

significant portion of unemployed university graduates in Bahrain hold degrees in accounting, business administration, human resources, and marketing, according to new statistics released by the Ministry of Labour in response to a parliamentary inquiry by MP Jalal Kadhem.

The data indicates that 1.473 unemployed graduates hold de- versity graduates include law grees in accounting and finance, comprising 14.6% of the total graduates (bachelor's degree (782). and above).

Remarkably, 82.5% (1,216) of these unemployed accounting and finance graduates are women.

The second largest group of unemployed university graduates (1,413 or 14% of the total unemployed bachelor's degree holders) are those with degrees in business administration, human resources, and marketing.

The Ministry of Oil and Environment confirmed last month it is currently drafting legislation to address the issue, noting that existing regulations primarily cover professional fishing.

Microsoft expects to spend \$80 billion on AI this fiscal year

Microsoft president Brad Smith on Friday said the company is on track to pump about \$80 billion into artificial intelligence (AI) this fiscal year.

Smith contended AI is poised to transform all aspects of life, and it is imperative that the United States be the global leader when it comes to the technology, he wrote in an online post.

• **Russia vowed** yesterday to retaliate after it accused Ukraine of firing US-supplied ATACMS missiles at the border region of Belgorod the previous day, Outgoing US President Joe Biden authorised Kyiv to use the long-range weapons against Russia last year, in a move the Kremlin denounced as a grave escalation of the nearly threeyear conflict. "On January 3, an attempt was made from Ukrainian territory to launch a missile strike

against the Belgorod region using US-made ATACMS operational-tactical missiles,' the Russian defence ministry said. "These actions by the Kyiv regime, which is supported by Western curators, will be met with retaliation," it added, saving all the missiles were shot down. The ministry said earlier that air defences downed eight ATACMS missiles in total, without saying when or where.






