Marine Revival

Cabinet nod for law to prevent exploitation of marine resources

The Cabinet of the Kingdom of Bahrain yesterday approved a new law to regulate the fishing, exploitation, and protection of marine resources.

Given Bahrain's long history and tradition involving marine resources, proposals for regulating marine wealth have seen contentious debates in the lower and upper house of the Parliament in the recent past.

This has culminated in Monday's decision by the Cabinet, which was based on a memorandum submitted by the Ministerial Committee for Legal and Legislative Affairs regarding a draft law amending the decree-law that regulates the use of marine wealth.

After extensive debates, the Shura Council, which is Bahrain's upper legislative body, had in March this year voted in favour of a law to protect the Kingdom's sea and marine resources.

Through the law, the Shura Council had unanimously voted for amending a 2002 law, titled Fishing Organisation, Catching and Protection Law.

This legislative decree had outlined the overall legislative framework regulating the exploitation of fisheries and other marine resources and identify the responsibilities of the competent authority.

Among its provisions were an outright ban on foreigners from



practising commercial fishing. It had also specified that commercial fishing should not be carried out without a license issued by the competent authority.

Even when a licence is obtained for commercial fishing, the law had stipulated that a Bahraini captain should be on-board. The only exception as per the law was for fishing for the purpose of carrying out research or scientific studies, but that too needed the approval of the minister concerned.

Protecting marine wealth

In the 2002 law, steps to protect marine wealth were also

outlined, which included a ban on catching of larvae or small marine organisms, sea turtles, seabirds, and other mammals or tamper with their places of origin and reproduction.

Key amendments

Through the proposed amendments, the Shura Council had called for a ban on foreign vessels fishing in Bahraini waters so as to prevent overexploitation and to protect dwindling fish populations. Local owners were also to face stricter controls, needing authorization for any modifications to their vessels.

As per Shura's Public Utili-

ties and Environment Affairs Committee, such strict measures were needed as overfishing has become rampant, leading to the destruction of marine habitats and pushing species to the brink of extinction. The amendments would help in rejuvenating Bahrain's marine ecosystem, the committee had argued.

Further amendments sought for included bans on reclamation of drying fishing grounds without proper licensing and tighter rules for the sale of fishery products.

Fish farms

The amendments had also en-

couraged the development of fish farms to offset pressure on natural stocks, with government support to local fishermen in the form of technical guidance and financial aid.

Opposing voices at the Shura Council had highlighted the potential impact on tourism, particularly foreign fishing cruises.

However, a majority of the Shura Council had supported the amendments, stating that it would be a bold step in reversing environmental damage and will ensure the future of the Kingdom's fisheries industry.

With the Cabinet nod for a detailed regulation, the bane of overfishing that had been devastating Bahrain's waters are set to abate, giving a boost to long-term sustainability of the marine ecosystem.

Building boom

Bahrain's construction sector set for \$3.73b growth by 2029

Bahrain's construction sector is anticipated to rise from \$3.04 billion this year to \$3.73 billion by 2029, reflecting a steady annual growth rate of 4.18%, according to Mordor Intelligence.

This growth is largely propelled by significant government investment in large-scale projects and recent labour market reforms aimed at increasing productivity.

In 2020, the industry faced hurdles due to the effects of COVID-19 and declining oil prices.

Nevertheless, Bahrain's relatively low project costs compared to other GCC countries, coupled with its "free zone" status — which permits full

foreign ownership and unrestricted movement of profits and capital — continues to attract investment.

The 2021-2022 budget allocates BD600 million (\$1.6 billion) for infrastructure, housing, and other essential sectors.

Bahrain's economic recovery plan includes over 22 major infrastructure projects worth more than \$30 billion, which features the development of five artificial islands.

Public-private partnerships are projected to play an important role in progressing these projects, in keeping with the Vision 2030 policy, which promotes economic diversification, privatisation, and workforce development to boost infrastructure and industry growth.

High Court suspends sentence for director in 'Khatwa' case

The High Criminal Appeals Court, in its first session regarding the "Khatwa" case, has decided to postpone the hearing until September 22nd.

The court had previously convicted three employees from the Ministry of Social Development of causing harm to public funds belonging to the Social Insurance Organization, amounting to over BD266,000.

This was done through the falsification of statements related to the "Khatwa" programme, claiming that the beneficiaries met the requirements.

The court issued sentences ranging from five years to one and a half years imprisonment, along with fines exceeding BD500,000.

The decision to postpone the hearing was made to inquire with the Enforcement Prosecution regarding the second appellant, to determine whether the imposed sentence has been executed.

The court also instructed the third appellant's attorney to announce the hearing date.

Furthermore, the court ordered the suspension of the sentence for the first appellant until a final decision is reached on the appeal, while reminding her of the necessity to attend the hearing.

During the hearing, the first appellant, a director who was

sentenced to one and a half years imprisonment and was currently serving her sentence, appeared in court.

The certificates falsely claimed that the beneficiaries were working from home.

She was accompanied by her lawyer, Abdulrahman Ghanim, who argued for the suspension of the sentence and her acquittal.

The court allowed the appellant to speak and defend herself.

The third appellant, sentenced to five years imprisonment, was also present, while the second appellant, sentenced to three years imprisonment, did not appear.

The court sentenced the first defendant (third appellant) to five years imprisonment, the second defendant (second appellant) to three years imprisonment, and the third defendant (first appellant) to one and a half years imprisonment.

Down to the wire

Muharraq braces for tight runoff election showdown between Al Shaikh and Qarata

● **Second round set for September 14**

● **Both candidates hit campaign trail again**

The race for the First Constituency seat in Muharraq is set for a nail-biting finish, with a runoff election scheduled for Saturday, September 14th.

The Election Executive Administration announced the runoff, pitting Ebrahim Al Shaikh against Abdulwahed Qarata, on its online platforms.

Overseas voters will cast their ballots starting today.

Both candidates have confirmed they are ready to hit the campaign trail again, with activities resuming yesterday. While on Sunday saw no visible campaigning, both Al Shaikh and Qarata have promised rallies in the coming days.

Our sister newspaper, Al Ayam, reached out to all five candidates who participated in the first round, inquiring about their stance in the runoff.

Most remained tight-lipped, stating they haven't decided who to endorse.

Surprise

However, a surprise came from Saleh Al Sada, who announced his support for Qarata

in a video released early yesterday. Qarata, in turn, expressed his gratitude for the endorsement on his social media.

The outcome of the runoff will hinge heavily on the votes cast for the three candidates who were eliminated in the first round: former MP Hamad Al Kooheji, Al Sada, and Khawla Al Shamsi.

These candidates collectively garnered around 41% of the vote, with Al Kooheji's 20.2% coming in a close second to Qarata. Al Sada and Al Shamsi secured 10.8% and 10.4%, respectively.

Frontrunner

Al Shaikh emerged as the frontrunner in the first round, securing 30.7% of the votes. Qarata followed with 22.3%, making it a close race.

Despite Al Shaikh's lead, he

needs to secure the support of voters who backed the other candidates to guarantee victory in the runoff.

Despite this being his first foray into electoral politics, Qarata has proven himself to be a formidable contender, securing a spot in the runoff with 1516 votes.

Popularity

Al Kooheji saw a boost in pop-

ularity compared to the 2022 elections, where he received 1078 votes.

In this supplementary election, he garnered 1368 votes, a significant increase of approximately 290 votes.

The race for Muharraq's First Constituency is now down to the wire, with the runoff election promising to be a close contest.

Trash troubles

Al Qubaisi raises serious concerns as garbage bag shortage persists in Northern Governorate

● Residents have been left waiting for over three weeks

Abdullah Al Qubaisi, a member of the Northern Municipal Council, has expressed serious concerns over the ongoing shortage of garbage bags in the Northern Governorate.

Al Qubaisi stated that he has received numerous complaints from residents who have been without garbage bags for over three weeks.

“The service of distributing garbage bags to eligible residents is severely lacking and requires more oversight,” Al Qubaisi said. “I have contacted the Ministry, but they claim to be unaware of the issue.”

Al Qubaisi has demanded that the Ministry of Municipalities disclose its plans for monitoring and controlling the distribution of garbage bags.

He emphasised the need to hold accountable those responsible for the shortage, calling it “shameful” that the issue has

persisted since 2020.

Automated machines

Al Qubaisi also criticised the use of automated machines for distributing garbage bags in the Northern Governorate, calling them “ineffective.”



He explained that these machines are often malfunctioning, forcing residents to visit the municipality offices to obtain their bags. He highlighted that other governorates do not face similar issues with their machines.

To address the problem, Al Qubaisi urged the Ministry to implement a long-term solution, including a two-year plan based on the budget, as well as the provision of sufficient “reserve” garbage bags to handle any future shortages.

Bahrain eyes 1.9% annual growth in agriculture

Bahrain’s agricultural sector is expected to pick up by 1.9% annually from 2024 to 2029, according to Mordor Intelligence.

Despite its heavy dependence on imported foods, particularly fruits and vegetables, Bahrain remains a top global producer of dates.

Trade agreements with countries such as the US and Saudi Arabia have cemented Bahrain’s role as a leading importer of various agricultural goods.

In 2022, the government announced a strategy to enhance local agriculture, which included financial assistance and cooperation with technological businesses.

This approach attempts to reduce dependency on imports and increase local production.

The National Initiative for Agricultural Development addresses concerns such as water scarcity, growing expenses, and restricted land.

Modern farming techniques are being promoted, with farm-



ers receiving training and financial assistance.

Report

The report points out that Bahrain’s agricultural growth is driven by increasing food consumption, technological advancements, and better water efficiency. Nonetheless, the country continues to rely on imported food, with local production of grains and other essential crops remaining modest.

The government is also investing in the agricultural workforce, expanding green

spaces, and improving agricultural manufacturing.

Skills

Education and training are essential for advancing modern farming practices and boosting local skills.

In conclusion, Bahrain is looking into alternative farming methods such as hydroponics.

Key crops include dates, figs, mangoes, pomegranates, watermelons, and potatoes, while poultry and dairy products are mainly catered to the domestic market.

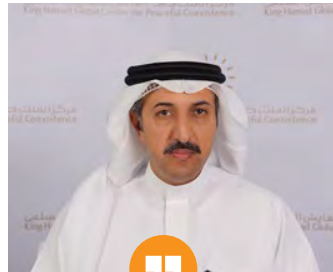
Peaceful Coexistence Diploma praised

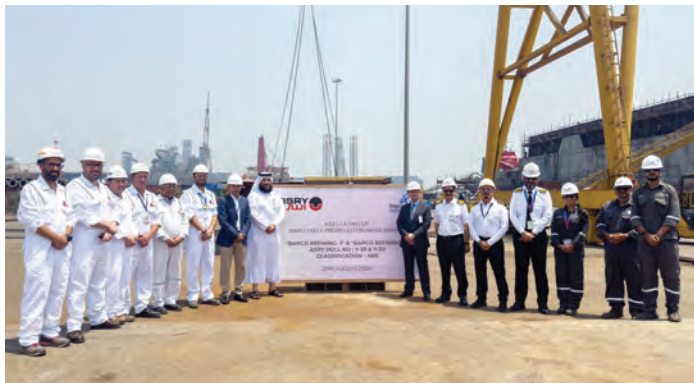

LEGAL VIEWPOINT

Response to the notice of arbitration

Arbitration starts by a "notice of arbitration" to be submitted from a claimant. The UNICITRAL rules of arbitration, provide for the contents of the notice of arbitration, that need to be articulated in the notice, to give it the legal form and formality.

After the role of the claimant in submitting the notice of arbitration, comes the role of the respondent. Response to the notice of arbitration, as in Article 4.1 of the Rules, shall come from the respondent within (30) days of the receipt of the notice of arbitration. As per the Rules, the respondent shall communicate to the claimant a response to the notice of arbitration, which shall include many points. As the name and contact details of each respondent, a response to the information set forth in the notice of arbitration, pursuant to the details mentioned in the Rules.

Moreover, the response to the notice of arbitration may, also, include any plea that an arbitral tribunal to be constituted under these Rules lacks jurisdiction, a proposal for the designation of an appointing authority as referred to in the Rules, a proposal for the appointment of a sole arbitrator and notification of the appointment of an arbitrator. Also, the respondent, may give brief description of counterclaims or claims for the notice of arbitration in case the respondent formulates a claim against a party to the arbitration agreement other than the claimant.

The constitution of the arbitral tribunal shall not be hindered by any controversy with respect to the respondent's failure to communicate a response to the notice of arbitration, or an incomplete or late response to the notice of arbitration, which shall be finally resolved by the arbitration tribunal.

Each party, in the arbitration, may be represented or assisted by the persons they choose. The names and addresses of such persons must be communicated to all parties and to the arbitral tribunal.

Important to mention that, the UNICITRAL Arbitration Rules, give both the claimant and the respondent, equal opportunity to explain their issues related to the arbitration dispute. Each party, is to be very careful and vigilant in presenting the notice of claim or the response to the notice. Each party to pin-point its document very precisely but including necessary details to give full view of his case or defense. If, you omit any important info, you will lose it. Help yourself to help your case. If another party is representing you, he must be a capable representative to take the role in excellent satisfactory way.

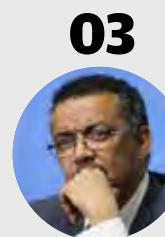

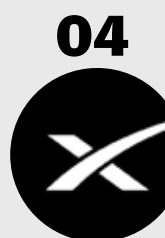

Israel orders new evacuation in Gaza

News in brief

The European Union said yesterday its allies had shared "credible" intelligence Iran had supplied Russia with ballistic missiles, a claim rejected by Tehran but not explicitly denied by the Kremlin. US media outlets reported last week that Washington believed Iran had transferred the weapons to Russia for use in Ukraine, citing anonymous sources. "We are aware of the credible information provided by allies on the delivery of Iranian ballistic missiles to Russia," EU spokesman Peter Stano said. "We are looking further into it with our member states and if confirmed, this delivery would represent a substantive material escalation in Iran's support for Russia's illegal war of aggression against Ukraine." Stano added that "the EU leaders' unanimous position has always been clear. The European Union will respond swiftly and in coordination with international partners, including with new and significant restrictive measures against Iran".

Peter Nygard, the founder of one of Canada's largest clothing brands, was sentenced Monday to 11 years in prison for four counts of sexual assault of women and a girl in Toronto. He faces release in about six and a half years with credit for time spent in pre-trial custody, or sooner if he is granted parole. Nygard, 83, is "a Canadian success story gone very wrong," Ontario Superior Court Justice Robert Goldstein said in handing down the sentence. He called him "a sexual predator," adding that "Mr Nygard used his wealth, power and profile to prey on his victims." Wearing a dark hoodie and a visor to shield his eyes from lights in court, Nygard did not appear to react to the decision.

Forty-seven inmates have escaped from a prison in central Liberia, the justice ministry said Monday, adding that it was "taking all necessary measures" to ensure their recapture. Initial investigations showed the detainees were able to flee because of a breach in the prison's security system, the ministry said in a statement on its Facebook page. It said it was working with the police and prison authorities to determine the exact cause of the breach. "Forty-seven inmates over the weekend escaped the Kakata Central Prison in Kakata, Margibi County," east of the capital Monrovia, the statement said. "The Ministry of Justice is deeply concerned about this incident and is taking all necessary measures to ensure the capture of the escaped inmates," it added, without specifying whether any of the escapees had been caught.



EU says has 'credible information' Iran sent missiles to Russia

The Israeli military said Monday it ordered the evacuation of several neighbourhoods and towns near Gaza City, warning of imminent fighting after rockets were launched from the area.

Avichay Adraee, a military spokesman, posted on social media platform X a map showing several areas in the Gaza Strip's northwest to be evacuated, declaring them part of a "dangerous combat zone".

Israel has issued numerous evacuation orders during its war against Gaza rulers Hamas, triggered by the Palestinian group's October 7 attack.

The evacuation orders have covered most of

Palestinian Ahmad Yunis and his three-year-old son Sami, both injured in an Israeli bombing in the Bureij refugee camp



Gaza's territory, according to the UN, and include areas where the military had previously said were largely cleared of Palestinian armed groups.

Adraee said Palestinian fighters were "once again firing rockets at the State of Israel" from Gaza's northwest, a focus of Israel's military operations in the early stages of the war.

Earlier Monday the armed wing of Islamic Jihad, a Palestinian group fighting alongside Hamas in Gaza, claimed responsibility for rockets launched at southern Israel.

The military said "two projectiles were identified crossing from northern Gaza into Israeli territory" late Sunday, with one intercepted and the other falling in the sea.

Previous evacuation orders Palestinian child Hanan lies in a bed at the Al-Aqsa Martyrs hospital in Deir el-Balah in the central Gaza Strip on September 8, 2024, amid the ongoing war between Israel and the Palestinian militant group Hamas.

The vast majority of Gaza's 2.4 million people have been displaced at least once during more than 11 months of war, according to the United Nations.

have sent people fleeing entire neighbourhoods or towns with whatever belongings they can carry with them.

Israel's military offensives in Gaza has killed at least 40,972 people, according to the Hamas-run territory's health ministry, which does not provide details of civilian and militant deaths.

The UN rights office says most of the dead are women and children.

The October 7 attack on southern Israel resulted in the deaths of 1,205 people, mostly civilians and including some hostages killed in captivity, according to an AFP tally based on official Israeli figures.

Several passengers injured as plane skids off Indonesia runway

A plane with 48 people aboard skidded off the runway in Indonesia's remote eastern region of Papua on Monday, police said, injuring several passengers.

The Southeast Asian archipelago has a poor aviation safety record, and Papua is covered in mountainous terrain where flying is hampered by frequent poor weather.

The ATR-42 aircraft belonging to Trigana Air was taking off from an airport in the remote Yapen Islands regency to Papuan capital Jayapura on Monday morning when it skidded off the runway.

The flight was carrying 42 passengers, including a baby, and six crew.

"Praise God everybody survived and has been taken to a hospital for a health checkup," local police chief Ardyan Ukie Hercachyo said in a statement. "We are investigating the incident and coordinating with related parties to ensure this will never happen again."

The local search and rescue agency said in a statement that some passengers were injured and traumatised by the incident. Indonesia relies heavily on air transport to connect its thousands of islands, but Papua is a particularly difficult area to reach.

Fuel tanker explosion in Nigeria kills at least 52: official

A fuel tanker exploded after colliding with a truck carrying passengers and cattle in northern Nigeria's Niger State killing at least 52 people, a rescue agency said yesterday.

Ibrahim Husseini, spokesman for the Niger State Emergency Management Agency or SEMA, told AFP the victims were given a mass burial following Sunday's early morning accident and explosion.

"The incident occurred when a petrol tanker loaded with PMS (fuel) collided with a trailer truck loaded with travellers and cattle," a SEMA statement said earlier.

Two other vehicles, a crane and a pickup van, were also involved, it said.

More than 50 cattle were also burnt alive.

A charred vehicle at the scene of the explosion of a fuel tanker after it collided with a vehicle carrying cattle and passengers on a route in Niger state's Agale local government district

First robot leg with 'artificial muscles' jumps nimbly: study

Researchers said yesterday they had designed the first robotic leg with "artificial muscles" -- oil-filled bags allowing machines to move more like humans -- that can jump nimbly across a range of surfaces. The small, disembodied robot leg was shown hopping over grass, sand and rocks in a video released alongside a new study in Nature Communications.

The researchers hope the technology can be used in the future to create humanoid robots to help out with "boring labour" around the house, study co-author Robert Katschmann told AFP. Conventional humanoid robots are built with motors and rigid metal joints similar to those used on factory construction lines, the robotics

professor at Switzerland's ETH Zurich university explained.

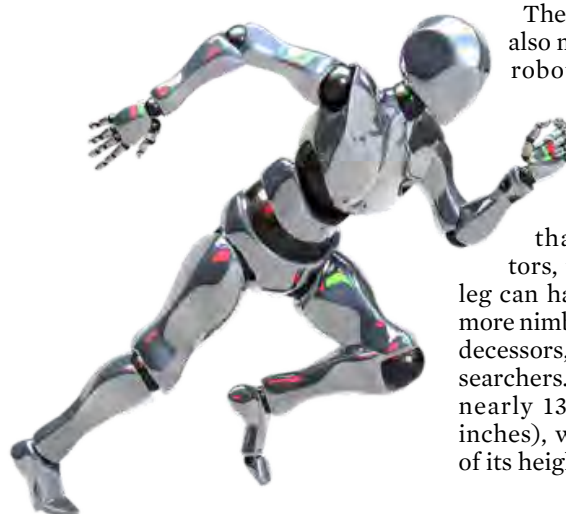
As well as being extremely expensive, such hulking robots could be dangerous if they were to enter people's homes. It is going to be "quite painful", Katschmann said.

The Swiss-led team of researchers was inspired by the 600 muscles in the human body to create something that can walk and jump in a more fluid, agile manner.

To do this, they used "artificial muscles", also known as electrohydraulic actuators. These soft actuators, which resemble freezer bags, are filled with oil and have electrodes attached.

The way the liquid contracts and expands allows the technology to more closely mimic animal muscles.

The electrostatic system also means that when the robot knee is in a bent position, such as a person would have when squatting, the system uses less electricity than traditional motors, the study said. The leg can handle rough terrain more nimbly than its rigid predecessors, according to the researchers. It was able to jump nearly 13 centimetres (five inches), which is 40 percent of its height, the study said.



No sign 'Russian spy' whale shot dead: Norway police

Police in Norway said yesterday that foul play was not suspected in the death of a beluga whale whose unusual harness had sparked suspicions it had been trained by Russia as a spy.

Nicknamed "Hvaldimir" in a pun on the Norwegian word for whale ("hval") and its purported ties to Moscow, the white beluga first appeared off the coast in Norway's far-northern Finnmark region in 2019.

Quickly becoming a celebrity in Norway, he was found dead on August 31 in a bay on the country's southwestern coast.

Last week, animal rights' organisations NOAH and One Whale claimed the whale had been shot dead and filed a police report. With an estimated age of 15 to 20 years, Hvaldimir was relatively

young for a beluga, which typically live up to 35 years, according to environmental group WWF.

The Norwegian Veterinary Institute conducted an autopsy, and police said that based on its preliminary report there was nothing to indicate "human activity" was responsible for Hvaldimir's death.

It suggested the beluga may have died of starvation, and said it would not launch an investigation. "There is nothing in the autopsy that indicates that Hvaldimir was shot," police official Amund Preede Revheim said in a state-

ment. He said the whale had "totally superficial" injuries.

"One of the wounds is a little deeper, but these injuries did not affect any vital organs and were not of a deadly nature," he added. Police did not provide a cause of death, but said a stick 35-centimetres (14 inches) long and three-centimetres wide was found lodged in his mouth.

"The autopsy revealed that his stomach was empty. In addition, most of his organs were deteriorated," Revheim said.



The head of One Whale, Regina Crosby Haug, told AFP last week that she saw "multiple bullet wounds around his body" when she said her goodbyes to Hvaldimir at the Veterinary Institute. One Whale and NOAH had published photographs showing what they claim are bullet holes on his blood-streaked body.

Senegal road accident kills 16, injures 22: fire brigade

At least 16 people were killed and 22 injured when a bus and a lorry collided in central Senegal early yesterday morning, the fire brigade told AFP.

The accident occurred around 6 am local time (0600 GMT) near the village of Ndangalma, a fire brigade official said, requesting anonymity.

Road accidents are frequent in Senegal, mostly due to the poor condition of roads and vehicles, as well as reckless driving and corrupt officials responsible for enforcing the law or issuing driving licences.

The government of President Bassirou Diomaye Faye in August promised concerted action in response to an upsurge in road

accidents. Transport Minister El Malick Ndiaye announced that roadside checks would be stepped up and penalties increased.

He also urged transport operators to uphold vehicle standards, train and raise awareness among employees, and respect working conditions particularly with regard to hours and fatigue.

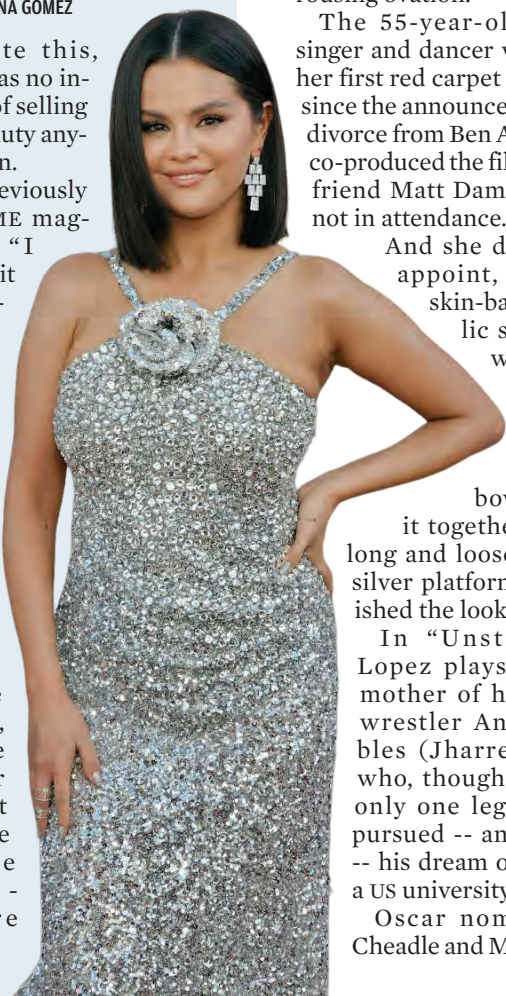
Selena is actually worth an eye-watering \$1.3 billion, according to Bloomberg, which has included the actress on its Billionaires Index for the very first time.

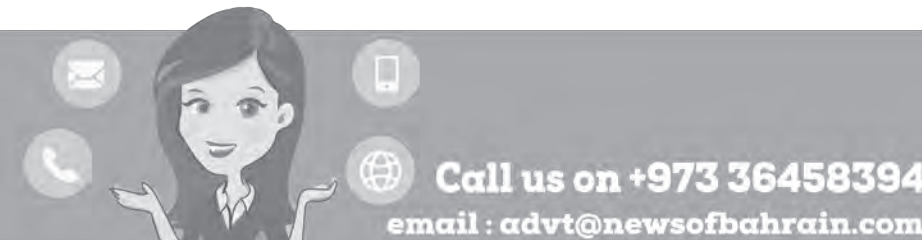

Sinner sweeps to US Open title

Italian world number one defeats Taylor Fritz, secures second Grand Slam of 2024

● Sinner wins 6-3, 6-4, 7-5 against Fritz

● First Italian man to triumph at US Open

● Fritz fails to end 21-year American men's Grand Slam drought

Jannik Sinner won his second Grand Slam title of 2024 on Sunday when he swept aside Taylor Fritz in the US Open final, shattering American hopes of a first male champion at the majors in 21 years.

World number one Sinner, who won his maiden Slam at the Australian Open in January, became the first Italian man to triumph in New York with a 6-3, 6-4, 7-5 victory.

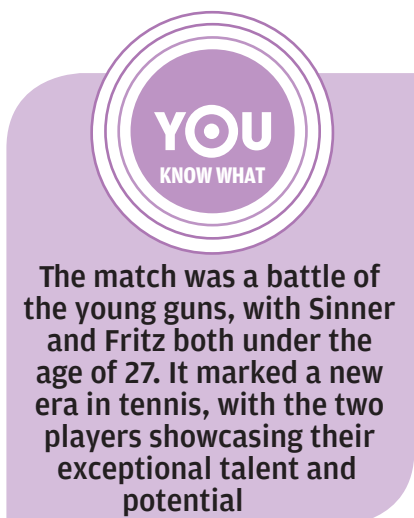
For 23-year-old Sinner, it was a 55th match win of the season and sixth title.

After his 21-year-old rival Carlos Alcaraz pocketed the French Open and Wimbledon titles to take his majors collection to four, the two men have cemented their places as the powerhouses of tennis's new era.

"This title means so much," said Sinner who arrived in New York under a cloud after it was revealed he had failed two drug tests but escaped sanction.

"The last period of my career has not been easy but I have my team and family who support me.

"I love tennis but off court there is a life also and I want to dedicate this tro-



phy to my aunt because she is not well and I don't know how much longer I will have her in my life.

"She was a very important part of my life and still is. It's nice to share this with her."

World number 12 Fritz was bidding to be the first American man since Andy Roddick in New York in 2003 to win a major.

He was backed by A-list celebrity support amongst the 23,000-strong crowd inside Arthur Ashe Stadium.

Pop queen Taylor Swift watched alongside boyfriend and NFL star Travis Kelce while Oscar-winning actor Matthew McConaughey was hard to miss as he donned a Stars and Stripes headband.

"It has been an amazing two weeks. Congratulations to Jannik, he played a great match. He was very impressive and was too good today," said Fritz.

'Next time'

"I'm sorry I couldn't get it done but

I will keep working and I feel I will get it the next time."

Sinner raced to a 2-0 lead in the first set before Fritz settled and levelled for 2-2.

The 26-year-old American saved a break point on the back of an exhausting 23-shot rally in the fifth game but soon slipped 4-3 down.

Sinner pounced again with a third break to claim the opening set as Fritz fired a backhand long.

The two players had only dropped serve a combined 20 times over six rounds each at the tournament before Sunday's final.

That strength shone through in the second set with the first nine games all service holds until the 10th.

Sinner then carved out two set points but only needed one, a deep forehand forcing Fritz into a desperate scramble before he buried his return limply in the net.

By that stage of the final, Sinner had committed just nine unforced errors to the 19 of Fritz in an illustration of his control of the court.

Fritz, the first American man in any Grand Slam final since Roddick at Wimbledon in 2009, saw three break points come and go in the first game of the third set.

But Sinner served up his fourth double fault of the final to hand Fritz a 4-3 lead.

With his back to the wall, the Italian top seed then broke back in the 10th game as Fritz served for the set and held for 6-5.

He went to two championship points when a disheartened Fritz ballooned a running forehand and sealed victory when the American netted.

Sri Lanka end decade-long wait for Test win in England

● Pathum Nissanka's century guides Sri Lanka to eight-wicket win in England

Pathum Nissanka's superb unbeaten century guided Sri Lanka to an ultimately commanding eight-wicket win at The Oval yesterday as they ended a decade-long wait for a Test-match victory in England.

Sri Lanka, set a target of 219, reached that total for the loss of two wickets before lunch on the fourth day, with Nissanka 127 not out and Angelo Mathews 32 not out in an unbroken stand of 111.

Victory gave Sri Lanka just a fourth Test win in England and first since a 100-run success at Headingley back in 2014.

England, however, took this three-match series 2-1 after wins at Old Trafford (five wickets) and Lord's (190 runs).

But defeat meant England, who whitewashed the West In-

dies 3-0 earlier in the season, failed to achieve a first home campaign clean sweep since 2004, when Michael Vaughan oversaw seven successive wins.

Nissanka, named player-of-the-match after also making 64 in the first innings, told Sky Sports: "It was a great opportunity to play in England and I enjoyed that innings."

"I just wanted to play my normal game and I have done that," added the opener, who spent two years out of the Test side.

And for Sri Lanka captain

Dhananjaya de Silva, there was no doubting the significance of leading his country to only their fourth win in 21 Tests in England.

"This is one of the happiest moments in my career and my life," said De Silva.

"We had a tough time in the last two weeks so to come here and get a win in English conditions against an English team, it is a very good moment for me, my team, and my country as well."

Sri Lanka resumed on 94-1, already well-placed to end a run of seven straight Test defeats by England.

Nissanka, recalled at Lord's, was 53 not out and Kusal Mendis unbeaten on 30.

Mendis, however, had added just nine runs to

his score when he hooked a Gus Atkinson bouncer to fine leg where Shoaib Bashir, doing well to sight the ball on a gloomy morning, held an excellent low catch diving to his left.

Sri Lanka were now 108-2 as Mathews, who made a brilliant 160 in their

Headingley success a decade ago, walked in to bat.

England captain Ollie Pope, with Sri Lanka making good progress against the quicks at 137-2, brought on off-spinner Bashir.

Bashir, however, promptly conceded 10 runs in an over, Nissanka pulling a dragged down ball to square leg and Mathews sweeping another four.

Wet outfield scraps first day of Afghanistan-New Zealand Test

The first day's play of the one-off Test between Afghanistan and New Zealand was called off yesterday without the toss due to earlier rain creating a wet outfield.

The toss is scheduled for 9:00 am (03:30 GMT) on Tuesday, day two of the five-day contest, and officials aim to get 98 overs in during the day.

Umpires made repeated inspections throughout yesterday at Afghanistan's adopted home ground near the Indian capital New Delhi at Greater Noida, the first Test at the ven-

ue. The ground staff worked overtime to clear wet patches at the ground, which witnessed bright sunshine for a large part of the day.

But the area has been hit by heavy rain over the past 10 days. Several practice sessions were cancelled for both teams ahead of the game.

Afghanistan's Ibrahim Zardran injured his ankle on the eve of the Test while fielding at a wet patch on the outfield.

Afghanistan has hosted several T20 and ODI internationals since 2017 at the venue, which lacks world-class facilities.
