BBK posts Q3, nine-month profit

LMRA conducts 1,344 inspection campaigns, visits

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) announced the completion of 1,344 inspection campaigns and visits from 27 October to 2 November 2024, resulting in the detention of 30 irregular workers and the deportation of 197 violators.

The inspections revealed multiple breaches related to various regulatory laws, particularly the Labour Market Regulatory Authority and Residency Laws in the Kingdom of Bahrain, with legal actions taken against observed violations.

The LMRA reported that 1,316 inspection visits were conducted across shops in all governorates, in addition to 28 joint campaigns; 17 in the Capital Governorate, 5 in Muharraq, 2 in the Northern Governorate, and 4 in the Southern Governorate.

Bahrain unveils landmark sports destination project

Truck violations

The General Directorate of Traffic registered 768 violations by heavy trucks in October, including driving during the peak hours, crossing the speed limits, wrong overtaking, and not following safety rules such as tyres and lights.

The law enforcement campaigns on heavy trucks include violations of load rules, risking the loads to fall on the road causing accidents and hindering traffic.

The General Directorate asserted the significance of trucks following the specific traffic rules for them, including periodic maintenance.

Focus on Bahrain investment opportunities



His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, chaired the weekly Cabinet Meeting yesterday at Gudaibiya Palace. The Cabinet commended the Bahrain Economic Development Board and other agencies for their efforts in coordinating the Forum, noting the high level of international participation and the opportunities it provides for potential investment in the Kingdom of Bahrain and the region. It also emphasised the Forum's role in enhancing insights on responding to economic developments.

Powering up trust

EWA holding off on overdue bills for Bahraini citizens, but shift to 'privatisation' looms

Power cuts have been kept at bay for over a year, as the Electricity and Water Authority (EWA) refrains from pursuing overdue bills, focusing instead on building public trust, says Collections Head Noura Al Neama.

She reassured citizens that while unpaid bills aren't "currently" being enforced, there's ongoing collaboration with banks to ease the strain for those in arrears.

Muharraq Municipal Council member Fadhel Al Oud, however, warned that a shift towards privatisation could see the authority adopting draconian debt collection tactics, raising fears of cut-offs that could push many into borrowing to settle their debts.

At a council session yesterday, Al Neama shed light on the authority's approach, explaining that it needs a steady revenue stream to maintain services, hence the recent introduction of a fixed deduction service to make payments manageable.

Meanwhile, partnerships with

local banks, including the National Bank of Bahrain, offer low-interest loans with extended repayment terms, providing a lifeline for citizens grappling with overdue bills.

Ongoing talks with CrediMax may further ease the load, giving customers the option to pay off bills interest-free when using their card.

Al Oud voiced his unease over potential privatisation, cautioning that turning the EWA into a private entity could mean draconian enforcement or even cut-offs for those behind on pay-

ments — a situation he believes would force many to take out loans, a burden they're ill-prepared to shoulder.

Transition

He noted that recent news suggests EWA's transition to a private company may be implemented in the near future.

"A repayment plan would be far better than driving people into debt," he argued, noting that citizens deserve relief from mounting financial pressures rather than added burdens.

Adding to the debate, council

member Ahmed Al Moqahwi brought attention to sudden power outages reported by residents.

He urged the authority to notify council members in advance of any planned disconnections, allowing them to assist residents in finding solutions before the lights go out.

Unacceptable

Al Moqahwi made it clear that unexpected cut-offs are unacceptable, particularly for families who need time to address their payments.

In response, Al Neama reaffirmed her earlier assurances, noting that no disconnections have occurred since the new system was introduced last year — a move intended to strengthen the authority's bond with the public.

She added that citizens now receive reminders of overdue amounts and deadlines on their bills, with additional alerts sent out beforehand.

Ali Fareed, Head of Customer Services, explained that the call centre operates 24/7, allowing customers to set up payment plans.

Eco-friendly activity

Gateway Gulf 2024 Concludes

Highlights GCC's Transformative Growth and Opportunities

The second edition of Gateway Gulf 2024, hosted by the Bahrain Economic Development Board (Bahrain EDB), wrapped up on Monday, spotlighting the Gulf Cooperation Council's (GCC) accelerating economic transformation.

Drawing a distinguished crowd of 250 ministers and global business and industry leaders, the forum underscored key high-growth sectors such as tourism, manufacturing, banking, and sports and leisure.

A key focus was how deeper integration among GCC member states can supercharge growth across these industries. During the panel 'Tourism as a Growth Accelerator in the GCC', H.E. Fatima bint Jaffer Al Sairafi, Bahrain's Minister of Tourism, emphasized tourism's role in economic diversification. She detailed Bahrain's Tourism Strategy 2022-2026, underscoring the

potential of marketing the GCC as a cohesive destination. Al Sairafi stressed the importance of collaborative government efforts to foster an environment where the private sector can flourish.

H.E. Khalid Humaidan, Governor of the Central Bank of Bahrain, shared forward-thinking perspectives on banking in the session 'The Next Ten Years

of Banking'. He highlighted the sector's digital transformation, advocating for the adoption of advanced technologies like AI, cloud computing, and blockchain. Humaidan balanced his vision with a focus on regulatory adherence and consumer protection. He proudly noted that Bahrainis make up 79% of the nation's financial workforce,

emphasizing the need for ongoing talent development and greater industry participation.

Meanwhile, H.E. Khalid Al Rumaihi, Chairman of Aluminium Bahrain (Alba), discussed opportunities in metals and manufacturing. Al Rumaihi pointed to Alba's global aluminium success as a springboard for developing downstream industries. He called for increased local content production, leveraging regional partnerships, and advancing renewable energy and Industry 4.0.

Shaikh Salman bin Isa Al Khalifa, CEO of Bahrain International Circuit, reflected on Formula One's immense impact on Bahrain's global visibility. Since 2004, F1 has attracted over 80 million viewers, with the venue hosting 363 events in 2023. Al Khalifa highlighted the sport's economic contributions and its role in skill development, noting its expansion influence on the wider region.

Gateway Gulf 2024: A \$12 Billion Success

Gateway Gulf 2024 concluded triumphantly, marking over \$12 billion in deals across 32 pivotal announcements.

The landmark event underscored Bahrain's emphasis on bolstering non-oil sectors and highlighted major trade and investment opportunities across the Gulf region.

In finance, Al Salam Bank launched ASB Capital, a newly established DFSA-licensed Category 3A asset management firm, poised to reshape asset management services across key markets. Investcorp announced strategic initiatives aimed at expanding its global investment footprint, while SICO Bank introduced a new suite of diversified investment products to strengthen financial market offerings. J.P. Morgan Payments committed to hiring technologists in Bahrain, a move expected to enhance the local digital workforce. Meanwhile, Singapore Gulf Bank debuted corporate banking services tailored to the evolving needs of the global digital economy.

Digital advancements featured prominently. ARRAY Innovation signed strategic partnerships with the National Bank of Bahrain, Aluminium Bahrain (Alba), and the Labour Fund (Tamkeen), driving enterprise software, AI, and machine learning solutions. Beyon unveiled plans for a

cutting-edge digital city and signed a development agreement with Edamah, a key step toward transforming Bahrain's digital landscape.

The manufacturing sector saw significant progress. Alba and Daiki Aluminium reaffirmed plans to establish a sustainable aluminium dross processing facility, promoting environmental stewardship. Racing Force Group, alongside Bahrain International Circuit, celebrated the completion of the Bell Racing Helmets factory extension and broke ground on a new open manufacturing production facility. Bahrain reduces security deposit for foreign worker agencies

Minister of Labour and Chairman of the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA), His Excellency Jameel Humaidan, has issued Decision No. (4) of 2024, amending Article (6) of the decision regulating the licensing of worker supply agencies.

The new decision reduces the security deposit required from agencies supplying foreign workers to Bahrain.

Previously, agencies were required to pay a BD200 security deposit for each worker brought to the Kingdom.

The amended decision, published in the Official Gazette, lowers this deposit to BD150 per worker.

The revised Article (6) now mandates that licensees deposit BD150 for each work permit issued, in addition to the pre-

scribed work permit fee.

This deposit serves as insurance with the LMRA.

The change aims to streamline the insurance mechanisms related to work permits.

The reduction in the security deposit is expected to ease the financial burden on recruitment agencies while maintaining the regulatory oversight intended to ensure responsible labor practices.

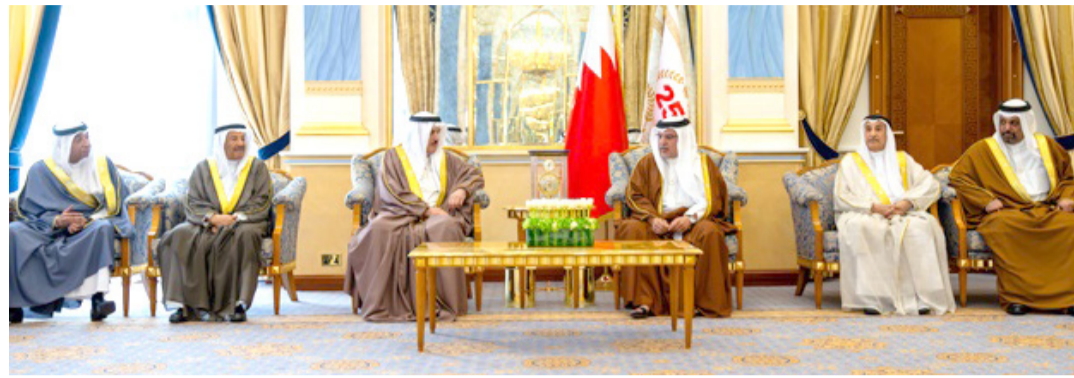

Financial rescue

BD500 million relief fund for citizens proposed to ease rising costs of living

With rising debt and living costs creeping up, the Parliament is considering a BD500 million relief plan to help households manage their expenses.

MP Khalid Buanaq warns that without action, many families may soon struggle to "put food on the table".

He points to flat wages and soaring bills as a "ticking time bomb" for the country.

Speaking to The Daily Tribune, Buanaq said, "Low pay poses a real threat, especially given that wages have stayed the same over the past decade".

Joblessness

He expressed his duty to voice the concerns of his area and the country as a whole, particularly as joblessness rises.

At the core of Buanaq's plan is securing this fund within Bahrain's 2025-2026 budget to ease the strain on citizens.

His proposal includes using part of the public debt — now at BD18 billion — to provide support.

Social benefits

This would involve raising social benefits for those most in need, offering direct cash support to help low-income families, and increasing assistance with utility costs such as electricity and water.

Buanaq's approach aims to target support where it's needed most, bridging gaps and building a stronger community.

He is also advocating for better pay and bonuses in the public sector to bring workers more security and motivation.

Expanding public sector roles, he believes, would help reduce joblessness and boost local demand.

He views this BD500 million

fund as a genuine means to improve living standards for Bahrainis, providing a clear path to enhance everyday life.

Social stability

He argues that such spending would reinforce social stability and encourage a shared sense of well-being, making a better quality of life more achievable.

Buanaq said that this plan aligns well with government goals and should be a priority in the upcoming budget, paving the way for a more prosperous and stable Bahrain.

Family relief as Parliament set to vote on seniority-based housing proposal

After waiting over 15 years for housing, some Bahraini families in cramped quarters may soon see relief, as Parliament is expected to vote on a proposal today that would prioritise seniority for housing allocation.

Backed by the Public Utilities and Environment Committee, the proposal urges the government to decide housing distribution purely based on how long applicants have been waiting, ignoring regional quotas.

This approach aims to prioritise those who have endured the longest waits, addressing what many see as a long overdue response to housing demands, especially in Bahrain's busiest areas.

The committee points to two core principles in Bahrain's Constitution: Article 9, which guarantees housing for citizens

on limited incomes, and Article 18, which ensures equal rights and duties for all without bias.

The seniority-based plan, they argue, would not only address the pressing need for housing but also uphold these principles of fair and equal treatment, giving applicants a fair chance, regardless of their location.

The proposal, championed by Second Deputy Speaker Ahmed Qarata and MP Jalal Kadhem

Hassan, alongside three other MPs, seeks to tackle the severe housing shortage in the Capital Governorate.

Projects

With land for new projects scarce and rents high, many families are forced into small, overcrowded spaces, living without privacy or adequate room.

These conditions have driven the call for a practical solution.

Article 9(c) of the Constitution obliges the government to provide housing for low-income citizens, viewing it as a fundamental part of Bahrain's social foundation.

Article 18 further guarantees that all citizens are treated equally, without favouritism.

The committee believes that making seniority the standard for allocation would honour these rights, creating a fairer system and easing disparities across the country.

BBK posts Q3, nine-month profit

BBK announced its financial results for the period ended 30th September 2024, recording net profit of BD 53.0 m including the 3rd quarter of 2024 net profit of BD 16.5 m.

Third quarter

The Bank achieved net profit attributable to the owners of the Bank of BD 16.5 m, 15.4% lower compared to the same period last year at BD 19.5 m. Earnings per share for the third quarter stood at 9 fils, compared to 11 fils for the same period of last year. The lower net profit was mainly due to higher provisioning during the quarter.

Total comprehensive income attributable to the owners of the Bank amounted to BD 20.7 m during the third quarter of 2024, compared to BD 23.7 m for the same period of last year, recording a decrease of 12.7%. Despite other comprehensive income remaining stable at BD

4.2 m, the decline is primarily due to the lower net profit recorded for the period.

The net fees and commission income increased from BD

10.1 m to BD 13.5 m, recording a growth of 33.7%, while investment and other income experienced a growth of 39.6% increasing from BD 11.1 m to BD 15.5 m. 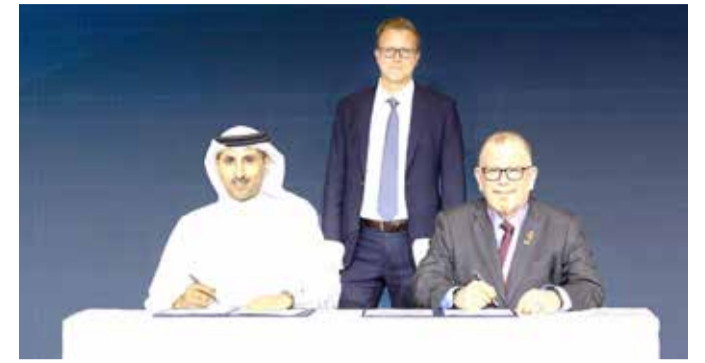

Eight OPEC+ members extend oil supply cuts until year end

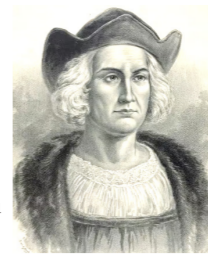
Eight members of the OPEC+ group of oil-producing nations said on Sunday they were extending supply cuts until the end of December.

The eight countries "have agreed to extend the November 2023 voluntary production adjustments of 2.2 million barrels per day for one month until the end of December 2024", the Vienna-based Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries said in a

statement.

The eight from the 22-member group extending the cuts are leaders Saudi Arabia and Russia, as well as Algeria, Iraq, Kazakhstan, Kuwait, Oman and the United Arab Emirates.

OPEC+ ministers are due to meet in early December in Vienna at the group's headquarters, but with Sunday's announcement, the eight countries have already decided not to reopen the taps until at least early 2025.

Russia to launch private Iranian satellites into orbit

A Russian rocket will launch two privately built Iranian satellites into orbit early Tuesday, the Iranian embassy in Moscow said.

The two countries have deepened ties and trade amid Russia's military offensive on Ukraine and conflict in the Middle East, with space launches just one aspect of their burgeoning partnership.

The imaging and communications satellites were designed and built by Iran's Omid Faza Company, the statement said, and will support agriculture, environmental monitoring and communications in remote areas.

Israel tells UN it is cutting ties with Palestinian aid agency

Israel formally notified the United Nations of its decision to sever ties with the agency supporting Palestinian refugees, it said Monday, after lawmakers voted to ban the organisation vital to the occupied territories.

The ban, which sparked global condemnation including from key Israeli backer the United States, should come into force in late January, with the UN Security Council warning it would have severe consequences for millions of Palestinians.

Israel has accused a dozen employees of the agency, UNRWA, of participating in the October 7, 2023 attack by Hamas, the deadliest in Israeli history.

Israeli settlers torched nearly 20 cars early Monday in the occupied West Bank city of Al-Bireh near Ramallah, according to the Palestinian civil defence and an Israeli security source.

An AFP journalist saw several cars completely charred, and the

blacked facade of the five-storey building outside which they were parked. An alert rang "at 3:30am (0130 GMT) signalling that settlers entered the area and committed acts of vandalism", said Rami Omar, head of the local civil defence office.

Israeli police, soldiers and Shin Bet security agency officers collected evidence in Al-Bireh for the investigation, the official added.

Israel's retaliatory campaign has killed 43,341 people in Gaza, a majority of them civilians, according to figures from the Ha-

considers to be reliable.

'UNRWA or nothing'

Jonathan Fowler, a UNRWA spokesman, told AFP the ban would probably cause the collapse of aid efforts to Gaza.

"If this law is implemented, it would be likely to cause the collapse of the international humanitarian operation in the Gaza Strip -- an operation of which UNRWA is the backbone," Fowler told AFP.

But Israel has dismissed the argument on Gaza, saying only a part of aid was being delivered into the territory by UNRWA.

Residents of Nur Shams camp in the occupied West Bank were fearful for the future after an Israeli raid last week damaged the UNRWA office there.

The 13,000 inhabitants of the camp near the northern city of Tulkarem depend heavily on UNRWA. "For us, it's UNRWA or nothing," Shafiq Ahmad Jad, who runs a phone shop in the camp, told AFP.

Hezbollah says launched 'big rocket salvo' at Israel's Safed

Lebanon's Iran-backed Hezbollah group said it fired rockets at the northern Israeli city of Safed on Monday, the latest attack in more than a month of war.

Hezbollah fighters launched a "big rocket salvo" at the city, the group said in a statement.

Modi condemns 'deliberate' Canada Hindu temple attack

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday condemned a "deliberate attack" on a Hindu temple in Canada blamed by some on Sikh activists, as already frosty bilateral ties plunged to a fresh low.

"I strongly condemn the deliberate attack on a Hindu temple in Canada," Modi said in a statement on X. "Equally appalling are the cowardly attempts to intimidate our diplomats".

"Such acts of violence will never weaken India's resolve. We expect the Canadian government to ensure justice and uphold the rule of law," Modi added.

Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau earlier said that the violence at the Hindu temple on Sunday in Brampton, about 50 kilometres (30

miles) northwest of Toronto, was "unacceptable". Video circulating on social media appears to show individuals carrying yellow Khalistan flags clashing with a rival group, including people holding Indian flags. There were also isolated fist fights, videos show.

India's foreign ministry spokesman Randhir Jaiswal had earlier said the attack on the temple was carried "perpetrated by extremists and separatists", and asked Canada to "ensure that all places of worship are protected" from such attacks.

"We also expect that those indulging in violence will be prosecuted," he added.

"We remain deeply concerned about the safety and security of Indian nationals in Canada".

36 dead in bus crash in Indian Himalayas

A bus in India plunged into a deep Himalayan ravine yesterday, killing at least 36 passengers and injuring several others, a government official said Monday.

Photographs released by government rescue teams showed the crumpled wreckage of the bus in thick undergrowth, with the twisted front of the vehicle squashed nearly flat.

Road accidents are common along the many mountainous roads in the Himalayan region, caused mostly by poor maintenance and reckless driving in the tortuous terrain.

"So far, 36 casualties have been confirmed," Deepak Rawat, a senior official from the northern state of Uttarakhand told reporters.

"Three critically injured have been sent to hospital using a helicopter."

A human chain of volunteers lined the steep slopes, and across a rushing river, helping pull out the wounded from the remains of the bus. Dead bodies were carried out and laid on the back of a truck.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi offered his "deepest condolences to those who have lost their loved ones in the unfortunate road accident".

Modi's office said in a statement that the families of those killed would receive 200,000 rupees (\$2,380) in support, while those injured would get 50,000 (\$595).

Final US campaign blitz for Harris and Trump

Bitter rivals Kamala Harris and Donald Trump embark on a final frenzied campaign blitz Monday with both hitting must-win Pennsylvania on the last day of a tight and volatile US presidential election campaign.

Republican Trump has promised a "landslide" as he seeks a

sensational return to the White House, while Democrat Harris said the "momentum" was on the side of her bid to be America's first woman president.

But the polls suggest a different story on the eve of Election Day -- total deadlock in surveys nationally and in the seven swing states where the result is expected to be decided.

The world is anxiously watching the election, which is set to have profound implications for conflicts in the Middle East and Russia's war in Ukraine, and for tackling climate change.

Now a race of dramatic twists, including two bids to kill Trump and Harris's shock late entrance, is coming down to the most viciously fought-over battleground.

Harris will spend the whole day campaigning in the rust-belt state of Pennsylvania, culminating in a huge rally in Philadelphia featuring singer Lady Gaga. Trump will travel to North Carolina, Pennsylvania and then Michigan.

In a sign of how crucial Pennsylvania is to occupying the Oval Office, Trump and Harris will hold dueling rallies in the industrial city of Pittsburgh.

The battle grounds

Under the Electoral College system, the candidate who secures 270 out of 538 votes wins, with battleground states playing a decisive role.

Pennsylvania (19 electoral votes) was narrowly won by Trump in 2016 and by Biden in 2020. Harris is emphasizing infrastructure and manufacturing investments, while Trump appeals to rural voters.

Georgia (16) saw Biden as the first Democrat to win since 1992, but Trump is optimistic, buoyed by a delayed state indictment.

North Carolina (16) remains competitive, with demographic shifts favoring Harris, though a scandal involving a Republican

Pennsylvania is the single biggest swing state prize under the US Electoral College system, which awards influence in line with population.

'You're fired'

official may impact Trump. Michigan (15) returned to the Democrats in 2020, but Harris risks losing support among Arab Americans over US policy on Gaza.

Arizona (11) was narrowly won by Biden in 2020, with immigration a key issue as Harris promises to revive border policy.

Wisconsin (10) flipped Democratic in 2020, with Harris and Trump now in a close race.

Nevada (6) hasn't voted Republican since 2004. Harris has recently gained ground by focusing on small business support and inflation.

These states, each carrying critical electoral votes, will likely determine the outcome of the 2024 election.

Both sides say they are encouraged by early turnout numbers, with over 78 million people having voted already, around half of the total number of ballots cast in 2020.

The closeness of the 2024

White House race reflects a deeply divided United States, as it chooses between two candidates whose visions could scarcely be more different.

Former president Trump has doubled down on his dark and violent rhetoric in his pursuit of a second term which would make him the first convicted felon and, at 78, the oldest major party candidate ever elected.

Vice President Harris, 60, has meanwhile made an astonishing rise to the top of the Democratic ticket after President Joe Biden dropped out of the race in July.

Harris is hoping abortion is a key issue that can hurt Trump, especially with woman voters, while Trump has focused on migrants and the economy and dubbed political opponents the "enemy from within."

They have both embarked on a zig-zag through the swing states, with raucous rallies, podcast interviews to reach reluctant voters, and stunts such as Trump riding in a trash truck and Harris appearing on television comedy show "Saturday Night Live."

'We have momentum'

For Harris's part, after some more encouraging recent polls, she told a noisy rally in Michigan on Sunday that "we have momentum -- it's on our side."

Harris also courted the large Arab-American community in Michigan that has denounced US handling of the Israel-Hamas war, saying she would do "everything in my power to end the war in Gaza."

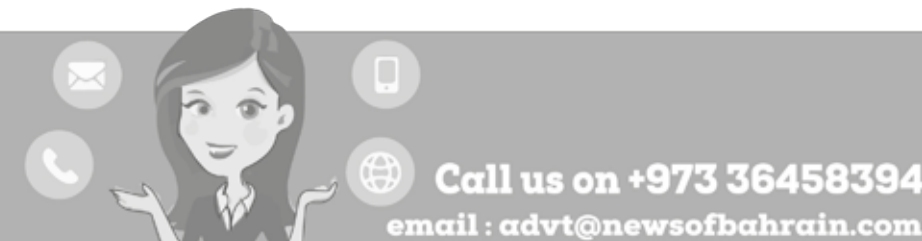
The final days of the campaign have seen both candidates roll out high-profile surrogates.

Trump-supporting tech tycoon Elon Musk has been making \$1 million giveaways to registered voters, while Harris has called on the star power of former president Barack Obama and ex-first lady Michelle Obama and singer Beyonce.

But outgoing President Biden, 81, has been notably absent from the trail since a gaffe in which he referred to Trump's supporters as "garbage" last week.

Biden will spend most of the last day of the campaign at the White House, while Harris will start her day with an event in his hometown of Scranton, Pennsylvania.

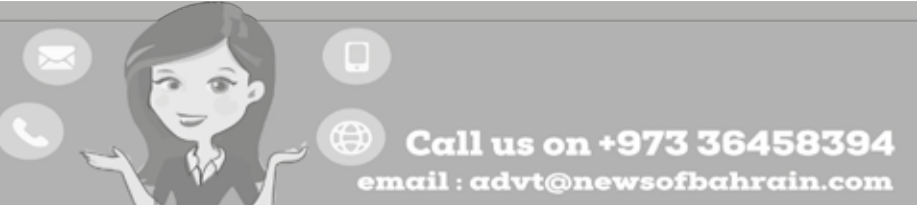

Verstappen strikes title blow with chaotic Brazilian GP win, Norris sixth

Three-time world champion Max Verstappen produced a virtuoso drive in often atrocious conditions to regain control of this year's world championship on Sunday when he charged from 17th on the grid to win the Brazilian Grand Prix.

Without a win in 10 races since the Spanish Grand Prix in May, Red Bull's series leader made light of the chaotic, rain-swept conditions to register a 62nd career triumph and fastest lap while nearest title rival Lando Norris of McLaren went from pole position to sixth.

The Dutchman's triumph lifted him to 393 points, increasing his advantage over Norris, on 331, to 62 with just three Grands Prix and one sprint race remaining.

Verstappen finished 19.477 seconds ahead of Alpine's French duo of Esteban Ocon and

Pierre Gasly with Mercedes' George Russell fourth and Charles Leclerc fifth for Ferrari in a tumultuous contest of accidents, two red-flag stoppages, penalties and planned post-race investigations.

For Alpine, the reward was a leap from ninth to sixth in the constructors championship, re-

portedly valued at an estimated \$50 million.

Norris, who struggled to find his usual pace, came home sixth ahead of McLaren team-mate Oscar Piastri, RB's Yuki Tsunoda and Liam Lawson and seven-time champion Lewis Hamilton in the second Mercedes.

India faces backlash after whitewash

Aging stars Kohli and Rohit under fire as New Zealand seal historic 3-0 triumph on Indian soil

● India suffer first home Test series whitewash since 1999-2000

● Batting collapses and inability to handle spin expose team's problems

● Rohit and Kohli's poor form a major concern ahead of Australia tour

Virat Kohli and Rohit Sharma came under fire yesterday as India chucked over a 3-0 Test series home defeat to New Zealand, with critics calling the team ageing and low on confidence.

The cricket superpower went down by 25 runs on Sunday in the third Test inside three days at Mumbai for only their second series whitewash at home.

It sealed New Zealand's historic first-ever Test series triumph on Indian soil.

For India there is little time to fix things -- they travel to Australia for a five-match Test series starting on November 22.

"Losing 3-0 at home is a tough pill to swallow and it calls for introspection," former skipper Sachin Tendulkar wrote on social media.

"Was it lack of preparation,

was it poor shot selection or was it lack of match practice?"

India went into the series against the Black Caps second in the ICC Test rankings, behind Australia, and as clear favourites.

But repeated batting collapses -- they were 46 all out in their first innings in the opening Test -- set alarm bells ringing.

It hardly got much better from there.

"I accept the fact that we were not good enough with the bat in the entire series," said skipper Rohit.

It particularly showed up the Indian batsmen's surprising inability to handle spinners on turning pitches in their own backyard.

Mitchell Santner took 13 wick-

ets in the second match while Mumbai-born New Zealander Ajaz Patel took 11 in the third Test to condemn India.

Lack of motivation?

With Australia looming large, the form of 37-year-old Rohit and superstar batsman Kohli,

35, is of particular concern to Indian cricket fans.

Rohit made 91 runs in three matches. Kohli just 93.

"The cold fact is that this is now a team in transition with key figures ageing, out of form and low on confidence," the Times of India newspaper wrote.

"Two of their stalwarts, Rohit Sharma and Virat Kohli, seem to be in a state of terminal batting decline with a strange reluctance to acknowledge it and take corrective action like polishing their game by playing in domestic cricket," it added.

Indian media reported that all senior players, including Rohit and Kohli, had been advised to play the domestic Duleep Trophy four-day matches, but the

players refused due to a "lack of motivation".

"They should have had some practice, definitely," former India captain Sunil Gavaskar told the Indian Express.

"I know we beat Bangladesh and therefore it looked as if it was going to be a cakewalk against New Zealand," Gavaskar added.

"But New Zealand, obviously, had a better attack, with cricketers who have played in India and in the IPL, who have a sense of what Indian pitches do."

Rohit and Kohli retired from T20 cricket after the team's World Cup triumph in June.

Spinner Ravichandran Ashwin, 38, and Ravindra Jadeja, 35, also suddenly look like age is catching up with them, critics said.

Cummins leads Australia to tight ODI win over Pakistan

Pat Cummins' unbeaten 32 seals two-wicket win in first ODI against Pakistan

Skipper Pat Cummins kept his cool under pressure with a gritty unbeaten 32 to steer Australia to a nervy two-wicket defeat of Pakistan in the first of three one-day internationals yesterday.

Chasing 204, they reached the target with 99 balls to spare at the Melbourne Cricket Ground, surviving a huge scare when they lost three wickets in five balls.

"Wonderful match but it got a little tighter than I would have

liked it there," said Cummins.

With Mitchell Marsh and Travis Head on paternity leave, the world champions had a new-looking opening partnership in Jake Fraser-McGurk and Matt Short.

But Short lasted just four balls before top-edging to Saim Ayub off Shaheen Shah Afridi while Fraser-McGurk's luck ran out on 16, slapping Naseem Shah to Irfan Khan at mid-on.

The experienced Steve Smith steadied the ship alongside Josh Inglis.

They put on 85 for the third wicket before Smith was undone by Haris Rauf on 44, well caught by Ayub at backward point.

Inglis followed for 49 soon after going for a big hit off Afridi, taken by Khan on his knees.

And when Rauf removed Marnus Labuschagne (16) three balls later, then Glenn Maxwell for a golden duck, Australia were suddenly 139-6 and it was game on.

Mohammad Hasnain bowled Aaron Hardie (10) and Sean Abbott (13) was guilty of a lazy run out, leaving the hosts needing 19 runs and two wickets left, with

Cummins and Mitchell Starc (two) seeing them home.

"Really happy with how the guys bowled, everyone played their roles beautifully," Cummins added.

"Obviously we need to try and find some partnerships (in the batting)."

In Pakistan's first 50-over game since last year's World Cup, Starc broke through in the third over with Ayub chopping onto his stumps.

That brought Babar Azam to the crease, unburdened by the captaincy after quitting last month.

He upped the tempo before Starc struck again, with Abdullah Shafique caught behind for

a tame 12.

Azam put on 39 with Rizwan before spinner Adam Zampa entered the fray and broke the partnership, bowling Azam for 37 with his fourth delivery.

His replacement Kamran Ghulam lasted just six balls, no match for a brutal Cummins bouncer, gloving to wicketkeeper Inglis to leave Pakistan struggling on 70-4 after 19 overs.

A patient Rizwan played himself in, but the wickets kept falling.

Salman Agha was smartly taken at square leg for 12 by Short off Abbott and Rizwan then departed attempting a sweep from part-time spinner Labuschagne.

Afridi hit an entertaining 24, but Starc again struck, rattling his middle stump, before a late flurry, with Shag adding a quick-fire 40.
