University student's appeal against expulsion rejected by court

Bahraini university stu-Adent who was expelled for attempting to hack into the university's electronic systems has had his appeal rejected by the Administrative Court.

The court upheld the university's decision, stating that the student's actions were proven through an administrative investigation and a final criminal judgment against him.

The student had argued that the expulsion was arbitrary and excessive, claiming that the university had overreacted to his actions. He requested a reduction in the punishment.
