Ratan Tata, the former Tata Group chairman who put a staid and sprawling Indian conglomerate on the global stage with a string of high-profile acquisitions, has died, the Tata Group said in a statement late yesterday. He was 86.

Tata, who ran the conglomerate for more than 20 years as chairman, had been undergoing intensive care in a Mumbai hospital, two sources with knowledge of his medical situation said.





Court dismisses landlord's rent demand after key handover

TDT | Manama

landlord's demand for Aunpaid rent was tossed out by court after he had accepted the home's keys from the departing tenant, essentially nullifying his case.

The tenant walked away with a win after a court ruled that the landlord had no claim to BD720 in outstanding rent.

The landlord had taken the keys back when the tenant vacated the property in June, two months before the lease was due to end.

Lawyer Jassim Al Essa, representing the tenant, argued that the landlord's acceptance of the keys amounted to an agreement to end the rental contract.

The court agreed, ruling that the claim had no legal

The landlord had filed the case in August, demanding rent for July and August, insisting that the tenant was bound by the lease until the end of August 2024.

He claimed the property had been rented out for BD360 per month, and under the contract, the tenant was liable for the full

However, the court found that the tenant had properly told the landlord of his wish to vacate, and that the landlord's taking of the keys marked the end of their agreement.

A written note, dated 30th June, showed that the landlord had taken back the home, weakening his claim for extra rent.

The High Civil Court has ordered an insurance company to pay BD36,000 in compensation to the family of a 17-year-old boy who died in a traffic accident.

The ruling comes after the victim's family chose to forgive the 19-year-old driver responsible for the accident, opting instead to pursue legal action against the driver's insurance com-

According to their lawyer, Dr Mohammed Al Kooheji, the family, consisting of six members, filed a civil lawsuit against the insurance company after the criminal charges against the driver were dropped due to a reconciliation agreement.

The court's decision hinged on the insurance company's liability under the mandatory motor vehicle insurance law.

The court heard testimony detailing the severity of the injuries sustained by the victim, including near-complete amputation of an upper limb and fractures to the skull and rib cage, as stated in the death certificate.

The court recognized the pain suffered by the victim.

Digital heist

12-member criminal gang accused of fraud through mobile payment application

he High Criminal Court has commenced the trial of a 12-member criminal gang accused of defrauding victims through a mobile payment application.

The group allegedly targeted individuals, including a ministry employee from whom BD468 were stolen.

The Public Prosecution charged the 12 defendants with conspiracy and aiding others, including unidentified individuals, in using the electronic Image used for illustrative purposes only signatures of several victims to illegally access their bank accounts

The gang allegedly obtained victims' bank verification codes through fraudulent means and false pretenses to steal funds.

The charges include unauthorized access to victims' accounts and the use of fraudulent methods, including the use of the bank card verification code, to steal money.

Gridlock in Bahrain

I'm writing today to share my daily odyssey through the wild, unpredictable streets of Bahrain. You'd think navigating a tiny island would be a breeze, but oh no, it's become an extreme sport of sorts. One minute you're calmly driving, and the next, you're stuck behind a concrete truck that's parked like it owns the road (probably because it does).

Let's start with the accidents. It's as if car crashes have become an unofficial spectator sport, with drivers stopping mid-road to marvel at the carnage like it's the Formula One. I spent a solid hour and a half in traffic the other day because people were too busy rubbernecking to remember how to drive. The authorities? Oh, they're there, but instead of, you know, actually directing traffic, they seem to be enjoying the show too. Perhaps they're undercover enthusiasts of 'Bahrain's Got Traffic'.

And don't get me started on the backroads, where concrete mixers block 70% of the lanes, forcing drivers to either reverse into oblivion or wait for divine intervention. For a nation of excellent food, our traffic certainly has a way of giving one indigestion. By the time I finally make it home, I feel like I've travelled across entire continents. To add to the excitement, people treat emergency lanes as personal racetracks, and kids are bouncing around in cars as if seatbelts are a suggestion.

The solution? "Just add another lane," some say. But more lanes will only give us more room for accidents and rogue concrete trucks. What we really need is a metro system (preferably one that runs underground, above ground, and maybe in the air). Or perhaps we could just carpool - a novel idea that would reduce traffic by 2-3 times, if we could all agree on the shared playlist.

Until then, I'll keep navigating this vehicular Hunger Games and hoping for a day when Bahrain's roads are as peaceful as its sunsets.

Urgent Need for Pedestrian Infrastructure in Manama

am writing to express my deep concern regarding the alarming lack of pedestrian infrastructure in the Manama area, specifically between Gudaibiya Palace signal and Ras Ruman signal. Despite the high volume of traffic and pedestrian footfall in this region, the existing facilities are woefully inadequate to ensure the safety and well-being of pedestrians.

There are currently only two traffic junction signals and three pedestrian crossing signals in this 1.5 km stretch. Given the heavy traffic flow and the large number of pedestrians crossing the roads, this is simply insufficient. The absence of pedestrian overpasses or underpasses has created a dangerous situation for pedestrians, who are forced to risk their lives by crossing busy roads.

I have personally witnessed numerous near-misses and accidents involving pedestrians in this area. It is disheartening to see people, particularly children and the elderly, risking their lives to cross the roads. The lack of safe pedestrian crossings is a serious public safety issue that cannot be ignored.

I urge the relevant authorities to take immediate action to address this critical problem. The construction of pedestrian overpasses or underpasses at strategic locations along this busy corridor would significantly improve pedestrian safety and enhance the overall quality of life for residents and visitors alike.

Furthermore, I would like to emphasize the importance of promoting pedestrian-friendly urban planning. By creating safe and accessible pedestrian infrastructure, we can encourage more people to walk and reduce reliance on cars, contributing to a healthier and more sustainable city.

I trust that this matter will receive the urgent attention it deserves. Thank you for your time and consideration.



Announcing the sanctions, a Football Association spokesperson said on Friday: "The forward admitted that he committed an act of violent conduct around the 87th minute by biting an opponent.

"An independent regulatory commission imposed his sanctions following a hearing.

"Its written reasons will be published in due course."

Wales international Beck, who is on loan from Liverpool, was sent off for kicking out at Duane Holmes in the same incident late in the game.

The two players could face each other again this month as Osmajic has been named in the Montenegro squad to take on Wales in a Nations League tie on 14 October. Osmajic is not the only footballer to receive a lengthy ban for violent conduct during a game.






