Bahraini film wins award at Russian festival

The "Sheikh Al Tanweer" (Shaikh of Enlightenment) film continued clinching international prizes, the latest of which was the "Best Director" award granted to its Director, Eva Daoud, by HALO International Film Festival, held in Saint Petersburg, Russia.

The film, produced by the Shaikh Ebrahim bin Mohammed Al Khalifa Centre marking its 20th anniversary, was praised by the festival's jury, and appreciated by the audience.

Sponsored by the Economic Development Board (EDB), Batelco, and the Gulf Petrochemical Industries Company (GPIC), the film depicts places as memories of nations.

It reflects the vision of the centre and its management that there are no dilapidated houses, but rather homes whose people have stopped loving them.

Al Qaeda confirms top figure killed in Yemen strike

Al Qaeda yesterday confirmed the death of a senior figure in the jihadist network's Yemen branch in a suspected US air strike last month, SITE Intelligence Group reported.

Security and local government sources told AFP on Wednesday Hamad bin Hamoud Al Tamimi had been killed, identifying him as a top leader of Al Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula (AQAP), which Washington regards as among the group's most dangerous branches.

Tamimi, who is also known as Abdel Aziz Al Adnani, died in a drone strike on February 26 that targeted his residence in war-torn Yemen's northern Marib province, according to the statement reported by SITE, which monitors jihadist websites.

The statement identified him as a "media official" who "previously managed external operations in the group."

Bahrain International Circuit (BIC), "The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East", announced yesterday a record sell-out crowd for the final day of the Formula 1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix 2023.

The 36,000 spectators who witnessed another incredible race under the lights in Sakhir was the highest single day attendance in the race's 19-year history, with a total of 99,500 attending over the weekend.

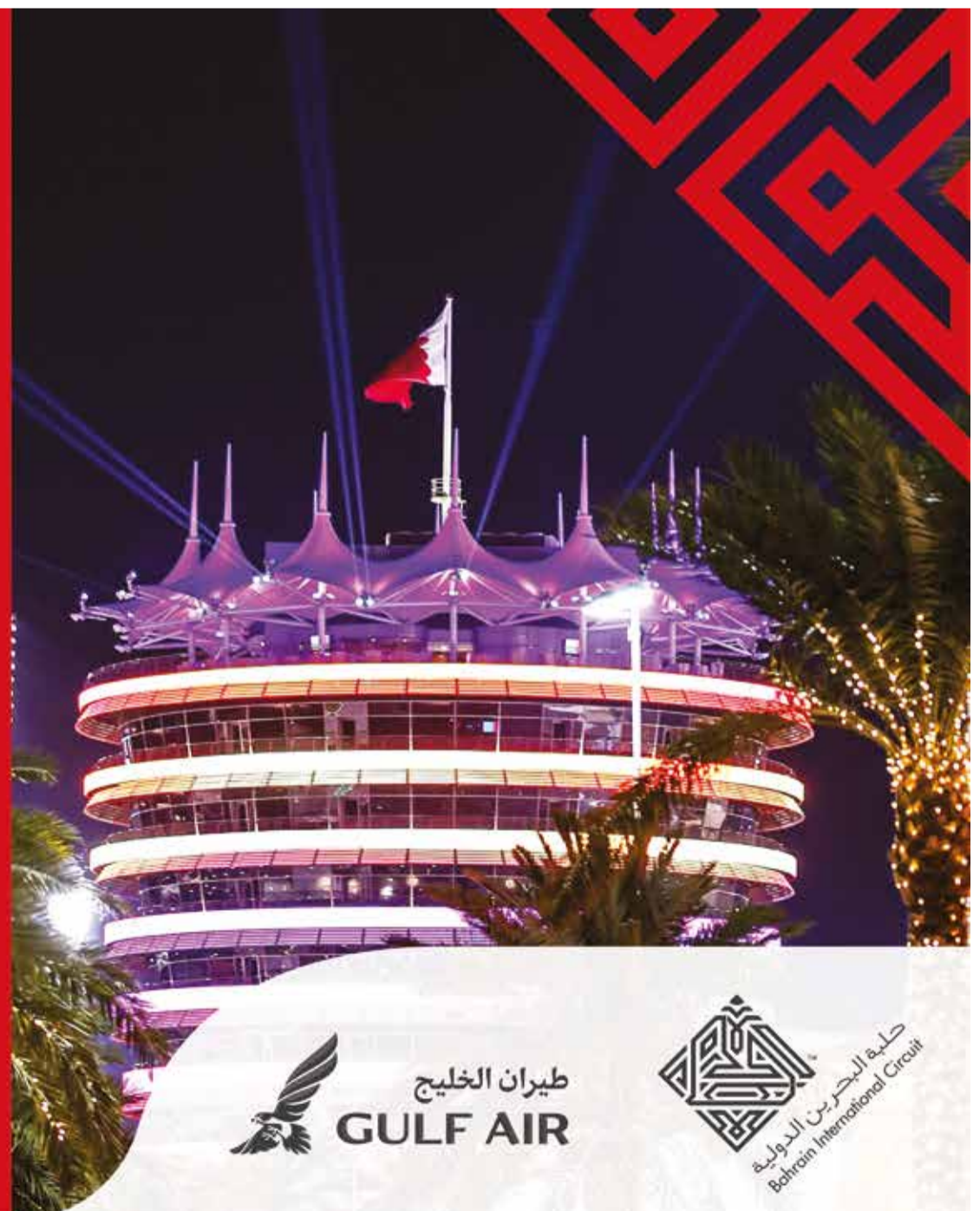

Women's participation in motorsport growing

Women's participation in motorsport has thoroughly increased in recent years, thanks to the growing trend of fans' acceptance towards women joining the sport.

Faten Amin, the first Bahraini woman to be recognised in the FIA Volunteers and Officials Awards as Best Chief Observer of the Year, told The Daily Tribune: "There are a variety of barriers women face in any sport, however, the main obstacle involves the community's acceptance to women participating in a male-dominated field.

"Many possess the perception that motorsport is only associated with men, which is simply not true, and we are seeing this start to change."

Over recent years, female sport has significantly risen, creating a sense of normalcy around women's participation in the sport.

"With time, I have seen the barriers women face slowly fade as perceptions and opinions start to change with new generations, and with this, we are starting to see more women joining the sport," Faten said.

Motorsport has significantly evolved in technical terms over the years; however, Faten noted that seeing women's involvement in the sport is crucial, especially for young fans seeing a role model to look up to.

"It is great seeing more wom-

en in motorsport, but it is important to also remember the other women involved in the process such as the technical side. That has made a great impact in recent times regarding women's involvement," she voiced.

As more women are involved around the paddock, working as mechanics, drivers, and engineers, this shifts the negative perception of women in sports, and allows young girls who aspire for a career in motorsport, a chance to see inspirational role models, in both strategic positions and driving positions.

Discussing the progress made in past years is crucial to look to the future. What does the future of motorsport look like for women?

Faten believes more leaders, race directors, mechanics, and drivers will be women in the future.

"As we see the sport grow in various ways, with changes in society, we will see the progression of women in the sport. As more women participate, it encourages others to be inspired or enlightened by it, and motivates others to join the rising," she said.

Faten noted her hopes and aspirations for the future highlighting Bahrain as a country with immense potential to participate in the growth of women in motorsport, which can certainly encourage women in the Kingdom to take part.

3 Asian men jailed for conning ex-MP

The High Appeals Court upheld the jail sentences issued against three Asian men convicted of conning a former MP out of BD2,000 by posing as representatives of a financial company.

The trio are said to have placed a phone call to the victim and informed him of the importance to share his bank account details or risk having it suspended.

Afraid of such a thing, he directly shared it, only to receive messages indicating that an amount of BD1,800 was transferred from his bank account



to another account.

As a result, he filed a case at the Anti-Economic Crime Directorate. The trio were arrested following a thorough investigation and put on trial on charges of fraud.

Bahraini man fined BD3,600 for slapping delivery driver

A Bahraini man paid the price of slapping a man in the face after the Civil Court obligated him to pay BD3,600 as material and emotional compensation.

The Court also obligated him to pay the costs of the case, attorney fees, and the fees of the delegated medical committee that signed the plaintiff's physical examination.

The lawyer of the plaintiff stated that his client works as a delivery driver and that

the defendant assaulted him by slapping him in the face. A criminal order was issued fining him BD50; however, the assault caused material damage to the plaintiff, as he was unable to work for a week.

Additionally, he was emotionally distressed due to the assault. The lawyer requested that his client be presented to the medical committee for a medical examination.

The medical committee conducted a medical examination

and submitted a report indicating that the plaintiff suffered from a facial injury resulting from the slap. The report confirmed that the injuries were treated conservatively and that there was pain at the site of injury with 5% total incapacity.

According to the Civil Code, the criminal ruling gains authenticity before civil courts given the occurrence of the crime, which resolves the matter between a criminal and a civil case.

Egypt arrests 29 over alleged online crypto scam

Egyptian authorities have detained 29 people, including 13 foreigners, accused of running an online cryptocurrency scam that defrauded thousands of investors, state media reported yesterday.

The network pocketed about \$620,000 at the expense of its victims in the country now battered by an economic crisis and rapid inflation, the report said.

The group ran the online platform "HoggPool" which promised its clients "financial gains after having lured them by fraudulent means", said a statement released by the prosecution service late Saturday.

The scheme promised large profits from crypto-currency mining and trading services, for fees charged at an attractive foreign exchange rate.

"They sold people a computer tool: you paid 4,000 Egyptian pounds for it, and you

earned 30,000 pounds. You paid 100,000 and you earned a million," said TV talk show presenter Amr Adib.

Launched in August, HoggPool abruptly ceased operations in February and vanished with the money, the state-run daily Al-Ahram reported.

Authorities said the network was planning to launch a new platform called "Riot" when they were arrested.

The interior ministry said 16 Egyptians and "13 foreign nationals of the same country", which was unidentified, had been arrested. Officials also seized 95 mobile phones, 3,367 SIM cards and 41 foreign bank cards, it said.

Egypt, the Arab world's most populous country with nearly 105 million people, is suffering one of its worst-ever economic crises.

In one year the Egyptian pound has lost half its value against the dollar.

News in brief

◆ **Prince Harry and his wife** Meghan Markle have been invited to King Charles III's landmark coronation in May but are yet to decide whether to attend, reports said yesterday. The California-based couple, who quit the British monarchy in 2020 amid growing internal tensions, "recently received email correspondence from His Majesty's office regarding the coronation", a spokesperson for them told Britain's Sunday Times. "An immediate decision on whether the Duke and Duchess [of Sussex] will attend will not be disclosed by us at this time," their representative added, using their formal titles. Buckingham Palace declined to comment.

◆ **Estonians** were voting yesterday for a new parliament in an election that could strengthen far-right nationalists, who have campaigned against further arms deliveries to Ukraine. Prime Minister Kaja Kallas's centre-right Reform Party is predicted to win by the opinion polls, but will likely have to form a coalition to hang on to power. The party is expected to garner 24% to 30% of votes, according to final polls during the week. The far-right EKRE was predicted to take second place with 14-25%. The Centre Party was on 16-19% and Estonia 200 between nine and 15%.

China increases military spending

◆ **China said yesterday** its military spending would rise at the fastest pace in four years, warning of "escalating" threats from abroad at a meeting of its rubber-stamp parliament that is set to hand Xi Jinping a third term as president. The increase in the world's second-largest defence budget came as Beijing announced an economic growth goal of around five percent for this year -- one of its lowest in decades. The country's planned budgets for the year put defence spending at 1.55 trillion yuan (\$225 billion), a 7.2 percent rise and the quickest rate of increase since 2019. It officially rose 7.1 percent last year.

500-year-old spices found on Baltic shipwreck

A well-preserved spices, ranging from saffron and peppercorns to ginger, has been discovered on the wreckage of a royal ship that sank off Sweden's Baltic coast over 500 years ago, Reuters reported.

The spices were found buried in the silt of the Gribshunden, a ship owned by King Hans of Denmark and Norway that caught fire and sank in 1495 while the monarch attended a political meeting ashore in Sweden.

The discovery was made during an excavation led by Brendan Foley, an archaeological scientist at Lund University, after sporadic dives had recovered other items such as figureheads and timber from the wreckage.

"The Baltic is strange - it's low oxygen, low temperature, low salinity, so many organic things are well preserved in the Baltic where they wouldn't be well preserved elsewhere in the world ocean system," said Foley. "But to find spices like this is quite extraordinary."

The spices would have been considered a symbol of high status, as they were expensive and imported from outside Europe, making them a luxury that only the wealthy could afford. The spices would have been on board the ship as King Hans made his way to Sweden for the meeting, and their discovery sheds light on the ship's historical significance. Lund University researcher Mikael Larsson described the find as "very unique and very special" since this is the only archaeological context where saffron has been found.

Pakistan police attempt to arrest former Imran Khan

Police in Pakistan said officers attempted yesterday to arrest former prime minister Imran Khan, who is battling several legal cases as he pressures the government for early elections.

Officers from the capital, Islamabad, arrived at Khan's home in the eastern city of Lahore, which was surrounded by hundreds of his supporters, but were unable to carry out the arrest.

"A team of Islamabad police has arrived in Lahore to arrest Imran Khan to comply with the court orders," Islamabad police said in a tweet.

"Imran Khan is reluctant to surrender -- the Superintendent of Police had gone into the room but Imran Khan was not present there."

The arrest warrant was issued after Khan failed to appear in court in a corruption case on February 28.

Khan is accused of failing to declare gifts received during his time in office or the profit made from selling them.

Government officials must declare all gifts but are allowed to keep those below a certain value.

Khan later spoke to party workers in his Zaman Park house in Lahore, where police remained outside.

"I am being summoned in fake cases and the nation should know about them," he said.

"It will be a bad omen for the country if the nation does not stand against the corrupt rulers."

The vice chairman of Khan's Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf party, Shah Mehmood Qureshi, earlier told reporters in Lahore: "We have received the notice from Islamabad police -- the notice does not contain any order for the arrest."

"We will consult our lawyers and follow the legal process."

Pakistan's courts are often used to tie up lawmakers in tedious and long-winded proceedings that rights monitors have criticised for stifling political opposition.

Khan, who was shot in the leg during a rally last year, has attempted to disrupt politics in the South Asian nation since he was forced out of office in a no-confidence vote in April.

He has been pushing for early polls due no later than October by holding protests, pulling out of parliament and dissolving the two provincial assemblies his party controls in a bid to force the government's hand.

The nation of more than 220 million is in dire economic straits with runaway inflation, scant foreign exchange reserves and stalling bailout talks with the International Monetary Fund.

To pull the country out of its spiral, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif is battling to revive the next tranche of a \$6.5 billion loan deal sketched with the IMF in 2019.

Prince Harry says always felt 'different'

London, United Kingdom

Prince Harry reportedly revealed he has long felt "slightly different" to the rest of Britain's royal family in an interview on Saturday with a trauma expert.

In a wide-ranging discussion with Dr Gabor Mate, Harry, 38, described himself as coming from a "broken home" and said he was trying not to pass "trauma" onto his children, according to reports of the live-streamed conversation.

The interview follows the January publication of the prince's controversial memoir, "Spare", in which he admitted his adolescence was marked by drugs and

alcohol and detailed the breakdown in his relationships with fa-

ther King Charles III, and brother William.

"I certainly have felt throughout my life, my younger years, I felt slightly different to the rest of my family," Harry told Mate, according to numerous media reports on the interview.

"I felt strange being in this container, and I know that my mum felt the same so it makes sense to me," he added, referring to his late mother Princess Diana.

Harry went on to credit his wife Meghan Markle for having "saved" him.

"I was stuck in this world, and she was from a different world and helped draw me out of that," he said, describing her as "an exceptional human being".

New cases of poisoning in different Iran regions: media

Tehran, Iran

More cases of mysterious poisoning of Iranian schoolgirls were reported yesterday in several provinces, local media reported, sparking calls for the authorities to act amid growing concern among parents.

Since late November, hundreds of cases have been reported, mainly in the holy city of Qom south of the capital Tehran, with at least 52 schools targeted, according to an official tally published on Saturday.

Some of the students have required hospitalisation.

The latest spate of poisonings affected several students in two high schools in the western city of Abhar and in the southwest-

ern city of Ahvaz, ISNA news agency said, quoting local health officials.

Schoolgirls at a primary school in the city of Zanjan in the west were also targeted, ISNA added.

More cases were reported in the holy city of Mashhad in the northeast, Isfahan in the centre and Shiraz in the south, according to Mehr and Ilna news agencies.

Dozens of schoolgirls were taken to local hospitals for treatment, the reports said.

On Friday, President Ebrahim Raisi said he had asked the ministers of intelligence and interior to follow up on the poisoning cases, dubbing them "the enemy's conspiracy to create fear and despair" among the

people.

Interviewed by the Fars news agency, Deputy Interior Minister Majid Mirahmadi said the "plotters of the poisoning of girls" were seeking "to close the schools".

He added, however, that those behind this action were also trying to spark more protests in the Islamic republic.

Mirahmadi was referring to the protest movement triggered in Iran by the September 16 death in custody of Mahsa Amini, a young ethnic Kurd arrested for an alleged breach of strict dress rules for women.

Mirahmadi said that most of the affected students suffered complications due to "anxiety and stress".

Three arrested over killing of Philippine governor

Three people have been arrested over the murder of a Philippine provincial governor and eight others, authorities said Sunday, adding another suspect was killed in a shootout.

Seventeen people were also wounded in the audacious attack on Saturday in the sugarcane-growing heartland of the Philippines.

At least six gunmen armed with rifles and wearing military-style uniforms opened fire in the governor's home in Pamplona municipality in the central province of Negros Oriental.

Governor Roel Degamo became the latest victim of a recent rash of assaults on local Philippine politicians.

Two of the three suspects arrested were former soldiers who were dishonourably discharged several years ago, the Philippine Army said in a statement.

A fourth suspect was killed in a shootout in a plantation on Saturday night, police spokesman Lieutenant Colonel Gerard Pelare told journalists.

Pelare said about 10 suspects were involved in the attack. Authorities believed they were still on the island after ports were closed to prevent their escape, he said.

The previous death toll had been put at six but was raised to nine late Saturday, police said. Thirteen people were hospitalised for their wounds, while four others were treated for minor injuries.

Negros Oriental is one of two provinces on Negros island, which is the centre of the nation's sugar industry and home to some of the country's wealthiest landowners as well as some of its poorest farm workers.

Degamo, 56, was at least the third politician to be shot in the Philippines since last year's general election.

The Supreme Court declared him last month the rightful winner of the contest for the Negros Oriental governorship following a recount that unseat-

ed his rival, who had previously been proclaimed victor.

Degamo had campaigned for President Ferdinand Marcos during Marcos' run for the top job.

Marcos has condemned the "dastardly and heinous" assassination of his political ally and has sent his top officials, including police and military chiefs, to investigate.

Authorities presented evidence at a news conference on Sunday gathered from the suspects, including high-powered firearms and camouflage uniforms, and vowed to solve the case.

"We will capture the mastermind, I assure you that," Interior Secretary Benjamin Abalos said.

LEGAL VIEWPOINT

Some legal issues about Family Companies

Family companies exist in Bahrain and other Gulf Countries since long time and they took tremendous efforts to boost and develop trade and other related corporate issues. Those companies mostly started from zero balance, when established by older generations, but the founders were great, of exceptional determination and dedication that took the business to prominent future. Some of the family companies, in the region, are carefully doing remarkable work and good achievements from generation to generation. However, this legacy does not exist all through, in most cases, due to the fact that many family companies mostly diminish from the second or third generation.

There are many legal and corporate issues that could result in making certain obstacles in the pathway of many companies particularly family companies. However, we could say that some of the obstacles may arise for cultural or social reasons associated to the way of life in the region. And, this could happen in every part of the globe, the Gulf is not an exception by all means.

Apart from above instance, we believe that many family companies are lacking corporate governance rules. There is no clear segregation between the owners of the business and the business itself. They are all the same in one unit; the natural entity is not severed from the juristic entity. This could be one of the major setbacks facing family companies and leading to their diminishment. Corporate governance rules are essential for any corporate work activity otherwise the process will be greatly damaged and the whole system will reach a non-operating stage.

Founders of family companies, or in other words fathers of such companies, are required to establish and put in action a clear-cut corporate governance rules that are to be closely observed and monitored by all family members involved in the affairs of the company. The main concept emerging from application of the corporate rules relates to clear demarcation between the affairs of the company from one end and the affairs of the family from another end. No mixture or blending at all between the two affairs and each family member must understand and adhere to this concept. A built-in operational system within the family is required. This non-mixture includes, among other things, the financial matters and related administrative affairs while maintaining the juristic entity process. The company budget must always be different from personal wallet budget and vice versa ... etc. Also, family companies must have clear strategy, proper planning, standard accounting practices, different managerial levels including Board of Directors and executive body. The role of each must be clear and in order, however, they must support each other as observed in the "check-and-balance" concept.

The head(s) of the company must excel in giving good examples to younger generations and must plant family ego, values and traditions looking for good future harvest or, otherwise, deep roots in the tree of the family to face strong winds for survival. Nowadays, there is a legal requirement of injecting new ideas and brains by appointing good reliable independent outsiders in the Boards \ executives to play an independent active role in the affairs of the company, future plans and all other affairs for prosperous future.

Very clear succession plans in family companies are a must and should be carefully arranged for otherwise setbacks could happen and could lead to the end of the life of the company in very short span. Succession policy is not that difficult affair; however, it could cause a real headache and unnecessary havoc for the whole process and future prospects. The succession strategy in family companies will ultimately lead to trustful continuity among present and future generations. To achieve this goal, things must be put in action.

Family companies could be very strong or, in the other extreme, could be very fragile. In both cases, special intensive care is needed to go through for existence. Following legal corporate methods and solid corporate governance rules will yield in healthy and long-life family companies that will serve all family members and the community wherein they are existing. Thus, both ends will benefit. Better for all family companies to have a relook in their structure and to start reshaping for a new-look.

Chris Rock hits back at Will Smith in Netflix livestream

Chris Rock finally hit back at Will Smith on Saturday in a brutal stand-up routine, a year after the actor slapped him in front of a global TV audience for the Oscars.

The comedian came out swinging, accusing the Hollywood star of “selective outrage” when he reacted to a jibe about Jada Pinkett Smith’s shaved head, and saying Smith lashed out at a shorter man because he was annoyed his wife had cheated on him.

“Will Smith practices selective outrage,” Rock told an audience in a show that was streamed live on Netflix.

“Everybody that really knows, knows I had nothing to do with that. I didn’t have any entanglements,” he said, referring to Pinkett Smith’s acknowledged marital infidelity.

Rock was presenting an Oscar in Hollywood last March when

he made a crack about Pinkett Smith’s closely cropped head. She has alopecia.

The “Men in Black” star mounted the stage and slapped the comedian hard across the face, before returning to his seat and yelling obscenities at the presenter.

A few minutes later, Smith was presented with an Oscar for best actor for his role in “King Richard.”

He later apologized to Rock, but was banned from the Oscars for a decade.

Rock was praised for his measured response on the night, and has maintained near silence on the issue in the year since.

But on Saturday night’s livestream from Baltimore, he let rip. “People ask ‘Did it hurt?’. It still hurts,” he said.

“Will Smith is significantly bigger than me. Will Smith played Muhammad Ali in a movie. You think I auditioned for

that?”

“I finish it”

The comedian said Smith had been widely mocked after an episode of his wife’s podcast in which the couple talked about her affair and how it affected him.

“Why would you do that?” he asked. Many people have been cheated on, but the Hollywood power couple are the only ones

who discussed it in public that way, he said.

“Everybody in the world called him a bitch. They called his wife a predator. Everybody called him a bitch,” he said, noting that he had tried to offer condolences after news of the affair became public.

Rock said the animosity from Pinkett Smith stemmed from a few years earlier when she had

fuck? That’s how it is; she starts it, I finish it. Nobody was picking on her.”

Rock, who at times appeared genuinely angry, said before last year he had always loved Smith, first as a rapper, and then as an actor.

“He’d made some great movies. I’ve rooted for Will Smith my whole life,” but now, he said, he was rooting for the slave master who beats Smith’s character in his latest movie, “Emancipation.”

Rock’s show was the first live comedy event for Netflix, with the platform reportedly also looking at offering live sports.

Rivals including Disney+ and Amazon Prime Video already offer live events including sports and musical performances.

Netflix hosts a live comedy festival at dozens of venues in Los Angeles, but those shows have not yet been available to stream live on its platform.

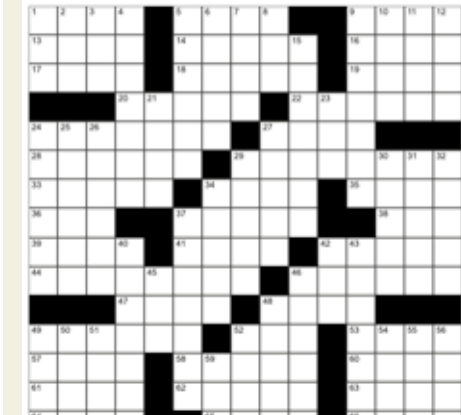

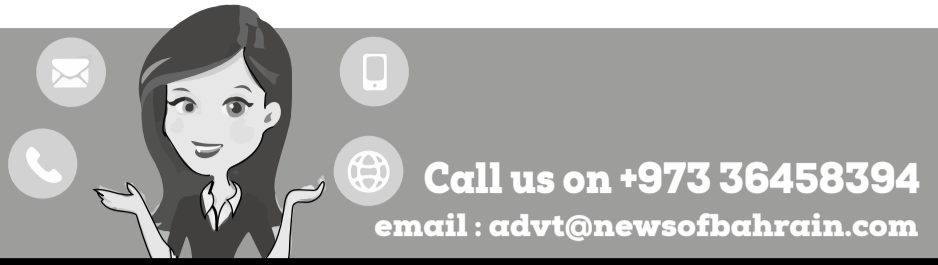

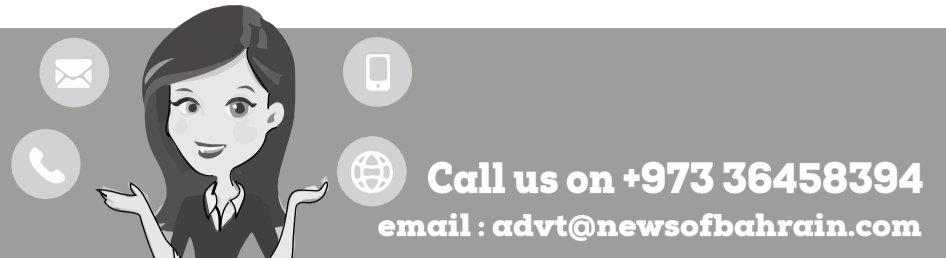

Barcelona clung on with 10 men to beat Valencia 1-0 and move 10 points clear of Real Madrid at the top of La Liga yesterday, thanks to Raphinha's early header.

The Brazilian winger nodded the Catalans in front in the 16th minute. But after Ferran Torres missed a penalty and Ronald Araujo was sent off, the hosts were left fighting tooth and nail for the three points.

"The important thing is we keep adding points and we have three more," Raphinha told Movistar.

"It's hard to play with one less man, we did what we needed to, moved deeper and we pulled out the win."

Barca retreated in the final half hour following Araujo's 59th minute red card but survived to beat Ruben Baraja's Valencia, who are 19th and two points from safety.

Barcelona's 1-0 Copa del Rey semi-final first-leg triumph over Real Madrid on Thursday followed two consecutive defeats, and this narrow victory felt like a significant step to-

wards a first league title since 2019.

Madrid can cut the gap back to seven points later on at Real Betis, but were hoping a depleted Barcelona would stumble at Camp Nou.

Liverpool rewrite record books in 7-0 thrashing of Man Utd

Cody Gakpo, Darwin Nunez and Mohamed Salah all scored twice as Liverpool shrugged off a season of frustration to thrash Manchester United 7-0 at Anfield yesterday.

Jurgen Klopp's men set a new record margin of victory in the clash between English football's two most successful clubs.

Just a second defeat in 23 games in all competitions realistically ends United's hopes of a first league title in a decade as they remain 14 points adrift of leaders Arsenal in third.

But there could even more lasting damage from the club's heaviest defeat since 1931.

Liverpool close to within three points of fourth-placed Tottenham with a game in hand on Spurs still to come.

Klopp's side won the two league meetings between the teams by an aggregate score of 9-0 last season, but the tables

Max Verstappen was in a class of his own as he powered defending world champions Red Bull Racing to spectacular one-two finish last night in a hugely thrilling Formula 1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix 2023, kicking off the new F1 season in front of a massive sold-out crowd at Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) in Sakhir.

The reigning F1 double world champion started from pole and made the most of the clear air ahead of him, taking his two-stop strategy to his first-ever

victory in Bahrain while building a comfortable lead ahead of teammate Sergio Perez.

Fernando Alonso, also a two-time F1 world champion and three-time winner at BIC, joined the Red Bull pair in the top three in his maiden grand prix weekend with Aston Martin.

Verstappen commented after his win: "You never really know what will happen later on in the race, so very happy to finally win here in Bahrain. I think we have a good race package, we can definitely fight with this so a big thank you to the team."

A magnificent fireworks display brilliantly lit up the night sky as the chequered flag came down after 57 laps of intense action, waved by Italian multi-time grand prix motorcycle world champion Giacomo Agostini.

Presenting the winner's trophy to Verstappen in the post-race podium ceremony was Supreme Council for Youth and Sports First Deputy Chairman, General Sports Authority President and Bahrain Olympic Committee President, His Highness Shaikh Khalid bin Hamad Al Khalifa.

Also on the podium for the prize-giving and handing out the other awards were Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) President Mohammed Ben Sulayem, Gulf Air Chairman of the Board Zayed R Alzayani, Minister of Youth Affairs Rawan bint Najeeb Tawfiqi, and Bahrain Motor Federation President and FIA Vice-President for Sport for MENA Shaikh Abdulla bin Isa Al Khalifa.

The F1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix 2023 was the first of 23 rounds in this year's FIA F1 World Championship. It was the 19th running of the world-famous desert race and the 10th time it was held as a night event.

Verstappen won last night's

F1 spectacle in a total race time of one hour 33 minutes 56.736 seconds. He made a quick getaway at the start while Ferrari's Charles Leclerc was able to overtake Perez at turn one to go second.

The Red Bulls maintained their strong pace throughout with Verstappen finishing a comfortable 11.987 seconds ahead of Perez.

But the challenge of Leclerc and Ferrari teammate Carlos Sainz faded as the race entered its closing stages. After starting alongside one another on row two, Leclerc, last year's winner at BIC, was forced to retire on lap 39 after stopping on the track, while Sainz gave up his potential place on the podium to Alonso on lap 45.

Alonso capped a fantastic weekend in Bahrain with his final classification in third, 38.637s from Verstappen.

Sainz salvaged fourth place for Ferrari 48.052s from the

winner, while seven-time F1 world champion and Bahrain record-holder with five wins in Sakhir, Lewis Hamilton, was classified fifth 50.977s back for Mercedes.

Lance Stroll marked his impressive comeback from a pre-season injury by taking sixth for Aston Martin 54.502s adrift, while Mercedes's George Russell followed in seventh 55.873s from the victor. Valtteri Bottas of Alfa Romeo was eighth 72.647s behind, while completing the top 10 and the race's points-scorers were Pierre Gasly (+73.753s) of Alpine, who had a superb result after starting from 20th on the grid, and Williams's Alexander Albon (+89.774s).

Yuki Tsunoda came 11th for AlphaTauri 90.870s from first, while classified one lap behind from 12th through 16th, respectively, were Logan Sargeant of Williams, Kevin Magnussen of Haas, Nyck de Vries of AlphaTauri, Nico Hulkenberg of Haas, and Alfa Romeo's Zhou Guanyu, who clocked the race's fastest lap of 1:33.996.

McLaren's Lando Norris completed the classification in 17th with a two-lap gap from Verstappen.

Joining Leclerc as non-finishers were McLaren rookie Oscar Piastri, who had a disappointing start to his F1 career after being forced to retire 13 laps into the race, and Alpine's Esteban Ocon, who was given a slew of penalties but then retired on lap 41.
