India has decided to resume regular international commercial flight operations from March 27 after two years of COVID-19 curbs, the nation's civil aviation ministry said yesterday.

"After having recognised the increased vaccination coverage across the globe and in consultation with the stakeholders, the government of India has decided to resume scheduled commercial international passenger services to/from India from March 27, 2022, i.e. start of Summer Schedule 2022," the ministry in a statement said.

According to the ministry, the ongoing suspension of international flight operations will stay until March 26.

● NASA commends Kingdom for joining global list of signatories

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) has lauded Bahrain for becoming the latest nation to sign the US-led Artemis Accords, an international treaty that outlines peaceful and responsible exploration of the Moon and space in general.

"I am so pleased to see Bahrain has shown its commitment to the peaceful exploration of space by signing the Artemis Accords," said NASA Administrator Bill Nelson in a statement posted on its website.



The accords will shape Bahrain's vision for the advancement of space science

"This important decision by Bahrain follows the recent successful launch of the Light-1 spacecraft, developed by Bahrain's National Space Science Agency (NSSA) in cooperation with the United Arab Emirates (UAE), another Artemis Accords signatory."

Adding to a growing list of

signatories, the Kingdom also became the second Arab country to sign the accords, which embrace a common set of principles to guide cooperation among nations participating in NASA's Artemis programme.

In particular, the accords set international standards of how the Moon should be explored

and lists guidelines on activities such as mining on the Moon, releasing scientific data publicly, transparency with the public on policies, and providing emergency assistance.

17th nation

Interestingly, Bahrain became the 17th nation, and the third in the Middle East to sign the Artemis Accords, following the UAE and Israel. It is also the eighth country to sign it under the Biden-Harris US administration.

Bahrain joins 16 other countries that have already signed the Artemis Accords, namely the US, UK, UAE, Japan, Italy, Canada, Australia, Luxembourg, South Korea, New Zealand, Brazil, Ukraine, Israel, Poland, Mexico and Romania.

NSSA Chief Executive Officer Dr Mohamed Al Aseeri signed the Artemis Accords on March 2 for Bahrain.

The signing was discussed

as part of a joint statement following last week's US-Bahrain Strategic Dialogue between Secretary of State Antony J. Blinken and His Royal Highness Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

Vice President Kamala Harris also announced Bahrain's signing of the Artemis Accords during a joint news conference March 4 with HRH Prince Salman.

The UAE signed the agreement in 2020 as a founding country, shortly after announcing that it was sending a rover to the lunar surface.

Bahrain is also an emerging space nation, with plans to develop and launch nanosatellites and increase research capabilities.

It announced that it had joined the accords during the visit to the US last week by HRH the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

Kingdom, EU bond 'multi-dimensional'

The Bahrain Center for Strategic, International and Energy Studies (Derasat) hosted a discussion panel titled 'EU-Bahrain: A Multi-Dimensional Partnership', yesterday to discuss further enhancing relations between the Kingdom and the European Union.

The event coincides with the first anniversary of the signing of the Cooperation Arrangement between Bahrain's Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the European External Action Service signed on 10 February 2021, which provides an institutional framework for political dialogue and cooperation in areas such as trade, research, and innovation, clean energy, and renewables.

Panelists included Patrick Simonnet, EU Ambassador to KSA, Bahrain and Oman, and Ahmed Al Qarainees, Chief of European Affairs at the Bahrain Ministry of Foreign Affairs as well as Dr Andrea Cozzi, Managing Director of Eni in Bahrain and Rim Jalali, Executive Director of the French Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Bahrain (FCCIB).

The audience included MoFA staff, representatives from other organisations, and Derasat researchers. Discussions covered major economic, cultural, and environmental, and opportunities to enhance cooperation and further develop mutual interests.

Dr Hamad Ebrahim Al Abdulla, Derasat Executive Director, said, "The Kingdom of Bahrain views the European Union as a distinguished regional organization and a model for integration and complementarity; one that the Kingdom ensures it develops its relations with bilaterally or holistically."

Dr Al Abdulla pointed to estimations that indicated a commercial exchange worth 2.5 billion Euros between Bahrain and

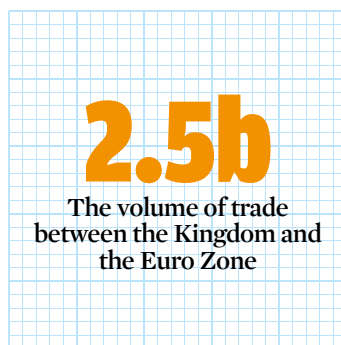
the EU until the end of 2021, in addition to the numerous European companies operating in Bahrain, and European expertise found in the Kingdom's public and private sectors.

Derasat's Executive Director referred to the increased frequency of exchange visits between both sides in the past few years, ensuring how keen they are on developing their relations based on the largely entwined interests, as confirmed by regional challenges, especially the COVID pandemic.

He said that energy security and climate change are additional challenges, and all of them require an extended mutual dialog to coordinate the efforts in countering these challenges.

EU Ambassador Patrick Simonnet said, "Cooperation with the Kingdom of Bahrain is multi-dimensional given its importance as an EU partner."

He also stated that signing the 2021 Cooperation Agreement was a significant step in developing multi-sector relations, including economic and commercial diversification, research and innovation, human rights, clean energy, and renewable energy sources – a field in which



the EU is at the global forefront.

He pointed to the EU's work on enhancing individual relations through the exchange of students and researchers.

Bahrain MoFA's European Affairs Chief Ahmed Ebrahim Al Qarainees affirmed the need for strengthened bilateral relations with the EU in all areas.

He described the relations as rapidly growing in economic, educational, environmental, and parliamentary aspects, due to the focus by the Kingdom's wise leadership on cooperating with the EU in more constructive aspects.

He said that such meetings are crucial in setting the frameworks for cooperation, based on previous achievements to increase Bahrain-EU partnerships.

Dr Andrea Cozzi, Managing Director of Eni in Bahrain and Lebanon, and Deputy Managing Director and Head of Geoscience in Eni UAE, said that Eni, the Italian oil company, entered Bahrain in 2019, and is seeking opportunities for hydrocarbon excavation, renewables, and liquefied natural gas (LNG).

He added that Eni also pursues supply initiatives, carbon circular economy, managing water and soil, waste recycling, and advancing the implementation of the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals and Bahrain's Vision 2030, as well as contributing to Bahrain's future energy needs in a more efficient and sustainable way.

Rim Jalali, Executive Director of the French Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Bahrain (FCCIB), one of the most active foreign business organizations in the Kingdom, said, "I am delighted to discuss the dynamic French business presence in the Kingdom, in banking, retail, hospitality, and industry; all reflecting how keen numerous French corporations indeed are in making Bahrain their regional base, a trend that can grow in the post-COVID environment."

Life inches back to normal as Covid-19 threat eases

All sectors of economy on growth track following updated four-tier traffic light system

Three weeks after the Kingdom entered the green zone of Covid-19 Alert Level Traffic Light System, life in the Kingdom has almost returned to normal except for the use of face masks at public places.

The updated four-tier traffic light system to combat the spread of the virus keeps track of infection numbers before deciding on the levels to be implemented.

A senior retail sector executive with a leading retailer, who doesn't want to be identified, said normalcy has returned to the segment although the paradigm changing shift to e-commerce has taken place during the pandemic period.

"The retail segment landscape has changed with the e-commerce element setting in with great might during the post-pandemic recovery period though it has outperformed many other sectors."

Muneer K K, a cold store owner in East Riffa, said sales have gone up after the Kingdom moved from Yellow Level

to the Green Level. "Sales really declined during the Yellow Level period as people were not coming out after being afraid of getting infected with Covid. There were days when I thought of closing down my store."

"But now I am optimistic. Things are improving though it hasn't reached the pre-pandemic levels. I believe as a cold store owner I can stand on two legs as the retail market looks positive."

Speaking to The Daily Tribune, Imtiaz Fareed, Purchasing Manager at Home Electronics, said the post-pandemic recovery doesn't specifically apply to the

home appliance and electronic equipment market as there was a huge demand for these products from the majority who were stuck at their homes.

"When all other segments of the retail industry declined, we were flourishing with 2020 being a bumper year as the sales of home appliances and electronic equipment went up apart from bulk sales also contributing to the overall growth. This sales boost has continued during the Post-Covid period as well."

Baiju Cheravattayi, Operations Manager with Sun and Sand Restaurant located on Ex-

hibition Road, said the hotel and restaurant sector is also witnessing a boost after the Kingdom moved to the green zone.

"We had many unvaccinated customers, who stopped coming during the Yellow Level Alert. Now the situation has changed and all are welcomed. Our restaurant enjoys a rich patronage of a large number of customers from Saudi Arabia. With the Saudi Government easing travel restrictions including the cancellation of RT-PCR for inbound travellers, we are seeing a good business now."

"I can say that the restaur-

rant and hotel industry is on a post-Covid recovery track," he added.

The Daily Tribune earlier reported about new Covid cases going down, flattening the Covid curve. There were 1,699 new cases on Monday along with 2,749 recoveries and one death. There are 18,581 active cases including 39 hospitalised patients infected with Covid-19. The Kingdom has so far registered a total of 528,834 cases and 7,864 tests were recorded on Tuesday.

Bahraini man's five-year jail sentence for forging contracts overturned

The Cassation Court has overturned the conviction of a Bahraini man who was earlier sentenced to five years in prison for forging contracts before submitting to Labour Fund

(Tamkeen) to receive financial support.

According to court files, the defendant was accused of embezzling BD22,000 from Tamkeen after faking the contracts which were related to the national employment support pro-

gramme.

As per the records, the Ministry of Labour's monitoring team visited the company headquarters for a normal check to ensure they are abiding by the rules as it was discovered that most of the employed staff were girls, al-

though the company was operating in the construction industry.

The team found that there were only three Asian men in an apartment, while the clock-in-and-out system showed no other employees were serving in the company.

Further investigations uncovered that most of those who signed the contracts were already outside Bahrain and they inked the agreements years ago after they were eluded that they would join after putting put to paper.

It was discovered that the defendant received financial support worth BD22,000 from Tamkeen. He was charged with forgery and fraud to earn financial. The Cassation Court sent the case to the High Appeals Court to re-hear it.

Biden bans Russia oil imports to US

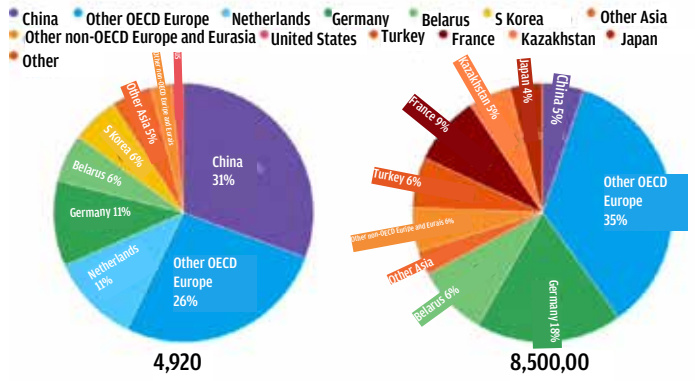
US President Joe Biden announced a ban on Russian oil and other energy imports on Tuesday in retaliation for the invasion of Ukraine, underscoring strong bipartisan support for a move that he acknowledged would drive up US energy prices.

“We’re banning all imports of Russian oil and gas energy,” Biden told reporters at the White House. “That means Russian oil will no longer be acceptable in US ports and the American people will deal another powerful blow to (Russian President Vladimir) Putin’s war machine.”

Oil prices jumped on the news,

Russia exports between 4 and 5 billion bbls of crude a day and about 8,500 billion cubic feet of natural gas annually



with Benchmark Brent crude LCOC1 for May climbing by 5.4% to \$129.91 a barrel by 1345 GMT.

Biden has been working with allies in Europe, who are far more dependent on Russian oil,

to isolate Russia’s energy-heavy economy and Putin. Britain announced shortly before Biden’s remarks that it would phase out the import of Russian oil and oil products by the end of 2022.

Biden said sanctions imposed by the United States and its allies had already caused the Russian economy to “crater”. He said the latest moves had been made in close consultation with allies and partners around the world.

The United States imported more than 20.4 million barrels of crude and refined products a month on average from Russia in 2021, about 8% of US liquid fuel imports, according to the Energy Information Administration,

U.S. gas pump prices near a record high

U.S. drivers were paying an average of \$4.065 a gallon for gasoline on March 7 after Russia’s invasion of Ukraine sent crude oil prices rocketing higher over the past week. That’s only about 5 cents below the record of \$4.11 a gallon set in July 2008, according to AAA.



and the ban is expected to send already high gasoline prices and inflation soaring. The United States also imports a negligible amount of coal from Russia.

Biden predicted prices would rise further as a result of “Putin’s

war,” but pledged to do all he could to minimize the impact on the American people. He also warned US gas companies against exploiting the situation to engage in profiteering or price gouging.

Kaspersky highlights importance of encouraging women to pursue careers in IT security

More than half (56%) of women in tech have seen levels of gender equality improve in their organization over the past two years, with a further 70% agreeing that their skills and experience were considered ahead of gender when applying for their first role in IT or tech.

This progression in such a short space of time represents a positive step towards sector inclusivity. But the findings from Kaspersky’s Women in Tech report, Where are we now? Understanding the evolution of women in technology, also highlights that there is still room for improvement.

The idea of gender equality represents more than just physical bodies through doors. It is also the notion of perceptions, feelings, stereotypes and opportunity. To this end, a positive sign of progression comes from more than two-thirds of women (69%) now feeling confident that their opinions are respected from the very first day in a tech role. The increased levels of working from home seen over the past year have also had a comparatively positive effect, with 46% of women agreeing that gender equality is improved among teams that work remotely. Despite a global improvement in perceptions around gender representation, over a third (38%) of women claim that a lack of women in the tech industry makes them wary of entering the sector.

While these figures may seem relatively low, they emphasize the gap between gradual improvement and complete equality. This notion is supported by the wider realization that 44% of women

maintain that men progress faster than they do in the tech space. Considering that a similar number (41%) agree that a more equal gender split would be conducive to improved career progression and rectifying that mismatch, the report can conclude that the link between representation, and overall behaviors, opportunity and equality, has not been made just yet.

To ensure women’s positive career experiences are reflected right across the globe, key steps and initiatives are needed to support a career in tech, including the provision of more mentoring or internship programs to provide access to opportunities and experience. But in order to instill a belief that the tech industry is a place for women to work and succeed, the journey needs to start much earlier.

“The issue of gender stereotypes needs to be addressed long before women enter the workplace. It needs to start at school, to engage and encourage an interest in IT and tech fields. Our work at Kaspersky with schoolchildren in a number of countries across the globe aims to ignite this interest at an early age and provide insight into what a career in tech might look like. The first step in a new direction is always the hardest. Without a supportive environment, girls can struggle to find kindred spirits in online communities or at relevant offline events. They need to see that IT professionals are ordinary people with diverse skillsets and abilities, and that anyone can aspire to join the tech space,” comments Noushin Shabab, Senior Security Researcher, Global Research & Analysis Team at Kaspersky.

◆ **Tens of thousands of Sydney residents have been told to evacuate** their homes as severe storms and flash flooding inundated swathes of Australia's largest city yesterday. The national weather bureau warned of "a tough 48 hours ahead" for the city, with 60,000 people subject to evacuation orders and warnings across the affected areas, according to emergency services. The death toll from a week of what officials have called "unprecedented" floods across much of Australia's east coast rose to 18 on Tuesday, as police continued to search for a mother and son whose car was discovered abandoned in a stormwater canal in Sydney's flood-hit west.

Moscow threw a potential spanner in the works on Saturday, just as months of indirect talks between Tehran and Washington in Vienna appeared to be headed for an agreement, with Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov saying the Western sanctions over Ukraine had become a stumbling block for a nuclear deal.

Putin signs law allowing government to quickly raise pensions

◆ **Russian President Vladimir Putin** has signed a law allowing his government to quickly raise pensions, part of a set of anti-crisis measures after Russia was hit by a wave of economic sanctions over Ukraine, the RIA news agency reported yesterday. Another new initiative signed into law by Putin gave individuals and small- and medium-sized businesses the right to request "credit holidays," RIA reported.

◆ **Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC)** has successfully put a second military satellite, the Noor 2, into orbit, the state-media said yesterday. The announcement came as talks held in Vienna to revive an agreement restraining Iran's nuclear program have reached a critical stage. Noor 2 is orbiting at an altitude of 500 kilometres (311 miles). The first military satellite, launched by the Islamic Republic in April 2020, placed the Noor, or "light" in Persian, at an orbit of 425km (265 miles) above the earth's surface. Iran will send a series of military satellites into orbit over the coming years, Space Commander of the Revolutionary Guards' Aerospace Force Ali Jafarabadi said on Tuesday, the semi-official Fars news agency reported.

11-year-old flees Ukraine alone with just a phone number scribbled on his hand

As women and children flee Ukraine while men of fighting age stay back to join local defence units amid Russia's armed attack on the country, the photo of a young boy has gone viral.

The 11-year-old boy is being hailed as a "hero" after travelling nearly 700 miles (1,000 km) to Slovakia alone, armed with only a letter and a phone number written on his hand.

"With one plastic bag, passport and phone number written on his hand, he came completely alone because his parents had to stay in Ukraine," the Slovakian Ministry of Interior said in a Facebook post.

Hailing the boy for his courage, the ministry added: "[The boy] gained all of them with his smile, fearlessness and determination, worthy to be a true hero."

Sharing images of him being greeted by volunteers at the border, the post said the volunteers took care of him making sure he was kept warm and provided him with food and drinks, and even packed some for him for his journey ahead.

According to the Interior Ministry, the young boy is from Zaporizhzhia - the site of the Ukrainian nuclear power plant, which was captured by Russian forces last week. Images show the boy wearing a beanie and a heavy winter coat while standing in front of a table stocked with drinks and food.



The Slovakian authorities shared another video of the boy's mother explaining why he had to travel alone. Identified as Yulia Pisetskaya, in a video posted on Facebook, the mother, a widow, said that she had put her son on a train to Slovakia out of desperation.

"I want to thank the Slovak customs and volunteers who took care of my son and helped him cross the border. I am grateful you have saved my child's life. Next to my town is a nuclear power plant that the Russians are shooting at. I couldn't leave my mother - she can't move on her own," the woman said, as translated by HuffPost.

Authorities dialled the number on the boy's hand and were able to contact his relatives in Bratislava, Slovakia, who later picked him up. The ministry, which posted photos of the child, said, "the whole story ended well".

The United Nations human rights office said on Tuesday that it had verified 1,335 civilian casualties in Ukraine, including 474 killed and 861 injured, since Russia's invasion began on Feb. 24.

Russia proposes nationalising foreign-owned factories that shut operations

A senior member of Russia's ruling party has proposed nationalising foreign-owned factories that shut down operations in the country over what the Kremlin calls a special military operation in Ukraine.

A reporter for Politico said Britain was expected to announce steps to reduce dependency on Russian energy.

Several foreign companies including Toyota, Nike and home furnishings retailer IKEA have announced temporary shutdowns of stores and factories in Russia.

Attacks on Ukrainian hospitals, ambulances increasing rapidly, WHO warns

Attacks on hospitals, ambulances and other health care facilities in Ukraine have increased rapidly in recent days and the country is running short of vital medical supplies, the World Health Organization (WHO) said on Tuesday.

The UN agency confirmed on Monday that at least nine people had died in 16 attacks on health care facilities since the start of a Russian invasion of Ukraine on Feb. 24. It did not say who was responsible.

The WHO's senior emergency officer for Europe, Catherine Smallwood, told a news briefing that the tally included incidents where ambulances had been commandeered for purposes other than emergency healthcare.

"We will continue to update those numbers. They've been increasing quite rapidly over the past few days," Smallwood said.

The agency is working to rapidly provide medical supplies to Ukraine, where oxygen, insulin, personal pro-

TECTIVE equipment, surgical items and blood products are running low, Europe regional director Hans Kluge told the briefing.

The supply of oxygen, children's vaccines, especially against polio amid an outbreak, and mental health expertise are among the WHO's top priorities for the region, he said.

In a separate statement, the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) said countries neighbouring Ukraine which are hosting Ukrainian refugees should include them in their vaccine programmes against a range of diseases.

They should prioritise vaccinating against COVID-19 and polio and also against measles, as the current inoculation coverage is insufficient to prevent measles outbreaks, the ECDC said in a statement.

"Crowding in bomb shelters and reception centres could facilitate the start of a measles outbreak, particularly as spring coincides with the natural seasonality of the disease," the agency added.

Putin says will not use conscript soldiers in Ukraine

Russia will not use any conscript soldiers in Ukraine, President Vladimir Putin said yesterday.

"I emphasize that conscript soldiers are not participating in hostilities and will not participate in them. And there will be no additional call-up of reservists," Putin said in a televised message to mark International Women's Day.

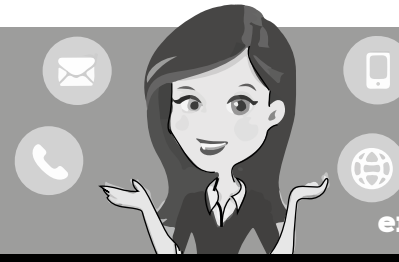

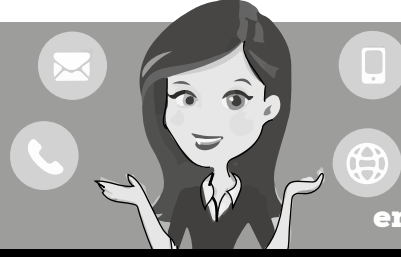

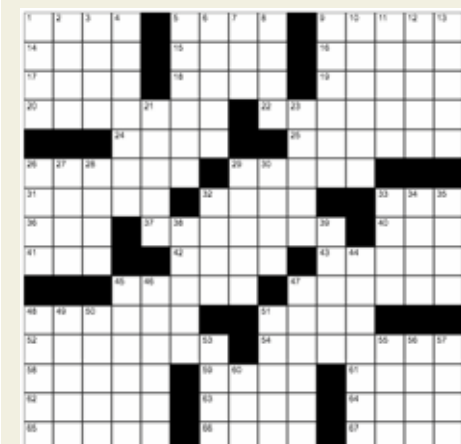

Formula 1's superstar drivers and team members have begun arriving in the Kingdom of Bahrain ahead of the F1 Aramco Pre-Season Testing 2022, taking place tomorrow to Saturday at Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) in Sakhir.

The stage is set for F1's first on-track running in preparation for the start of the 2022 FIA F1 World Championship. The season kicks off with the F1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix from 18 to 20 March at "The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East".

First to arrive from motorsport's biggest names was Pierre Gasly of AlphaTauri. Large groups of F1 team personnel along with officials from F1 and the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) have also started to reach the Kingdom.

They were received upon touching down at Bahrain International Airport by BIC's Meet

and Greet Team, who assisted the Kingdom's guests on their arrival formalities and their transportation to their respective hotels.

Meanwhile, preparations at BIC have ramped up ahead of the start of on-track action tomorrow.

This week's tests are scheduled to begin at 10am each day and continue until 2pm before heading for an hour-long break. Running will resume at 3pm and conclude at 7pm over the three days of testing.

Zverev handed suspended eight-week ban by ATP for Acapulco outburst

Men's tennis governing body has handed world number three Alexander Zverev a suspended eight-week ban for smashing his racket against the umpire's chair at last month's ATP 500 event in Acapulco, for which he was expelled from the tournament.

Zverev was fined \$20,000 for verbal abuse, \$20,000 for unsportsmanlike conduct and forfeited more than \$31,000 in prize money and all rankings points earned

The biggest penalty in men's tennis to date was handed down to Australian Nick Kyrgios in 2019 for verbally abusing a chair umpire and smashing two rackets. After an initial fine of \$113,000, he was given a suspended ban of 16 weeks and an additional fine of \$25,000 following an ATP investigation

from singles and doubles action at the Abierto Mexicano tournament.

Following a review, the ATP found the 24-year-old German had committed "aggravated behaviour" and issued an additional fine of \$25,000 and an eight-week ban from any ATP-sanctioned event.

The ATP said, however, the ban and the additional fine were suspended, providing that over a probation period ending one year after the incident, Zverev does not incur any more fines for unsportsmanlike conduct.

Mohamed "L'Ambiance" Said Maalem made it clear that he plans to humble BRAVE CF Middleweight World Champion Mohammad "The Latest" Fakhreddine when they meet inside the cage once again.

Both men are set to face each other for the vacant BRAVE CF Light Heavyweight Championship in a rematch at the highly-anticipated BRAVE CF 57, which takes place at Khalifa Sports City Arena in Isa Town, Bahrain on Friday, March 11.

The bad blood between the two stemmed from their canceled fight at BRAVE CF 50 in

April 2011 when Fakhreddine opted to pull out of the contest due to illness. The war of words on social media and in person ensued soon afterwards.

Said Maalem and Fakhreddine had the opportunity to

settle the score at BRAVE CF 52: Bad Blood four months later, but to compound the misery, it ended in controversy.

The result of the fight originally had Said Maalem winning by stoppage in the first round, but the Italian Federation of Grappling and Mixed Martial Arts—the authorized governing body that sanctioned the fight—overturned the outcome following a thorough investigation.

It was found that there were illegal strikes made by Said Maalem to the back of Fakhreddine's head in the final sequence, prompting the commission to call for a no contest.
