# Airport passenger traffic soars to 6.9mln last year

lmost seven million passengers passed through Bahrain International Airport (BIA) in 2022.

This was confirmed during a meeting held by Bahrain Airport Company's (BAC) Airport Facilitation Committee.

BIA welcomed 6.9 million passengers, a 127.5% jump from three million in 2021, and only 29% less than pre-pandemic figures of 9.6 million in 2019.
