my parents returned to Bahrain. I finished my high school in 1982 and went to America. From there I again headed to the Soviet Union to study law. I got married in Kiev and authorities here did not grant me, my wife and children visas. So I went to Kuwait again and stayed there until the invasion by Iraq," he recalled. "After the Iraqi invasion, I returned to Bahrain. By then the global order had changed with the collapse of the Soviet Union. Here I did many businesses before starting my practice as a lawyer." Qaheri attributes his passion to his student life in America. "Initially I

took my mom's and aunt's recipes and began cooking for myself," he said, adding that the cooking saga continued even after his marriage with an Ukrainian woman. Among other things, Qaheri likes to make friends with people apart from interacting with youth. "I am very active on social media. I started an account under the name Bahraini cook and since then there has been no looking back. I began showcasing all my dishes along with sarcastic

Qaheri is also associated with 'Productive Families Programme' - a brainchild of the Social Development Ministry. "I am one of the beneficiaries of the project. The event had about 10,000 visitors and he would prepare special breakfasts and other dishes for many of them.
