UN urges 'immediate' end to Israeli-Palestinian violence following deadly raid in West Bank

The United Nations yesterday urged Israel and the Palestinians to "immediately" end violence as intra-Palestinian tensions erupted following a deadly Israeli military raid in the occupied West Bank.

Palestinian Authority security forces in the West Bank city of Nablus fired tear gas at mourners attending the funeral of a Hamas militant killed in Tuesday's raid, amid a surge in violence in the Israeli-Palestinian

"We are in the midst of a cycle of violence that must be stopped immediately," UN Middle East peace envoy Tor Wennesland said in a statement.

"The Security Council has on the parties to observe calm and restraint, and to refrain from provocative actions, incitement northern West Bank. and inflammatory rhetoric."

Businesses in Palestinian cities across the West Bank shuttered yesterday in a general strike to protest the deadly Israeli raid.

It was the latest in a string of fatal military operations in the Palestinian territory, which Israel has occupied since the Six-Day War of 1967.

Thousands gathered in Jenin for the funerals of the five Palestinians killed alongside Khroushah, with heavily armed masked fighters firing volleys into the air.
