**Voters speak**

Busaiteen by-elections: Qarata and Al Shaikh advance to second round

● Next round set to be held on Saturday, Sep. 14

Following the vote count in Muharraq's first electoral constituency for the by-elections, Abdulwahid Qarata and Ebrahim Al Shaikh have emerged as the leading candidates. Both will advance to the second round scheduled for next Saturday, 14th September.

Polling stations in Muharraq's First Constituency (Busaiteen) were closed and secured at 8:00 pm, after residents cast their ballots to elect a new MP.

Seven independent candidates had been vying for the seat following the disqualification of Mohammed Rafiq Al Hussaini due to foreign citizenship, as ruled by the Court of Cassation on 10 July.

The contest is one of Bahrain's most closely watched, with over 11,900 registered voters.

**Observers**

The process began under the scrutiny of election observers, with the chairman of the supervisory committee ensuring the ballot boxes were empty before sealing them.

"There was a steady flow of voters at the Busaiteen polling station, with a good turnout. Ten lines were opened to manage the crowd," Judge Mohammed Al Rumaihi told The Daily Tribune. Voters of all ages participated, with a noticeable presence of women.

## Asian fugitive extradited to Bahrain

The International and Interpol Affairs Directorate of the Anti-Corruption and Economic and Electronic Security got back an Asian fugitive from a country to serve a sentence after being convicted of money laundering in coordination with the Financial Intelligence National Centre.

He was handed over to the Kingdom eight days after is-

suing an international notice based on an international arrest warrant issued by Bahrain's Public Prosecution as part of coordinating and cooperating with brotherly and friendly countries to track down the accused.

The directorate asserted that per the rules of the law, legal proceedings were taken against the arrestee before handing him to the Financial Intelligence National Centre.

Bahrain has launched its National Summary Data Page (NSDP), a unified platform for publishing financial, economic, and demographic data, aimed at enhancing transparency and the integration of statistical information.

The page facilitates the exchange of statistical and descriptive data.

His Excellency Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa Al Khalifa, the Minister of Finance and National Economy, highlighted Bahrain's commitment to strengthening its international status under



the leadership of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa.

He emphasised the role of comprehensive data in improving governance, attracting in-

The Finance Minister also stressed the importance of ongoing cooperation with the International Monetary Fund (IMF) to apply the highest international standards, commending the collaborative efforts between Team Bahrain and the IMF that contributed to the launch of the NSDP.

The NSDP is available through Bahrain's Open Data Portal, providing data exchange through Statistical Data and Metadata Exchange (SDMX) and supporting Bahrain's efforts to meet the IMF's Special Data Dissemination Standard (SDDS).

## Banking on change

Parliament to consider new law allowing partial check payments

The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee of the House of Representatives is currently reviewing a new law proposed by the government aimed at significantly reforming the existing regulations governing check transactions.

The government's memorandum to the parliament emphasises the need for these changes, citing the negative aspects revealed by the practical application of check transactions. The proposed law aims to address these issues through various amendments and new provisions.

One of the key features of the new law is the introduction of partial check payment. This provision mandates banks to fulfill partial payment of a check if the account balance is insufficient to cover the full amount, unless the holder explicitly refuses partial payment.

The law further stipulates that the holder can resubmit the partially paid check, and the drawer is obligated to mark the check with details of each partial payment. The original check must be returned to the holder along with a certificate confirming the partial payment.

### Regulations

The proposed law also man-

dates the Central Bank of Bahrain (CBB) to issue regulations outlining the terms, conditions, and procedures for implementing partial check payment, including both cash payment and settlement through book entries, such as account crediting, bank transfers, clearing, or other methods determined by the bank.

Furthermore, the law states

that the drawer's credit record will be marked in cases where a check is returned due to insufficient funds or partial payment.

The CBB will issue regulations defining the criteria and procedures for such marking, as well as the procedures for its removal.

### Transactions

This new law, if passed, could significantly impact the way check transactions are conducted in Bahrain, potentially leading to a more flexible and efficient system for both individuals and businesses.

It will also reduce the cases of the bounce-checks referred to the Public Prosecution.

According to official statistics released recently, checks returned due to financial reasons saw a slight decrease in number, from 3,215 in the first half of 2023 to 3,102 in the first half of 2024, but their value rose from BD7.8 million to BD9.0 million.

# Blueprint for progress

Muharrag Municipal Council: 156 recommendations and 21 decisions in 10 months

The Muharrag Municipal Council has revealed that its 21 meetings over the past 10 months have resulted in 156 recommendations and 21 decisions.

Key among these are the preservation of coastal areas, the development of promenades and parks, the construction of playgrounds, and infrastructure projects including sewage networks and street improvements.

The council approved a proposal to establish a dedicated marina for the maintenance of traditional boats in Muharrag, and recommended finding suitable solutions for rainwater accumulation.

They also submitted requests for the planting of trees in several squares and streets, as well as the establishment of a nursery and greenhouses.

The Muharrag Municipal Council prepared its annual report on the second phase of the sixth term of municipal council work, covering the period from September 2023 to June 2024.

## Meetings

A total of 21 council meetings

## Chairmanship

The Services and Facilities Committee, chaired by member Ahmed Yusuf Al Maqhaw, held 17 meetings and issued 130 recommendations and 8 decisions.

The Technical Committee, chaired by member Moham-

med Yusuf Al Mahmoud, held 13 meetings and reached 7 recommendations and 2 decisions.

According to the report, some of the council's most prominent recommendations include providing insights on the proposal submitted by the Council of Representatives regarding the preservation and development of

coastal areas in all governorates, and the provision of essential services to them.

## Ideas

The council also presented ideas for the creation of promenades, the development of existing parks, their maintenance, the construction of playgrounds

for the youth of Muharrag, and taking necessary precautions and measures to address rising sea levels.

The council also approved a proposal to establish a dedicated marina for the maintenance of traditional boats in Muharrag, and recommended finding suitable solutions for rainwater accumulation.

They also submitted requests for the planting of trees in several squares and streets, as well as the establishment of a nursery and greenhouses.

## Action

Regarding the development of street infrastructure and finding solutions to traffic congestion, the council has taken action on several projects.

Notably, they are following up on the completion of Riya Avenue and the streets leading to it, as it is a strategic street connecting various areas of Muharrag and leading to the capital, Manama.

In addition, they are monitoring streets, roads, and pathways in all districts, creating entrances and exits, bridges, and a dedicated marina for the maintenance of traditional boats.

## Reduction in Baggage Allowance: Indian Expatriates Raise Protest

Reduction in baggage allowance of passengers from 30 kilogrammes to 20 kilogrammes by Air India for flights to the GCC region has been questioned as unfair by Pravasi Legal Cell (PLC), an organization dedicated to the welfare of Indian expatriates.

A formal representation has been filed by PLC to K. Rammoohan Naidu, Union Minister for Civil Aviation of India, expressing deep concern over the recent reduction in free baggage allowance on Air India Express flights.

Talking to The Daily Tribune, Sudheer Thirunilathu, PLC President and Global PRO, said Air India's decision will soon

be followed by other air airlines operating to India from the GCC region and this would cause great difficulties for the Indian expatriates.

## Difficult

Further, he pointed out that Air India is also not allowing passengers of Air India Express to carry laptops onboard and is insisting for including laptops in the seven-kilogramme limit for cabin luggage, making it further difficult for passengers who are already facing the reduced allowance of 20 kilogrammes of check-in luggage.

In the complaint to the aviation minister, PLC focuses Air India's decision to cut the free baggage allowance from 30 kg to 20 kg on flights from the

United Arab Emirates (UAE) to India, a move that has caused widespread distress among Indian expats, particularly those in the GCC countries.

The PLC argues that this change was implemented without sufficient notice or explanation, putting additional financial strain on passengers.

## Tight budgets

"Many expatriates, especially low-income workers, can only afford to visit their families every two or three years. The reduction in baggage allowance, combined with exorbitant charges for excess baggage, severely impacts their already tight budgets," stated advocate Jose Abraham, Global President of PLC, in the letter.

## Ireland and UK to 'reset' relations as Starmer visits Dublin

UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer yesterday made the first visit by a British leader to Ireland in five years, vowing to "reset" damaged post-Brexit relations between the neighbouring nations.

The visit, described by Downing Street as a "historic moment for UK-Ireland relations", signals a further warming in ties that had frayed under the UK's previous Conservative government.

Irish counterpart Simon Harris welcomed Starmer to Dublin, with the pair shaking hands and posing for photographs before heading for talks.

# China tells US it presents 'opportunity' not 'threat'

Chinese Vice Commerce Minister Wang Shouwen told his US counterpart on Saturday that a modern China was an economic "opportunity" not a "threat" to the United States, the ministry said.

Trade is one of the many areas of friction between the world's two leading powers, along with rivalry in technology and tensions in the South China Sea and over Taiwan.

Wang met US Under Secretary of Commerce for International Trade Mari-sa Lago in the northern port city of Tianjin --

the second meeting this year between the two officials.

They held "professional, rational and pragmatic" discussions on political and trade issues, raised in particular by the business communities of the two coun-

tries, the commerce ministry said in a statement.

Wang expressed China's concerns about the numerous US customs duties and sanctions targeting Chinese companies or products.

He also stressed that Beijing was opposed to restrictions put in place by the United States on trade and investment "under the pretext of Chi-

nese overcapacity".

"A modern China with a large population presents an opportunity, not a threat for the United States," Wang told his US counterpart, according to the ministry.

Chinese companies and products are the target of numerous US sanctions or restrictions, imposed in particular in the fight against unfair competition or in the interests of national security.

Washington announced on Thursday a further tightening of controls on exports of advanced technologies in a measure that targets the Asian giant, among others.



## UAE's Etihad finds 'no issues' with engines of A350 fleet: statement

Dubai, United Arab Emirates

UAE carrier Etihad Airways said it found no issues with the engines of its Airbus A350 fleet following inspections prompted by an engine fire on one of Hong Kong-based Cathay Pacific's flights. The Cathay incident prompted the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) to issue an emergency directive to airlines ordering mandated inspections on all A350-1000s, which are powered by Trent XWB-97 engines made by Rolls-Royce.

Etihad Airways, which operates five of the Airbus A350-1000s, is the only airline in the United Arab Emirates that has this aircraft type in service.

# How a taxi driver in El Salvador got rich with Bitcoin

San Salvador, El Salvador

Napoleon Osorio is proud of being the first taxi driver to have accepted payment in bitcoin in the first country in the world to make the cryptocurrency legal tender: El Salvador.

He credits President Nayib Bukele's decision to bank on bitcoin three years ago with changing his life.

"Before I was unemployed... and now I have my own business," said the 39-year-old businessman, who uses an app to charge for rides in bitcoin and now runs his own car rental company.

Three years ago the leader of the Central American nation took a huge gamble when he put bitcoin into legal circulation in a bid to revitalize El Salvador's dollarized, remittance-reliant economy.

He invested hundreds of millions of dollars of taxpayer money in the cryptocurrency, despite warnings about volatility risks from global institutions.

Osorio credited the US founder of the NGO My First Bitcoin,

John Dennehy, with encouraging him to accept payment in the cryptocurrency.

He now has 21 drivers working for his Bit-Driver brand and has made enough profit from the currency's rise to be able to buy four rental vehicles.

A divorced father of two teenagers, he also no longer struggles to pay for their education.

Launching bitcoin as legal tender on September 7, 2021, Bukele said he wanted to bring

the 70 percent of Salvadorans who do not use banks into the financial system and promptly began plowing public money in cryptocurrencies.

To spur Salvadorans to use bitcoin he created the Chivo Wallet app for sending and receiving bitcoin free of charge and gave \$30 to each new user.

His grand ambitions for bitcoin fell foul of the International Monetary Fund (IMF), which hesitated to grant El Salvador a

\$1.3 billion loan because of its official use of the cryptocurrency.

In August, however, the IMF announced a preliminary loan agreement with El Salvador, while saying it needed to mitigate "potential risks."

### Offered as 'option'

While Osorio has grown relatively wealthy with bitcoin, a study by the University Institute for Public Opinion showed that 88 percent of Salvadorans had yet to use it.

"From the beginning... it was clear that it was clearly an ill-advised measure that the population rejected," the director of the institute, Laura Andrade, told AFP.

One-quarter of Salvadoran GDP comes from remittances sent home by family members, mostly from the United States.

But in 2023 only one percent of the transfers were made in cryptocurrencies.

In an interview with Time magazine in August, Bukele acknowledged that while "you can go to a McDonald's, a supermarket, or a hotel and pay with Bit-

coin" it had "not had the widespread adoption we hoped for."

He added that "the positive aspect is that it is voluntary; we have never forced anyone to adopt it. We offered it as an option, and those who chose to use it have benefited from the rise in Bitcoin."

He also confirmed that he had around \$400 million in bitcoin that is kept in a public "cold storage wallet" -- a way of storing bitcoin offline.

Bitcoin's fortunes have been mixed. This week it was trading

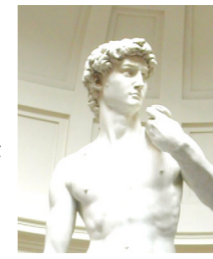
at around \$52,000, down from a peak of \$73,616 on March 13. In November 2022 it fell as low as \$16,189. Independent economist Cesar Villalona told AFP that Bukele himself had hobbled bitcoin's take-up by stripping it of the usual functions of a currency.

"Bukele... said: there will be no salary in bitcoin, there will be no pensions in bitcoin, there will be no savings in bitcoin and there will be no price in bitcoin, and in so doing took away the three functions of money," Villalona said.

Luis Contreras, an instructor at My First Bitcoin, told AFP many Salvadorans were simply afraid of making the switch.

The organization has taken cryptocurrencies into public schools, teaching around 35,000 students to use bitcoin so far.

Contreras says the hardest thing about training people on bitcoin "is their fear of new things, which creates a fear of technology" as well as "the fear of moving from a classic currency in the current economy to one that is totally digital and decentralized."



News in brief

The crew of a plane that crashed in Brazil last month had reported a failure in its de-icing system, according to an official report released Friday. Videos showed the Voepass airline flight in a downward spin, falling almost vertically before it crashed into a residential area in the town of Vinhedo, some 80 kilometers (50 miles) northwest of Brazil's financial capital Sao Paulo on August 9.

Though the preliminary report noted "very icy" conditions, it did not point to a specific cause of the crash, in which all 62 people on board died. A minute before the ATR 72-500 plane started to lose altitude, the copilot noticed "a lot of ice," according to the report, released by Brazil's Aeronautical Accidents Investigation and Prevention Center (CENIPA). Hours after the incident, experts pointed to the possibility of ice formation on the wings affecting the plane's lift, contributing to the accident.

Italy's culture minister resigned Friday weeks after being caught in an adulterous affair with a younger woman who filmed their rendezvous with internet-connected smart glasses. Gennaro Sangiuliano had tried to hold on to his job after being embroiled in the scandal that emerged last month, when Maria Rosaria Bocca started posting photos of the two of them at public events. "After reflecting during these painful days I decided to irrevocably resign from my post as Minister of Culture," Sangiuliano wrote to Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni in a letter published by his ministry. Meloni, in a statement, thanked him for his "extraordinary service". Sangiuliano's departure comes less than two weeks before Italy hosts a meeting of culture ministers of the G7 group of industrialised countries, which Italy is

presiding this year. Donald Trump was set to hold a rally in the US swing state of Wisconsin on Saturday while Democrat Kamala Harris hunkered down in another crucial battleground, Pennsylvania, preparing for next week's televised presidential debate. Trump and Harris are essentially tied in the polls, with the Republican again shrugging off a mountain of scandals that would have sunk candidates of the past. 'Starliner is back on Earth': Boeing Starliner successfully lands without NASA astronaut Sunita Williams

Boeing's Starliner spacecraft has safely returned to Earth after completing an uncrewed journey back from the International Space Station (ISS). The capsule touched down at White Sands Space Harbor in New Mexico at 9:31 a.m. IST, concluding a critical test mission for NASA's Commercial Crew Program. Though initially launched with NASA astronauts Sunita Williams and Butch Wilmore, the spacecraft returned without them due to safety concerns. In this case, that the patient received antiviral treatment, and that no further cases have been detected among close contacts".

Sunita Williams and Butch Wilmore remain aboard the ISS, continuing their work as part of the Expedition 71/72 crew. They are now scheduled to return to Earth in February 2025 aboard SpaceX's Dragon capsule, part of NASA's Crew-9 mission. Despite the complications, NASA remains committed to working with Boeing to develop Starliner into a reliable spacecraft. NASA's Steve Stich, manager of the Commercial Crew Program, said, "Every test provides valuable data. We're confident that Boeing will make the necessary improvements to ensure Starliner's future success."

Truce hopes slim as Gaza war enters 12th month

The war between Israel and Hamas in Gaza entered its 12 month Saturday with little sign of respite for the Palestinian territory or hope for Israeli hostages still held captive. The chances of a truce that would also swap Palestinian prisoners jailed by Israel for hostages held by Hamas appear slim, with both sides sticking doggedly to their positions. Hamas, whose October 7 attack on Israel sparked the war, is demanding a complete Israeli withdrawal, but Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu insists troops must remain along the Gaza-Egypt border. The United States, Qatar and Egypt have all been mediating in an effort to bring about a ceasefire

American activist killed

International pressure to end the war was further underlined by Friday's shooting dead in the West Bank of a Turkish-American activist demonstrating against Israeli settlements in the occupied territory. The family of 26-year-old Aysenur Ezgi Eygi has demanded an independent investigation into her death, saying on Saturday her life "was taken needlessly, unlawfully, and violently by the Israeli military". The UN rights office said Israeli forces killed Eygi with a "shot in the head". Turkey said she was killed by "Israeli occupation soldiers".

in the war that authorities in the Hamas-run Gaza say has killed at least 40,939 people. According to the United Nations human rights office, most of the dead are women and children. Hamas's October 7 attack on Israel resulted in the deaths of 1,205 people, mostly civilians including some hostages killed in captivity, according to official Israeli figures. Of 251 hostages seized by Palestinian militants during the attack, 97 remain in Gaza including 33 the Israeli military says are dead. Scores were released during a one-week truce in November. Israel's announcement last Sunday that the bodies of six hostages including a US-Israeli citizen had been recovered shortly after being killed sparked grief and anger in Israel.

Super Typhoon Yagi hits Vietnam after leaving deadly trail

Super Typhoon Yagi uprooted thousands of trees, swept ships and boats out to sea and ripped roofs off houses in northern Vietnam yesterday, killing at least three people, after leaving a trail of destruction in Southern China and the Philippines. The storm made landfall in Vietnam's Hai Phong and Quang Ninh provinces, packing winds exceeding 149 kilometres (92 miles) per hour, Vietnam's National Centre for Hydro-Meteorological Forecasting said. The death toll in Vietnam from storm-related damage rose to four

as roofing torn away by Yagi flew through the air, killing three residents of Quang Ninh, state media said. A man in Hai Duong province further inland was killed on Friday when heavy winds brought down a tree. More than a dozen others, believed to be sailors on fishing boats, are missing. "It has been years since I witnessed a typhoon this big," said Tran Thi Hoa, a 48-year-old woman from Hai Phong. "It was scary. I stayed indoors, after locking all my windows. However, the sound of the wind and the rain was unbelievable,"



Yagi brought winds of more than 230 kilometres (143 miles) per hour, uprooting trees and prompting the evacuation of around 460,000 people.

she told AFP. In Hai Phong, AFP reporters encountered streets filled with fallen trees, metal roofing and broken signboards that had been ripped off properties. Before hitting Vietnam, Yagi tore through Southern China and the Philippines, killing at least 24 people and injuring dozens of others. At least four people were

killed and 95 injured in southern China after the storm hit Hainan and Guangdong provinces on Friday, CCTV said on Saturday, citing local authorities. Before hitting the Vietnamese mainland, the typhoon unrooted hundreds of trees on Co To island, about 80 kilometres from mainland Quang Ninh.

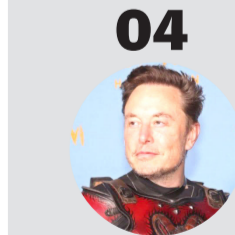

"I would never want to not be a person that wouldn't sell their house to make a movie. I love that. I think it's cool. I admire the hell out of it."

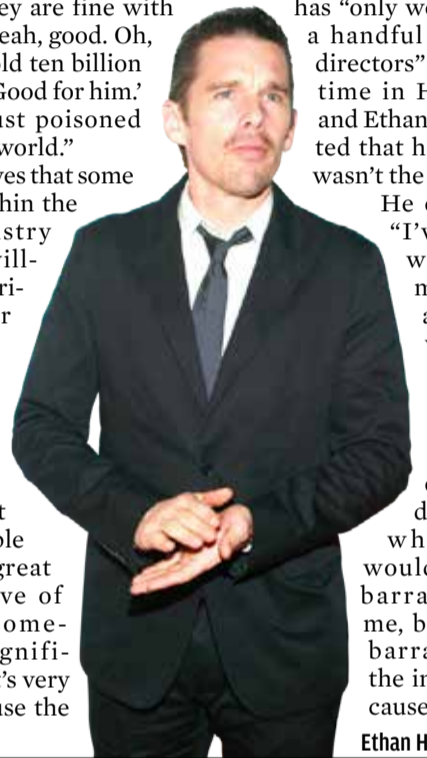
Meanwhile, Ethan has admitted to feeling embarrassed that he's worked with so few female directors during his time in the movie business.

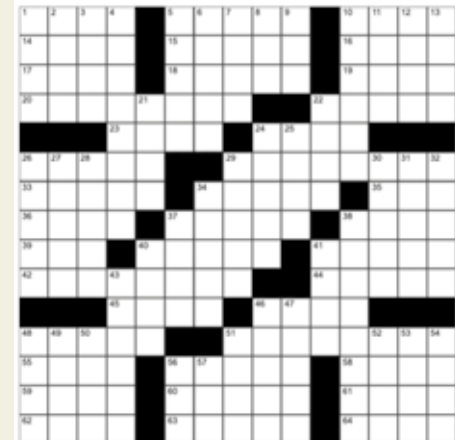

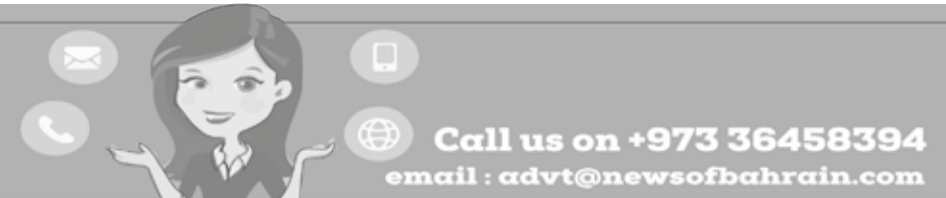

## England's Wood out for rest of 2024 with elbow injury

England fast bowler Mark Wood said Friday it was "rubbish news" he had been ruled out for the rest of the year with a right elbow injury.

The 34-year-old express quick had already been sidelined from the concluding two matches of England's three-Test series against Sri Lanka after suffering a right thigh muscle strain while bowling in the series opener at Old Trafford.

But Friday's statement from the England and Wales Cricket Board said

Wood, a key member of England's squad as they build towards next year's Ashes in Australia despite a career blighted by ankle and back problems, had noticed increasing stiffness and discomfort in his elbow during the Test series against the West Indies earlier in the season.

It added Wood had "managed the discomfort" while bowling in Manchester, where England won by five wickets in a Sri Lanka series they are now looking to wrap up with a 3-0 clean sweep in the ongoing third Test at the Oval.

Wood will now miss England's upcoming three-Test tours of both Pakistan in October and New Zealand in December.

# Fritz ends America's 15-year wait, sets up US Open final with Sinner

American Taylor Fritz makes history, sets up final showdown against world number one Jannik Sinner

● Fritz first American in US Open final since 2009

● Fritz defeats Frances Tiafoe in five sets

● Sinner defeats Jack Draper in straight sets despite injury and illness

Taylor Fritz became the first American man since 2009 to reach a Grand Slam final on Friday, setting up a US Open title showdown against world number one Jannik Sinner.

Fritz, the world number 12, twice fought back to defeat compatriot Frances Tiafoe 4-6, 7-5, 4-6, 6-4, 6-1 in his semi-final.

Australian Open champion Sinner became the first Italian man to make the New York final with a 7-5, 7-6 (7/3), 6-2 win over

an ailing Jack Draper of Britain. "He overwhelmed me at the start and I was freaking out a little," said 26-year-old Fritz after securing victory with a 16th ace.

"I just told myself to stay in it, hold serve and apply scoreboard pressure.

"I did all I could to stay in it. If I hadn't have done that I'd regret it forever. In the final, I will come out and give it everything."

Andy Roddick was the last American to make a men's singles final at the Slams at Wimbledon in 2009. He was also the last man from the country to capture a major title when he won the 2003 US Open.

Fritz was just five years old at the time.

Tiafoe was the better player for large parts of the semi-final but after dumping a lazy drop shot into the net to surrender the fourth set, his game fell apart.

In a 27-minute final set, Tiafoe won just nine points as he slumped to a second US Open semi-final loss in his last three visits.

"It's tough to swallow, it's

going to hurt," said Tiafoe.

"I thought I was the better player but in the fourth set I had some cramps. My body kind of shut down on me. Probably to do with nerves."

Earlier, in a gruelling three-hour match, Draper, the first Brit in the

semi-finals since Andy Murray won the title in 2012, was undone by 10 double faults and 43 unforced errors.

He also vomited on the court, blaming anxiety for the illness.

"Jack and I know each other very well, we are great friends off court," said Sinner, who unleashed 43 winners in the match where he also injured his wrist in a nasty fall.

"It was a very physical match. He's so tough to beat so I'm excited to be in the final."

The 23-year-old Sinner added: "In the final, it will be a very tough challenge. I'm happy to be in that position because if you are in the final on a Sunday it means you are doing an amaz-

## US Open bride-to-be cancels wedding, wins Grand Slam title

Ukraine's Lyudmyla Kichenok became a Grand Slam champion at the US Open on Friday, just two days after cancelling her wedding.

Kichenok, 32, teamed up with Latvia's Jelena Ostapenko to beat Kristina Mladenovic and Zhang

Shuai 6-4, 6-3 in the women's doubles final.

On Wednesday, she had been planning to marry boyfriend Stas Khmarsky who is also Ostapenko's coach.

But a run to the championship match for the seventh seeds meant the

ceremony was temporarily shelved.

"My boyfriend and I were supposed to get married on Wednesday but it didn't happen," said Kichenok.

"We actually had the appointment but I was playing the semi-finals."

"I try my best all the time to keep evolving, to keep learning, and it's definitely something I've had to just work through my whole entire life," added Draper of his struggles.

"When you play the top players, the intensity is different. It's a step up. It was a big occasion for me. I definitely felt more nerves around," he said.

"I'm quite an anxious human being. I think when you add all that together sometimes I do feel a bit nauseous on court, and I feel a little bit sick when it gets tough."

Despite both men having been born in 2001, Sinner was playing in his 20th Grand Slam event.

Draper, plagued by ankle and shoulder troubles in the early stages of his career, was competing at the majors for just the 10th time.

## Zambanini sprints to podium in Tour of Britain's 'Queen Stage'

**E**doardo Zambanini of Team Bahrain Victorious came in a very impressive third on the toughest stage at this year's Tour of Britain, from Sheffield to Barnsley.

After that, the attacks started again, and 8 guys went clear. Back in the main bunch we organised ourselves before the finale."
