To approve the amendment and restatement to the Company's Memorandum and Articles of Association to comply with the law amendments of the Bahrain Commercial Companies Law No. (21) for the year 2001 and its amendments ("**BCCL**"), in addition to any other amendment, subject to the approval of the CBB and the Ministry of Industry and Commerce ("**MoIC**").
- 4. To authorize Mr. Abdulla Abdulaziz Taleb, Chief Executive Officer, or any other person whom he duly authorizes, to represent the Company before the MoIC, the Notary Public, Private Notary and/or any other governmental or non-governmental authority as may be necessary or required to carry out and complete the procedures required, including but not limited to, amending, restating and notarizing the Memorandum and Articles of Association to reflect the matters under Agenda Items 2 and 3.

NOTES:

- (a) Each Shareholder, regardless of the number of the shares he or she owns, shall have the right to attend the Meeting, and shall have a number of votes equal to the number of shares he or she owns in the Company. Any provision or decision to the contrary shall be null and void (Article 203 of the BCCL).
- (b) Any Shareholder may appoint a proxy to attend the Meeting on their behalf, provided that the proxy holder shall not be the Chairman of the Board of Directors, a Director serving on the Board of Directors or an employee of the Company. However, this shall not prejudice the right to delegate a first-degree relative. This shall be by virtue of a special proxy evidenced in writing designated for this purpose by the Company. Legal representatives of the members lacking capacity or under legal incapacity shall represent them in the Meeting (Article 203 of the BCCL).
- (c) Shareholders intending to appoint a proxy to represent them at the Meeting are requested to present the proxy form to KFin Technologies (Bahrain) W.L.L. ("**KFin Technologies**") (on bahrain.helpdesk@kfintech.com) no later than 24 hours prior to the time of the Meeting (Article 203 of the BCCL). Proxy forms may be obtained electronically from the Company's website www.ithmaarholding.com, Bahrain Bourse website or Dubai Financial Market website.

n EU court yesterday overturned the European Commission's decision to approve massive government bailouts for German airline Lufthansa and Scandinavia's SAS during the coronavirus pandemic, after a legal challenge by rival airlines.

Lufthansa, one of Europe's biggest airline groups, received a multi-billion-euro cash injeclapse as the pandemic brought Sweden and Denmark. air travel to a halt.

The ruling was made in response to a complaint lodged by Irish airline Ryanair, which has long railed against what it sees as unfair aid paid out to rivals, as well as German charter airline Condor.

The court said mistakes included considering Lufthansa could not obtain financing on the markets, failing to require a mechanism incentivising Lufthansa to buy back Germany's shareholding, and potential impacts on market competitiveness.

The commission said in a statement it would study the judgement and "reflect on possible next steps".

Given Lufthansa paid back the bailout cash in 2021, it is not clear if the ruling will have any impact.



The number of wildfires that forced 30,000 people to flee in the past four days has fallen from a peak of 110 to 81, with 24 still listed as out of control. ustralia's kangaroos could die in "catastrophic" numbers if a population boom is left unchecked, ecologists have warned, while backing the industrial-scale culling of the marsupials.

To outsiders, the kangaroo is an instantly-recognisable symbol of the Australian wilderness, but within the country the native animal poses a major environmental headache.

Kangaroos have a "boom and bust" population cycle -when fodder is plentiful on the back of a good wet season their numbers can balloon by tens of millions.

Hopping mobs of kangaroos can rapidly strip paddocks bare, but ecologist Katherine Moseby warned they would starve to death in droves when food ran out.

"The last drought we estiof the kangaroos in some areas died," she told AFP.

"They are starving to death

Moseby said the kindest way to save kangaroos from this fate was to shoot them, and harvest the meat, as a way of keeping numbers in check.

15 children drown, 25 missing in Nigeria boat accident

Fifteen children drowned and 25 others were missing when their overloaded boat capsized in a river in northwest Nigeria, a local official said yesterday.

The children were on their way from Dundeji village in Sokoto State to collect firewood in the bush on Tuesday on the other side of Shagari river when local administrator of Shagari district, said.




