Push for 'fair' night shift pay

MP proposal seeks 10% extra allowance for night and on-call workers

Bahrain's Labour Law may soon set a minimum 10 per cent shift allowance for night and on-call roles if MP Jalal Kadhem's amendment to Article 50 gains approval, addressing long-standing fairness concerns for private-sector workers.

"Fairness means the worker should get extra pay during their shift to help keep a decent standard of living," Kadhem's proposal states, pointing out the toll night shifts can take on both body and mind, as well as the isolation that often comes with such work.

Kadhem has put forward an amendment to Article 50, calling for a set allowance for those working night shifts and in roles requiring them to be on-call.

The proposal aims to ensure workers receive at least 10 per cent more on top of their basic pay, providing a clear way to recognise the demands these roles bring.

At present, the Labour Law allows for a general work nature

allowance, but without setting a minimum.

Kadhem's amendment seeks to set a base level, giving a clear standard across the private sector.

The proposal is based on Bahrain's Constitution, particularly Article 13, which calls on the state to "guarantee job opportu-

nities for citizens and fairness in working conditions."

By setting the shift allowance in law, the amendment aims to strengthen fairness for Bahrain's workers, making sure those bearing the challenges of irregular hours are properly valued.

Shift system

Kadhem's statement stresses that the shift system is widely used across Bahrain, affecting workers in many fields.

It argues that a set allowance is needed to ease the ongoing

demands of such work, which can wear down both body and mind over time.

The proposal will now be reviewed by Parliament's specialised committee, which, if it agrees, will pass it to the government to be drafted into law.

31 die, 14 hurt in Israeli strikes on Lebanon

A wave of Israeli strikes on east and south Lebanon yesterday killed at least 31 people, the health ministry said, as Israel intensified its air campaign against Iran-backed Hezbollah.

"Israeli enemy raids targeting the Baalbek-Hermel region killed 20 people, including 11 in the Knaisseh locality," a statement from the ministry said of attacks on the east of the country where Hezbollah holds sway.

Another 14 people were wounded, it said.

In the south, where Hezbollah also has a strong presence, Israeli strikes killed at least 11 people, including six rescuers linked to the group and its Shiite ally Amal.

Labour Ministry to honour workers in high-risk jobs

The Ministry of Labour is seeking nominations to honour citizens working in high-risk professions as part of the 'For You' initiative under the national 'Bahrainouna' plan.

Engineer Mustafa Aqeel Al Shaikh, Director of the Ministry's Inspection and Safety Department and head of the 'For You' team, expressed the Ministry's regard for citizens engaged in these demanding fields.

Al Shaikh noted that the Ministry intends to recognise 20 citizens selected by their employers, with a dedicated ceremony set for December.

The Ministry's call for nominations marks the second wave of 'For You,' a programme forming part of The National Plan to Promote the Spirit of Belonging to the Nation and Reinforce the Values of Citizenship (Bahrainouna).

roles in the private sector. Al Shaikh invited private sector employers to nominate employees meeting the pro-

Eligibility for nominations is

based on the definition outlined in Ministerial Order No.(8) of 2013 which sets out safety and health standards for workplaces.

High-risk professions include work at heights, handling health-endangering chemicals, operating high-pressure equipment or high-voltage power, maintaining and installing electrical systems, and working in conditions involving extreme heat, noise, vibration, or radiation.

Scope

The scope also covers tasks involving radioactive substances, potential carcinogens, and machinery with exposed parts.

Other areas include work in confined spaces, professional diving, excavation and demolition, mining, lifting operations, and healthcare roles with risks of virus exposure.

Louvre Meets Bahrain

Digital tour unveils ancient treasures of Dilmun and Tylos

Bahrain is stepping into the digital age of archaeology with an innovative experience set to connect its residents and students to the ancient civilisations of Dilmun and Tylos.

Bahrain Heritage Tour, a new digital initiative led by the Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities, will be launched on Sunday, and run through November 23rd, in partnership with the French Embassy in Bahrain and the Louvre Museum in Paris.

Heritage

This interactive tour invites Bahrain’s public, school and university students, and the broader community to explore Bahraini heritage through state-of-the-art digital tools.

Featuring artefacts like pottery jars, cuneiform tablets, Dilmun seals, and statues, the experience introduces the public to the social and cultural life of Bahrain’s ancient inhabitants.

Each artefact, meticulously documented and presented on tablets through a custom-built application, promises a glimpse into the daily lives and artistry of the Dilmun and Tylos eras.

Collection

Inspired by the ongoing exhibition ‘From Dilmun to Tylos: An Archaeological Journey in the Kingdom of Bahrain’ at

the Louvre in Paris, the Bahrain Heritage Tour extends the reach of this collection beyond museum walls.

Julien Cuny, head of the French archaeological mission in Bahrain, will oversee the two-week tour as it moves across Bahrain’s governorates, visiting schools, universities, and key public archaeological sites.

The project aims to bridge modern Bahrainis with their ancient roots, creating a direct link to their country’s heritage while fostering awareness of the need to protect its archaeological treasures.

Millennia-old history

Special emphasis is placed on Dilmun burial mounds, historical structures scattered in Bahrain’s A’ali region, which reflect the Kingdom’s enduring link to its millennia-old history.

For participating students from the University of Bahrain, the tour culminates in an academic exchange program in France.

This initiative, organized by the Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities, will allow students to deepen their knowledge in heritage preservation and archaeological research, fostering a new generation of cultural custodians.

The Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities ex-

tended gratitude to the Gulf Petrochemical Industries Company (GPIC) for their support, as well as to other collaborators, including the Arab Regional Centre for World Heritage, the Observatory of Heritage in the Middle East and the Mediterranean, and the École du Louvre.

The Femme Fatale Studio developed the application for this experience, while Iconem contributed to the photography of the showcased artefacts.

Originally inaugurated at the Louvre in October 2022, the ‘From Dilmun to Tylos’ exhibition represents a five-year collaboration between Bahrain and France.

Landmark agreement

Featuring over 70 artefacts, it was born from a landmark agreement signed during His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa’s 2019 visit to Paris.

These artefacts, alongside others from the Louvre’s own Near East Department, narrate a 4,000-year legacy of Bahrain’s role as a centre of commerce, politics, and cultural exchange.

Caring for seniors

MPs set to debate key proposal on free rides for elderly patients

Bahrain's elderly could soon have access to free rides for doctor's appointments, as MPs take up a key proposal next Tuesday to fund transport for seniors in need of care.

This plan seeks to ease the trouble of reaching check-ups and treatments, making sure older citizens can get the care they need without the added task of finding transport.

Currently, the Ministry of Health does not provide specific transport services for elderly patients, although government hospitals do offer a similar option for kidney patients who have no other means or need assistance due to health issues. The Ministry has acknowledged the proposal, indicating it may consider extending transport assistance to more elderly patients if resources allow.

Healthcare system

Bahrain's healthcare system already includes mobile clinics run by primary health centres to assist elderly patients who struggle to visit medical facilities.

These mobile units bring consultations, lab tests, and social support to those who are housebound, providing a straightforward solution for older individuals needing regular care.

The Services Committee, led by MP Mamdouh Al Saleh, reviewed the proposal after Speaker Ahmed Al Musallam referred it in June and has backed it.

MPs Maryam Al Dhaen,

Ahmed Al Salloom, Mahdi Al Shuwaikh, and Hanan Fardan support the scheme, viewing it as an important step toward easing healthcare access for Bahrain's ageing population.

With the committee's approval, the proposal now heads to Parliament, where it's likely to win broad support.

If approved by parliament and government, it would serve as a key help for seniors, easing travel troubles and giving them simpler access to healthcare sites.

Calls for emergency services witness surge

Bahrain's emergency services experienced a surge in call volume in September 2024, handling a total of 15,961 calls.

This marks an increase from August's high of 15,402, indicating a sustained and pressing demand for emergency response resources throughout the country.

In August, the Emergency Operations Centre processed 15,402 calls, with 67% classified as emergency situations, 28% as traffic incidents, and 5% as security issues.

The Coast Guard effectively managed 131 incidents, while the National Ambulance Service responded to 4,774 calls.

Trend

September's data reveals a similar trend of heightened demand for emergency services.

The 15,961 calls received during this month were categorised as follows: 66% general emergency responses, 28% traffic incidents, and 6% security matters.

The Coast Guard operations centre responded to 200 calls, which included 143 search and rescue missions, 6 maritime accidents, and 51 requests for assistance, illustrating the diverse challenges faced by responders.

The National Ambulance Service attended to 4,778 calls, which encompassed 3,127 medical emergencies, 852 patient transfers between hospitals, 393 injuries resulting from traffic accidents, 372 injuries from other incidents, and 34 fire-related injuries.

36,000 jobs by 2030 from \$14.9b construction boom

Cementing its concrete role in the competitive GCC market, Bahrain's construction sector is projected to contribute \$14.9 billion and 36,100 jobs to the economy by 2030.

Currently at 8.7 per cent of GDP (\$9.4 billion), the sector's share is expected to increase to 11.3 per cent, showcasing Bahrain's growing appeal for investors.

A recent report from the Arab Investment & Export Credit Guarantee Corporation shows Bahrain's strong position in the Arab construction industry, with three Bahraini companies among the top ten investors from 2003 to 2024.

Investments

Tameer Holding, for example, ranks second in project costs, with investments ex-

ceeding \$20.7 billion.

GFH Financial Group and Gulf Holding Company also made substantial contributions, collectively creating over 17,000 jobs, which has had a considerable impact on employment in the sector.

Regionally, the UAE's Majid Al Futtaim Group leads with investments of more than \$23 billion across 19 projects, while Bahrain's Tameer Holding follows closely, holding a 4.8 per cent share in the Arab construction market.

Significant presence

Meanwhile, GFH Financial Group has established a significant presence by creating over 8,000 jobs in the region, with Gulf Holding Company adding 9,000 jobs.

Bahrain ranks among the top Arab nations for attracting construction projects.

Man's sentence reduced for fraudulent car sale

A Bahraini man has had his prison sentence reduced from three years to one year after being convicted of defrauding an Asian national in a car sale scam.

The High Appeals Court handed down the reduced sentence.

The defendant convinced the victim that he was the legitimate owner of a "scrap" car, presenting a forged ownership

certificate.

The victim, after viewing photos and videos provided by the defendant, agreed to purchase the vehicle.

The transaction took place as planned, with the victim handing over the agreed-upon sum of money and receiving the car and the fraudulent ownership certificate.

However, the victim subsequently discovered the certificate to be fake and the information incorrect.

BKIC announces nine months profit exceeding BD4 million

Bahrain Kuwait Insurance Company (BKIC) announced its consolidated financial results for the nine months ended 30th September 2024.

Q3 results

The company reported q3 net profit attributable to the shareholders of BD 1.064 million compared to BD 1.183 million for the same period last year. Earnings per share were 7 fils compared to 8 fils for the same period of last year.

The decrease in results within the current quarter compared to the same period last year is mainly attributed to enhance-

ments in the actuarial model assumptions as per the requirements of IFRS 17 followed by reductions in the discount rates applied. These adjustments have led to a one-time exceptional decrease in profit.

The total comprehensive income attributable to the shareholders reached BD 2.177 million compared to BD 0.856 million for the quarter Q3-2023, registering an increase of 154%. The increase was mainly due

to increased fair value gains recorded in the 3rd quarter 2024 compared to the same period in 2023.

The Company achieved 3.5% growth in Insurance revenue, from BD 28.267 million in the 3rd quarter of last year to BD 29.249 million in the 3rd quarter of the current year. The Insurance service results decreased by 61%, from BD 1.032 million in the 3rd quarter of last year to BD 0.404 million in the 3rd quarter of the current year. The Total investment income increased by 3.3%, from BD 0.891 million in the 3rd quarter of last year to BD 0.920 million in the 3rd quarter of the current year.

Nine months results

The consolidated financial results for the nine-month period ended 30th September 2024 presented a net profit attributable to the shareholders of BD 4.002 million, compared to BD 3.962 million of the same period last year, representing an increase of 1%. Earnings per share were 27 fils during the current period which remained unchanged for the same period last year. The total comprehensive income attributable to the shareholders was BD 4.420 million compared to BD 3.387 million for the same period last year, registering an increase of 30.5%.

The company achieved 7% growth in Insurance revenue of BD 85.907 million during the nine months of this year, com-

pared to BD 80.222 million in the first nine months of last year.

The Insurance service result decreased by 13.5%, to BD 2.608 million in the nine months of this year compared to BD 3.016 million in the same period last year. The net investment income decreased by 1%, from BD 3.450 million in the nine months of last year to BD 3.415 million in the same period of this year.

BKIC's CEO Dr. Abdulla Sultan commented that the company's consolidated results in the first nine months of 2024 are satisfying. He commented that in spite of the adverse effects of change in actuarial assumptions the company recorded marginally increased net profit attributable to shareholders.

As part of Bahrain Bourse's continuous efforts to develop the Capital Market in the Kingdom of Bahrain, Bahrain Bourse has launched the 'Trading Incentives Scheme', to enable market participants, including market makers, liquidity providers, and other brokers, to obtain rebates for market makers and liquidity providers. The 'Trading Incentives Scheme',

which is expected to be effective starting 1st January 2025, while the details pertaining to the

Trading Incentives Scheme implementation will be announced one month prior to commencement. The Scheme is a key objective of Financial Services Sector Development Strategy (2022-2026), and is aligned with the Listing Incentives Program recently launched by Bahrain Bourse.

The objective of the Trading Incentives Scheme is to incentivize market makers, liquidity providers, and other brokers to

increase their volume of trades executed pursuant to the business rules of Bahrain Bourse and cleared by Bahrain Clear, which will stimulate further liquidity in the market. The Trading Incentives Scheme will allow market makers up to 60% rebate on trading commissions for listed securities in which they act as market makers.

The scheme aims to further complement the Listing Incentive Programme which was

recently launched by Bahrain Bourse to encourage listing of privately held companies on both Mainboard and Bahrain Investment Market and aims to be aligned with the key objective of Financial Services Sector Development Strategy (2022-2026). The scheme will also support the recently launched Market Making Guidelines and Liquidity Provision Guidelines, as it will attract new market participants to the market.

On this occasion, Sh. 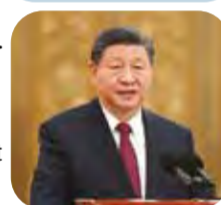
Burkina Faso's foreign minister praised cooperation with Russia on Saturday as "suing" his country better than its historic ties with France.

Afghan women not barred from speaking to each other: morality ministry

Women in Afghanistan are not forbidden from speaking to each other, the Taliban government's morality ministry told AFP on Saturday, denying recent media reports of a ban.

Afghan media based outside the country and international outlets have in recent weeks reported a ban on women hearing other women's voices, based on an audio recording of the head of the Ministry for the Propagation of Virtue and the Prevention of Vice (PVPV).

Women's voices have also been banned from television and radio broadcasts in some provinces.

The law codified many rules the Taliban government has imposed based on their strict interpretation of Islamic law since they came to power in 2021, with women bearing the brunt of restrictions the United Nations has called "gender apartheid".

The Taliban authorities have banned education after secondary school for girls and women, also barring them from various jobs as well as parks and other public places.

Women in Afghanistan are barred from singing or reciting poetry aloud in public, according to a recent "vice and

virtue" law detailing sweeping codes of behaviour, including that women's voices should be "concealed" along with their bodies when outside their homes.

The alert from the Famine Review Committee warned of "an imminent and substantial likelihood of famine occurring, due to the rapidly deteriorating situation in the Gaza Strip."

"Famine thresholds may have already been crossed or else will be in the near future," said the alert.

On October 17, the body projected that the number of people in Gaza facing "catastrophic" food insecurity between November and April 2025 would reach 345,000, or 16 percent of the population.

The Integrated Food Security Phase Classification (IPC) report classified that as IPC Phase 5 -- a situation when "starvation, death, destitution and extremely critical acute malnutrition levels are evident."

Qatar out of Gaza talks

Warns Hamas over Doha office: diplomatic source

AFP | Dubai, United Arab Emirates

Qatar has withdrawn as a key mediator for a Gaza ceasefire and hostage deal and warned Hamas that its Doha office "no longer serves its purpose", a diplomatic source told AFP yesterday.

"The Qataris informed both the Israelis and Hamas that as long as there is a refusal to negotiate a deal in good faith, they cannot continue to mediate," the source said on condition of anonymity.

Qatar, with the United States and Egypt, has been engaged in months of fruitless negotiations for a truce with hostage and prisoner releases.

The informed source said Qatar had already "notified both sides, Israel and Hamas as well as the US administration" of its decision.

"The Qataris conveyed to the US administration that they would be ready to re-engage in mediation when both sides... demonstrate a sincere willingness to return to the negotiating table", the source added.

Lebanon says 2 children among 7 dead in Israeli strikes on Tyre

Lebanon's health ministry said

yesterday seven people including two children were killed in Israeli strikes on the southern city of Tyre a day earlier, with rescuers still searching for missing people

under the rubble. "Israeli enemy strikes on the city of Tyre killed seven people including two girls, and injured 46 others," the ministry said, adding

that body parts had been found and will be "identified with DNA testing". It added that rubble was being cleared following the strikes as

part of ongoing efforts to locate missing persons. The ministry had on Friday reported a toll of three killed and 30 injured in the strikes.

Iran urges Trump to change 'maximum pressure' policy

Iran signalled an openness towards Donald Trump Saturday, calling on the president-elect to adopt new policies towards it after Washington accused Tehran of involvement in a plot to kill him.

Vice President for Strategic Affairs Mohammad Javad Zarif urged Trump to reassess the policy of "maximum pressure" he employed against the Islamic republic during his first term.

"Trump must show that he is not following the wrong policies of the past," Zarif told reporters.

His remarks came after the United States accused Iran of conspiring to assassinate Trump. Zarif on Saturday that it was Trump's political approach towards Iran that led to the surge in enrichment levels.

"He must have realised that the maximum pressure policy that he initiated caused Iran's enrichment to reach 60 percent from 3.5 percent, and increased its centrifuges," he said.

"As a man of calculation, he should do the math and see what the advantages and disadvantages of this policy have been and

whether he wants to continue or change this harmful policy," Zarif added.

On Tuesday, election day in the United States, Trump told reporters he was "not looking to do damage to Iran". "My terms are very easy. They can't have a nuclear weapon. I'd like them to be a very successful country," he said after casting his ballot.

Trump's election victory came after Iran and Israel attacked each other directly, raising fears of a further regional spillover of the conflicts in Gaza and Lebanon.

Germany marks 1989 Berlin Wall fall with 'Preserve Freedom' party

Germany marked 35 years since the Berlin Wall fell with festivities on Saturday under the theme "Preserve Freedom!", against the somber backdrop of war in Gaza and Ukraine, and fears that democracy is under attack around the world.

The liberal ideals of 1989 "are not something we can take for granted", Chancellor Olaf Scholz said on Friday, just days after the his governing coalition collapsed.

"A look at our history and at the world around us shows this," added Scholz, whose three-party alliance imploded the day Donald Trump was re-elected US president, plunging Germany into political turmoil and towards new elections.

November 9, 1989, is celebrated as the day East Germany opened the

borders to the West after months of peaceful mass protests, paving the way for German reunification and the collapse of Soviet Communism. That "joyful day" underlines the sombre fact "that freedom and de-

mocracy have never been a given", Berlin mayor Kai Wegner told a commemorative service at the Berlin Wall Memorial on Saturday.

One Berliner who remembers the momentous events, retiree Jutta Krueger, 75, said it was "a shame" Germany's political crisis had erupted just before the anniversary weekend.

"But we should still really celebrate the fall of the Wall," she said, hailing it as the moment East Germans could travel and "freedom had arrived throughout Germany".

Saturday's event at the Berlin Wall Memorial, which was attended by President Frank-Walter Steinmeier, honoured the at least 140 people killed trying to flee the Russian-backed German Democratic Republic (GDR) during the Cold War.



Despite strict security, more than 5,000 people managed to escape over, under, or through the Wall, though many lost their lives in the process. It's estimated that between 136 and 200 people died attempting to cross.

The fall of the Berlin Wall -- symbol of the Cold War and the division between an Eastern and a Western Bloc -- contributed to the collapse of Communism in eastern Europe and the reunification of Germany a year later.

The 155-kilometre "wall of shame" was erected around West Berlin in 1961 to end an exodus of citizens from the Western Bloc enclave in Communist East Germany.

Heat, air pollution, disease

How climate change affects health

AFP | Paris, France

Record-breaking heat, extreme weather events, air pollution and the spread of infectious disease: climate change poses an already vast yet rising threat to the health of humans around the world, experts warn.

The latest round of UN climate talks begin next week during what is expected to be the hottest year in recorded history -- and in the shadow of climate sceptic Donald Trump's re-election as US president.

The COP29 negotiations will be held in Azerbaijan as the world continues to emit increasing levels of planet-heating fossil fuels, even as many nations have been lashed by devastating floods, droughts, heatwaves and

storms.

"Climate change is making us sick, and urgent action is a matter of life and death," the World Health Organization warned this week.

Here are some of the ways that global warming affects health.

Extreme heat

The EU's climate monitor said this week that 2024 is "virtually certain" to surpass last year to become the hottest year in recorded history. It is also expected to be the first year that is more than 1.5 degrees Celsius warmer than the 1850-1900 pre-industrial average.

Out of 15 ways that climate change impacts health being tracked by experts as part of The Lancet Countdown, 10 have now "reached concerning new re-

ords", according to the group's latest report.

The number of over-65s who died from heat has risen by 167 percent since the 1990s, just one of the recent all-time highs, the report said.

Extreme heat leads to numerous health risks such as kidney disorders, strokes, adverse pregnancy outcomes, cardiovascular and respiratory diseases, organ failure and ultimately death.

Jeni Miller, executive director of the Global Climate and Health Alliance, said "this year has underlined the growing impacts of a warming climate on people's health and wellbeing".

She pointed to extreme heat leading to 700 deaths and more than 40,000 cases of heat stroke in India, "climate-exacerbated" rains causing a dam to collapse

in Nigeria killing 320, and 48 out of 50 US states "experiencing moderate or worse drought".

Spain is meanwhile still recovering from its deadliest floods in a generation, while parts of the United States and Cuba are picking up the pieces after recent hurricanes.

Droughts, floods and other extreme weather events are also expected to hit global crops, leading to rising hunger in many regions.

Air pollution

Almost all -- 99 percent -- of the world's population breathes air that exceeds the World Health Organization's guidelines for air pollution.

This pollution has been found to increase the risk of respiratory diseases, strokes, heart dis-

ease, lung cancer, diabetes and other health problems, posing a threat that has been compared to tobacco.

Almost seven million premature deaths a year are linked to air pollution, according to the WHO.

Just last week, Pakistan's second-biggest city Lahore recorded air pollution at 40 times the level deemed acceptable by the WHO.

In better news, the Lancet Countdown report found that deaths from fossil fuel-related air pollution fell by nearly seven percent from 2016 to 2021, mainly due to efforts to reduce pollution from burning coal.

Infectious diseases

The changing climate means that mosquitoes, birds and mam-

mals will roam beyond their previous habitats, raising the threat that they could spread infectious diseases with them.

Dengue, chikungunya, Zika, West Nile virus and malaria are all mosquito-borne diseases that could spread wider in a warming world.

The transmission risk of one dengue-spreading mosquito has risen by 43 percent over the last 60 years, according to the Lancet Countdown. A new global record of over five million dengue cases was recorded last year.

Storms and floods create stagnant water that are breeding grounds for mosquitoes, and also increase the risk of water-borne diseases such as cholera, typhoid and diarrhoea.

Top art collector displays rare treasures in Madrid

After visiting Europe 60 years ago as a penniless art aficionado, Juan Antonio Perez Simon overcame hardship to amass a remarkable collection, which is

on display for the first time in Madrid.

"I have always wanted to share my works with the public," the Spanish-born millionaire businessman, 83, told AFP in a written exchange. "It makes me profoundly happy."

Perez Simon's lifelong passion for art has led to a collection boasting 4,000 paintings, drawings, sculptures and decorative objects. The new exhibition at Madrid's grandiose Cibeles Palace -- "70 great masters of the Perez Simon collection" -- runs



A painting by Lawrence Alma Tadema to mid-January and is crammed with art treasures, ranging from the 16th century to today.

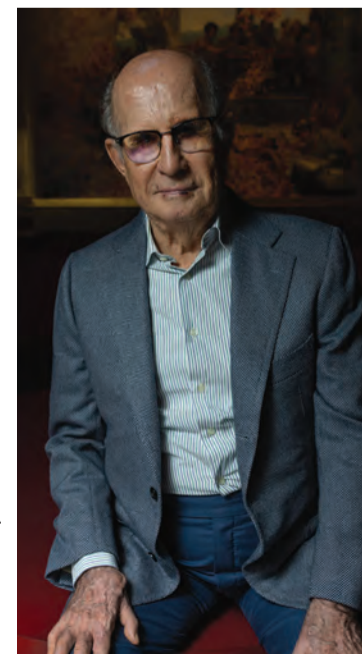
They include works by masters like Van Gogh, Sisley, Picasso, Rubens, Goya, Monet, Renoir, Magritte and Rothko.

Perez Simon, who has spent most of his life in Mexico where

he now lives, has never previously lent his collection to a museum in this way, even if some items have been loaned around the world.

After this show, a new site dedicated to 200 pieces of his collection is due to open in Madrid. It will be an addition to the Spanish capital's established art institutions -- the Prado, Reina Sofia and Thyssen museums -- to which millions of visitors flock every year. Perez Simon said the loan would be long-term, although details are still being finalised.

Madrid city hall has said he has already agreed to take care of securing, storing and transporting the works. Born in a rural family in Spain's northwestern Asturias region, Perez Simon moved to Mexico at the age of five before making a fortune in telecommunications.

In the Bahraini jersey category for Tour Champions, the yellow jersey for best time was awarded to Mohammed Issa Al Ghaidh of the Victorious team, making him the Tour champion by time. The 21-year-old now has scored five in his past four games since returning from a hip injury.

Bayern are now six clear atop the table on 26 points, but RB Leipzig can cut the gap to three with a win in their home match against Borussia Moenchengladbach later on Saturday.

Injury-hit Dortmund suffered yet another setback, losing 3-1 at Mainz after Emre Can was sent off in the 27th minute for a studs-up tackle on Lee Jae-sung.

Bayer Leverkusen's title defence continued to stutter with a 1-1 draw at last-placed Bochum, who equalised in the final minute.

Leverkusen were ahead from the 18th minute onwards after Florian Wirtz slid a ball across the turf and into the path of Patrik Schick, who blasted home.

Leverkusen are now nine points behind Bayern and have dropped 13 points this campaign, more than they did across all 34 games last season.

The draw was just Bochum's second point this season after 10 games in their first match under veteran coach Dieter Hecking.

Elsewhere, Werder Bremen won 2-1 at home against Holstein Kiel thanks to an 89th-minute goal from Oliver Burke after Phil Harres' second-half strike cancelled out Jens Stage's opener for the hosts just after the half-hour.
