Bahrain pushes for regional peace and stability

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa reaffirmed Bahrain's support for all regional and international efforts aimed at preventing further conflict and tension, ensuring the well-being and development of the peoples of the region, and fulfilling their aspirations for growth and prosperity.

HM the King was speaking as he received His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, yesterday at Sakhir Palace.

Global space apps hackathon event in Bahrain successful

The National Space Science Agency (NSSA) organised the seventh edition of the global space science applications hackathon on October 5-6, in collaboration with NASA.

The event took place at two locations simultaneously: the University of Bahrain and Bahrain Polytechnic, with over 300 students, entrepreneurs, professionals, specialists, and enthusiasts participating.

The Bahrain Society of Engineers contributed to hosting and organising this year's edition. The hackathon is held in various cities worldwide, with 15 space agencies, including NASA, the European Space Agency, the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency, the Canadian Space Agency, and others, taking part this year.

The previous edition saw over 57,999 participants from more than 152 countries.

Russian activist left dead on front line in Ukraine

Anti-Kremlin activist Ildar Dadin, who was imprisoned in Russia for protesting against Vladimir Putin, was killed on the front line in Ukraine where he was fighting alongside Kyiv forces, his relatives and Russian media said yesterday. Ildar Dadin died in combat in the Kharkiv region, in northeast Ukraine, his friend and former Russian MP Ilya Ponomarev, announced on Facebook.

Help free Gaza

Rallies held worldwide calling for immediate ceasefire and end to Israel's 'flagrant injustice'

Tens of thousands of protesters marched in cities around the world over the weekend calling for a ceasefire in Gaza and Lebanon ahead of today's first anniversary of the Hamas' deadly storming of southern Israel which sparked the war in Gaza.

In Washington, a man set himself on fire as more than 1,000 people demonstrated outside the White House demanding an end to US military aid to Israel, AFP journalists said.

In Morocco yesterday, tens of thousands of protesters gathered in the capital, Rabat, waving Palestinian flags and calling to break off diplomatic ties with

Israel, which the kingdom normalised in 2020.

"Resistance does not die" and "The people want an end to normalisation", they chanted outside parliament.

"We consider Palestine to be a national cause," Khadija Mokhtari, a 56-year-old retiree taking part in the protest, told AFP.

She attended to protest the "flagrant injustice, Israeli killings and the genocide" against Palestinians, she added.

March

Thousands also marched in support of Gaza and Lebanon in cities across Turkey, including Istanbul and Ankara.

In Ramallah, in the West Bank

yesterday, protesters carried a banner showing photos of Palestinian journalists slain while covering the conflict.

In Saturday's Washington protest, a man set his left arm ablaze before bystanders and police extinguished the flames.

Thousands also marched through New York's Times Square on Saturday, some carrying pictures of people killed in Israel's military offensive in Gaza.

Clashes broke out at a pro-Palestinian protest in Rome that drew thousands on Saturday.

Dozens of young demonstrators threw bottles and firecrackers at police, who responded with tear gas and water cannon.

At least one policeman was injured and two protesters detained, AFP journalists said.

In Berlin, just over 1,000 protesters joined a pro-Palestinian demonstration on Saturday, many wearing a keffiyeh, a traditional scarf symbolising the Palestinian struggle against Israel.

Sky-high future takes shape

Three-day Routes World 2024 kicks off in Bahrain for first time, bringing together more than 2,300 global aviation leaders

The 29th edition of Routes World, the premier global aviation forum, commenced yesterday at the Bahrain International Exhibition & Convention Centre, marking the first time the event is being hosted in the Kingdom of Bahrain.

From October 6 to 8, over 2,300 delegates, including representatives from 230 airlines and 530 airports, are gathering to shape the future of global aviation.

The event is hosted by Bahrain International Airport (BIA), managed by Bahrain Airport Company (BAC), in collaboration with the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority (BTEA) and the Bahrain Economic Development Board (EDB).

Notable attendees include H.E. Mohamed bin Thamer AlKaabi, Minister of Transportation and Telecommunications; H.E. Fatima bint Jaafar Al Sairafi, Minister of Tourism; and Mohamed Yousif AlBinfalah, CEO of BAC.

Platform

During the opening ceremony, Minister AlKaabi welcomed

global participants, underscoring the importance of the event as a platform for discussions on the future of aviation, particularly enhancing global air connectivity.

He highlighted Bahrain's strategic location and its potential as a key player in a sustainable and thriving aviation sector.

Minister Al Sairafi emphasized that the event supports the objectives of the Kingdom's Tourism Strategy 2022-2026, fostering the symbiotic relationship between tourism and aviation.

She lauded Bahrain's modern exhibition infrastructure and its

growing prominence as a destination for international conferences and exhibitions, reflecting the nation's economic vision for 2030.

Milestone

BAC CEO AlBinfalah noted that hosting Routes World 2024 marks a significant milestone for Bahrain's aviation, tourism, and logistics sectors.

He expressed pride in showcasing the country's cutting-edge infrastructure and its vision to become a global hub for connectivity.

Throughout the three-day event, more than 9,000 meet-

ings are expected to take place, featuring over 40 speakers, including five airline CEOs.

Key sessions on the opening day included a Powerhouse Panel discussing the post-pandemic recovery of the aviation sector, as well as keynote speeches from CEOs of leading airlines, such as Jeffrey Goh of Gulf Air, Tony Douglas of Riyadh Air, and Steven Greenway of Flyadeal.

As Routes World 2024 unfolds, the focus will shift to critical issues like sustainability and air freight, as Bahrain positions itself as a future leader in the global aviation industry.

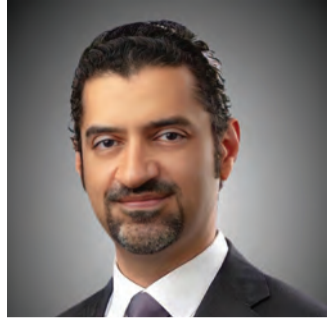

University student accused of stealing grandmother's funds

A Bahraini university student, already serving a six-month prison sentence for defrauding his aunts of over BD24,000, is facing new charges.

This time, he is accused of exploiting his grandmother, allegedly stealing BD4,000 through unauthorized transfers using a mobile banking application.

Bitterly, the student was living with his grandmother.

The student's previous conviction stemmed from a series of fraudulent transactions between 2020 and 2023.

Guilty

He was found guilty of using his aunts' electronic signatures and PINs to gain access to their mobile banking accounts, systematically transferring significant sums of money to his own account.

The court, recognizing the

severity of the crime and the financial hardship inflicted upon the victims, ordered an interim compensation of BD450 to the aunts, pending further legal proceedings to determine the full extent of restitution.

The new case centers on similar allegations. The Public Prosecution contends that the student, using illicit methods, gained unauthorized access to his grandmother's mobile banking account.

He allegedly transferred BD4,000 to his personal account, leaving the elderly woman financially vulnerable.

The prosecution's case rests heavily on bank statements that clearly show the unauthorized transfers from the grandmother's account to the student's account, providing irrefutable evidence of the fraudulent activity.

The theft was uncovered by the victim's son, who noticed the significant depletion of his mother's bank account during a routine check.

Time's up at 3am!

New regulations set closing time for Bahrain's tourism restaurants

New rules require tourism restaurants in Bahrain to close by 3am, part of an effort to improve operational standards and safety.

Tourism Minister, Her Excellency Fatima bint Al Sairafi, has announced that hotels serving food and drinks must cease all activities by this time.

Live entertainment, including music and DJs, will now be banned between 2:30am and 12pm for categories 1, 2, 3, 4, and 6, while category 5 is restricted until 6pm.

This new directive replaces previous regulations regarding operational hours, with all conflicting provisions now repealed.

Opening

Independent tourist restaurants must obtain a licence from the Bahrain Tourism and Ex-



hibitions Authority (BTEA) before opening.

They must also secure approval for their locations and cannot alter management or permit others to operate on their premises without prior consent from the relevant authorities.

Strict adherence to licensing conditions is crucial, as establishments must comply closely

with their approved activities.

Health licence

Moreover, all venues are required to display a valid health licence and adhere to health and safety standards.

They must maintain registered point-of-sale systems and provide detailed invoices to customers.

As these regulations take ef-

Bahrain launches new portal for endangered species trade

The Supreme Council for Environment has announced the launch of a new online service for international trade in endangered species, accessible through a dedicated portal (please specify the portal name if known).

This initiative aims to modernize and streamline the permitting process for CITES (Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora) regulated species.

The new online platform allows for the electronic submission of applications for the import, export, and re-export of endangered species.

Application methods

This represents a significant upgrade from previous application methods; the older system has been decommissioned for new applications, although existing applications submitted

through the old system will continue to be processed.

The system covers a wide range of endangered flora and fauna, including various species of birds (such as falcons and owls), mammals (including elephants, lions, tigers, and others, along with their parts and derivatives), reptiles (iguanas, monitors, crocodiles, snakes, and turtles), marine life (sea horses,

dugongs, dolphins, sharks, coral, and caviar from endangered sturgeon), and plants (cacti, orchids, agarwood, sandalwood, and others). All these species are subject to CITES regulations.

Permits

Exporting live animals may require additional permits from relevant Bahraini authorities, such as veterinary permits,

The online system will ensure compliance with CITES regulations and contributing to broader conservation efforts in Bahrain.

and all shipments must comply with International Air Transport Association (IATA) regulations.

Trade for personal use is limited to a maximum of two specimens.

The online system is expected to improve efficiency and transparency in the management of international trade in endangered species, ensuring compliance with CITES regulations and contributing to broader conservation efforts in Bahrain.

29-year-old cleaner arrested in drug ring bust

The High Criminal Court has officially scheduled October 28th to announce its ruling in the high-profile trial of a 29-year-old Asian man, who is currently employed as a cleaner, and is accused of being involved in a significant drug trafficking operation that has drawn considerable attention.

The defendant, whose occupation is officially listed as a cleaner, faces multiple serious charges, including possessing hashish with the intent to traffic, as well as possessing hashish, heroin, and a controlled substance for personal use.

All these charges are in direct violation of Bahraini law, which strictly regulates drug-related offenses and imposes severe

penalties on those found guilty.

The case originated from an extensive undercover investigation that targeted an Asian-led drug trafficking network known for utilizing "dead drop" methods via couriers to distribute

illegal substances.

Sophisticated operation

This sophisticated operation involved various individuals acting as intermediaries to transport drugs discreetly.

The investigation revealed that the defendant played a crucial role as one of these couriers, facilitating the movement of drugs between suppliers and users.

During a thorough search of the defendant's residence, law enforcement officials discovered two gloves containing traces of a dark paste, which is believed to be hashish.

This evidence was pivotal in building the case against him.

When questioned by authorities, the defendant confessed to using drugs himself, candidly stating that he had been purchasing them from another Asian man for a period of four months.

He disclosed that he made five separate purchases, each time acquiring between 5 to 10 grams of the illicit substances.

Home delivery for newborn passports launched

The Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA) has unveiled a new home delivery service for newborn passports, aiming to ease the process for new parents.

This service, accessible through the e-Government portal and the NPRA-Bahrain app, allows families to bypass service centres and focus on welcoming

their babies.

His Excellency Shaikh Hisham bin Abdul Rahman Al Khalifa, Undersecretary for NPRA at the Interior Ministry, announced the rollout of this delivery option in response to rising demand from citizens.

The initiative has been developed in partnership with the Information and eGovernment Authority and logistics provider Tam.

The Undersecretary explained that this service simplifies the process of obtaining passports for newborns.

Parents can now receive their passports at home, with a verification code sent to ensure secure delivery.

Shaikh Hisham encouraged citizens to take advantage of this and other eServices, which aim to enhance the quality of government offerings.

Bahrain's luxury real estate market set to hit \$376 million by 2029

Bahrain's high-end real estate market is projected to rise from \$279.82 million in 2024 to \$376.39 million by 2029, reflecting an annual growth rate of 6.11%.

This growth is driven by increasing demand from Gulf buyers and foreign investors, alongside steady interest in upscale rental real estate.

Despite stable capital values across the broader housing sector, an oversupply of properties has dampened the market in recent years, according to Mordor Intelligence.

However, demand for luxury villas and premium properties remains strong, particularly among expatriates, retirees, and foreign buyers attracted to Bahrain's secure environment, reasonable cost of living, and diverse community.

Values

Real estate firms have observed a slight decrease in values, with apartment and villa prices dropping by 1.2% and 2.6%, respectively, in early 2022.

Foreigners are restricted to buying in designated freehold areas, such as Durrat Al Bahrain, Reef Island, and Amwaj

Islands.

With approximately 9,000 units expected in Diyar Al Muharraq by 2026, some are concerned about the potential pressure on rental prices.

Major developments like the Golden Gate Towers, Oryx Bahrain Bay, and Paramount Tower are expected to add over 4,000 luxury units to the market in the coming years, potentially impacting both sales and rental prices as these projects are completed.

Key players

The sector remains fragmented, with key players like Diyar Al Muharraq, Naseej, and Ithmaar Development Company leading large-scale projects.

Mergers and acquisitions are expected to increase, potentially spurring further growth and attracting more firms into Bahrain's luxury property market.

Bahrain's real estate sector continues to evolve, with a focus on sustainability, transparency, and forward-thinking policies that encourage investment.

The market is set to remain a strong draw for foreign buyers, particularly from the Gulf, Europe, and Asia.

Comply or pay

Employers beware: LMRA introduces new hefty fines for violating hiring rules

● **First offense BD500, repeat offenders face BD1,000 fine**

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) has rolled out a new tiered fine system aimed at employers who violate hiring regulations.

The rules, featured in the latest edition of the Official Gazette, stipulate that those caught employing foreign workers without the necessary permits will face an immediate penalty of BD500. Repeat offenders will see the fine double to BD1,000.

This move signifies increased vigilance over labour practices and aims to boost compliance



among employers of foreign workers.

Employers who persist in employing expat workers with expired permits will face escalating fines depending on how long the violation continues.

A fine of BD100 applies if the offence is detected within 10 days of the permit's expiry, ris-

ing to BD200 between 10 and 20 days, and BD300 for delays extending from 20 to 30 days. Beyond 30 days, the statutory minimum fine will be enforced.

Permit

Moreover, expat workers found to be working without a permit for the first time will

This action reflects a heightened awareness of labour practices and seeks to enhance compliance among employers of foreign workers.

incur a fine of BD500.

Employers can now settle these penalties online; once fines are paid within the new time frame, the case will be closed, preventing any further legal repercussions.

These changes replace the regulations established in 2008, as the LMRA seeks to improve compliance across the board.

Couple wins major lawsuit against sorcerer and accomplice in scam

The High Civil Court has delivered a significant victory to a couple who were victims of a complex fraud scheme orchestrated by a sorcerer and his accomplice.

The High Civil Court ordered the pair to pay the couple substantial compensation for defrauding them of their property under the guise of removing a curse.

The couple, hoping to conceive a child, sought the sorcerer's help.

Exploiting their vulnerability, the defendants convinced them that their land, valued at approximately BD100,000, was cursed and needed to be transferred to the sorcerer to break the spell.

Tactic

Using the same tactic, they also acquired two vehicles (worth around BD6,000) and gold jewelry (BD7,000) belonging to the couple.

The couple subsequently filed a criminal complaint, leading to a three-year prison sentence for the sorcerer. His accomplice was initially acquitted but later received a two-year prison sentence and a 5,000 Bahraini dinar fine after a successful appeal by the



prosecution.

In the civil case, the court ordered the defendants to jointly pay the husband approximately BD96,800, the wife BD800, and a further BD1,100 to both as compensation for damages.

Equivalent value

The court also ruled that the land and vehicles must be returned to the couple, or their equivalent value must be paid.

Evidence presented included

WhatsApp messages between the husband and the sorcerer, detailing financial transactions totaling BD17,500, further solidifying the fraudulent nature of the scheme.

The couple's lawyer, Zahra Hassan, successfully argued for the annulment of the land sale contract, citing coercion, deception, and exploitation.

She also secured additional compensation for the couple's displacement from their home.

Rescuers say 17 dead in Gaza as Israel troops encircle Jabaliya

Gaza's civil defence agency said yesterday that Israeli air strikes in Jabaliya killed at least 17 people as Israeli forces said they had surrounded the area to prevent Hamas from regrouping.

Following a year of fighting after Hamas's unprecedented October 7 attack on Israel, large swathes of Gaza have been reduced to rubble as the Israeli army aimed to completely destroy the militant group.

But in recent months, troops have returned to several areas across the Palestinian territory where they had previously conducted operations against Hamas, only to find militants regrouping.

The Israeli military said Sunday its forces surrounded the Jabaliya area of northern Gaza in response to indications that Hamas was rebuilding despite nearly a year of strikes and fighting.

"The troops of the 401st Brigade and the 460th Brigade have successfully encircled the area and are currently continuing to operate in the area," the military said in a statement on Sunday.

It cited intelligence suggesting the "presence of terrorists and terror infrastructure in the area of Jabaliya... as well as efforts by Hamas to rebuild its operational capabilities in the area".

Israeli aircraft struck "dozens of military targets" in support of ground troops, it said.

Hamas-run Gaza's civil defence spokesman Mahmud Bassal said multiple strikes rocked Jabaliya overnight.

Lebanon state media says 'very violent' Israeli strikes hit south Beirut

Official Lebanese media said Israeli strikes hit south Beirut Saturday night into Sunday, some of them "very violent", with AFP correspondents hearing explosions for over two hours in one of the most intense barrages yet.

"Israeli enemy warplanes carried out four very violent strikes on (Beirut's) southern suburbs, and one strike on the Chweifat" area, with ambulances rushing to the site, Lebanon's National News Agency said.

Iran has prepared response to any Israeli attack

Iran has prepared a plan to respond to a possible Israeli attack following the Islamic republic's retaliatory missile strike against it last week, local media reported yesterday.

"The plan for the necessary response to a possible action by the Zionists (Israel) has been fully prepared," Tasnim news agency said, quoting "an informed source" in the armed forces.

On Tuesday, the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) fired some 200 missiles at Israel in retaliation after the leaders of groups allied to Tehran were killed in attacks.

"If Israel takes action, there will be no doubt that an Iranian counterattack will be carried out," said Tasnim.

It added that Iran "has a list of many Israeli targets", and said Iran's attack on Tuesday "showed that we can level to the ground any place it desires".

Israel strike hits car factory in Syria: monitor

An Israeli strike in Syria on Sunday targeted trucks transporting aid for Lebanese people, wounding three aid workers, a war monitor said, the latest such attack on the country.

Israeli aircraft launched "air strikes with three missiles targeting... three trucks loaded with food and medical supplies inside an Iranian car factory... in southern Homs", said the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights.

The attack destroyed the trucks and wounded three aid workers, said the British-based monitor with a network of sources inside Syria.

Israel army says more troops deployed near Gaza ahead of October 7 anniversary

The Israeli military said Sunday it deployed more troops to defend southern communities and areas bordering Gaza, ahead of the anniversary of the October 7 attack by Hamas.

"The IDF's (army) Gaza Division has been reinforced with several platoons, with forces stationed to defend both the communities and the border area," the military said.

"The soldiers are fully equipped to defend the region in coordination with local security forces," it said in a statement.

Inside Gaza, the military said three divisions were working to "dismantle terrorist infrastructure and degrade Hamas's capabilities".

"The Southern Command remains at a heightened state of vigilance and readiness for the coming days," commanding officer Major General Yaron Finkelman was quoted as saying.

Earlier, the military said its forces had surrounded the area of Jabaliya in central Gaza where Hamas was trying to rebuild its operational capabilities.

"The soldiers are fully equipped to defend the region in coordination with local security forces," it said in a statement.

Inside Gaza, the military said three divisions were working to "dismantle terrorist infrastructure and degrade Hamas's capabilities".

"The Southern Command remains at a heightened state of vigilance and readiness for the coming days," commanding officer Major General Yaron Finkelman was quoted as saying.

Earlier, the military said its forces had surrounded the area of Jabaliya in central Gaza where Hamas was trying to rebuild its operational capabilities.

On October 7 last year, Hamas broke through the border from Gaza into Israel in what would become the deadliest attack in Israel's history.

At the end of the Jewish holiday of Sukkot, they launched their assault by land, air, and sea.

Israel's relentless offensive on Gaza has so far killed at least 41,870 people, a majority of them civilians, according to the health ministry in the Hamas-run Palestinian territory.

A Testament to Peaceful Coexistence and Cultural Harmony

In the heart of the Gulf, the vibrant sounds of drums and the scent of incense carry far beyond the ornate pandals of Adhari Park. This is the celebration of Durga Puja, organized annually by Bongiyoy Samaj Bahrain, a Bengali community group in the Kingdom, since 1988. For over three decades, this festival has transcended its religious roots to become a powerful symbol of peaceful coexistence, reflective of Bahrain's commitment to tolerance and inclusivity.

From its humble beginnings within the club premises of Bongiyoy Samaj, Durga Puja has blossomed into a grand cultural event that draws not only members of Bahrain's Bengali community but also visitors from neighbouring Gulf countries like Saudi Arabia and Qatar. What began as a small gathering now attracts crowds ranging from 2,000 to 2,500 people over the festival's four days. These visitors span a spectrum of nationalities and religions, coming together to participate in the exuberant festivities. This year, the festival begins on October 9th (Wednesday).

Celebrating inclusion

At the heart of this celebration lies Bahrain's remarkable openness and the freedom it affords all religious communities to practice their faith without restriction. "The Kingdom's values of tolerance and peaceful coexistence are experienced by all our members," said Subhodip Ghosh of Bongiyoy Samaj. "Despite differences in opinion, every one of us agrees on the freedom Bahrain offers. It is this very spirit of inclusion that makes Bahrain our home."

The Durga Puja celebrations have not only thrived but have evolved over the years. The festival was first held at the Shree Krishna Temple in Bahrain,



before moving to Adhari Park due to increasing numbers. This transition has allowed Bongiyoy Samaj to preserve the grandeur of Bengal's traditional Pujas, complete with intricately crafted idols flow in from Kolkata, elaborate

pandals, and traditional performances like the dazzling 'Dhanuchi' dance, performed to the rhythmic beats of the 'dhak'.

"The stirring synergy of chants, floral scents, and the clattering bangles brings to life memories of home," said Sudipto Saha, former president of



Bongiyoy Samaj. "But this festival is more than just a religious observance. It has become a multicultural event, attended by Indians, Bangladeshis, and Bahrainis alike. It's a celebration of art, culture, and performance that unites us across boundaries of caste, creed, and religion."

The festival has even garnered international recognition, winning the prestigious 'Biswa Bangla Sarad Samaan' award in 2017 for the best Durga Puja celebration outside of India. Yet, it is not just the scale or splendour of the event that makes it special. The festival serves as a living testament to Bahrain's harmonious blend of cultures, with temples, churches, and gurdwaras coexisting alongside mosques - a rare sight in many parts of the world.

Open-minded government

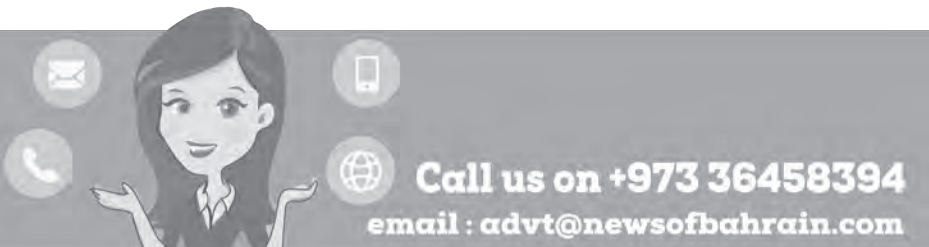

Juventus held by Cagliari after late penalty drama

Juventus were held to a surprise 1-1 home draw by Cagliari on Sunday after a late penalty which led to the Turin giants conceding second place in Serie A to Inter Milan.

Razvan Marin lashed home the 88th-minute leveler to give Cagliari a point at the Allianz Stadium after Roberto Piccoli was clumsily brought down by Douglas Luiz,

Romania midfielder Marin's arrowed penalty levelled Dusan Vlahovic's 15th-minute spot-kick and moved Cagliari up to 15th, a

His opener was controversial as the penalty was awarded for Cagliari defender Sebastiano Luperto's fingers grazing the ball as he engaged in an aerial tussle with Federico Gatti.

The spot-kick was given after a VAR check as Luperto's arm was high in the air when he touched the ball, but he was landing from his jump and had Gatti leaning on his shoulder while two other players also battled for the ball.

India captain Harmanpreet Kaur produced a steely 29 to steer her side to a scrappy six-wicket victory over Pakistan in Dubai on Sunday.

Set 106 to win after restricting Pakistan to 105-8 in their 20 overs, India were looking comfortable at 61-1. But two wickets in two balls by Pakistan captain Fatima Sana opened the door before Kaur took her side to the brink of victory.

With India two runs short, however, she slipped and appeared to rick her neck, leaving the field unbeaten on 29 from 24 balls.

Sajeevan Sajana hit the winning runs from the next delivery

All of the Indian bowlers contributed with Arundhati Reddy the most successful as she removed Omaira Sohail (3) and Aliya Riaz (4) in the middle order before clean bowling Dar in the final over to finish with 3-19 from her four overs.

"I've worked a lot on my T20 bowling in all stages of the in-

nings. I'm still working hard now. I kept it simple and attacked the stumps," said Reddy who was named Player of the Match.

India lost Mandhana for seven but Shafali Verma and Jemimah Rodriguestook them to 61 before the second wicket fell in the 12th over.

Verma, their impressive 20-year-old opener, struck three fours in a 35-ball 32 before holding out to mid-on.

That gave Pakistan a sniff of a chance but Kaur made sure India made it 13 wins from 16 against Pakistan in T20Is.

After losing their opening match to New Zealand, this was a much-needed win for In-

dia in Group A. They remain fourth in the group, with Pakistan just ahead of them on net run rate.

The Polish striker reached 10 goals for the season in nine league games, stretching his lead as the division's top goalscorer with a first-half treble.

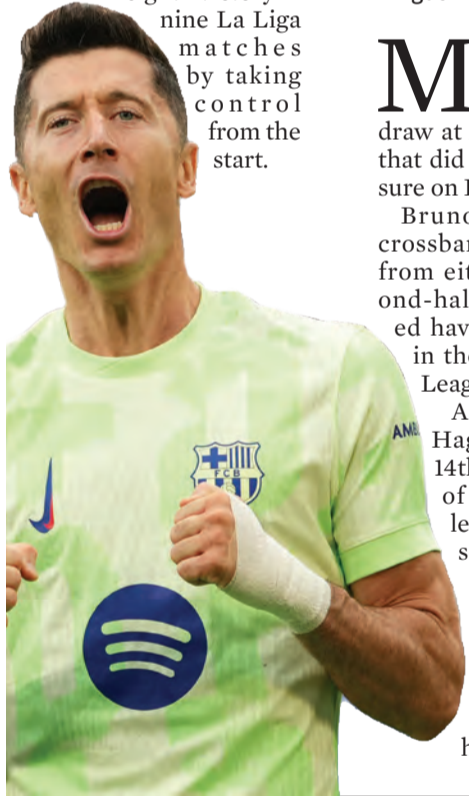

Manchester United's winless run stretched to five games in a 0-0 draw at Aston Villa on Sunday that did little to ease the pressure on Erik ten Hag.

Bruno Fernandes hit the crossbar with the best effort from either side from a second-half free-kick but United have now failed to score in their last three Premier League games.

A point leaves Ten Hag's men still down in 14th, having won just two of their opening seven league games of the season.

"We know in this moment we have a lack of goals," said Ten Hag.

"In that perspective it's not a good start, we have to step up. That's

an area we have to improve."

Fifth-placed Villa missed the chance to move into the top four as they were unable to repeat their heroics of beating Bayern Munich in midweek.

United's 3-0 humiliation on home soil by Tottenham last weekend had plunged Ten Hag's job back into peril.

A 3-3 draw against Porto in the Europa League on Thursday did the Dutchman's case little favours as United blew an early two-goal lead to trail 3-2 before Harry Maguire's injury-time leveller. Ten Hag reacted by dropping centre-backs Lisandro Martinez and Matthijs de Ligt after their chastening night in Portugal with Maguire and veteran Jonny Evans brought back in to the starting line-up.

Villa had a far more memorable European night in midweek when Bayern were beaten 1-0 as the Champions League returned to Birmingham for the first time

in over 40 years.

Both sides showed signs of fatigue as the match failed to spark into life.

"We missed some energy, but I am happy because the draw was not the worst result," said Villa boss Unai Emery.

"In the second half we corrected some things to control the match." Ten Hag controversially replaced Marcus Rashford at half-time in Porto after he had scored and set up Rasmus Hojlund's second for United inside the opening 20 minutes.

The United boss said that decision was motivated by managing the minutes of his wingers and Rashford was the visitors' biggest threat.

Bruno hits bar

The England international cut inside and forced Emi Martinez into the only save of the first half with a powerful strike after five minutes.

Morgan Rogers fired wide

at the other end, but United's reshaped defence held out with little problems until the break.

Ten Hag was forced into another defensive reshuffle at half-time as Maguire and Nonsair Mazraoui were forced off injured as De Ligt and Victor Lindelof came on.

Rashford forced Martinez into another good save with a blistering shot from outside the box. But he was lucky not to be sent-off for two bookable offences just minutes apart.

Rashford had been booked when he brought down Leon Bailey and was swiftly substituted by Ten Hag to avoid a United dismissal for the third consecutive game.

Fernandes' red card against Tottenham had been rescinded to allow him to play and the United captain came as close to anyone to scoring a winner with a free-kick that came back off the bar.

West Indies cruise to T20 World Cup win over Scotland

The 2016 winners, who had suffered a 10-wicket thrashing by the South Africans at the same Dubai venue on Friday, were rarely threatened by a Scotland side making their tournament debut this year.

Arshdeep, Chakravarthy help India hammer Bangladesh in T20 opener

India's Arshdeep Singh and returning Varun Chakravarthy rattled the Bangladesh batting to set up a dominant seven-wicket win for the hosts in the first T20 international on Sunday.

Left-arm quick Arshdeep and spinner Chakravarthy took three wickets to help bowl out Bangladesh for 127, a total India overhauled with 49 balls to spare in Gwalior and lead the three-match series 1-0.

It was India's first win in the format at home after they were crowned T20 World Cup champions in



Barbados in June.

Opener Sanju Samson and skipper Suryakumar Yadav -- both scoring 29 -- started the chase with a blazing stand of 40 for the second wicket to take the steam out of the opposition attack.

Samson, a wicketkeeper-batsman, smashed six boundaries but Suryakumar fired up the home crowd with his 14-ball knock laced with two fours and three sixes.

Suryakumar smashed Mustafizur Rahman for a six over long-on but fell next ball caught at long leg.

Hardik Pandya then clubbed 39 off 16 balls

with five fours and two sixes, sharing an unbeaten stand of 52 with debutant

Nitish Kumar Reddy, who made 16.

But it was the Indian bowl-

ers who made an early impression after the hosts elected to field first and Arshdeep backed his captain's decision with two wickets inside three overs.

Litton Das top-edged an angling delivery from Arshdeep to be caught at short cover and soon fellow opener Parvez Hossain Emon inside-edged the ball onto his stumps.

Debutant quick Mayank Yadav -- an IPL pace sensation who made heads turn with deliveries of more than 150 kilometres (93 miles) per hour, started with a maiden over and then struck in his second to send back Mahmudullah Riyad out for one.

Wickets kept falling and Chakravarthy, who has returned to the team after the 2021 T20 World Cup, struck regular blows

with his mystery spin to rattle the opposition middle-order.

Mehidy Hasan Miraz fought hard with an unbeaten 35 but found little support and Arshdeep ended the innings in 19.5 overs. Bangladesh, led by Najmul Hossain Shanto, came into the T20 matches at the back of a 2-0 loss in the Tests.



The next match is in the Indian capital New Delhi on Wednesday.
