7orld number one Carlos Alcaraz edged closer to a US Open rematch with Italy's Jannik Sinner on Thursday as Grand Slam winners Aryna Sabalenka and Marketa Vondrousova booked their places in the third round.

Defending champion Alcaraz eased into a last 32 meeting with Britain's Dan Evans after dispatching South Africa's Lloyd Harris 6-3, 6-1, 7-6 (7/4) in 2hr ning to the last ball," 28min on the Arthur Ashe Stadium showcourt.

It means Alcaraz is just two the first man to dewins away from a potential fend the US Open quarter-final collision with since 2008, Italian sixth seed Sinner, who when Roger continued his serene progress Federer through the draw with a 6-4, hoist-6-2, 6-4 defeat of compatriot e d Lorenzo Sonego.

Last year, Alcaraz and Sinner produced an epic five-set quarter-final classic that was not completed until 2.50am local time -- the latest ever finish in US Open history.

Rohit's side will play their opening match of the tournament against Pakistan on Saturday in Pallekele, the first of three potential clashes between the bitter rivals in Sri Lanka.
