HRH Prince Salman appoints Ministry of Transportation director

His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, yesterday issued Edict (107) of 2023, appointing a director at the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications, based on a proposal by the Minister of Transportation and Telecommunications.

Under Article (I), Khalid Al Sayed Hussain Yaseen shall be appointed as Director of the Meteorological Directorate at the the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications.

Under Article (II), the Minister of Transportation and Telecommunications shall implement the provisions of this edict, which comes into effect upon its issuance and will be published in the Official Gazette.

HRH Prince Salman also issued Edict (108) of 2023, appointing a director at the Education and Training Quality

Authority (BQA), based on a proposal by the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the BQA.

Under Article (I), Duaa Isa Abdulwahab shall be appointed as Director of the Vocational Reviews Directorate at the BQA.

Under Article (II), the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the BQA shall implement the provisions of this edict, which comes into effect upon its issuance, and will be published in the Official Gazette.

Administrative Court declines domestic worker's lawsuit

The High Administrative Court declined a domestic worker's lawsuit to obligate the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) to accept her grievance and renew her residency which was cancelled due to an absence report filed by her previous sponsor.

She was surprised to discover the report filed with the defendant, the LMRA, which prevented her from renewing her residency by Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA). Thereby, she filed a grievance; however, the grievance was rejected.

The court stated that Article (33) of Law No. 19 of 2006 for Regulating the Labour Market stipulates: all persons concerned may file a grievance against any decision issued pursuant to the provisions of this Law within 30 days of the date of their notification of such a decision. Grievances against decisions issued under the provisions of Articles 38 of this Law shall be filed with the minister concerned with the Commercial Registry; grievances against decisions issued by the Board of Directors shall be filed with that Board; and grievances against other decisions shall be filed with the Chief Executive. Grievances shall be considered, and the



results of such consideration notified to the person filing the grievance, within 30 days of filing.

Grievance

The person filing a grievance may appeal a decision to reject the grievance before the competent court within 30 days of notification of such a decision or the expiry of the period specified for considering the grievance without notification of the person filing it of the result of the consideration of his grievance. Appeals may not be brought before the courts until a grievance has been filed against the decision and the decision rejecting the grievance has been issued, or the expiry of the period referred to in the above Paragraph without notification.

The court stated that as established in the lawsuit papers, the plaintiff was notified of the outcome of the grievance she submitted in April 2023; however she filed her appeal several months later past the deadline. Therefore the court ruled to decline appeal and obligated the plaintiff to pay the lawsuit fees.

'Maternity Leave, Pay Denied'

Employer Faces Criminal Trial: Refusal of Maternity Leave Sparks Legal Action

Legal proceedings have been set in motion as the Public Prosecution took decisive action against an employer who refused to grant maternity leave with pay to a female employee, a violation that runs afoul of established laws.

The genesis of this legal confrontation traces back to a complaint lodged with the Inspection and Occupational Safety Department at the Ministry of Labour. The complainant, a female worker in a private com-

mercial establishment, sought justice after her employer not only rejected her maternity leave

but also proceeded to deduct from her monthly salary. Despite submitting a medical report de-

tailoring her health condition and the prescribed sick leaves, the employer remained unyielding.

The Head of the Prosecution, underscoring the gravity of the situation, emphasized that Bahraini legislation unequivocally guarantees the right of female workers to a maternity leave spanning sixty days. This duration encompasses the period both before and after childbirth. The legislative framework is meticulously designed to strike a delicate balance between professional commitments and family life.

Unusual theft case: Inmate's sentence modified

The corridors of the Correction and Rehabilitation Center witnessed an unexpected twist as the High Criminal Court modified the sentence of an inmate involved in a peculiar theft case. Originally sentenced to five years for stealing another inmate's ATM card, the sentence was reduced to three years following the defendant's objection.

The incident unfolded within the confines of the Centre for



Correction and Rehabilitation, where both the defendant and victim are serving their sentences. The defendant's daring act took place while the victim slept, successfully pilfering the bank card from the security depository. Each inmate at the center receives such a card, enabling families to transfer funds for their needs.

The defendant swiftly navigated to the inmate store, indulging in a shopping spree that included purchasing cigarettes and a phone credit refill totaling BD45. Subsequently, he discarded the pilfered card in the

building courtyard, setting the stage for an unexpected turn of events.

Fortune favored the victim as another inmate stumbled upon the card and promptly

returned it. The security cameras captured the defendant's guilt, leading to a summons by the authorities. In a surprising admission, the defendant confessed to utilizing the victim's card, citing the victim's alleged theft of personal belongings as his justification.

The Public Prosecution weighed in with charges against the defendant, encompassing the use of the victim's electronic signature and card PIN for the illegal seizure of funds. Additionally, the defendant faced charges for the theft of the aforementioned card, adding layers of complexity to this unusual case within the correctional facility.

Brazil to join OPEC+ from next year

Major producer Brazil will join OPEC+ from next year, the oil cartel announced yesterday.

Brazil is among the world's top 10 producers and has been the largest oil producer in Latin America since 2016.

Its crude production hit a record 3.7 million barrels per day in September, a near 17 percent increase from the same month



last year and a 6.1 percent hike from August, according to pricing agency Argus Media.

Ministers of the 13-member Organization of the Petroleum

Exporting Countries (OPEC) headed by Saudi Arabia and its 10 partners led by Russia were meeting to discuss further output cuts to boost prices.

"The meeting welcomed Alexandre Silveira de Oliveira, Minister of Mines and Energy of the Federative Republic of Brazil, which will join the OPEC+... starting January 2024," OPEC said in a press release.

OPEC+ was born in late 2016 when Russia and nine others joined forces with the Saudi-led OPEC to prop up falling prices.

"Considering that Brazil is a large oil producer and is driving oil production growth it is im-

portant to have them on board, but it seems that they are not cutting production like Mexico, so would conclude with: good for OPEC+, less relevant for oil market balances," UBS analyst Giovanni Staunovo said.

The 23-member OPEC+ faced its biggest crisis in 2020 as countries locked down due to the Covid pandemic, sending oil demand plunging.

The group agreed in April 2020 to slash output by 9.7 mil-

lion barrels per day in order to boost sagging prices.

It began to raise production again in 2021 as the market improved.

In the most recent meetings amid plunging prices, OPEC+ members have announced voluntary cuts to boost prices.

Since the end of 2022, the alliance has implemented supply cuts of about five million barrels per day (bpd) with Saudi Arabia taking the lead.

John Travolta cheated death in Thanksgiving plane disaster

John Travolta came within minutes of being killed in a fiery crash after the plane he was flying suffered a catastrophic electrical failure.

The 'Pulp Fiction' star - who is a qualified pilot - was caught up in a mid-air disaster in November 1992 when he was flying his family from

Florida to Maine for the Thanksgiving holiday as all his electrical systems including his navigation instruments cut out during the approach to Washington, D.C.

Speaking during a question-and-answer session in London after a screening of his new short film 'The Shepherd', Travolta explained: "I actually experienced a total electrical failure, not in a Vampire but in a corporate jet over

Washington, D.C. ...

"I knew what it felt like to absolutely think you're going to die," said Travolta, who was piloting a Gulfstream II from Florida to Maine for Thanksgiving when the incident occurred. "I had two good jet engines but I had no instruments, no electric, nothing. And I thought it was over ... I had my family on board and I said: 'This is it, I can't believe I'm gonna die in this plane.'"

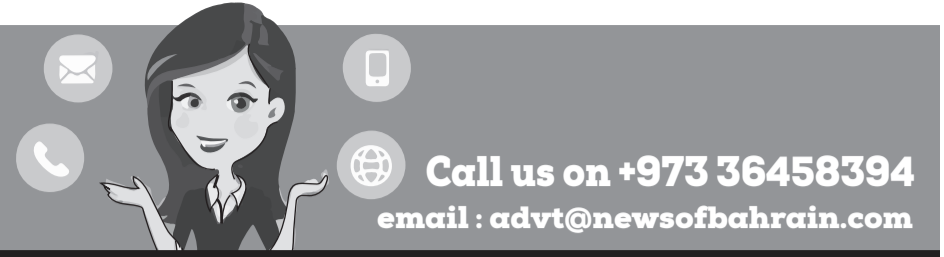

Najmul puts Bangladesh in control against New Zealand

Skipper Najmul Hossain Shanto hit his third Test century in four innings to put Bangladesh on course for a strong total in the second innings of the first Test against New Zealand in Sylhet yesterday.

The hosts reached 212-3 at stumps on the third day, leading New Zealand by 205 runs, with Najmul unbeaten on 104.

Former captain Mushfiqur Rahim made an unbeaten 43 and put on 96 runs in the unbroken fourth-wicket stand with Najmul.

Najmul, who scored a century in both innings of Bangladesh's previous Test against Afghanistan in June, also shared 90 runs with Mominul Haque for the third wicket.

The left-hander has now become the first Bangladeshi cricketer to score a hundred on his debut as Test captain.

He took his hundred, his fourth in Tests, with a single off Ajaz Patel in 191 balls before signing off the day in style with a boundary in the last ball.

The 25-year-old has struck 10 fours so far in his innings.

He was however involved in two runouts on the day, with the last being Mominul, who made 40.

Mominul praised Najmul for his “outstanding” batting.

“He knows very well about his game and has a clear mind,” Mominul said.

Patel, the only New Zealand bowler with some success on the day, trapped opener Zakir Hasan leg-before for 17.

Tim Southee directed a straight drive by Najmul onto the stumps at the non-striking



end to run out Mahmudul Hasan for eight next over.

Mominul, who joined Najmul in the rescue act, was also the hero for Bangladesh with the ball, having taken the last two New Zealand wickets in the morning.

The tourists, replying to Bang-

ladesh's first-innings 310, resumed on 266-8, still 44 runs behind.

Southee and Kyle Jamieson frustrated Bangladesh for more than an hour to share 52 runs for the ninth wicket, until left-arm spinner Mominul removed them both in the same over.

Mominul trapped Jamieson leg-before for 23 to leave New Zealand 316-9, and then bowled Southee four balls later for 35 to finish with career-best figures of 3-4.

“We definitely didn't think it was going to be easy to rock up in the second innings and knock them over,” Jamieson said.

Southee hit three boundaries in his 62-ball stay.

Head coach Aron Kristjansson will be managing the Bahrainis. According to a Bahrain Handball Association official, he is scheduled to arrive in the King-
