Western powers sanction Iran over missiles to Russia

Western powers yesterday announced fresh sanctions on Iran for supplying Russia with short-range missiles for imminent use against Ukraine, calling it a dangerous escalation of the conflict that threatened European security.

Britain, France and Germany said they would cut aviation agreements with the Islamic republic and sanction its national carrier Iran Air, claiming Tehran had repeatedly defied warnings about the weapons transfers.

"This act is an escalation by both Iran and Russia, and is a direct threat to European security," the so-called E3 powers said in a joint statement.

Four climbers found dead on Mont Blanc

Four climbers from Italy and South Korea were found dead on the Alps' highest peak of Mont Blanc yesterday after they had been missing for three days in bad weather, the local French prefecture said.

The mountaineers had "died of exhaustion", the Haute-Savoie prefecture told AFP, adding that rescuers who finally reached the site found the two Koreans first, close by the two Italians.

A helicopter from the PGHM mountain police based in Annecy was able to land at around 1:30 pm (1130 GMT) and found the bodies between 100 and 200 metres (330-660 feet) from the summit.

Russia planes roar over North Korea

Bahrain's FDI surge generates \$439m and 2,091 new jobs

Kingdom continues to attract significant foreign investment

Bahrain's economy continues to attract significant foreign investment, with the Arab Investment and Export Credit Guarantee Corporation (Dhahran) reporting a strong performance in the first half of 2024. The Kingdom secured nine foreign direct investment (FDI) projects, totaling \$439 million and generating 2,091 new jobs. This positive trend reflects Bahrain's commitment to fostering a business-friendly environment and attracting diverse

investments.

The Kingdom's strategic location, robust infrastructure, and commitment to economic diversification have made it an attractive destination for international investors.

High-value investments

While the UAE led the region with 607 FDI projects and Egypt topped the list in terms of investment value at \$20.5 billion, Bahrain's success highlights its ability to attract high-value investments.

The UK emerged as the largest investor in the region with 128 projects, while the US ranked first in terms of investment cost with over \$6.8 billion for the same period, the report highlighted.

Globally, FDI in the first half of 2024 focused heavily on digi-



talisation and renewable energy, reaching a combined value of \$138 billion.

Oil and gas sector

The report also highlighted

the significant role of the oil and gas sector in the Arab region, with Arab countries recording around \$406 billion in foreign investments over the past 22 years.

This sector attracted 610 projects, implemented by 356 foreign and Arab companies.

The report further identified the UAE, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Bahrain, Iraq, Egypt, Kuwait, Oman, Algeria, Mauritania, Libya, Tunisia, Sudan, and Yemen as the best Arab countries in terms of lower risks and higher incentives for investment in the oil and gas sector.

This assessment was based on Fitch's 2024 analysis, considering key indicators such as country and industry risks and incentives in the exploration, production, and refining stages.

iGA highlights Bahrain's AI initiatives at global summit

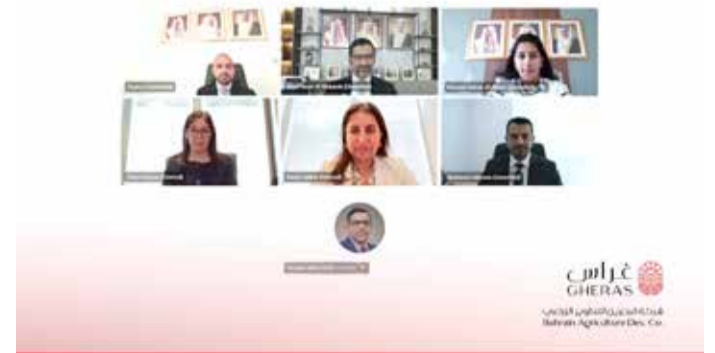
Agricultural sector thriving

Court summons father in arson and defamation case

The High Appeals Court has ordered the father of a business manager to appear in court, following the conviction of the son for arson and defamation.

The son, aged 36, was initially sentenced to three years in prison and fined BD50 by the High Criminal Court for setting fire to his father's residence and verbally abusing his sister.

The Public Prosecution accused the man of setting fire to property belonging to his father on July 15, 2023, in a building that was occupied, putting people and their property at risk.

He was also accused of using defamatory language against his sister, without provocation, in her presence.

The sister, aged 45, testified that she was in the living room with their father when she heard sounds of breaking and shouting coming from the defendant's room.



The son was also accused of using defamatory language against his sister, without provocation, in her presence.

The defendant entered the room, claiming that his father and sister had cast a spell on him.

The father dismissed this as hallucinations due to drug use, which angered the defendant further. He hurled insults at his parents and threatened to burn them and the house down before returning to his room.

The sister stated that approximately half an hour later, she smelled smoke and saw thick smoke coming from under the defendant's door.

Dentist fined BD1,200 for nerve-damaging crown

A dentist has been ordered by court to pay BD1,200 in damages following a flawed crown fitting that caused ongoing pain, additional tooth decay, and nerve damage.

The patient, still in discomfort after the procedure, sought a second opinion. Subsequent consultations revealed that a necessary root canal had been omitted before fitting the crown, worsening the decay and impacting the nerves.

Lawyer Zainab Madan, representing the patient, explained that despite the crown being placed, the patient's condition deteriorated.

Subsequent dental evaluations showed that the decay had not been fully addressed and that a root canal should have been performed prior to the crown fitting.

The patient's complaint to the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) led to an investigation that found the dentist had failed to meet professional standards.

The NHRA's report revealed that the dentist's omission of necessary X-rays resulted in a flawed diagnosis and inadequate treatment, breaching Bahrain's medical regulations as outlined in Decree-Law No. 7 of 1989 and Law No. 38 of 2009.

The court concluded that the dentist's actions amounted to malpractice and ruled that both the dentist and the clinic were liable to pay compensation for the physical and emotional harm caused.

Although the dentist appealed, the Civil Court of Appeal upheld the original ruling, maintaining the joint responsibility for the BD1,200 payment.

Renowned lawyer acquitted of defamation charges

The Court of Cassation has upheld the acquittal of a prominent lawyer on charges of defamation.

The lawyer was initially charged by the Public Prosecution in November 2023 with defaming the complainant.

The prosecution alleged that the lawyer had made defamatory remarks against the complainant without providing specific details.

The Public Prosecution issued a criminal order fining the lawyer BD100.

However, the lawyer appealed the decision, and the Lower Criminal Court acquitted her.

The Public Prosecution subsequently appealed the acquittal, leading to the Court of Appeal overturning the acquittal and imposing a fine of BD50. The lawyer then appealed to the Court of Cassation.

Wake-up call for financial security

Life insurance in Bahrain faces declining demand despite growing sector

A recent decline in life insurance policy purchases in Bahrain has raised concerns among industry experts.

According to a report by the Central Bank of Bahrain, life insurance premiums dropped by 31.82% in the first six months of 2023 compared to the same period in 2022.

This contrasts with a rise in premiums for other insurance types, such as health insurance (12%) and car insurance (8%).

Insurance expert Fathallah Ibrahim attributes the decline to a lack of awareness among consumers regarding the benefits of life insurance as a safety net for themselves and their families.

He emphasises that life insurance provides financial security and stability for policyholders and their families, particularly in the event of unforeseen circumstances.

"Life insurance not only benefits families directly, but also has a positive impact on government spending and social welfare. Families with life in-

urance policies have a continuous source of income to cover healthcare, education, and other essential needs, reducing the burden on public resources," Ibrahim said.

Financial goals

He added: "Life insurance is more than just a safety net; it's a versatile tool for achieving financial goals. From education planning and retirement planning to investment, wealth creation, and even financial planning for SMEs and family businesses, life insurance can

play a crucial role."

Despite the challenges faced by life insurance, the overall insurance sector in Bahrain has witnessed significant growth, both in terms of quantity and quality.

The introduction of new insurance products, including those with a social impact, such as health insurance, has contributed to the sector's expansion.

Market

Health insurance, in particular, continues to dominate the market, accounting for ap-

proximately 35% of total insurance premiums in the first six months of 2023.

Ibrahim believes that insurance companies should focus on developing and launching value-added insurance products that cater to the needs of citizens and address emerging risks.

He stressed the importance of collaboration between insurance companies, insurance regulators, banks, healthcare providers, and civil society organizations to maximize the benefits of these services and products.

Payback time

Approximately 30 Bahraini citizens have filed a collective complaint with the General Directorate of Anti-corruption and Economic and Electronic Security of the Ministry of Interior against the owner of an unlicensed travel agency, alleging financial losses due to the agency's failure to fulfill its contractual obligations.

The Bahrain Tourism and Exhibition Authority (BTEA) shut down the agency and referred it to the Public Prosecution after raiding its premises.

The raid followed the release of the story about the Bahraini tourists who were visiting Iraq to observe the Arbaeen occasion.

Part of a group of 140, the tourists were stranded when the unlicensed travel agency owner fled after failing to pay hotel bills amounting to BD15,000.

Intervention

The agency's failure to pay for the accommodation led to the hotel holding the travelers' passports. The Bahraini embassy in Iraq intervened to secure the release of the passports.

Hassan Al Hilli, one of the affected travelers, confirmed the submission of the complaint, praising the cooperation of the security personnel and officials at the Directorate of Anti-corruption and Eco-

omic and Electronic Security.

He stated that the investigation is ongoing and that the complainants are seeking compensation for all financial losses incurred during the trip due to the agency's breach of contract.

Legal actions

Al Hilli also mentioned that there are other affected individuals from Saudi Arabia who will be filing separate legal actions in the coming days.

The problems did not end with the return of the passports, as some travelers discovered that the agency had not booked sufficient visas for their return flight.

The Bahraini Consulate in Iraq, in collaboration with the Gulf Air booking office in Iraq, intervened to ensure the travelers were not penalised and allowed to board their flights.

Public cleanliness at your fingertips

20 vending machines for waste bags installed across Bahrain

Twenty vending machines for waste bags have been set up across Bahrain, according to Fadhel Al Oud, Chairman of the Technical Committee at the Muharraq Municipal Council.

The Ministry of Municipalities and Agriculture has installed these machines to distribute household waste bags automatically, eliminating the need for residents to visit service centres in the capital or municipalities.

These machines dispense garbage bags without the need for appointments or waiting, and are strategically located in commercial centres throughout all governorates.

Shopping

This setup enables residents to use the service while shopping.

"Residents can use the vending machines, located across the kingdom, by presenting a smart card and entering their electricity account number," Al Oud explained

BACA approves restoration of historic Muharraq building

The Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities (BACA) has given the go-ahead for the restoration of a historic building in Muharraq.

This decision allows for internal modifications to suit the owner's requirements while

strengthening the structure's core components, without altering its external façade.

The move comes after the Muharraq Municipal Council inquired about the restoration of derelict heritage-listed properties.

They had previously voiced concerns over building number

668, located in Block 206.

Historical importance

The authority acknowledges the building's considerable historical importance, though it has deteriorated over the years, with parts of it succumbing to collapse.

A report dated 14 August 2019

stressed the need to preserve the structure and safeguard its architectural features due to its historical significance.

Dalal Al Muqahwi, a member of the Muharraq Municipal Council from the second constituency, has voiced discontent over the authority's request for the council to finance the res-

toration.

Obligation

She argued that it is the authority's obligation to fund either the repair or demolition of these heritage properties.

Al Muqahwi pointed out the building's severely degraded state and reiterated past calls

for its cleaning and restoration, as well as similar requests for other properties in the second constituency.

The Muharraq Municipal Council remains firm in its stance, insisting that BACA should cover the full expenses for the restoration and cleaning of these rundown buildings.

Public safety a priority

New taskforce to tackle growing problem of abandoned houses in Hamad Town

A taskforce has been set up to tackle the growing problem of abandoned buildings in Hamad Town, following a meeting at the Northern Governorate Municipal Council.

Officials from several departments gathered yesterday to consider the issue.

The session, convened by council member Abdulla Al Qubaisi, discussed the threat these neglected homes pose to the area.

problematic properties to the Ministry of Housing.

The Ministry of Housing, for its part, finds itself tied up in red tape.

The problem, as it stands, is that many of the derelict buildings in Hamad Town are privately owned.

Although the Ministry reviews housing projects annually and steps in when absolutely necessary, its hands are tied when it comes to private properties. If a building is deemed dangerous, the case is referred to the courts, which then assess whether legal action is required.

Security concerns

Captain Salem Murad, from the Northern Governorate Police Directorate, explained how the police are dealing with security concerns related to these buildings.

Working closely with the municipal council and other authorities, the police have identified unsafe properties and, when necessary, overseen their demolition.

They've also worked with property owners to secure these buildings and prevent criminal activity.

Challenges

Though each department faces its own set of challenges, the meeting resulted in the creation of this taskforce, which will coordinate efforts moving forward.

Led by the Northern Governorate Municipal Council, the taskforce will inspect and follow up on abandoned properties, working in tandem with the EWA, the Ministry of Housing, and the police.

The goal is to find long-term solutions to the issue and bring safety and peace back to the residents of the Northern Governorate.

drug abuse,” Al Qubaisi told The Daily Tribune.

Dr Sayyed Shbbar Al Wadai, who will oversee the taskforce, outlined the gravity of the situation.

“Properties left in disrepair not only pose safety risks but also facilitate illegal activities, diminishing the quality of life for local residents,” Al Wadai said.

His concern reflected the broader frustration of the local population, who have long been at the mercy of authorities dragging their feet.

Debate

Engineer Reda Jassim, from the Electricity and Water Authority (EWA), lent his voice to the debate, pointing out that the EWA had already begun addressing the issue in prac-

tical terms. Steps include cutting off power from abandoned buildings and conducting safety checks.

“Our annual maintenance programme is in place to identify and rectify such issues before they turn into something far worse,” Jassim said.

Dr Hussain Al Jamari, a legal advisor to the Northern Municipality, highlighted the limitations faced by the council when it comes to enforcement.

“The council can only intervene when buildings are an immediate danger or at risk of collapse,” he said, advocating for changes to Article 18 of the Buildings Regulation Act.

Authority

Ministry rejects Muharraq market one-year fee exemption request

The Ministry of Municipalities has dismissed a proposal from Muharraq Municipal Council Chairman Abdulaziz Alnaar seeking a one-year waiver of municipal fees for shops in the Muharraq market, pending redevelopment.

The ministry's stance rests on the argument that the fees in question cannot be exempted

under existing legislation.

Shaikh Mohammed bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, Undersecretary for Municipal Affairs, addressed this during the opening session of the new convening period.

He clarified that any waiver of municipal fees is governed by Article 67 of the Executive Regulations of the Municipalities Law, as set out by Decree-Law No. 35 of 2001 and reinforced by

Decision No. 160 of 2002.

This law outlines the specific criteria for exemptions, which the current request did not meet.

Alnaar, who put forward the proposal, argued that the market's ongoing closures were adversely impacting traders and thus sought a temporary suspension of fees. He referred to Article 45, which allows for partial or total exemptions.

UAE-backed group sells Spectator magazine after UK block

London, United Kingdom

British right-wing magazine The Spectator announced yesterday its sale to a hedge fund manager after the UK government objected to the acquisition of its parent company by a US-UAE joint venture.

The US-Emirati consortium, RedBird IMI, last year struck a £1.2-billion (\$1.6-billion) deal to buy Telegraph Media Group, owner of the 196-year-old weekly publication and the Telegraph newspapers.

However, the UK's previous Conservative government ordered the venture to conduct a swift resale of TMG amid the potential impact on freedom of speech given Abu Dhabi's press censorship record.

The Spectator, a right-wing publication once edited by former prime minister Boris Johnson, said that it had been bought by hedge fund manager Paul Marshall for £100 million.

The Telegraph newspapers -- British right-wing broadsheets -- are still looking for a new buyer.

Redbird IMI is majority-owned by Sheikh Mansour bin Zayed Al Nahyan, vice president of the United Arab Emirates and owner of Manchester City Football Club. The US partner is investment firm RedBird Capital. Founded in 1828, The Spectator is one of the oldest magazines in the world still in print.

BMW recalls 1.5 mn cars over bad brake, cuts outlook

Frankfurt, Germany

BMW said yesterday it was recalling about 1.5 million vehicles due to problems with their brakes and cut its outlook for the year, sending the German luxury carmaker's shares tumbling.

The development will hit revenues in the second half of the year, said the group, which also includes the Rolls-Royce and Mini brands.

The financial impact in the three months to the end of



September will be in the "high three-digit million" euro range, it said.

The braking system behind the problems was supplied by Continental. The German auto supplier said the affected component would be replaced if problems were detected.

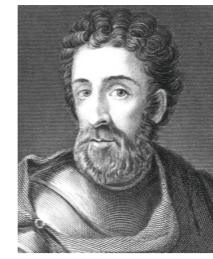

the "braking performance is not compromised and brakes can always be applied".

As well as the impact of the recall, BMW said "the ongoing muted demand in China is affecting sales volumes. Despite stimulus measures from the government, consumer sentiment remains weak".

New iPhone built for AI starts at US\$799

The newly released Apple iPhone 16 with generative artificial intelligence is the first designed from the ground up for Apple Intelligence and its breakthrough capabilities, said Apple chief executive Tim Cook at an event at the iPhone-maker's Silicon Valley headquarters.

He said "Apple Intelligence" is a new suite of software features for all devices that was announced in June at the company's annual developers conference, where it also announced a partnership with ChatGPT-maker OpenAI.

The features will be available as a software download on the iPhone 16 and other premium models next month, but only as a test and in English. Other languages would follow down the road.

In the short-term, the new powers would include AI-infused image editing, translation, and small, creative touches in messaging, but not more ambitious breakthroughs promised by other AI players, such as OpenAI or Google.

Launched more than 12 years ago, Siri has come to be seen as a dated feature, overtaken by a new generation of assistants such as GPT-4o, OpenAI's latest offering.

New iPhone 16 models start at \$799 and will be available starting September 20, according to Apple.

The company also announced new models of Apple Watch and AirPods at the event, highlighting coming health benefits like hearing protection and detecting sleep apnea.

Apple shares appeared un-

moved by the iPhone event.

'More personal'

With \$39 billion in sales last quarter, the iPhone counts for roughly 60 percent of Apple's revenue, and remains the main entryway to the company's services, such as the App Store or Apple TV, which are becoming a growing part of its business.

Apple is only just coming out of a long sales slump as users increasingly stick with older models longer.

Apple's announcement closely follows Google, which last month unveiled AI-infused Pixel 9 smartphones, its challenge to the iPhone.

Pixels account for a tiny sliver of the global smartphone market dominated by Samsung and Apple, but Google argued its new line is a chance to answer what -- after all the hype -- AI can actually do for customers.

Samsung has also showcased AI across a range of its consumer electronic products as it looks to extend its leadership in global smartphone sales.

"On certain things, Apple is behind (on AI features)," Creative Strategies analyst Carolina Milanesi told AFP.

"But from a usability perspective, Apple's tools are more personal and integrated into the device. That is where the difference is and that takes longer (to design)," she added.

Huawei unveils triple-folding phone with hefty price tag

Chinese tech giant Huawei on Tuesday unveiled the world's first triple-folding phone at more than three times the price of the newest iPhone, hours after its US competitor lifted the curtain on its own new handset built for AI.

The Mate XT was officially launched in a keynote presentation by Huawei executive Richard Yu at the firm's headquarters in the southern city of Shenzhen. Originally designed as a premium phone for a niche audience, more than three million people registered interest in buying the Mate XT ahead of its launch.

The gadget officially goes on sale on September 20,

with prices beginning at an eye-watering \$2,800 -- over three times more than the new iPhone 16.

Advertised in a sleek red and gold design, the phone can transform into a 10.2 inch (26 centimetre) tablet and weighs 298 grams (10.5 ounces).

"This is the world's first triple-folding phone," Yu said at the keynote.

"We have put in a huge amount of effort into solving the problems regarding mass production and product reliability," he added.

Its release comes a day after Apple announced its iPhone 16, built for generative artificial intelligence as it seeks to boost sales and keep up in the technology race.

Sony to release PlayStation 5 Pro on November 7

Sony said yesterday it would launch an upgraded version of its flagship games console with better graphics and AI capabilities on November 7, calling it PlayStation 5 Pro.

The Japanese firm's gaming division has endured tough times this year, with PlayStation 5 missing its sales targets and PlayStation announcing 900 job cuts in February.

The gaming industry is struggling with a wider downturn as the investment that poured into the sector during Covid has largely dried up.

In a short video announcement, PlayStation's lead architect Mark Cerny showed off the capabilities of the new console, which will retail for \$700 and 800 euros, roughly 250 euros more than the current PlayStation 5.

He trumpeted hardware improvements that allowed games to run much faster, with better rendering of light and an AI system that provided sharper images.

"Simply put it's the most powerful console we've ever built and a worthy edition to the PS5 family," he said.

Analyst Daniel Ahmad of Niko Partners pointed out that Sony had already tried to boost sales of its previous console by releasing a pro version in 2016.

But the PlayStation 4 Pro had limited impact, Ahmad wrote on X, because it was "a premium product tailored for a niche audience".

"What will really drive PS5 sales is a lower price on the base models (and games like GTA6)," he wrote, referring to the forthcoming "Grand Theft Auto" sequel.

Australia struggle as Son lifts South Korea

Australia failed to score for the second successive match, China slumped to another defeat but Son Heung-min scored a stunning goal as South Korea got off the mark in Asian World Cup qualifying yesterday.

Graham Arnold's Socceroos, having been shocked at home 1-0 by Bahrain last week, dominated a Group C encounter with Indonesia but were held 0-0 in front of almost 80,000 fans at the Gelora Bung Karno Stadium in Jakarta.

Australia carved out a succession of chances but lacked any cutting edge, coming closest when Bayern Munich teenager Nestory Irankunda thundered a shot against the post.

"It was our game all along," Irankunda said. "We should have won it. We should have put them away in the first half."

Next month, Arnold's men face China at home in Group C and then a tough trip to in-form Japan.

"There's eight games to go," said Arnold. "It's not like it's a disaster, but I've got to go home and do a lot of thinking."

Saudi Arabia had to play the last 71 minutes of their Group C match against China in Dalian with 10 men, but Roberto Mancini's side found a way to come back from a goal behind to win 2-1 in the dying seconds.

Hassan Kadish equalised with a header from a corner before half-time and repeated the feat in the last minute of the 90 to spark wild celebrations from the visitors.

China, who were thumped 7-0 in Japan last week in their opening Group C encounter, had taken the lead in the 14th minute via an Ali Lajami own goal.

Wild weather

South Korea's English Premier League strike force of Hwang Hee-chan and Son Heung-min both scored as they beat Oman 3-1 in Muscat.

Wolverhampton's Hwang opened the scoring after 19 minutes before Jung Seung-hyun's own goal equalised on the stroke of half-time.

Tottenham's Son got South Korea's second, turning outside the box and firing home an unstoppable left-foot finish on 82 minutes.

Joo Min-kyu put the result beyond doubt in the 11th minute of added time after being played in by Son. It was South Korea's first win in the final Asian qualifying phase after they were held goalless at home by Palestine last week.

The Palestinians could not repeat their heroic performance in Seoul, however, and were beaten 3-1 by Jordan in a match played in Kuala Lumpur because of the war in Gaza.

North Korea drew 2-2 with Asian Cup champions Qatar in wild weather in a Group A match played in Vientiane.

Ri Il Song gave North Korea an early lead, in what was nominally their home fixture, before they were reduced to 10 men when Jang Kuk Chol was red carded for preventing a

goal-scoring opportunity. Akram Afif scored the resulting penalty and Almoez Ali put the Qataris 2-1 up at half-time.

After the break, the heavens opened violently, dumping huge amounts of water on the Laos National Stadium pitch. Kang Kuk Chol pierced the gloom with a rasping free-kick equaliser from 30 yards before puddles on the pitch grew into lakes leaving the referee no choice but to take the players off.

There was a delay of more than 20 minutes

until the rain eased but when the teams resumed there were no further goals as the players struggled on the waterlogged surface.

In another Group A match Uzbekistan beat Kyrgyzstan 3-2 in Bishkek.

The top two from each of the three six-team Asian groups will be guaranteed a place at the expanded

48-team World Cup in the United States, Canada and Mexico.

The third qualifying round wraps up in June.

F1 design guru Newey joins Aston Martin

London, United Kingdom

Formula One design guru Adrian Newey said his aim is to turn Aston Martin into world champions after he was unveiled at the team's Silverstone headquarters on Tuesday.

Newey, widely considered the greatest technical mastermind of his generation, has committed his long-term future to the British outfit after it was announced earlier this year that he would be leaving Red Bull.

Newey, who will start his new job in March 2025, joins as managing technical partner and will also become a shareholder.

"I am thrilled to be joining Aston Martin," said the 65-year-old. "I have been hugely inspired and impressed by the passion and commitment that (team owner) Lawrence (Stroll) brings to everything he is involved with."

"Lawrence is determined to create a world-beating team. He is the only majority team owner who is actively engaged in the sport."

Newey will work with the team's drivers, Stroll's 25-year-old son, Lance, and two-time world champion Fernando Alonso, 43.

"This is huge news," said Lawrence Stroll. "Adrian is the best in the world at what he does -- he is at the top of his game -- and I am incredibly proud that he is

joining Aston Martin.

"It's the biggest story since the Aston Martin name returned to the sport and another demonstration of our ambition to build a Formula One team capable of fighting for world championships."

Red Bull announced in early May that Newey would be leav-

ing the world champions and would step back from design duties to focus on final development and delivery of the RB17 hypercar.

Aston Martin are currently fifth in the constructors championship heading into the final stretch of the season.

Newey, who will reportedly earn up to £30 million (\$39 million) a year, has built a reputation as the greatest F1 designer in history after winning 12 drivers' championships and 13 constructors' titles in a career that spans the Williams, McLaren and Red Bull teams.

He helped transform Red Bull from an energy drinks company into an F1 giant, with Sebastian Vettel landing four consecutive titles between 2010 and 2013.

Mercedes then emerged as the dominant force but Red Bull fought back to reclaim their spot at motor racing's summit, with Max Verstappen taking the 2021 title before storming to the next two championships.

Molchanov extends world record

Three days after blacking out on the point of equalling one freediving world record, Alexey Molchanov broke another at the World Championships off Corsica on Tuesday.

The Russian reached a depth of 125 meters, in the 'constant weight with bifin' (CWTB) category at the International Association for the Development of Freediving (AIDA) world championships in the Gulf of Ajaccio.

That broke his own world record by two metres in a discipline in which divers wear separate flippers on each foot but may only pull on the guide rope once, when they turn to ascend. They are not allowed to discard any weights they are using to help them descend to their target depth, although Molchanov



usually dives without weights.

On Saturday, Molchanov had attempted to match his own record of 100 metres, set off Honduras last year, in constant weight freediving without any fins, the most difficult discipline.

This time, ascending from the much colder depths of the Gulf of Ajaccio, he blacked out two meters from the surface. As a result, he received a red card, disqualifying him.

The Russian also holds AIDA's world record in constant weight with a monofin at 136 metres and in variable weight at 156 metres.

Molchanov is the son of freediver Natalia Molchanova, herself the holder of 41 world records and 23 world champion titles, who died while diving in August 2015 in Formentera in the Balearic Islands.

England bring in new blood for 1st Australia T20

Jordan Cox, Jacob Bethell and Jamie Overton are set to make their England Twenty20 debuts in the opening game of the three-match series against Australia yesterday.

Phil Salt captains the side in Southampton in the absence of injured skipper Jos Buttler.

The T20 series is followed by five one-day internationals against the same opposition, with England picking youthful squads after relinquishing their T20 and 50-over world titles over the past year.

Essex's Cox, 23, was the top-scorer for men's champions Oval Invincibles in this year's Hundred competition while Barbados-born Bethell, 20, impressed for Birmingham Phoenix.

portunities against Japan's organized defense, managing only one shot on goal throughout the match. In contrast, Japan dominated possession with 76% and registered 14 shots on goal. Bahrain's defense, though resilient at times, couldn't contain the relentless Japanese attack.

Bahrain's next test will be against Indonesia on October 10, where they will hope to bounce back and reignite their World Cup qualification campaign.

Afghanistan-New Zealand Test second day called off

Ground staff used electric fans in a desperate bid to dry the pitch in the Test between Afghanistan and New Zealand Tuesday, but play was called off for a second straight day with one official calling it "a huge mess".

The one-off Test at Afghanistan's adopted home near India's capital New Delhi was supposed to start on Monday, but the toss is yet to take place because of rain and the poor condition of the Greater Noida ground.

On Tuesday, groundsmen covered areas of the pitch in anticipation of more rain, while others waved electric fans over the worst wet patches.

The venue, hosting its first Test, has only basic drainage and has been criticised for its facilities dubbed "ill-equipped" by The Times of India newspaper.

Despite sunshine on Monday and Tuesday the outfield remained soaked after days of preceding monsoon rain.

The teams stayed in their hotels on Tuesday morning but New Zealand, who were unable to complete any of their training sessions ahead of the Test, later put up nets on the ground and players went through their drills.

Afghanistan has hosted several Twenty20 and one-day internationals at Greater Noida since 2017.

Japan's Panasonic to end Olympic sponsorship after 37 years

Japanese electronics giant Panasonic said Tuesday it will stop serving as a major sponsor of the Olympics and Paralympics, citing "management considerations".

The company said it agreed with the International Olympic Committee (IOC) not to extend their sponsorship agreement when the current contract expires in December.

Panasonic became an "official Worldwide Partner of the Olympic Games" in 1987 and expanded its sponsorship to the Paralympics from 2014, the firm said in a statement.

But it decided to let the contract expire "as the Group



continually reviews how sponsorship should evolve with broader management considerations".

"As a result of this review, and after extensive consultation with the IOC, the parties agreed to refrain from renewing the Olympic and Paralympic Partner Agreement," Panasonic said without offering details.
