

**The Indian Club Bahrain set to host International Series Badminton Tournament 2023**

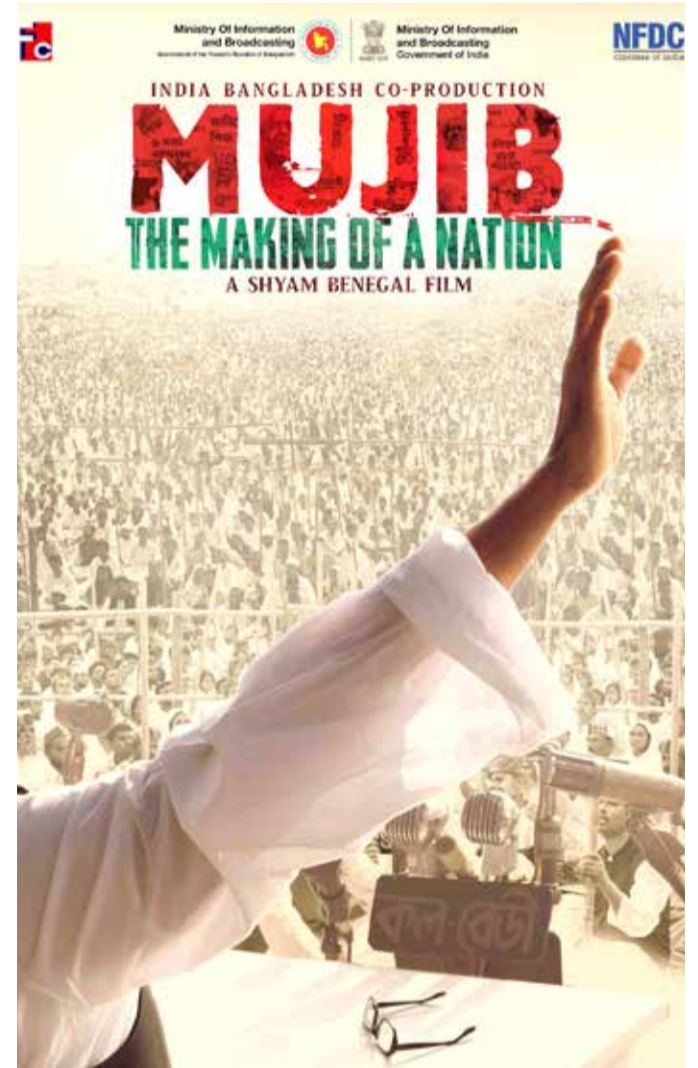


**PWA Refreshment Drive**
