### BD250,000 lost in rental scam

Three Asian employees at a car dealership have been sentenced to one year in prison and deportation for embezzling BD253,631 by turning company cars into a covert rental scheme.

The trio, aided by two accomplices, used forged invoices and erased company records to siphon the proceeds, which they split among themselves. Vehicles were discreetly rented out near Andalus Park, with accomplices advertising and delivering them to renters.

The dealership's lawyer, Issa Al Wadaei, revealed how the employees abused their roles and falsified records to mask the theft. The court ordered the stolen amount to be repaid, with a related civil claim for additional damages referred to the Civil Court.

### **Former MP** fined for concealing assets

Aformer parliamentarian and current lawyer has been fined BD2,000 by the Lower Criminal Court for concealing assets during the enforcement of a court judgment.

The case involved a popular restaurant in which the defendant is a part-owner.

A court order had been issued against the restaurant, prompting enforcement proceedings.

When asked to disclose his assets, the defendant submitted a declaration omitting two vehicles.

The prosecution argued that this omission was deliberate, intended to hinder the enforcement process and conceal assets to avoid fulfilling the judgment.

The prosecution charged the defendant with obstructing enforcement proceedings and intentionally concealing assets to avoid fulfilling the judgment.

They also alleged that he failed to disclose all his assets from the date the case was filed.

### **Inflation-wary US consumers** flock to 'Black Friday' deals

Us shoppers were out in force for "Black Friday," with preliminary data showing strong online sales despite inflation nerves prompting retailers in the world's biggest economy to come up with ever more

As markets and consumers eye possible turbulence during the transition from President Joe Biden to Donald Trump, there are hopes that the year's biggest shopping season -- stretching from Thanksgiving to Christmas -- will be a bo-

The National Retail Federation (NRF) said a record 183.4 million people are planning to shop over the weekend, ticking up from 182 million last year and 18.1 million higher than 2019, before the Covid pandemic derailed the global econ-

Adobe Analytics said US consumers had spent \$7.9 billion online as of Friday afternoon, an increase of 8.2 percent over last year, with a projected final tally between \$10.7 and \$11 billion -- an e-commerce record for Black Friday.

The so-called "Black Friday" discounts day originated as a single day when shoppers poured -- sometimes stampeded -- into malls in search of incredible deals, but is now accompanied by "Small Business Saturday" and "Cyber Monday." While inflation has been largely tamed from its post-Covid spike, Americans remain wary, with consumer prices still significantly elevated above their pre-pandemic levels.

♦ Vietnam said Saturday that it will build a \$67 billion highspeed railway from Hanoi to Ho Chi Minh City, in a much-needed boost to infrastructure that is expected to drive growth and enhance its reputation among foreign investors. The railway, which will stretch more than 1,500 kilometres (930 miles) from the capital in the north to the country

Vietnam to build \$67 bn highbusiness hub in the south, will reduce the current journey time by rail from 30 hours to **speed railway** around five. "The national assembly voted to

approve... a resolution on investment policies for the high-speed railway project on the North-South axis," said a statement on Vietnam parliament's website. Vietnam's transport infrastructure is considered relatively weak, with a road network struggling to keep up with demand and an underdeveloped rail system. The expressway density is one of the lowest in the region, although Vietnam is pushing to expand it, while road transport costs are among the highest.

**The United States** has approved the proposed sale of spare parts for fighter jets and radar systems as well as communications equipment to

Taiwan, in deals valued at \$385 million, a US agency said Friday. While Washington does not have official diplomatic relations with Taipei, it remains the island's most important backer and biggest arms supplier. The proposed sale of the F-16 and radar system parts

consists of equipment in existing US military stocks and was worth an estimated \$320 million, the Defense Security Cooperation Agency said in a statement, with deliveries estimated to start in 2025. "This proposed sale serves US national, economic and security interests by supporting the recipient's continuing efforts to modernize its armed forces and to maintain a credible defensive capability," the DSCA said. "The proposed sale will improve the recipient's ability to meet current and future threats by maintaining the operational readiness of the recipient's fleet of F-16 North Korea's

◆ Russian Defence Minister Andrei Belousov met with North Korean leader Kim Jong Un and agreed to boost military cooperation between the two isolated nations, Pyongyang state media said Saturday. The United States and South Korea have accused the nuclear-armed North of sending more than 10,000 soldiers to help Russia fight Ukraine,

with experts saying Kim is eager to gain advanced technology, and battle experience for his troops, in return. Kim, who met Belousov on Friday, blasted the recent decision by Western powers to permit Kyiv to strike inside Russia with their weapons, saying it constituted a "direct military intervention in the conflict", according to KCNA. "It is an exercise of the right to self-defence for Russia to take resolute action to make the hostile forces pay the price," Kim was quoted as saying.


