Priyanka Chopra Jonas: My daughter is not gossip!

Priyanka Chopra Jonas is “really protective” of her daughter and won’t allow her to be subjected to “gossip”. The 40-year-old actress has 15-month-old Malti Marie with pop star husband Nick Jonas and admits it was “so painful” when she was trolled for using a surrogate for her first child.

Speaking to Bella magazine, she said: “I’ve developed a tough hide when people talk about me, but it’s so painful when they talk about my daughter. I’m like, ‘Keep her out of it.’ She’s not going to be gossip.”

“I’ve been really protective of this chapter of my life with my daughter. Because it’s not about my life only. It’s her’s, too. I was in the operating room when she came out. She was so small, smaller than my hand. We spent every single day with her on my chest, on my husband’s chest. I

didn’t know if she would make it or not.”

She later revealed it was medically necessary for her to use a surrogate due to “complications”.

The ‘Citadel’ star also spoke about wanting to inspire other young women of colour to become future Hollywood stars.

She said: “Hopefully I’ll open doors for the next generation of

girls. Hopefully we’ll see more Indian or South Asian actors in Hollywood. I want to commemorate the success and achievements of South Asians outside of India, in the international sphere, because we deserve that position.”

Priyanka previously recalled the terror she and Nick felt after Malti was born three months prematurely and admitted they didn’t know if the tot would survive.

She told Britain’s Vogue magazine: “I was in the operating room when she came out. She was so small, smaller than my hand ... I saw what the intensive-care nurses do. They do God’s work.

Gwyneth Paltrow is proud of making divorces “a little bit easier”.

The 50-year-old actress announced her split from musician Chris Martin, 46, in 2014 with a post on her Goop website which revealed they were “consciously uncoupling”. And, although Gwyneth takes no credit for coming up with the concept, she believes that their amicable divorce has helped others to move forward too.

In a Q A on her Instagram, Gwyneth said: “I definitely did not coin the phrase, but I feel despite us taking quite a lot of s*** for it when we first announced

that all these years ago, I feel very proud that we were able to, maybe, make some divorces a little bit easier, happier.”

“It makes me feel pretty proud when people come up to me on the streets and say, ‘Thank you for introducing that concept because I’ve become good friends with my ex’. I’m very happy that we were able to play a small part in that cultural shift.”

The term “conscious uncoupling” was first coined by Katherine Woodward Thomas in 2009.

Speaking to Dax Shepard’s ‘Armchair Expert’ podcast in 2019, Gwyneth explained: “It is a way to circumvent [pain of divorce] and go directly to the point where we’re friends, and we remember what we loved about each other, and constantly acknowledge that we created these incredible human beings together.”

Actress Elizabeth Olsen has talked about doing her own stunts and said that there are “stunt doubles” for a reason.

During Wednesday’s episode of ‘The Late Show,’ the ‘Love & Death’ star told Stephen Colbert that she has found doing most of her stunts in the Marvel Cinematic Universe “ridiculous,” reports hollywoodreporter.com.

When specifically doing stunts attached to a wire, she said: “Your stomach leaves you. It’s like, I guess, the joy people get on roller coasters, which I don’t get, but people love that feeling.”

The ‘Godzilla’ actress said when she first started doing stunts, she would just laugh, but that she’s “definitely recovered from my giddiness. Sometimes I’m just like, ‘Okay, They do how many more of these do

you want? I can do this all day,’ kind of thing. But sometimes I get a little freaked out.”

She even recalled filming a stunt for Doctor Strange in the Multiverse of Madness, where she had to be dropped from 30 feet in the air.

“They wanted to drop me pretty quickly so that it looked like it had an impact, but I kept landing like Peter Pan, kind of like fencing,” she said. “I was like, ‘Just use the double. This is so ridiculous.”

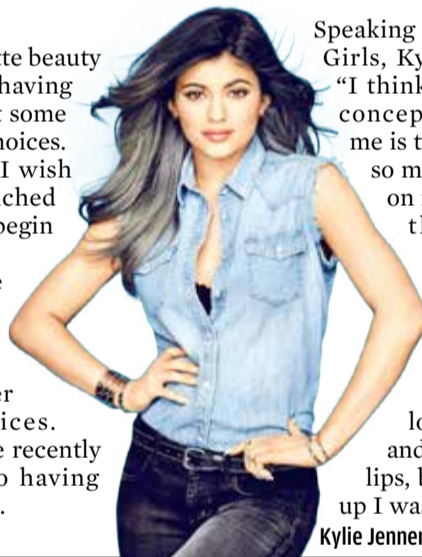
things I did.”
