Indian tycoon Ratan Tata dies

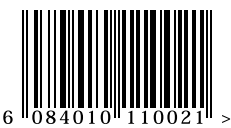

Tata, who ran the conglomerate for more than 20 years as chairman, had been undergoing intensive care in a Mumbai hospital, two sources with knowledge of his medical situation said.

Security and stability

HM the King also called for de-escalation in Lebanon, safeguarding its sovereignty, independence, and territorial integrity.

Furthermore, His Majesty affirmed Bahrain's support for any initiative or action aimed at bringing peace to the region, benefitting its countries and paving the way development and prosperity for all its people.

Warm hospitality

On his part, the UK Foreign Secretary expressed his appreciation to HM King Hamad for

the warm hospitality.

He praised HM the King's efforts in strengthening the historic bilateral ties, noting the UK's ongoing interest in expanding cooperation.

Lammy further emphasised that Bahrain remains a key strategic partner for the UK in the region.

UK Pushes for De-escalation and Stability During Middle East Visit

The United Kingdom is ramping up efforts to promote de-escalation and security in the Middle East, as Foreign Secretary David Lammy begins a critical visit to Bahrain and Jordan.

The trip underscores the UK's commitment to working with regional partners to reduce tensions and prevent further violence following the escalations on October 7.

Lammy's visit includes key meetings with leaders in Bahrain and Jordan, both vital allies of the UK in the region.

His discussions will focus on the urgent need to prevent further escalation in Gaza and Lebanon, as well as to promote a ceasefire.

Instability

The Foreign Secretary will also emphasize the UK's stance against Iran's actions and its proxies, which have contrib-

uted to instability across the region.

Speaking ahead of his visit, Lammy said, “The situation is incredibly dangerous, and further escalation or miscalculation in the region is in no one's interests. We must not waver at this critical period to achieve ceasefires in Gaza and Lebanon, get desperately needed aid into Gaza, and secure the release of all hostages.”

While in Bahrain, the Foreign Secretary will meet with UK

Armed Forces personnel stationed in the Gulf, emphasizing the UK's role in maintaining security in the region, particularly in the Red Sea.

Ongoing efforts

He will also tour HMS Lancaster, a Royal Navy vessel currently patrolling the area, to observe the UK's ongoing efforts to counter Houthi activity.

Court dismisses landlord's rent demand after key handover

A landlord's demand for unpaid rent was tossed out by court after he had accepted the home's keys from the departing tenant, essentially nullifying his case.

The tenant walked away with a win after a court ruled that the landlord had no claim to BD720 in outstanding rent.

The landlord had taken the keys back when the tenant vacated the property in June, two months before the lease was due to end.

Lawyer Jassim Al Essa, representing the tenant, argued that the landlord's acceptance of the keys amounted to an agreement to end the rental contract.

The court agreed, ruling that the claim had no legal footing.

The landlord had filed the case in August, demanding rent for July and August, insisting that the tenant was bound by the lease until the end of August 2024.

He claimed the property had been rented out for BD360 per month, and under the contract, the tenant was liable for the full term.

However, the court found that the tenant had properly told the landlord of his wish to vacate, and that the landlord's taking of the keys marked the end of their agreement.

A written note, dated 30th June, showed that the landlord had taken back the home, weakening his claim for extra rent.

New Labour Law proposal aims to enhance employment opportunities in Bahrain

MP Jalal Kazem has proposed a draft law to amend certain provisions of the Labour Law.

The proposal mandates that all public and private companies submit their available job vacancies to the Ministry of Labour to facilitate necessary recruitment processes.

The proposed legislation includes financial penalties ranging from BD200 to BD500 for any employer or their representative who fails to comply with the new requirements.

Transparency

This initiative aims to promote equality and equal opportunity in the hiring process while reinforcing transparency in the job market.

MP Kazem emphasised that the primary objective of this

proposal is to ensure fairness and equality in job opportunities by publicising vacancies through the Ministry of Labour's electronic employment exhibition.

Moreover, MP Kazem highlighted the importance of simplifying processes for job seekers and securing their right to apply for positions that match their qualifications and skills.

"This law will make it easier for citizens to access suitable job vacancies through the Ministry of Labour's electronic employment exhibition, which will serve as a central database filled with options to organise the labour market and guide job seekers towards available opportunities," he stated.

Furthermore, MP Kazem pointed out the unprecedented-

ed rise in unemployment and job seekers in the Kingdom of Bahrain.

He stressed that the government is now obliged to provide appropriate mechanisms to reduce unemployment rates and encourage a more inviting work environment in the private sector for citizens who are looking for new opportunities.

BD36,000 payout for family of boy crash victim

The High Civil Court has ordered an insurance company to pay BD36,000 in compensation to the family of a 17-year-old boy who died in a traffic accident.

The ruling comes after the victim's family chose to forgive the 19-year-old driver responsible for the accident, opting instead to pursue legal action against the driver's insurance company.

According to their lawyer, Dr Mohammed Al Kooheji, the family, consisting of six members, filed a civil lawsuit against the insurance company after the criminal charges against the driver were dropped due to a reconciliation agreement.

The court's decision hinged on the insurance company's liability under the mandatory motor vehicle insurance law.

The court heard testimony detailing the severity of the injuries sustained by the victim, including near-complete amputation of an upper limb and fractures to the skull and rib cage, as stated in the death certificate.

The court recognized the pain suffered by the victim.

Worker wins BD8,000 after unlawful dismissal

After more than two years of fighting for unpaid wages, a Bahraini worker has won a case against his former employer.

A court ordered the company to pay him over BD8,000 in back pay, damages, and fines for wrongful dismissal.

The ruling came after the worker, who had been sacked without just cause following

three years of service, took legal action.

The court heard that he had an open-ended contract with a monthly wage of BD500 but had not received his pay regularly from October 2021 to March 2024.

Represented by lawyer Ali Al Qaseer, he sought pay for the delayed wages, unused annual leave, wrongful dismissal, notice pay, and legal interest from the date the payment was due.



The employer claimed it had trouble meeting payroll due to lower income and fewer orders.

They also argued that the amounts claimed by the worker did not match their records and insisted that he had left verbally.

Al Qaseer countered this by stating that the worker had been let go after repeatedly asking for his unpaid wages.

The court found that the worker had been wrongly sacked, as there was no doubt about the work ties, and the company failed to give a valid reason for his dismissal.

Digital heist

12-member criminal gang accused of fraud through mobile payment application

The High Criminal Court has commenced the trial of a 12-member criminal gang accused of defrauding victims through a mobile payment application.

The group allegedly targeted individuals, including a ministry employee from whom BD468 were stolen.

The Public Prosecution charged the 12 defendants with conspiracy and aiding others, including unidentified individuals, in using the electronic signatures of several victims to illegally access their bank accounts.

The gang allegedly obtained victims' bank verification codes through fraudulent means and false pretenses to steal funds.

The charges include unauthorized access to victims' accounts and the use of fraudulent methods, including the use of the bank card verification code, to steal money.

Banking information

A female ministry employee, one of the victims, testified that she received a call from an Asian man claiming to be a bank employee who needed to update her banking information.

She provided her verification code and later discovered she had been defrauded of BD468.

Meanwhile, a Ministry of In-

terior officer testified that information was received about a group of Asian individuals engaging in electronic fraud.

The investigation led to the identification of the defendants.

Necessary tools

The officer stated that the first and twelfth defendants allegedly led the gang, recruiting

members and providing them with the necessary tools.

Their method involved searching for random mobile payment app numbers, recording valid ones, and noting the associated bank and account holder's name.

The second stage, according to the officer, involved contacting victims, impersonating bank or official personnel, obtaining their banking details, and stealing their funds.

Defrauding victims

The remaining defendants allegedly collected numbers, while the first and twelfth defendants were responsible for contacting and defrauding victims.

The officer confirmed that the ministry employee victim

was contacted by the first defendant, who impersonated a bank employee and requested data updates, subsequently stealing BD468 and transferring the money to another individual.

Examination of the first defendant's phone revealed communication with the victim on the day of the incident.

The second defendant stated that someone introduced him to the seventh defendant, who, along with the first defendant, recruited them to contact individuals and obtain the mobile payment numbers.

Selling sweets

The fourth defendant stated that he arrived in Bahrain with the eighth defendant, who said he would work selling sweets for the twelfth defendant.

Fasht Al Jarim and Fasht Al Adhm are crucial habitats for fish reproduction, stressing the need for their protection.

Furthermore, the legislation seeks to protect coral reefs and biodiversity, which may boost tourism and improve food security while also reinforcing Bahrain's obligations to protect natural reserves and wildlife habitats.

During the meeting, the committee reviewed documents from the Council of Representatives and considered insights from its legal advisor and relevant authorities.

SE Asian summit seeks progress on Myanmar civil war
Southeast Asian leaders met for talks with a Myanmar junta representative at a regional summit yesterday as they try to kickstart faltering diplomatic efforts to broker an end to the country's civil war. The disputed South China Sea will also be on the agenda at the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) gathering, after months of violent clashes between Chinese vessels and Philippine and Vietnamese fishermen.

North Korea has appointed a new defence minister, state media said yesterday, while making no mention of an expected step by Pyongyang to harden its position against Seoul. No Kwang Chol was named the new defence minister at a key parliamentary meeting, succeeding Kang Sun Nam, the Korean Central News Agency (KCNA) reported without further detail. No was part of Kim's delegations during visits to Singapore in 2018 and Vietnam in 2019 for discussions with then-US president Donald Trump.

Niger ups flood toll to 339 dead, more than 1.1 million affected
Torrential rains in Niger have left 339 people dead and more than 1.1 million displaced since June, state media reported Tuesday, updating a previous toll. Niger's interior minister last month stated at least 273 were dead and more than 700,000 affected as extreme weather slammed the Sahel nation. As of September 23, the floods had impacted more than 1.1 million people, resulting in 339 dead and leaving another 383 injured, state news agency ANP said.

The Israeli army intensified shelling of northern Gaza and closed roads, preventing the delivery of aid, the war-torn Palestinian territory's civil defence agency said yesterday. The army, which said it surrounded Jabalia in northern Gaza at the weekend, issued new evacuation demands on Tuesday, as analysts suggested Hamas was regrouping, despite a year of strikes and fierce fighting.

"The shelling is intensifying, targeting civilians and their homes, causing significant fear and terror among the residents," said Ahmad al-Kahlut, the agency's director in north Gaza.

The director said the Israeli army also was targeting the northern towns of Beit Lahia and Beit Hanun along with Jabalia.

"Roads have been closed, and there has been a continuous siege for the fourth consecutive day,

with no supplies entering the North Gaza Governorate," Kahlut said.

According to the director, "a large number" of people died in northern Gaza during the fighting.

But he said counting the casualties had been complicated by the "difficulty of recovery and access to all areas".

The Palestinian Red Crescent said its teams had transported

three dead and 15 injured from the al-Rafai school in Jabalia, where displaced Gazans had sought shelter.

The civil defence's Kahlut said his agency had been receiving calls for help from various parts of northern Gaza, but staff had been unable to enter these areas for security reasons.

"So far, Kamal Adwan Hospital is still operational and is dealing with the injuries that the teams

can recover," he said, referring to a hospital in Beit Lahia.

Hospitals struggling

Hisham Abu Aoun, head of the intensive care unit for the Friends of the Patient Hospital, said at least six children were evacuated to his hospital in Gaza City.

Amal Nasr, a resident of Jabalia, said her daughter Dana and husband Rami were both injured by gunfire while fleeing the area.

"My daughter Dana was shot in the neck, and my husband was shot in his leg by the occupation forces," she said, adding her daughter was taken to a Gaza City hospital and was now in stable condition.

"I was injured while we were leaving our house. I was shot in the neck and started to bleed", Dana Nasr told AFP from the Al-Ahli Hospital.

"There were many injured peo-

ple in the streets of Jabalia," she added.

Gaza's hospitals are struggling with limited supplies. The health ministry appealed Tuesday for international help, warning fuel shortages could force hospitals to close.

The UN's agency for Palestinian refugees, UNRWA, said "intensified military operations" in northern Gaza forced it to halt services. This included the evacuation of seven UNRWA schools used as shelters by displaced Gazans. The Israeli army yesterday said operations were ongoing "throughout Gaza".

It said Israeli troops had "eliminated" 20 Palestinian combatants in the Jabalia area and had dismantled a weapons storage facility a day earlier.

Trump secretly sent Covid tests to Putin: Bob Woodward book

Then-president Donald Trump secretly sent Covid test kits to Vladimir Putin despite a US shortage during the pandemic, and spoke multiple times with the Russian leader after leaving office, Bob Woodward says in an explosive new book.

The famed reporter's opus also chronicles some of President Joe Biden's own acknowledged missteps and his struggle to prevent escalation of conflict in the Middle East, including exasperation with Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu over futile efforts to get Israel and Hamas to reach a ceasefire.

In excerpts of "War" published Tuesday by The Washington Post, where Woodward is an associate editor, he says Trump retains a personal relationship with Putin even as he campaigns for another term and the Russian president conducts a war against US ally Ukraine.

With the coronavirus raging in 2020, Trump sent a batch of coveted tests to his counterpart in Moscow. Putin accepted the supplies but sought

to avoid political fallout for Trump, urging he not reveal the dispatch of medical equipment, the book says.

According to Woodward, Putin told Trump: "I don't want you to tell anybody because people will get mad at you, not me."

Woodward also cites an unnamed Trump aide who indicated the Republican leader may have spoken to Putin up to seven times since leaving the White House in 2021 -- despite the US effort to help Ukraine resist Russian invasion and the severe deterioration of relations with Moscow.

'Catastrophic' Hurricane Milton approaches Florida

"catastrophic" Hurricane Milton was closing in on the storm-battered state of Florida yesterday as US officials pleaded with residents to flee or risk dying.

President Joe Biden warned that the Category 5 storm could be the worst natural disaster to hit the state in a century.

As the second huge hurricane in as many weeks rumbled toward Florida's west coast, people raced to board up homes and flee.

"It's a matter of life and death, and that's not hyperbole," Biden said from the White House on Tuesday, urging those under orders to leave to "evacuate now, now, now."

By yesterday morning (0900

Harris, Trump trade blows in US election media blitz

Kamala Harris and Donald Trump exchanged barbs over the airwaves Tuesday as they reached out to the few remaining undecided voters in the final stretch of an election seen as one of the closest in modern US history.

Harris has maintained a lead of two-to-three points in national polling since mid-August, despite presidential and vice presidential debates, encouraging jobs data, an interest rate cut, escalating international crises and a devastating hurricane.

"I literally lose sleep -- and have

been -- over what is at stake in this election," the Democratic vice president, 59, told radio icon Howard Stern in a 70-minute live interview.

A poll from Siena College and The New York Times out Tuesday highlighted the deadlock, finding Harris ahead of her Republican rival by 49 percent to 46 percent -- although it had the pair in a dead heat in September.

Poll-watchers expect the stalemate to break only in the last couple of weeks before election day on November 5, as the small fraction of wavering Americans who will decide the election break one way or the other.

Trio wins chemistry Nobel for protein design, prediction

Americans David Baker and John Jumper, together with Briton Demis Hassabis, shared the Nobel Prize in Chemistry yesterday for work revealing the secrets of proteins through computing and artificial intelligence.

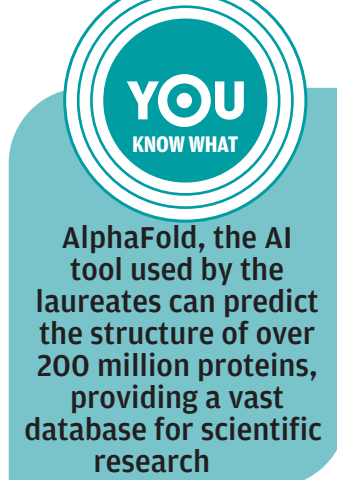
The three were honoured for cracking the code of the structure of proteins, the building blocks of life, with the jury hailing their work as holding "enormous potential" in a range of fields.

Biochemist Baker, 62, was given half the award "for computational protein design", while Hassabis and Jumper shared the other half "for protein structure prediction", the Nobel committee said.

"David Baker has succeeded with the almost impossible feat of building entirely new kinds of proteins," it said in a statement.

The committee added that his work has led to the creation of proteins that "can be used as pharmaceuticals, vaccines, nanomaterials and tiny sensors."

Hassabis and Jumper developed an AI model "to solve a 50-year-old problem: predicting proteins' complex structures," the jury said of the duo

Scientific dream

The AI tool is used to predict the three-dimensional structure of proteins based on their amino acid sequence, and the AlphaFold database now contains the predicted structure of over 200 million proteins.

The jury said that the laureates' discoveries "hold enormous

potential."

"Proteins are the molecules that enable life. Proteins are building blocks that form bones, skin, hair and tissue," Heiner Linke, chair of the Nobel Committee for Chemistry, told a press conference.

"To understand how life works, we first need to understand the shape of proteins," he said, and added that being able to predict their structure from their amino acid building blocks had "long been a dream."

Baker told reporters yesterday was a turning out to be "quite a unique, special day" for him.

"I was sleeping when the phone rang, and I answered the phone and I heard the announcement," Baker said via phone link after the prize was announced in Stockholm.

The researcher said he was really excited about "all the ways in which protein design can now make the world a better place," while listing areas such as health, medicine as well as technology and sustainability.

Tuesday's physics prize honoured key breakthroughs in artificial intelligence (AI), going to American John Hopfield and British-Canadian Geoffrey Hinton, known as the Godfather of AI.

Urgent Need for Pedestrian Infrastructure in Manama

I am writing to express my deep concern regarding the alarming lack of pedestrian infrastructure in the Manama area, specifically between Gudaibiya Palace signal and Ras Ruman signal. Despite the high volume of traffic and pedestrian footfall in this region, the existing facilities are woefully inadequate to ensure the safety and well-being of pedestrians.

There are currently only two traffic junction signals and three pedestrian crossing signals in this 1.5 km stretch. Given the heavy traffic flow and the large number of pedestrians crossing the roads, this is simply insufficient. The absence of pedestrian overpasses or underpasses has created a dangerous situation for pedestrians, who are forced to risk their lives by crossing busy roads.

I have personally witnessed numerous near-misses and accidents involving pedestrians in this area. It is disheartening to see people, particularly children and the elderly, risking their lives to cross the roads. The lack of safe pedestrian crossings is a serious public safety issue that cannot be ignored.

I urge the relevant authorities to take immediate action to address this critical problem. The construction of pedestrian overpasses or underpasses at strategic locations along this busy corridor would significantly improve pedestrian safety and enhance the overall quality of life for residents and visitors alike.

Furthermore, I would like to emphasize the importance of promoting pedestrian-friendly urban planning. By creating safe and accessible pedestrian infrastructure, we can encourage more people to walk and reduce reliance on cars, contributing to a healthier and more sustainable city.

The incident took place in a Sky Bet Championship match between the two Lancashire clubs at Deepdale on 22 September which ended in a goalless draw.

Blackburn boss John Eustace said in his post-match news conference at the time: "[Beck's] got a big bite mark on the back of his neck.

"He's shown all the lads. He's a little bit quiet, a little bit shook up."

Announcing the sanctions, a Football Association spokesperson said on Friday: "The forward admitted that he committed an act of violent conduct around the 87th minute by biting an opponent.

"An independent regulatory commission imposed his sanctions following a hearing.

"Its written reasons will be published in due course."

Wales international Beck, who is on loan from Liverpool, was sent off for kicking out at Duane Holmes in the same incident late in the game.

The two players could face each other again this month as Osmajic has been named in the Montenegro squad to take on Wales in a Nations League tie on 14 October. Osmajic is not the only footballer to receive a lengthy ban for violent conduct during a game.

In April 2013, Uruguayan Luis Suarez, who was playing for Liverpool at the time, was given a 10-match ban for biting Branislav Ivanovic during a Premier League game against Chelsea.



Frenchman Eric Cantona was given a nine-month ban after infamously kung-fu kicking a Crystal Palace fan during a clash against Manchester United at Selhurst Park in January 1995.

Paolo Di Canio, then at Sheffield Wednesday, was sent off for pushing referee Paul Alcock during a match against Arsenal in September 1998. The Italian reacted to being shown a red card.

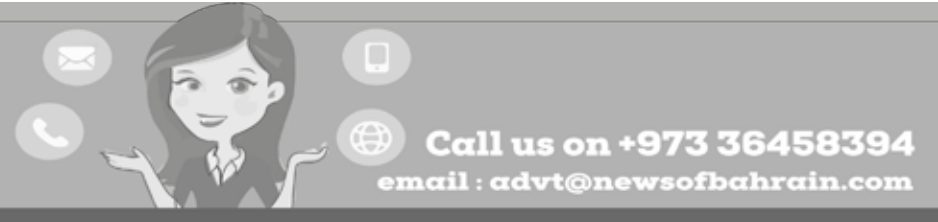

Reddy stars as India crush Bangladesh to clinch T20 series

India 221 for 9 (Reddy 74, Rinku 53, Taskin 2-16) beat Bangladesh 135 for 9 (Mahmudullah 41, Varun 2-19, Reddy 2-23) by 86 runs

Rookie all-rounder Nitish Kumar Reddy smashed 74 and took two wickets to help India thrash Bangladesh by 86 runs for a series-clinching win in the second T20 international yesterday.

Reddy's blitz included four fours and seven sixes and his 108-run fourth-wicket stand with Rinku Singh, who hit 53, powered India to 221-9 at New Delhi's Feroz Shah Kotla ground.

India, led by Suryakumar Yadav, kept Bangladesh down to 135-9 in 20 overs to take an unassailable 2-0 lead in the three-match series.

Mahmudullah Riyad top-scored with 41 after the veteran batsman on Tuesday announced his retirement from T20 internationals at the end of this series.

The 38-year-old Mahmudullah hit three sixes in his 39-ball knock of his 140th T20 for Bangladesh.

Spinner Varun Chakravarthy and medium-pace bowler Reddy, playing his second match after he made his international debut in the opening win, took two wickets each.

The tourists elected to field first and reduced India to 41-3 inside six overs before Reddy and Rinku counter-attacked in their century stand.

Reddy took on the attack with sixes and fours and reached his fifty in 27 balls.

Reddy hammered Mehidy Hasan Miraz for three sixes and a four before being caught out by him in the next over from Mustafizur Rahman.

Rinku kept up the attack as he smashed fast bowler Tanzim Hasan for two fours and a six to raise his fifty in 26 balls but soon got out to Taskin Ahmed.

Hardik Pandya made 32 off 19 balls before being dismissed by leg-spinner Rishad Hossain, who got two more wickets in the final over to end with three.

Bangladesh scored 14 in the first over but were never in the chase as they lost regular wickets to slip to 46-4 in 6.5 overs.

Root breaks Cook's England record

Joe Root surpasses Alastair Cook, hits unbeaten 176 as England reaches 492-3 against Pakistan

● Root overtakes Cook's record of 12,472 Test runs

● England trails Pakistan by 64 runs on day three

● Root adds 243 runs with Harry Brook, who scores 141*

Joe Root went past Alastair Cook as England's highest Test run scorer with an unconquered hundred against Pakistan, anchoring his team to 492-3 in the first Test in Multan yesterday.

The 33-year-old overhauled Cook's aggregate of 12,472 runs and became the fifth-highest scorer of all time after he drove seamer Amer Jamal for a straight boundary to reach 71 just before lunch.

Root was still batting on 176 at

the close on day three with his partner Harry Brook on 141 not out, taking England within 64 runs of Pakistan's first innings total of 556.

The pair added 243 runs for

the unbroken fourth wicket, re-buffing Pakistan's bowling attack on a lifeless pitch that had punished England's bowlers on the first two days.

Pakistan's head coach Jason

Gillespie said his team needed early wickets on Thursday.

"We suspected the way England will look to get a lead and have a crack at us," he told reporters. "We have to come out in

the morning and hit the ground running."

Root's memorable 481-minute knock includes 12 boundaries. Brook amassed the same number and added a six despite suffering cramps.

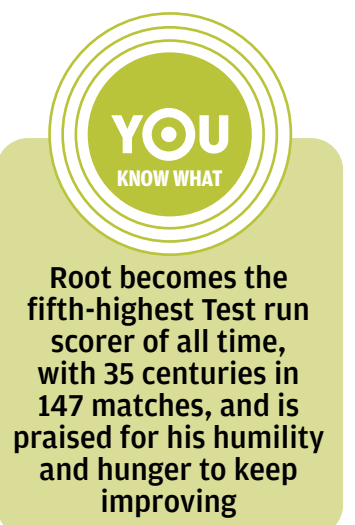
Root reverse swept spinner Abrar Ahmed for a single to reach his 35th Test hundred -- the sixth most by any batsman -- getting to the mark off 167 balls.

Brook reached his sixth hundred with a single off part-timer Saud Shakeel from 118 balls, adding to his previous three in England's 3-0 series rout of Pakistan two years ago.

Root added 136 for the third wicket with Ben Duckett, who made a robust 84 and showed no effect from a thumb dislocation on Tuesday that forced him to bat at number four.

Duckett was the only man dismissed in the second session, trapped leg-before by Jamal after hitting 11 boundaries.

All three Pakistan fast bowlers -- Shaheen Shah Afridi, Naseem Shah and Jamal -- have taken a wicket each. Frontline spinner Abrar has conceded 174 runs in



35 wicketless overs.

Pakistan also reviewed three not out decisions to no avail.

It was a day to remember for Root, who took 268 innings and 147 Tests to go past his former captain Cook's total of 12,472 runs from 161 Tests in a glorious career that ended in 2018.

Root also added 109 for the second wicket with Zak Crawley, who hit 13 fours in an 85-ball knock of 78.

Bahrain FA urges fans to avoid disruptive behaviour after FIFA fine

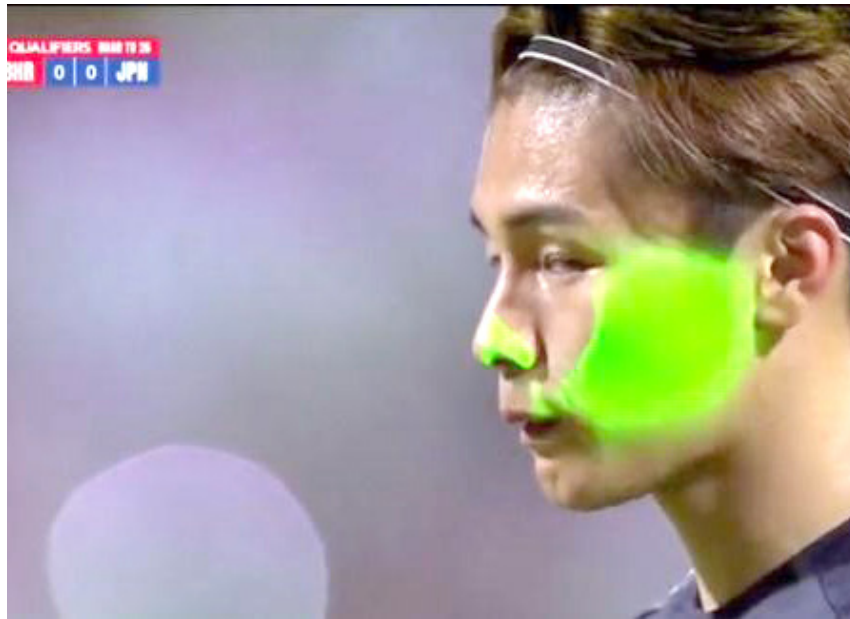
● **Fans urged to support the team positively**

In light of a recent penalty imposed by FIFA, the Bahrain Football Association (BFA) has issued a stern request to its supporters ahead of the match against Indonesia. The BFA was fined \$4,400 due to fan misconduct during Bahrain's 5-0 blowout to Japan, which included the use of laser pointers and whistles to distract players. With the next two matches potentially defining Bahrain's qualifying campaign, the FA is keen to ensure a positive atmosphere in the stands.

Crunch Time

As Bahrain prepares to host Indonesia at the National Stadium tonight,

the stakes couldn't be higher. Indonesia enters the match with renewed confidence, following valuable draws against Saudi Arabia and Australia. For Bahrain, there is little room for error, as anything less than a win could severely

impact their chances of progressing. Having yet to find the back of the net in their last two matches—excluding the own goal that gifted them a win against Australia—Bahrain must capitalize on this home fixture.

The Fallout

The 5-0 defeat to Japan last month left Bahrain reeling—not just from the result but also from the repercussions of poor fan behavior. Many supporters left the stadium early, disillusioned by the scoreline, while others resorted to using laser pointers and whistles, actions that have now drawn FIFA's ire.

In the aftermath, Japan's manager, Hajime Moriyasu, voiced his concerns, stating, "But I would like to see an end to the booing that happened during the national anthems at today's game, and the attempts to obstruct my players, which could have done them physical damage".

He added, "The Bahrain team were able to compete in a very fair manner, and I would like the fans to do the same". The fine serves as a reminder that fan conduct is not only a matter of national pride but can also affect the team on and off the pitch.

Positive Fan Engagement

With the penalty fresh in mind, the BFA is urging supporters to channel their passion constructively. They have asked fans to refrain from using dis-

ruptive tactics and instead focus on providing vocal support for the players throughout the 90 minutes. The Federation's message is clear: the team needs the fans, but it needs them to be a source of motivation, not distraction.

Saudi Arabia Clash Looms Large

While the Indonesia match is the immediate focus, Bahrain can't ignore what comes next—a highly anticipated meeting with Saudi Arabia just five days later in Riyadh. A win over Indonesia would provide crucial momentum heading into the Saudi clash, where the team will need to be at full strength both physically and mentally.

Victory Requires Unity

The message from the Bahrain FA is unmistakable: the road to World Cup qualification is a collective effort. The players need to deliver on the field, but the fans also play a key role. Avoiding distractions and showing unwavering support, regardless of the score, will be critical to the team's success. With a passionate crowd behind them, Bahrain has the potential to take a huge step toward World Cup qualification tonight.
