erena Williams continues her quest for a record-equalling 24th Grand Slam title in the French Open third round yesterday as the highest-ranked player left in her half of the draw, while Alexander Zverev cruised into the last 16 for the fourth straight year.

World number four Aryna Sabalenka, who was the highest-seeded women's player still in the tournament, was dumped out by Russia's Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova in yesterday's early

The Belarusian third seed, who has never reached a Grand Slam quarter-final, slumped to a 6-4, 2-6, 6-0 defeat.

The 31st-seeded Pavlyuchenkova will next face Victoria Azater-final against Williams up for grabs.

"There is far more to come and we are looking forward to our next steps with ambition and much anticipation."


