed the people of Iran and warned that their government was bringing them "closer to the abyss". "With every passing moment, the regime is bringing you -- the noble Persian people -- closer to the abyss," said Netanyahu. "There is nowhere in the Middle East Israel cannot reach," the prime minister added, warning the people of Iran that their "regime plunges our region deeper into darkness and deeper into war". "Don't let a small group of theocrats crush your hopes and your dreams," Netanyahu said.

German air force to fly out some Beirut embassy staff

Germany sent an air force plane to strife-torn Lebanon yesterday to fly out some Beirut embassy staff, their dependants and German citizens with medical conditions, the government

said. "An Air Force A321 aircraft flew to Beirut today to support the departure of the colleagues and their families," said a joint statement by the foreign and defence ministries. "German nationals who are

particularly at risk due to medical circumstances are also being taken on the Bundeswehr aircraft," said the statement, which added that staff of some German partner organisations were also being picked up.

Agriculture Organization said that approximately 68 percent of the permanent crop fields in the Gaza Strip showed "a significant decline in health and density" in September.

Hamas's unprecedented Octo-

ber 7 attack on Israel resulted in the deaths of 1,205 people, mostly civilians, according to an AFP tally based on Israeli official figures that include hostages killed in captivity. Israel's retaliatory military of-

fensive has killed at least 41,615 people in Gaza, most of them civilians, according to figures provided by the Hamas-run territory's health ministry. The UN has described the figures as reliable.

Nepal surveys flood wreckage as death toll reaches 200

Search and rescue teams in Nepal's capital picked through wrecked homes on Monday after waters receded from monsoon floods that killed at least 200 people around the Himalayan republic.

Deadly floods and landslides are common across South Asia during the monsoon season from June to September but experts say climate change is making them worse.

Entire neighbourhoods in Kathmandu were inundated after the heaviest rains in more than two decades, with the capital temporarily cut off from the rest of Nepal after landslides blocked highways.

"According to the latest figures, 200 have died, 127 are injured and 26 are still missing," home ministry spokesman Rishi Ram Tiwari told AFP.

Police said at least 35 of those killed were buried alive when earth from a landslide careened into vehicles on a highway south of Kathmandu.

Bulldozers were being used to clear nearly two dozen sections

of major roads leading into Kathmandu that had been blocked by debris.

The home ministry said it was working to rescue numerous people who had been stranded on the highways. Rescuers in knee-high

rubber boots were using shovels to clear mud from the worst-hit riverside neighbourhoods around Kathmandu, many of them unauthorised slum settlements.

The International Centre for Integrated Mountain Development (ICIMOD), a Nepal-based think tank, said the disaster had been made worse by unplanned urban encroachment around the Bagmati River, which flows through the capital.

Nepal's army said more than 4,000 people had been rescued, with helicopters, motorboats and rafts bringing stranded people to safety.

Nilkantha Pandey of the humanitarian organisation CARE Nepal said many of those affected by the floods needed safe drinking water and temporary housing.

"Mostly informal settlements have been affected," Pandey said. "It is time to respond and not delay."

UAE condemns 'heinous' attack on ambassador's home in Sudan

Dubai, United Arab Emirates

The United Arab Emirates reacted with outrage yesterday after the home of its ambassador in war-torn Sudan was attacked and badly damaged.

The kingdom blamed the Sudanese armed forces for the "heinous" attack. Sudan's army denied carrying out the attack, insisting it does not target diplomatic missions.

The army accuses the UAE of backing the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF), which it has been fighting since April 2023 in a war that has killed

tens of thousands of people and ignited a dire humanitarian crisis. "The United Arab Emirates has strongly condemned the heinous attack that targeted the residence of the UAE head

100 dead in storm Helene damage, flooding across US southeast

At least 100 people have been killed after destructive floods ripped through the US southeast, officials said Monday, with the emergency response effort fast becoming a political football in a region that could decide the presidential election.

Rescue operations sought to find survivors and deliver supplies across Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Tennessee in areas where

torrential rains brought by Hurricane Helene caused havoc. Residents face power cuts, supply shortages, blocked roads and broken communication lines in often mountainous terrain.

Republican candidate Donald Trump will on Monday visit Valdosta in Georgia -- an epicenter of the flooding destruction, and also a key state in the tight election being held in just five weeks' time.

Trump's Democrat opponent Vice President Kamala Harris

cancelled campaign events to return to Washington for a briefing on the federal response, while President Joe Biden was due to speak on Monday morning from the White House.

Biden, who has approved federal aid for several states in the wake of the disaster, plans to travel to hard-hit areas this week, "as soon as it will not disrupt emergency response operations," the White House said Sunday, adding that Harris would do the same.

Russia plans sharp defence spending hike in 2025

Russia plans to boost its defence budget by almost 30 percent next year as it diverts resources to its Ukraine offensive, spending more on the military than welfare and education combined, a draft budget showed on Monday.

Moscow had already ramped up military spending to levels not seen since the Soviet Union era, pumping out missiles and drones to fire on Ukraine and paying lucrative salaries to its hundreds of thousands of sol-

diers fighting on the front lines. The latest planned increase in spending will take Russia's defence budget to 13.5 trillion rubles (\$145 billion) in 2025, a document published on the parliamentary website showed, up from 10.4 trillion in 2024.

That figure does not include

some other resources being directed to the military campaign, such as spending that Russia labels as "domestic security" and some outlays classified as top secret.

Combined spending on defence and security will account for around 40 percent of Russia's total government spending, seen at 41.5 trillion rubles in 2025. Before sending the draft budget to the Russian parliament, Moscow trumpeted an increase in investment and social welfare alongside higher military outlays.

Libya gets new central bank chief under UN-backed deal

Libya has appointed a new governor for the central bank, under a UN-backed deal to resolve a dispute between the country's rival administrations that halved oil output.

Tensions and violence have risen since August around the central bank in oil-rich Libya, which is split between a United Nations-recognised government in the west and a rival power in the east. The tensions prompted governor Seddik al-Kabir to flee the country.

After talks facilitated by the United Nations, the rival administrations on Thursday signed an agreement to name a new central bank governor.

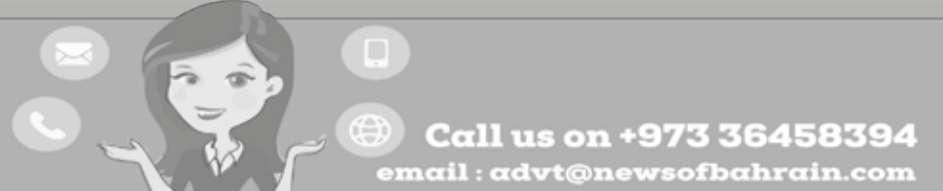

In the third round, Jun pushed for a finish, dropping Wesner midway through, but was unable to secure the finish. However, in the fourth round, Jun's earlier leg kicks proved decisive as he finished Wesner with a low leg kick to become

the new Light Heavyweight champion.

Pavel Dailidko realized his dream and became the BRAVE CF Heavyweight champion by defeating Patryk Dubiela in the co-main event, marking his fifth consecutive finish in BRAVE Combat Federation. Dubiela attempted to use his grappling

skills, but Dailidko defended successfully and landed powerful ground-and-pound strikes, leading to a first-round stoppage. Dailidko's victory earned him a place in the history books as the first-ever BRAVE CF Heavyweight champion.

In a fight of the year contender, Monika Kucinic defeated Fabio-

la Pidroni by split decision after three intense rounds. Pidroni nearly finished Kucinic with a head kick in the first round, but Kucinic recovered and staged a comeback in the second and third rounds. Despite Pidroni's attempts at takedowns, Kucinic stood ground with her striking and eventually took home the win. This is Kucinic's second victory of the year, following her finish at BRAVE CF 81.

Luka Podkrajšek returned to the winning column with a TKO victory over Italian Veteran Michele Mirabella, finishing the fight with ground-and-pound strikes. In his post-fight interview, Podkrajšek revealed that he fought with a broken rib and hinted at possible retirement.

Elsewhere, Miha Frlc earned a quick win, stopping Samuele Di Guardo in just 37 seconds with strikes. This marked Frlc's first victory in BRAVE CF and kept his undefeated record intact.

Kristjan Toniste used his experience to secure a unani-

mous decision win against Domen Drnovsek in their Super Lightweight fight. Toniste dominated the stand-up exchanges and successfully defended Drnovsek's submission attempts, handing Drnovsek his first professional loss.

Marina Spasic remained undefeated with a third-round stoppage of Maristela Alves. After a competitive fight in the

IMMAF European champion Kirill Negru delivered a strong performance, defeating Ilian Sinani by unanimous decision in the opening bout of the card. With the win, Negru earned a spot in the IMMAF World Championships in Uzbekistan and vowed to bring home the gold medal for Slovenia.

BRAVE CF 88, held in partnership with WFC, was the organization's second event in Slovenia this year. BRAVE CF will next head to Spain for BRAVE CF 89, scheduled for October 19.

Two returning BRMC champions were amongst the winners in the opening event, including Tariq Soofi and Nasser Nass.

Tariq triumphed in the Micro MAX class over the weekend, while Nasser, last season's title winner in the Mini MAX cate-

gory, marked his debut in the Junior MAX division with a sensational grand slam – taking pole position, winning the final while leading every lap, and posting the fastest lap.

Others to take the chequered flag in their respective classes were Rayyan Najjar in the Mini MAX, Tye Mejia in the Senior MAX, Abdulla Sajjad in the MAX DD2, and Mohamed Almahroos in the DD2 Masters.

The BRMC is one of the region's premier karting championships. It brings together participants of various ages and nationalities, who battle it out in their very own Rotax-powered machinery.

The series is being organised

and run by BIC and BIKC, in cooperation with the Bahrain Motor Federation, Bahrain Karting Commission, and Motorsport Marshals Club.

Tariq was the winner in the Micro MAX category after taking the chequered flag in their nine-lap final in a time of nine minutes 30.622 seconds. Tariq started the race behind Abdulaziz Alsarraf, but was able to take the lead on lap five. He went on to triumph 5.595 seconds ahead of Abdulaziz, while Rashid Almahroos claimed third place 12.559s adrift.

Earlier in the round, Tariq was also the winner in class in the seven-lap pre-final, while Abdulaziz clinched pole in qualifying

and Rashid set the pace during the free practice.

In the Mini MAX class, Rayyan ended the final third on the track but later inherited first place. Rayyan had a winning time of 9:07.241 after nine laps – just 0.794 seconds ahead of runner-up Jude Andrews. William Lette claimed the other podium spot 21.199s back.

Shaikh Ahmed bin Saqer Al Khalifa had earlier taken an outright victory in the seven-lap pre-final from pole position, while Rayyan topped the Mini MAX timesheet in practice.

Amongst the Junior MAX runners, Nasser started the new championship from where he left off last season – atop the

podium.

Celebrating his graduation to the higher tier, Nasser won the 15-lap final from pole to flag in 14:07.585, narrowly beating out the defending champion in class, Khaled Najjar, by 0.863s. Demir Abali came third 3.865s from the victor.

Nasser secured his grand slam with the race's best lap of 55.923s. He earlier also won the pre-final after securing the top spot in qualifying, while Leopold Juch was quickest in practice.

The Senior MAX featured the meeting's largest grid with 15 competitors, and it was Mejia who stood tall at the end.

He won the 15-lap final after a tough battle. He started the race from second place and gained the lead midway through, but lost it heading into the final stages only to recapture the advantage on the penultimate lap, en route to winning in 13:53.192.

Mejia pipped Musaad Albasam at the chequered flag by 0.220s, while Zain Elhommosany joined them on the podium just 1.003s behind.

Mejia also won the pre-final and set the pace in Senior MAX qualifying and practice.

In the MAX DD2 category, Sajjad triumphed after 15 laps in the final with a time of 13:39.674. He was 7.284s ahead of Raoul Sadi, while Oliver Kruglov came third 7.609s adrift. Sajjad also won the pre-final and claimed pole in qualifying, while Sadi was quickest in practice.

In the DD2 Masters, Almahroos ran the final unopposed and finished his 15-lap outing in 13:57.119.

Following all the action in round one, the winners were presented their respective trophies by officials in the podium ceremonies.

The championship resumes with round two on 12 October, to be followed by rounds three and four on 15 and 29 November, respectively. The BRMC will then begin 2025 with round five on 11 January, before holding round six on 24 January. The seventh and penultimate meeting will take place on 8 February, setting the stage for the BRMC finale two weeks later on 21 February.
