Thomas Bjorn will tee it up as long-awaited return to the Kingdom of Bahrain for the Bahrain Championship from February 1-4, 2024, and golf fans can now secure free general admission tickets.

The tournament, which will be held under the patronage of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, will mark the DP World Tour's first visit to the Kingdom since 2011 and forms part of the International Swing on the 2024 Race to Dubai.

Former Ryder Cup Captain Bjorn, who is Denmark's most successful golfer of all-time with 15 DP World Tour wins to his name, will return to the Kingdom for the first time in 13 years, since he finished in a tie for 44th at the Volvo Golf Champions.
