

Hotel Clash Heats Up

High Civil Court refers over half-a-million-dinars rental dispute to Bahrain Chamber

he High Civil Court has referred a high-stakes rental dispute involving a prestigious hotel owner and its tenant to the Bahrain Chamber for dispute settlement in economic, financial, and investment matters.

The court cited the Real Estate Sector Regulatory Law, asserting its lack of jurisdiction due to the claim amount surpassing half a million Bahraini dinars.

an engineering expert's report, claimed BD580 in losses due to changes in the hotel's classification and outstanding debts resulting from mismanagement.

On the contrary, the defendant argued their right to withhold rent for necessary repairs and additions. They emphasised their good-faith entry into the hotel management contract, asserting they were unaware of the hotel's actual condition.

As the court emphasised its obligation to assess jurisdiction independently, the case was referred to the Bahrain Chamber. The chamber, with authority over disputes exceeding BD500,000 in lease contracts, will scrutinise evidence and arguments from both parties before delivering a




