

US, Saudi, UAE and India discuss railway project

The US is currently in talks with Saudi Arabia, the UAE, and India to construct a project that would link Middle Eastern nations through a network of railway lines.

Reports claimed that the railways would also be connected to India via shipping lanes from ports in the region.

Sources say that the White House National Security Advisor, Jake Sullivan, is expected to arrive in Saudi Arabia on Saturday, and will meet with Saudi, Emirati, and Indian counterparts next week to further discuss the proposed project and other regional issues.

Eight unlicensed manpower agencies, 26 illegal workers face legal action

Eight unlicensed man-power agencies were referred for legal action after failing to acquire the necessary licenses, and 26 irregular workers were arrested for violating their work permits.

This came as the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) conducted a joint inspection campaign in the Capital Governorate, in coordination with the General Directorate of Crime Detection and Forensic Evidence and the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA) of the Ministry of Interior.

The campaign resulted in the detection of violations related to Labour Market and Residency Laws and Regulations. Acquire the licenses from the LMRA to avoid legal accountability.

"We have recovered 22 bodies, including 15 females and seven males. There are around six people in the hospital. Rescue operations are on," a police officer told AFP.




