The competition is being organised and run by the West Asia Volleyball Association and it is scheduled to take place until March 18.



ustralia opener Usman AKhawaja yesterday said emotions took over after he struck his first Test century in India as the tourists dominated the opening day of the fourth match.

Australia reached 255-4 at stumps after they won the toss and elected to bat in their bid to square the four-match series at the world's biggest cricket stadium in Ahmedabad.

After a long grind, Khawaja was batting on 104 alongside Cameron Green, on 49, at close of play as the pair put together an attacking stand of 85.

The left-handed Khawaja put on key stands including a 79run third-wicket partnership with skipper Steve Smith, who made 38, to hand Australia a strong start.
