Too close to call

Harris or Trump? Long lines of voters in tense US presidential election

Millions of Americans voted yesterday in a presidential election defined by drama and uncertainty, with Kamala Harris and Donald Trump awaiting the outcome of a desperately close and hugely consequential race.

The result — perhaps coming overnight, or not for several days — will either make Harris the first woman president in the country's history, or hand Trump a comeback that sends shock waves around the world.

Polls show Democratic vice president Harris, 60, and Republican former president Trump, 78, may be heading for a photo finish after a head-spinning campaign.

Harris made a late, dramatic entrance into the race when President Joe Biden dropped out in July, while Trump has

ridden out two assassination attempts and a criminal conviction.

Tens of millions of voters were expected to cast their ballots yesterday, on top of the 83 mil-

lion who have already voted early, and both candidates put in a final word to try to sway the last undecided voters.

"We've got to get it done. Today is voting day, and people

need to get out and be active," Harris, who had already voted by mail, told Atlanta station WVEE-FM.

Vengeance

She described her opponent as "full of vengeance. He's full of grievance. It's all about himself." Trump voted in Florida near

his Mar-a-Lago residence, saying he felt "very confident" and that he wanted to be "very inclusive."

But he aired concerns about the vote count - heightening fears he will reject the result and cite fraud if he loses.

"If it's a fair election, I would be the first one to acknowledge it," he said.

Trump has said he would not seek election again in 2028, but he also recently has repeated baseless claims of election fraud while saying he should "never have left" the White House in 2021.

Across the country, voters lined up including in Black Mountain, North Carolina, where the voting station was a makeshift tent due to recent hurricane damage and flooding.

Long queues also formed in Erie, a critical city in battleground Pennsylvania.

Show of support for Gaza

MPs seek to block Israeli firms at Bahrain events

An urgent call to block Israeli participation in Bahrain's exhibitions and events raced through Parliament yesterday, pushed by Abdulwahed Qarata, just weeks after his election in

September's by-election.

Now awaiting government approval, the proposal aims to stop Israeli companies and individuals from joining high-profile gatherings, such as this month's Bahrain International Airshow.

This proposed measure seeks to deny Israeli companies and

individuals' entry to national and international events hosted within Bahrain.

The immediate focus is on prominent events right around the corner, including the Bahrain International Airshow from 13 to 16 November and the Jewellery Arabia Exhibition set for

26-30 November 2024.

Qarata expressed his position firmly, telling The Daily Tribune, "We oppose any support for those attacking our people in Gaza by allowing them space at our exhibitions."

He pointed to France's recent decision to exclude Isra-

li companies from its airshow, framing Bahrain's move as part of a broader international stance.

The motion cites Article 68, Clause 1 of the Constitution, asserting Parliament's right to formally request government action on public issues.

time patrol aircraft over the past 15 years, escorting nearly 4,000 merchant ships.

These efforts, backed by approximately 22,000 personnel, have ensured the safety of countless vessels passing through one of the world's most critical shipping lanes.

Though piracy incidents have decreased in recent years, the Ambassador warned of a renewed threat, particularly following a hijacking incident in 2023.

She noted that the diversion of military resources to address the

Houthi threat in the Red Sea could potentially increase piracy activities by criminal organizations seeking new revenue streams.

H.E. Ambassador Shaikh Abdulla bin Ali, meanwhile, reflected on the deepening ties between Bahrain and Japan, which were strengthened by the signing of a defense cooperation and exchange memorandum during the 2023 Manama Dialogue.

This agreement has already resulted in joint goodwill exercises and high-level visits, enhancing the strategic collaboration between the two nations.

Multinational cooperation

The reception underscored the significance of multinational cooperation within the Combined Maritime Forces, a coalition that allows for a coordinated and robust response to piracy and maritime security threats.

This partnership not only strengthens diplomatic and military relations but also reinforces regional stability, ensuring safer seas for all.

"The stability of this region is crucial for fostering commercial collaboration," OMACHI said during an exclusive conversation with The Daily Tribune.

Defense and trade

His words emphasized the significance of cooperation in both defense and trade, spotlighting Bahrain's critical role as a maritime partner.

The commemoration event was jointly hosted by Japan's Ambassador to Bahrain, H.E. Asako OKAI, alongside Vice Admiral OMACHI, in the presence of notable dignitaries, including H.E. Ambassador Shaikh Abdulla bin Ali Al Khalifa, Director General of Bilateral Relations at Bahrain's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and Commodore Osama Mubarak Al Hamdan, Deputy Commander of the Bahrain Royal Naval Force.

Vice Admiral George Wikoff, Commander of US NAVCENT, US Fifth Fleet, and the Combined Maritime Forces (CMF), also acknowledged Japan's pivotal contributions.

"Japan's significant investment in the CMF over the years has been instrumental in safeguarding maritime commerce and countering piracy," Wikoff stated, expressing gratitude for Japan's steadfast support.

Japan's Ambassador H.E. Asako OKAI highlighted the milestones achieved since Japan began its counter-piracy operations.

Council passes key measures

The Council of Representatives yesterday approved several proposals aimed at addressing housing issues for singles and enhancing employment standards for Bahrainis in higher education.

Among the key actions, the Council supported recommendations for increasing work permit fees and implementing seniority as the sole criterion for distributing housing units.

Additionally, the Council mandated that universities employ a minimum of 70 per cent Bahrainis with higher degrees within their teaching staff.

The Council supported the Services Committee's report advocating for a comprehensive approach to tackling housing challenges, particularly in the Capital Governorate.

The amended proposal includes a recommendation to increase the optional fee associated with the issuance or renewal of work permits, beyond the current Bahrainisation percentage.

Furthermore, the Council endorsed the Public Utilities and Environment Committee's recommendation that seniority be the sole criterion for distributing housing units to citizens, irrespective of regional allocations.

MPs approve proposal to ease traffic congestion

The Council of Representatives approved yesterday a proposal aimed at easing severe traffic congestion affecting key intersections in the Kingdom.

The initiative was spearheaded by MP Maryam Al Dhaen, along with fellow lawmakers Dr Ali Al Nuaimi, Ahmad Qaratah, Hassan Ibrahim, and Mamdouh Al Saleh.

The proposal addresses the heavy traffic that stretches from the intersection of 16th December Avenue and the National Charter Highway to the intersection of Shaikh Salman Avenue and Oman Avenue.

The lawmakers emphasised the urgent need for corrective measures to alleviate the growing congestion, which often leads to long lines of vehicles during various times of the day.

In the accompanying explanatory memorandum, the parliamentarians noted that despite the enactment of the Traffic Law No. (23) of 2014 and the implementation of multiple traffic management plans, Bahrain's roadways continue to experience significant traffic jams.

"The issues have prompted the call for immediate action," the memorandum stated.

Passport to trouble

Bahraini man accused of conspiring with fugitive in Iran to renew passport

A 40-year-old Bahraini man stands accused of conspiring with a fugitive in Iran to fraudulently renew his passport, a case that has drawn significant attention in the High Criminal Court.

The defendant has denied the allegations, which include forging passport stamps and extending the passport's validity for the years 2017, 2019, and 2024 while residing in Iran.

The unfolding legal drama involves two defendants.

The first, currently evading capture, is accused of forging signatures and stamps from the General Directorate of Nationality, Passports, and Residence Affairs (NPRA).

He allegedly produced a

counterfeit Bahraini passport intended to be used as a genuine document.

Forgery

Prosecutors claim the second defendant, the 40-year-old man, played a crucial role in this conspiracy by providing his passport and personal details to the fugitive, enabling the forgery.

He is further accused of presenting the forged passport to officials with full knowledge of its fraudulent status.

As per the case details, the defendant was apprehended at Bahrain International Airport after authorities discovered his expired passport.

He had sought the fugitive's assistance to renew it, despite being aware of the fugitive's criminal background and his own outstanding warrants.

Consultancy

Investigators uncovered that the fugitive operated a consultancy in Iran that specialised in forging passport stamps and signatures for Bahraini nationals wanted by law enforcement.

Additionally, it was revealed that the defendant's father had previously submitted an online application for a passport re-

placement, which was rejected due to non-compliance with the required regulations.

In February 2023, the defendant also secured a transit visa from the Bahraini embassy in the UAE.

Key evidence presented by the prosecution includes testimony from a passport specialist who identified signs of tampering on the defendant's passport and confirmed that the extensions were invalid.

Passport extensions

A senior official corroborated this, stating that passport extensions for citizens outside Bahrain must be handled through official embassies or consulates, not through unofficial means.

Forensic analysis confirmed that the passport stamps in question were entirely fabricated.

The High Criminal Court adjourned proceedings until November 12, granting the defense attorneys, Najla Ali Baqer and Hawra, time to review the evidence and prepare their case.

Criminals Out, Clean Clinics In

A proposed law to prevent persons convicted of a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude from opening private healthcare institutions was discussed by the Services Committee of the Shura Council yesterday.

The proposal is to amend the provisions of a 2015 law [Decree-Law No. (21)] and it was submitted by members Dr Ibtisam Al Dalal, Jamal Fakhro, Dr Jihad Al Fadel, Dalal Al Zayed, and Dr Al Salman.

The law also aims to protect the rights of Bahraini licensed healthcare professionals to establish private clinics, medical centres, medical complexes, alternative medicine centres, or centres for the practice of any

paramedical professions.

Institutions

Currently, the establishment of such institutions is restricted to Bahrainis licensed to practice one of the specialties listed within the institution's activities, while hospital establishment licenses are available to natural persons, companies, organisations, or branches of foreign healthcare institutions.

The proposed law stipulates that licensees or partners in establishing private healthcare institutions should not have been previously convicted of a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude, unless their rights have been restored or a pardon has been granted by the competent authorities.

Officials present at the meeting included Dr Ahmed Al Ansari, CEO of the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA); Dr Lulwa Shuwaiter, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Health; and Shaikh Mohammed bin Ibrahim Al Khalifa, Director of Health Strategic Evaluation at the Supreme Council of Health.

Cooperation

The committee reviewed the views and observations of the concerned parties regarding cooperation with programmes developed by the executive branch in the healthcare sector.

The proposed law grants the NHRA the authority to implement the national accreditation programme for healthcare institutions.

BD23,000 awarded to family after child's eye damaged by plastic arrow

A Bahraini family has been awarded BD23,000 in compensation after their child suffered permanent eye damage from a plastic arrow shot by another child.

The High Civil Court ruled in favour of the plaintiffs, awarding damages for medical expenses and suffering.

According to lawyer Zahra Hussain, the incident occurred on October 11, 2022, when the plaintiff's daughter was playing at the defendant's home.

The defendant's son allegedly shot a plastic arrow, striking the plaintiff's daughter in the eye.

The resulting injury required extensive treatment, both in Bahrain and abroad, ultimately leading to significant vision loss.

The court's ruling detailed the severity of the injury, citing medical reports indicating a 30% permanent visual impairment.

Surgeries

The reports described corneal damage, lens injury, and vitreous detachment, resulting in significant clouding of the cornea and potential for chronic redness, partial vision loss (up to 50%), and the need for future corneal and lens implant surgeries.

The possibility of complications, such as body rejection of the corneal implant or displacement of the artificial lens,

was also noted.

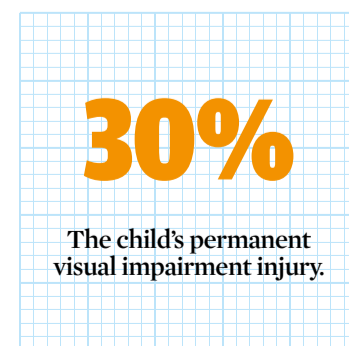
The court held the defendant's father responsible for the incident, citing his failure to adequately supervise his son.

Argument

The court rejected the defendant's argument that the absence of a criminal conviction should absolve him of responsibility, stating that the evidence presented, including witness statements, sufficiently established negligence.

The court also dismissed the defendant's claim of shared responsibility, finding no supporting evidence.

The BD23,000 compensation includes BD17,000 in material damages for the child's guardian, BD5,000 for medical expenses, and BD500 each in moral damages for the guardian and the child.



MPs support quicker residency for foreign spouses

Expat spouses of Bahrainis could soon benefit from faster residency approvals, as a proposal to streamline visa services for foreign spouses received unanimous backing from MPs yesterday.

This urgent push aims to reduce family separations and enhance stability in Bahraini homes, but its fate now rests with the government's approval.

MP Jalal Kadhem, who led the proposal, pointed out the Bahraini Constitution's focus on the family as the foundation

of society.

He explained that making visa and residency processes easier for foreign spouses would help families stay together and strengthen the Bahraini community.

"This move," he said, "would give families better access to education and health services, helping to raise a generation that's healthy and aware."

Positive role

Kadhem added that simplifying these processes could also help families feel more secure and settled, cementing their positive role in society.

"Bahrainis who marry abroad go through all the required paperwork, only to face long waits," he said.

"The ongoing issues have prompted the call for immediate action," the memorandum stated.

Q3 results

The net profit attributable to the shareholders for the three months ended 30 September 2024 was BD 351K compared to BD 245K for the same period in the previous year, an increase of 43%, and a corresponding earnings per share of 4.13 Fils compared with 2.88 Fils for the same period in the previous year. Total comprehensive income for the three months ended 30 September 2024 surged to BD 606K compared to BD 118K for the same period in the previous year, an increase of 414%.

The Company reported a total net profit of BD 406K compared to BD 498K for the same period in the previous year, with a decrease of 18%. Recognized Takaful Costs also increased by 77% to BD 7.631m in the third quarter of the year 2024 as compared to BD 4.321m for the same period in the previous year.

Mary Berry's Beef Stew Recipe

Ingredients:

- 1 tbsp sunflower oil
- 750 gms braising steak cut into 3/4 inch cubes
- 25 gms butter
- 2 small leeks, trimmed and finely sliced
- 1 tsp ground ginger
- 2 tsp paprika
- 40 gms plain flour
- 425 ml good-quality beef stock, hot
- 2 tbsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1 small celeriac, peeled and cubed into 3/4 inch pieces
- 2 heaped tbsp hot horseradish cream
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste
- Chopped fresh parsley, to garnish

Method:

- Heat the oil in a large ovenproof pan and fry the meat over high heat until browned all over. Remove with a slotted spoon and set aside.
- Preheat the oven to 160C/140C Fan/Gas 3.
- Add the butter and leeks to the same pan, lightly scraping the bottom of the pan to loosen up brown bits. Fry for a few minutes. Sprinkle in the ginger, paprika and flour, stir and cook for a minute. Stir in the stock and bring to the boil, stirring until thickened. Add Worcestershire sauce and season with salt and pepper. Return the meat to the pan, bring to the boil, cover with a lid and simmer for a few minutes.
- Transfer to the oven and cook for about 1 3/4-2 hours. After this time, stir in the celeriac; bring back to the boil for a few minutes then return to the oven for about 30 minutes, until the meat and celeriac are tender.
- Stir in the horseradish cream, sprinkle with parsley and serve at once.

The mushroom sauce served alongside had the most intense mushroom flavour perfumed with thyme. The chef revealed his secret to this amazing sauce, which involved blending some of the mushrooms and incorporating it into the sauce. Well, now you know. This dish was a mouthful of gorgeousness!

Just when I thought that it could not get any better, the roast chicken with potatoes and gravy won my heart. Extra points for the juices that gushed out as the chef pierced

the side of the chicken thigh! It assured me that the chicken was juicy and delicious. The chicken skin was golden, crisp and generously seasoned. I savoured the roast chicken with luscious gravy, Yorkshire pudding, perfectly roasted potatoes, zucchini, carrots and bell peppers.

The brick red hue and pungent aroma of spices lured me to try one of Britain's favourite dishes- The chicken tikka masala. It was scrumptious! Succulent pieces of chicken tikka coated in the rich gravy prepared from tomatoes and spices made this dish worth a try. The gravy had the perfect consistency and well-rounded flavours. After that flavour-packed chicken tikka masala, it was time for something sweet.

The dessert counter was spectacular, with an extensive range of meticulously fashioned, delightful treats. Victorian sponge cake, Dry English cake, tarts, brownies, and several mouthwatering petite fours graced the counter. With so many options to choose from, I had to make informed choices. My curiosity about the Battenberg cake and its enticing presentation led me to taste this German masterpiece. The cake was perfectly prepared, with evenly cut squares of pink and yellow moist cake glued flawlessly with jam and covered in marzipan. It was addictive!

I recommend the white chocolate cheesecake and the berry pavlova for fruit lovers. The creamy baked cheesecake was delightful with a buttery and biscuity crust. The tartness of the mixed berries topping balanced the rich and creamy, yet firm cheesecake. The cute and dainty strawberry-flavoured, pastel pink pavlovas had a dollop of custard and the fruit topping added a pop of colour and freshness.

Mother arrested after young children decapitated in Guadeloupe
Pointe-à-Pitre, France

A woman was detained and admitted to a psychiatric hospital on Tuesday after her two young children were found decapitated in France's overseas Caribbean territory of Guadeloupe, a prosecutor said.

The children, aged one and four, were found at the mother's home in the village of Sainte-Rose.

The woman, in her forties, was found to be mentally unstable and transferred to a psychiatric hospital, prosecutor Caroline Calbo said.

Police have opened an investigation into suspected double murder, she added.

A source close to the probe said that the woman's husband called police before dawn after discovering the bodies of the children.

Local radio channel RCI Guadeloupe said the father was in shock.

The source said that the mother had been incoherent and unable to explain what had happened.

WHO eyes big medical evacuation from Gaza on Wednesday
Geneva, Switzerland

The World Health Organization said Tuesday a large-scale medical evacuation was planned from Gaza this week, with more than 100 seriously ill and injured patients due to leave the war-ravaged territory.

The WHO said that alongside its partners it would evacuate as many as 113 patients on Wednesday, with most going to the United Arab Emirates and some heading to Romania for specialised care.

If it goes ahead, it would be the largest evacuation from Gaza since October 2023, according to data from the UN health agency.

Indonesia volcano erupts again after killing nine earlier
East Flores, Indonesia

A volcano in eastern Indonesia erupted again on Tuesday, blowing an ash column into the sky a day after it spewed fireballs on nearby villages that killed nine people.

Mount Lewotobi Laki-Laki, a 1,703-metre (5,587-foot) twin volcano located on the popular tourist island of Flores, shot flaming rocks at residential areas overnight Monday, setting wooden houses on fire and pock-marking the ground.

Authorities said it killed at least 10 people and injured dozens more, but on Tuesday revised the toll down by one. Lewotobi Laki-Laki erupted again on Tuesday, shooting ash a kilometre into the sky (0.6 miles), according to an AFP journalist near the volcano.

The polls put the US election on a knife-edge, but as Americans go to vote, Thailand's superstar baby hippo Moo Deng has predicted former president Donald Trump will regain the White House.

The chubby chomper took the internet by storm with her adorable antics at Khao Kheow Open Zoo, quickly becoming a staple of social media memes and inspiring a raft of merchandise.

Now Moo Deng, whose name means "bouncy pork", has predicted a comeback victory for the Republican over Democrat Kamala Harris.

Offered two dishes of carved fruit, each emblazoned with one of the candidates' names, the four-month-old pigmy hippo chose Trump, in video posted online by the zoo.

Moo Deng has proved a particular hit in the United States, where comedian Bowen Yang portrayed her in a "Saturday Night Live" comedy sketch.

She also beat both Trump and Harris in an unofficial presidential poll run by "The Tonight Show", taking 93 percent of the vote.

While the soothsaying skills of hippos are largely untested, other animals have achieved global fame predicting the outcome of world events, most notably the legendary Paul the Octopus.

The clairvoyant cephalopod shot to global stardom by correctly predicting eight matches in the 2010 World Cup from his aquarium in Germany.

How long is the count?

The first polls close at 6:00 pm Eastern Time (2300 GMT) but when the race is tight, it could take days before a victor is projected.

In 2020, US media declared Democratic candidate Joe Biden the winner on Saturday November 7, although polls closed the Tuesday before.

In 2016 and 2012, voters had a shorter wait.

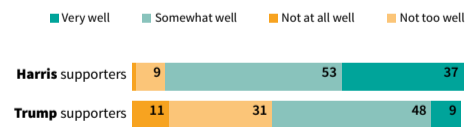
After votes are cast, local election officials, who may be appointed or elected, process and count them. Tallying methods vary from one location to

the next. Many states have changed election laws to allow mail-in or overseas votes to be prepared for counting ahead of Election Day, although Pennsylvania and Wisconsin have not made similar changes. Both are battlegrounds that could swing towards either party. With mail-in ballots not allowed to be processed until November 5, this could slow counting. Especially close vote counts can also trigger recounts.

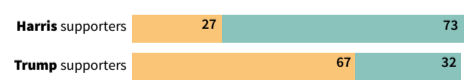
Confidence gap: Trump voters are skeptical that US election will be secure and well run

Who certifies it?

Rather than waiting for winners to be declared by local authorities, US news outlets call races based on what they see in the voting.

But this process is not official and results still have to be certified at the state level, with every ballot accounted for.

The deadline for states to certify their results is December 11, and each state's appoint-

ed electors then cast their votes for the candidate who won in their popular vote.

By December 25, electoral certificates of each state must be received by the President of the Senate, who is also the Vice President -- Harris.

O January 6, Congress counts and confirms the results, before the new president is inaugurated on January 20.

What may cause delays?

Certification is a formality, but experts warn that there are growing risks of obstructions.

At least 22 county election officials voted in 2022 to delay certification in battleground states, Brookings experts noted in a commentary last month.

This was nearly a 30 percent increase from 2020.

At least 35 election officials have "refused to certify election results and may be in a position to do so again," accord-

ing to Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington (CREW). Successful obstruction could impact state and federal certification deadlines, the campaign group warned.

The certification process has come under scrutiny and been especially politicized since Trump refused to concede the 2020 election.

In that race, dozens of legal challenges by Trump and his allies were tossed out by the courts.

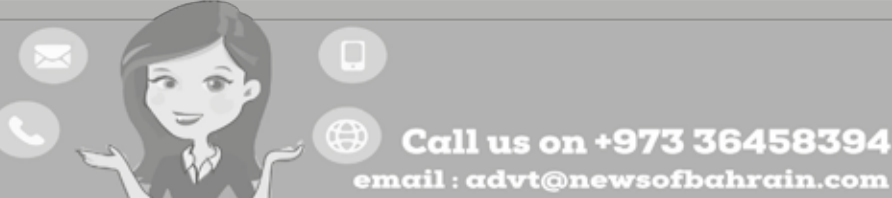

24-time Grand Slam champion withdraws due to ongoing injury, ends difficult season

Novak Djokovic said yesterday he will not defend his ATP Finals title due to an "ongoing injury" which has ended the 24-time Grand Slam champion's season. Tennis icon Djokovic was one of four players still battling for one of three remaining places at



the season-ending event in Turin, which kicks off on Sunday, but said on social media that he wouldn't be making a bid for a third straight Finals title.

"I was really looking forward to being there, but due to ongoing injury I won't be playing next week," Djokovic said.

"Apologies to those who were planning to see me. Wishing all the players a great tournament. See you soon!"

The 37-year-old Serb, currently ranked fifth in the world, sits sixth in "The Race", the ATP's annual rankings to determine the eight competitors at the Finals.

Jannik Sinner, Alexander Zverev, Carlos Alcaraz, Daniil Medvedev and Taylor Fritz had already qualified before Djokovic's announcement.

His retirement from the tournament automatically opens up the Novak Djokovic

final three places to Casper Ruud, Alex de Minaur and Andrey Rublev.

Ruud and Rublev are playing in Metz, France this week, with De Minaur in action in Belgrade.

Djokovic's withdrawal was not a surprise as he had already pulled out of the Paris Masters, effectively ending what has been a difficult season.

He hasn't won a single ATP title in 2024, the first time that has happened since 2006, and has been shoved aside by young stars Sinner and Alcaraz at the top of the game.

Djokovic did, however, win singles gold at the Paris Olympics, adding the final major honour which was missing from his record-breaking list of career achievements.

Man City will 'struggle' to overcome injury crisis, says Guardiola

Pep Guardiola believes Manchester City will struggle to overcome a mounting injury crisis but encouraged the English champions to bounce back in yesterday's Champions League trip to Sporting Lisbon.

City travel to Portugal after consecutive defeats to Tottenham in the League Cup and Bournemouth on Saturday, which ended an 11-month unbeaten run in the Premier League.

Ballon d'Or winner Rodri, who is out for the remainder of the season with a knee injury, leads a stellar cast of absentees in Guardiola's squad that also includes Oscar Bobb, Ruben Dias, Jack Grealish and John Stones.

Kevin De Bruyne could make his first appearance seven weeks but is unlikely to start, while Kyle Walker, Nathan Ake, Manuel Akanji, Jeremy Doku and Savinho are also not fully fit.

"You know the situation with Rodri, nominated the best player in the world," said Guardiola at his pre-match press conference on Monday.

"We know we will struggle, and we have to accept that, and it is fine.

"The games will be difficult; in previous seasons it was smooth. Personal reasons, injuries, we won six Premier Leagues in seven years. Things change, we have to accept that."

Manchester United fans in favour of leaving Old Trafford

A majority of Manchester United fans favour building a new stadium rather than re-developing Old Trafford, according to a survey released yesterday.

Of 50,000 United season ticket holders, club members and executive club members polled, 52% said they preferred the idea of a new facility, while 31% supported the re-development of one of the most recognisable stadiums in world football. Another 17% were undecided.

United's cross-city neighbours Manchester City left their Maine Road stadium in 2003 to move into the new City of Manchester Stadium, but Premier League rivals Liverpool have re-developed their Anfield home.

United released artist's images in September of a potential Old Trafford regeneration project and have indicated that a new stadium could be part of a multi-billion-pound re-development project.

The club's owners are considering options in conjunction with the Old Trafford Regeneration Task Force, which includes former United defender Gary Neville and World Athletics president Sebastian Coe among its members.

The Daily Telegraph has reported that a final decision on which option to choose is likely to be taken in the first half of 2025.

The Task Force is understood to have focused its discussions on building a new 100,000-capacity stadium rather than redeveloping Old Trafford.

Rick McGagh, United's director of fan engagement, said: "We know how important our home is to fans and we need to listen to them and gain all their views and insights in order to develop the world-class stadium they deserve."

"We are able to view the results through different lenses to understand if our season ticket holders feel differently about anything than say our official members. And if younger fans have different views to older fans."

Neymar to miss two weeks' training in fresh setback: coach

Neymar will miss at least two weeks' training after suffering a muscle problem in his second game back from long-term injury, his coach at Saudi club Al Hilal said.

The Brazilian superstar lasted just 26 minutes as a second-half substitute before limping off with an apparent right hamstring strain in Monday's 3-0 AFC Champions League Elite win over Esteghlal.

Neymar, 32, who moved from Paris Saint-Germain in a lucrative contract in 2023, was out for more than a year until last month following right knee surgery.

"Neymar, it's not an easy case," said Al Hilal's Portuguese coach Jorge Jesus.

"On the medical level, his knee is healed, but then he will have problems like today, muscle problems because he hasn't played for a long time."

"Now he has a muscle injury. I don't know how long he won't be able to train, two weeks at least," he added.

Al Hilal, the reigning Saudi champions, have not registered Neymar for the current Saudi Pro League season, which began last month.

But the former Barcelona player, with a reported salary of about 100 million euros (\$112 million) a year, is listed to play in the AFC Champions League Elite, Asia's biggest club tournament.

Benzema advises Mbappe to adapt

Former Real striker believes Mbappe must accept role as central striker to accommodate Vinicius on the wing

Former Real Madrid striker Karim Benzema believes Kylian Mbappe must learn to play as a central striker in the Spanish capital because he cannot displace Vinicius Junior on the left wing.

Mbappe completed a dream move to Madrid this summer at the end of his Paris Saint-Germain deal, but has not hit top form under Carlo Ancelotti.

The coach has retained Brazil international Vinicius in his favoured position on the wing and has used Mbappe, who prefers

to play off the left, down the middle.

"The problem, in my opinion, is that (Mbappe) is not a central striker, even with the national team, every time he plays as a number nine he doesn't feel right, because that's not his position," Benzema told Spanish television show El Chiringuito late Monday.

"On the left, he's got a guy who's at the same level as him, Vinicius, so there is a problem, you can't play Vinicius as a number nine or on the right, because when he plays on the left he makes the difference in every game. "Mbappe isn't a

real number nine. People ask a lot of him and he's under a lot of pressure, this isn't Paris Saint-Germain."

Since arriving from PSG the 25-year-old has eight

goals in 14 appearances across all competitions.

Benzema, who won the Balon d'Or at Real Madrid in 2022 before signing for Saudi Arabian side Al-Ittihad last year, said the striker should keep working hard to adapt to his new role.

"(I'd advise him)

don't give up, because I don't think he's going to push Vinicius to move -- he's the best player in the world at the moment," continued Benzema.

"Mbappe needs to get it into his head that today he's a number nine, and forget about the left flank for a while."

Benzema, who joined Real Madrid in 2009 and played there for 14 seasons, warned Mbappe that "if you go two or three games without a goal, you're going to have a lot of problems."
