Derasat is set to hold pre-election random survey

Bahrain Centre for Strategic, International and Energy Studies (Derasat) has announced that it will conduct a pre-election random survey for citizens, said Derasat Board of Trustees Chairman Dr Shaikh Abdullah bin Ahmed Al Khalifa.

The survey for the upcoming parliamentary and municipal elections, which will be held in November 2022, will be based on a random sample, distributed over all four governorates, and includes age groups from 20 years and above.

Data will be collected through Derasat media platforms, phone calls, SMS, e-mails and direct interviews conducted by qualified cadres to answer a questionnaire specifically designed for this purpose.

The poll aims to gauge voters' attitudes regarding participation in the parliamentary and municipal elections, and to identify their views on the performance of the previous parliament and municipal councils.

It also seeks to identify voters' aspirations for parliamentary and municipal work in the next session.

Cabinet reviews new labour market reforms

The Cabinet yesterday discussed the new set of labour market reforms that will replace the Flexi Permits, including increased inspections to identify employers engaged in illegal activity.

It followed up on the new scheme's implementation in line with His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister's directives.

The Cabinet also approved the mechanisms to be used to suspend the infrastructure connectivity fee for new buildings in areas with pre-existing amenities, and the exploration of investment opportunities for

cross-sector public-private partnership.

Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Infrastructure,

Shaikh Khalid bin Abdulla Al Khalifa, chaired yesterday the weekly Cabinet meeting at Gudaibiya Palace.

The Cabinet commended the visit of HRH Prince Salman to the Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BCCI), emphasising the importance of developing initiatives that will strengthen the private sector's role in the Kingdom's economic growth, foster private sector's development, and create opportunities for Bahraini citizens.

These initiatives include strengthening urban development, developing real estate projects, and providing employers with greater flexibility in paying and sourcing labour.

The Cabinet welcomed Bahrain's success in being elected to the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) Council for the next four years, which occurred during the International Telecommunication Union's Plenipotentiary Conference in Bucharest, Romania, emphasising that the election results reflect the international community's confidence in Bahrain and its progress in communications and modern technologies.

Probe begins into 'school electoral campaign video'

Decree-Law prohibits candidates to hold electoral meetings or speeches in public places

The Election Crime Investigation Committee has begun probing into an alleged electoral campaign at a school after being notified about a viral video, apparently an electoral law violation.

The Cybercrime Department of the General Department for Anti-Corruption, Economic Security and Electronics at the

Ministry of Interior stated that a video clip on social media platforms showed a parliamentary candidate, along with another person, as he was campaigning amidst a group of people gathering.

"Both the candidate and the second individual have been summoned and confronted with the content of the video clip as evidence of a violation of election law, prior to referring them to stand an urgent trial," said Advocate General, Head of the Electoral Crimes Investigation Committee.

Decree-Law No 15 of 2002 regarding the Shura and Representatives Council prohibits candidates, in the context of electoral propaganda, from organising or holding electoral meetings or giving speeches in places of worship, universities, scientific institutes, government and private schools, or in squares, streets and public roads.

The ministry also emphasised the rules governing election propaganda tools, including the slogans, posters, images, brochures and writings that are used in electoral campaigns.

Those candidates or their supporters who engage in discrimination against the tenets of the Islamic faith and the unity of the people, or anything that leads to sectarianism or division among residents will be penalised.

The officials have also banned the use of the Kingdom's flag or official emblem in gatherings, advertisements, electoral statements and loudspeakers outside polling places.

BD1,000

Fine for candidates who are violators of the law.

Those candidates who are violators of the law may be jailed up to one year or fined up to BDI,000.

According to the ministry, all candidates for the House of Representatives and local councils must adhere to civilised principles of conduct during their campaigns to avoid harming the reputation

of any other candidates, insulting them, or questioning their ability.

As part of the electoral code of conduct, the Ministry of Municipalities Affairs earlier banned erecting election campaign billboards on select 23 streets in the Kingdom.

As the deadline for filing nominations ended yesterday, it has become clear that the House of Representative Speaker along with six other parliamentarians will not be contesting polls this time.

Speaker Fawzia Zainal, the leading democratic figure in the Kingdom and the first woman to head the House of Representatives, did not file nominations and so are the other six incumbents.

Other incumbents who are not contesting the polls this time are Ghazi Al Rahma (represents the fourth constituency in the Northern Governorate), Muhammad Al Abbasi (represents the third constituency in Muharraq Governorate), Isa Al Kooheji (represents the fourth constituency in Muharraq Governorate), Ammar Qambar (represents the seventh constituency in Muhar-

raq Governorate), Youssef Al Thawadi (represents the eighth constituency in Muharraq) and Abdul Razzaq Hattab (represents the sixth constituency in the Southern Governorate).

The incumbents running in polls from the Capital Governorate are Adel Al Asoomi, Sawsan Kamal, Mamdouh Al Saleh, Ammar Al Bannai, Ahmed Al Salloum, Masooma Abdel Rahim, Zainab Abdel Amir, Fadel Al Sawad, Ammar Al Abbas, and Ali Ishaqi.

From the Muharraq Governorate, four incumbents are in the electoral battlefield; Hamad Al Kooheji, Ibrahim Al Nafi'i, Khaled Buanaq, and Hisham Al Ashiri.

The Northern Governorate has 11 incumbents who have filed the nominations: Kaltham Al Hayki, Fatima Al Qatari, Abdullah Al Dosari, Sayed Falah Hashem, Abdulnabi Salman, Ahmed Al Demistani, Abdullah Al Thawadi, Basem Al Maliki,

Youssef Zainal, Muhammad Buhamoud and Mahmoud Al Bahrani.

In the Southern Governorate, all current MPs except one are contesting the polls: Ahmed Al Amer, Ahmed Al Ansari, Ali Zayed, Mohamed Al Sisi, Ali Al Nuaimi, Issa Al Dossary and Badr Al Dosari. Isa Al Qadi has moved from the Southern Governorate to Muharraq Governorate to file his candidacy.

Meanwhile, the filing of appeals over the decisions made by the electoral committees can be carried out by the poll hopefuls in the next two days as well.

A record number of 560 citizens have filed their candidatures for the upcoming elections.

According to electoral records, 420 filed their candidatures in 2018 elections while there were 493 in 2014 poll fray.

The first day of filing nominations saw 325 electoral hopefuls submitting their papers,

which itself was a record when compared to previous electoral years.

The past five days have seen long queues of potential candidates at electoral supervisory centres, carrying documents and required papers marking the beginning of the Kingdom's biggest democratic festival.

It is learnt that 20 nominations were rejected till last evening over criminal accusations, address issues, absence of name in the voters' list as well as lack of Arabic proficiency.

Speaking to members of the media, Issa Sami Al Mannai, the Undersecretary for Justice and Islamic Affairs within the Ministry of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Endowments, said potential candidates can file appeals through the national portal bahrain.bh.

"The electronic appeals service that can be found in the electoral website will be available round the clock during this

specific period and the ministry has issued a set of guidelines for the process."

According to the law, any potential candidate has the right to appeal the decision by the electoral supervisory committee before higher judicial authorities and a decision will be taken by the higher judicial authority within seven days of filing the appeal.

The candidate lists will be displayed until October 12, during which time potential candidates can challenge the supervisory committees' decisions.

The committees must issue their final decisions by October 15, which can be challenged in court no later than October 18, and the court rulings must be issued by October 25.

The final list of candidates will be announced on October 26.

The Kingdom will head to the polls on November 12 with a run-off fixed on November 19.

Cigarette products are required to have digital stamps from 16 October

All cigarette products available for sale, trading, supply, or possession in local markets must have digital stamps starting from 16 October 2022.

The National Bureau for Revenue (NBR) confirmed the date of effectivity, the final phase of the Digital Stamps Scheme which will be applied to cigarette products in implementing the decision of the NBR's Chief Executive No. (3) for the year 2022.

The NBR encourages all importers and traders in the local market to deal in appropriate quantities and to avoid the storage of large quantities of cigarette products without digital stamps to be cleared prior to the last phase goes into effect by 16 October 2022, where the sale, circulation, possession or supply of cigarettes without the digital stamps in local market will be prohibited.

Therefore, starting from this date, any product in the supply chain that does not have the digital stamp must be returned through the relevant supply



chain to either be destroyed or moved for sale outside the territories of the Kingdom of Bahrain.

This is to ensure effective implementation starting from this date to avoid any violations through inspections or other operations conducted by the NBR, which requires taking further legal actions such as imposing administrative penalties or filing a criminal case for excise evasion.

This phase comes within a specific time plan that was effective with its first implementation phase on cigarette products as of 11 March 2022, where the system was made available to registered cigarette importers and local manufacturers.

Cabinet pushes for legislation to strengthen Bahrain rule of law

The Cabinet has approved a memorandum by the Government Executive Committee on the formulation of legislation that strengthens the rule of law, safeguards rights and supports development.

Chaired by Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Infrastructure, Shaikh Khalid bin Abdulla Al Khalifa, yesterday's Cabinet meeting discussed and approved several key memorandums, such as the following

1. A memorandum by the Ministerial Committee for Legal and Legislative Affairs on a draft decision on the issuance of regulatory requirements for the construction of various areas in the Kingdom of Bahrain.

2. A memorandum by the Ministerial Committee for Legal and Legislative Affairs on an MoU between Customs Affairs in the Kingdom of Bahrain and the State Customs Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan on cooperation in customs affairs.

3. A memorandum by the Ministerial Committee for Legal and Legislative Affairs on

the government's response to four proposals submitted by the Council of Representatives.

The Cabinet also reviewed a memorandum by the Minister of Education regarding the Kingdom's status in the United Nations Development Program (UNDP) report on the Human Development Index (HDI), which showed that compared to its previous report, the Kingdom of Bahrain has advanced by seven positions in the HDI and has also advanced in regional and global educational indicators.

The Cabinet took note of ministerial reports regarding:

- Participation in the 77th session of the UN General Assembly
- Participation in the state funeral for the former Prime Minister of Japan

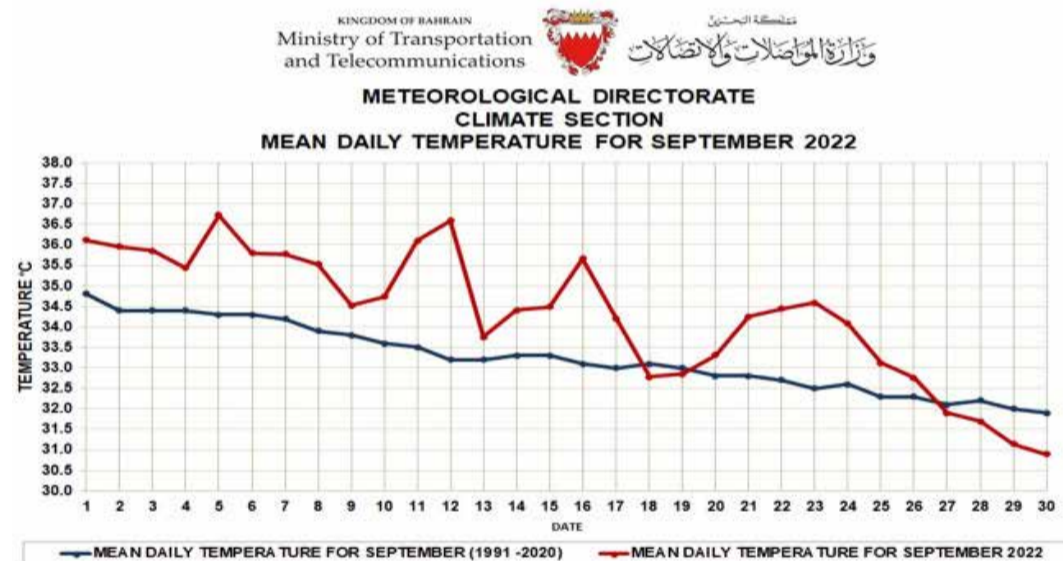
September 2022 is 'warmer' than usual in temperatures

Last month, September 2022, was warmer than normal in temperatures with above average wind speed, according to a latest report by the Meteorological Directorate within the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications.

The mean temperature of the month was 34.3°C which is 1.1°C above the long-term normal for September and this goes on record as the fifth highest mean temperature for September since 1902. This is the same as in September 2010. The highest mean monthly temperature for September was 34.8°C recorded in 2020.

The mean maximum temperature of the month was 38.5°C which is 0.8°C above the long-term normal and this goes on record as the seventh highest mean maximum temperature for September since 1946. This

is the same as in September 1998 and 2007. The highest mean monthly maximum temperature for September was 39.8°C recorded in 2020.

During the month Bahrain had

nine days with a maximum temperature exceeding 40°C. The highest temperature recorded during the month was 43.1°C which occurred on the 12th Sep-

tember at Bahrain International

Airport. The highest temperature recorded for September at Bahrain International Airport was 45.5°C which occurred on 4th September 2013.

The highest temperature

recorded in the month at Bahrain International Circuit was 45.8°C which was recorded on the 5th September and at Durrat Al Bahrain was 44.8°C which was recorded on the 12th September.

The mean minimum temperature of the month was 31.1°C which is 1.6°C above the long-term normal and this goes on record as the fifth highest mean minimum temperature for September since 1946. The highest mean monthly minimum temperature for September was 31.5°C recorded in 2015.

The lowest temperature recorded was 26.6°C on the 29th September at Bahrain International Airport but recorded 23.2°C on the same night at Durrat Al Bahrain.

The mean relative humidity for September was 56 per cent whereas the mean maximum relative humidity was 72pc and the mean minimum relative humidity was 33pc. The maximum

relative humidity was 84pc recorded on the 22nd September and the minimum relative humidity was 12pc recorded on the 12th September.

September 2022 was the third sunniest month for all September's since the sunshine records began in 1968. The total hours of sunshine for the month were 337.5 hours. The highest monthly total hours of sunshine for September was 339.8 hours recorded in 2014. Only trace amounts of precipitation were recorded on 21st September at the Bahrain International Airport.

The mean wind speed for September was 8 knots. The prevailing wind was 28pc from the Northwest direction. Gust winds reached 28 knots on the 24th and 26th September at Bahrain International Airport. Easterly winds accounted for 21pc of the observation. Dust was reported on the 25th September. Visibility dropped to 3000 meters at Bahrain International Airport.

LMRA takes legal action against illegal workers and establishments

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) has taken legal action against a number of illegal workers and establishments.

The clampdown followed a joint inspection campaign in the Southern Governorate in coordination with the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs at the Ministry of Interior and the Southern Governorate Police Directorate.

The campaign resulted in issuing several offenses related to violations of LMRA and Immigration laws and a number of arrests were made.

The LMRA stressed its commitment to report violations through the implementation of an intensive and continuous

work plan in different governorates, in cooperation with relevant entities.

It noted the important role of the community in supporting government efforts, calling on

the public to report any complaints related to violations of the labour market and irregular employment, by contacting the Authority's call center 17506055.

News in brief

◆ Britain said yesterday it had sanctioned senior Iranian

security officials and the country's "so-called Morality Police", saying the force had used threats of detention and violence to control what Iranian women wear and how they behave in public. The death of 22-year-old Mahsa Amini in police custody has sparked protests across Iran and internationally, with demonstrators calling for the downfall of Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei. Citing her death and the subsequent protests, Britain said it had sanctioned the morality police in its entirety, as well as both its chief, Mohammed Rostami Cheshmeh Gachi, and the Head of the Tehran Division, Haj Ahmed Mirzaei. "These sanctions send a clear message to the Iranian authorities - we will hold you to account for your repression of women and girls and for the shocking violence you have inflicted on your own people," Foreign Secretary James Cleverly said in a statement.

◆ **Heavy rains eased** across Australia's east yesterday, a slight relief for flood-weary residents but authorities warned another intense weather system could hit several inland regions bringing more downpours and triggering flash flooding. Northern Victoria state, southern New South Wales (NSW) and northern Tasmania should brace for widespread rains of up to 100 mm (4 inches), about a quarter of Australia's annual average, over two days from late Wednesday, the Bureau of Meteorology (BoM) said. "It is another big event ... so we're likely to see lots of moderate and possibly major flooding," BoM forecaster Dean Narramore told the Australian Broadcasting Corp on Monday.

◆ **Britain's government** named the top official in the country's trade ministry, James Bowler, to head the finance ministry after new chancellor of the exchequer Kwasi Kwarteng ousted his predecessor last month. Bowler replaces Tom Scholar as permanent secretary, who departed shortly after Kwarteng took office. That departure unsettled finance markets as it broke the British convention that non-partisan officials remain in post after a change of political leadership. Prime Minister Liz Truss said during her campaign to become leader of the Conservative Party that she wanted to break with "Treasury orthodoxy" which she said was holding back radical reforms.



UK names new official to head finance ministry after predecessor ousted

◆ **President Vladimir Putin** may meet Turkish President Tayyip Erdogan this week to discuss a Turkish proposal to host talks between Russia and the West on Ukraine, the Kremlin said yesterday. Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov told reporters that Russia had not received any signals about the prospect of negotiations with the West in Turkey, but did not rule out that Putin could discuss this with Erdogan. Both Putin and Erdogan are expected to visit Kazakhstan this week. Tensions between the West and Russia over its seven-month long invasion of Ukraine are still rising, with Moscow launching missile strikes across Ukraine on Monday in response to a weekend explosion that badly damaged a Russian-built bridge to Crimea.

Russia fired cruise missiles at cities across Ukraine during rush hour on Monday morning, killing civilians and

knocking out power and heat, in what President Vladimir Putin declared to be revenge for Ukrainian attacks including on a bridge to Crimea.

The missiles tore into busy intersections, parks and tourist sites in the centre of downtown Kyiv with an intensity not seen since Russian forces tried to capture the capital early in the war.

Explosions were also reported in Lviv, Ternopil and Zhytomyr in western Ukraine, Dnipro and Kremenchuk in central Ukraine, Zaporizhzhia in the south and Kharkiv in the east. Ukrainian officials said at least 10 people were killed and scores injured, and swaths of the country left

without power. In a televised address, Putin said he had ordered "massive" long-range strikes against Ukrainian energy, command and communication targets, using missiles fired from air, sea and land, in response to what he described as terrorist attacks, including Saturday's explosion at the Kerch Strait bridge. Veteran Indian politician Mulayam Singh Yadav dies at 82

Mulayam Singh Yadav, a veteran Indian politician and three-time chief minister of the country's most populous state, died yesterday after over six weeks in hospital, his son said.

Yadav, who was 82, entered politics in his 20s, rising to become chief minister of northern Uttar Pradesh state in 1989.

The state sends the highest number of lawmakers to the lower house of parliament and a strong showing in Uttar Pradesh is essential for any party or coalition to win power at the federal level.

Fondly called "Netaji", or respected leader, by his supporters, Yadav became Uttar Pradesh's chief minister for the second time in 1993, a year after a Hindu right-wing mob demolished the 16th century Babri Mosque in the town of Ayodhya, triggering nationwide violence.

He and his Samajwadi Party emerged as advocates for Muslims, who make up a sizeable minority in Uttar Pradesh. Yadav also served as India's

federal defence minister in a coalition government between 1996 and 1998.

He was chief minister of Uttar Pradesh for a third time from 2003 to 2007. In recent years, he handed over the leadership of the party to his son, Akhilesh Yadav, although he remained a senior leader and a member of the national parliament.

"My respected father and your 'Netaji' is no more," Akhilesh Yadav said in a tweet from the Samajwadi Party's official account.

UAE president to meet Russia's Putin today

United Arab Emirates President Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed al-Nahyan will travel to Russia today to meet with President Vladimir Putin, UAE state news agency WAM reported yesterday.

The announcement came less than a week after OPEC+, a group of oil producers that includes the UAE and Russia, agreed steep oil production cuts in defiance of US pressure.

US President Joe Biden's administration had pushed hard to prevent the production cut, hoping to keep a lid on gasoline prices ahead of midterm elections in which his Democratic Party could lose control of Congress.

Biden flew to Jeddah in July for a Gulf summit to try to mend relations, but left without securing a deal for higher oil production.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy said Monday's rush hour attacks were deliberately timed to kill people as well as to knock out Ukraine's power grid. His prime minister said 11 major infrastructure targets were hit in eight regions, leaving swaths of the country with no power, water or heat.

The body of a man in jeans lay in a street at a major Kyiv intersection, surrounded by flaming cars. In a park, a soldier cut through the clothes of a woman who lay in the grass to try to treat her wounds. Two other women were bleeding nearby.

Monday's strikes tore a huge crater next to a children's playground in one of central Kyiv's busiest parks. The remains of an apparent missile were buried, smoking in the mud.

More volleys of missiles struck the capital again later in the morning. Pedestrians huddled for shelter at the entrance of Metro stations and inside parking garages.

Germany said a building housing its consulate in Kyiv had been hit in Monday's strike, though it had not been used since the war started on Feb. 24. The European Union condemned Monday's "barbaric and cowardly attacks" on Ukraine, among a chorus of denunciations from Western countries.

By mid-morning, Ukraine's defence ministry said Russia had fired 81 cruise missiles, and Ukraine's air defences had shot



Within Russia, the strikes were cheered by hawks. Ramzan Kadyrov, the staunchly pro-Kremlin leader of Russia's Chechnya region who had demanded in recent days that military commanders be sacked, hailed Monday's attacks: "Now I am 100% satisfied with how the special military operation is being conducted." "We warned you Zelensky, that Russia hasn't even got started yet, so stop complaining ... and run! Run away without looking back to the West," he wrote.

down 43 of them.

Security camera footage showed shrapnel and flames engulfing a glass-bottomed footbridge across a wooded valley in the city centre, one of Kyiv's most popular tourist sites. One pedestrian could be seen running from the blast. Reuters later saw a huge crater below the bridge, damaged but still standing.

"They are trying to destroy us and wipe us off the face of the earth," Zelenskyy said on the Telegram messaging app. "The air raid sirens do not subside throughout

Ukraine."

Zelenskyy later filmed a video message on a mobile phone on an empty central Kyiv street. He said the strikes had two main targets: energy infrastructure and people.

"Such a time and such targets were specially chosen to cause as much damage as possible," he said.

Prime Minister Denys Shmygal promised to restore utilities as quickly as possible. Officials reported that power was down in Ukraine's second largest city Kharkiv and nearby Poltava.

Foreign Minister Dmytro Kuleba tweeted: "Putin's only tactic is terror on peaceful Ukrainian cities, but he will not break Ukraine down.

This is also his response to all appeasers who want to talk with him about peace: Putin is a terrorist who talks with missiles."

Olena Somyk, 41, sheltered with her 6-year-old daughter, Daria, in an underground garage where hundreds of other people waited for the all-clear. She had reached Kyiv earlier in the war after fleeing through Russia and across Europe from the Russian-occupied southern city of Kherson.

India does not want to say in advance how it will vote at the United Nations General Assembly on a likely draft resolution condemning Russia's proclaimed annexation of parts of Ukraine, Foreign Minister S. Jaishankar said yesterday.

"As a matter of prudence and policy, we don't predict our votes in advance," Jaishankar said during a joint media briefing along with Australia's Foreign Minister Penny Wong in Canberra.

The General Assembly is due to vote on the draft resolution on Tuesday or Wednesday, diplomats said.

Russia had vetoed a UN Security Council resolution introduced by the United States and Albania late last month condemning the proclaimed annexation, with China, Gabon,

Air France, Airbus plead not guilty in AF447 crash

A French criminal court opened the historic manslaughter trial of Air France and planemaker Airbus yesterday, with relatives demanding justice more than 13 years after an A330 passenger jet ploughed into the Atlantic, killing everyone on board.

The heads of both companies pleaded not guilty to involuntary corporate manslaughter after officials read out the names of all 228 who died when AF447 vanished during a night-time equatorial storm en route from Rio de Janeiro to Paris on June 1, 2009.

Families of several victims shouted protests including "shame" and "too little, too late" as Air France Chief Executive Anne Rigail and then Airbus Chief Executive Guillaume Faury expressed condolences in opening statements to the nine-week trial.

"Thirteen years we have been waiting for this day and we have prepared for a long time," said Daniele Lamy, who lost her son in the accident, before the two-hour opening hearing.

After a two-year search for

the A330's black boxes using remote submarines, investigators found pilots had responded clumsily to a problem involving iced-up speed sensors and lurched into a freefall without responding to "stall" alerts.

But France's BEA accident agency also revealed earlier discussions between Air France and Airbus about the reliability of the probes, and made dozens of safety recommendations from cockpit design to training

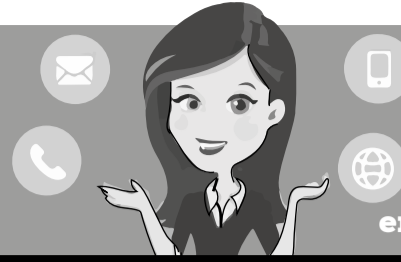
and search-and-rescue.

Summarising an earlier stage of the judicial process, a Paris judge said Airbus had been accused of reacting too slowly to a rise in the number of icing incidents, which hampered speed displays, and under-estimated the impact on startled pilots.

Preliminary findings had meanwhile called into question the efforts taken by the airline to ensure pilots were well trained.

Banking crisis breakthroughs win Nobel economics for Bernanke, Diamond, Dybvig

● Economists studied role of bank vulnerability in crisis

● Conclusions now a foundation of crisis-fighting tools

● Bank bailouts serve larger good

A trio of US economists including Former Federal Reserve Chair Ben Bernanke won this year's Nobel Economics Prize yesterday for laying the foundation of how world powers now tackle global crises like the recent pandemic or the Great Recession of 2008.

The trio, who also include Douglas Diamond and Philip Dybvig, won for their research on how regulating banks and propping up failing lenders with public cash can stave off an even deeper economic crisis, such as the Great Depression of the 1930s.

"The actions taken by central banks and financial regulators around the world in confronting two recent major crises – the Great Recession and the economic downturn that was gener-

ated by the COVID-19 pandemic – were in large part motivated by the laureates' research," the Swedish Academy said in announcing this year's prize winners.

Governments around the world bailed out banks in 2008 and 2009, generating a torrent of criticism as ordinary consumers suffered with many losing their homes even as banks, a key culprit of the crisis, were saved. But society on the whole benefited, the laureates' research suggests.

"Even though these bailouts have problems, ... they could actually be good for society," Diamond, a University of Chicago professor, told a news conference with the Swedish Academy, arguing that preventing the collapse of investment bank Lehman Brothers would have made the crisis less severe.

"It probably would have been better if Lehman Brothers had not collapsed unexpectedly,"

Diamond said. "Had they found a way I think the world would have had less of a severe crisis."

Ironically Bernanke was the chair of the US Federal Reserve at the time of Lehman's collapse in 2008, which became one of the main catalysts of the world's biggest financial turmoil since the 1930s.

Bernanke, now a fellow at the Brookings Institution, argued at the time that there was no legal way to save Lehman so the next best thing was to let it fail and use the government's financial resources to prevent wider systemic failures.

Part of that response, including ultra low interest rates and massive central bank asset buys are being reversed now as inflation is at its highest level in around a half a century in many parts of the world.

BANK RUNS

"What Bernanke did was to

show that banks played a central role in turning relatively small recessions into the depression in the 30s, and that was the worst economic crisis that the world has seen ever since," Professor John Hassler, member of committee for the Nobel Prize for Economics, said.

Bank runs can easily become self-fulfilling leading to the collapse of an institution and putting the entire financial sector at risk.

"These dangerous dynamics can be prevented through the government providing deposit insurance and acting as a lender of last resort to banks," the Academy said.

Dybvig, a professor at Washington University in St. Louis, and Diamond argued that banks taking short-term deposit and lending this cash out in the long term is the most efficient

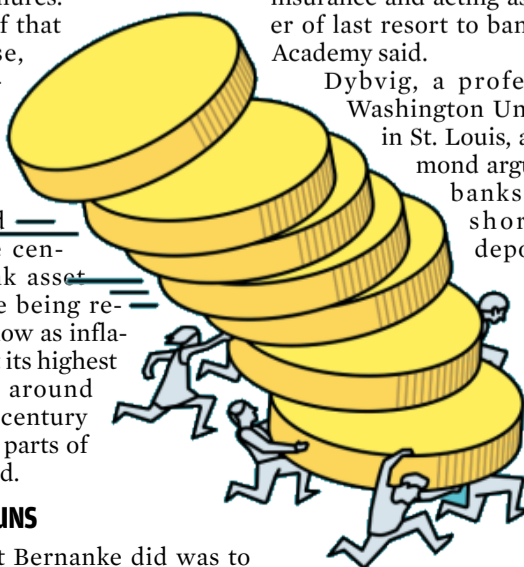
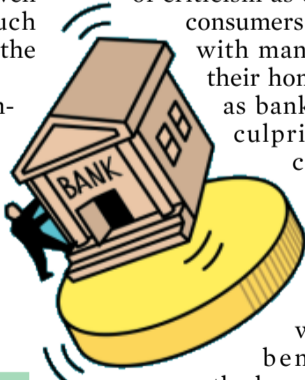

Grocer Jack, owned by HRH Prince Faisal bin Khaled from Saudi Arabia, was a close-up 5th in a very hotly contested Neom Turf Cup (Gr.3) in Riyadh. He has since won a listed race at Newbury in July and has been placed second in two Group races in August.

There are three Group 1 winners entered including Sisfahan, trained in Germany by Henk Grewe, who won the German Derby (Gr.1) last year and ran well in the 2021 Breeders' Cup Turf (Gr.1) at Del Mar. Grewe also entered See Hector, who won the Premio Parioli (Italian 2,000 Guineas) (Gr.3) at Rome in May.

Aidan O'Brien finished 3rd with Sovereign in the 2020 Bahrain International Trophy and the Ballydoyle trainer has once again strongly supported the race with Aikhal, Bolshoi Ballet, and High Definition, all receiving entries. Bolshoi Ballet hasn't run this year but won the Belmont Derby (Gr.1) in New York last season. High Definition won a Group Two race as a 2yo and was only just touched off when second in the Tattersalls Gold Cup (Gr.1) at Curragh in May. Meanwhile, Aikhal is a Group 3 winner.

Return

Godolphin, who narrowly missed out on winning last year's race with Barney Roy, return with five strong entries for the 2022 renewal. Last year's close 3rd Magny Cours (Andre Fabre) returned to

action on Saturday by winning Prix de Coye at Chantilly in impressive style for leading French trainer Andre Fabre. Royal Ascot winner Dubai Future, Listed winner Passion and Glory and Dubai Mirage are all possible runners for Saeed bin Suroor. Meanwhile, Bahrain Turf Club Foundation Stakes (Listed) winner Royal Fleet, who finished 3rd behind Alflaila on Saturday, is Appleby's sole entry.

Other notable entries include the John and Thady Gosden-trained Mostahdaf. The four-year-old son of Frankel chased home Broome in the Hardwicke Stakes (Gr.2) at Ascot, and beat Dubai Honour in the September Stakes (Gr.3) at Kempton in September.

George Boughey has enjoyed a stellar 2022 season having won his first British Classic with Cachet before claiming his first

two Royal Ascot successes with Inver Park and Missed The Cut. Missed The Cut is one of two entries in the race for Boughey, with Cadillac (fifth in the race last year for Jessica Harrington) the other.

Three locally trained horses have been entered. Dilawar finished 4th in the Prix d'Ispahan (Gr.1) for Francis Graffard in May but has been bought to race for Fawzi Nass. Joining Dilawar are Litigator (Haider Ebrahim) and Pensiore D'Amore (Mohammed Hassan) with the trio all trying to emulate Simsir who won the 2020 renewal.

Shaikh Salman bin Rashed al Khalifa, Executive Director of the Bahrain Turf Club, said: "We are very happy with the quality of horses entered for this year's renewal of the Group 3 Bahrain International Trophy. Some of the best trainers from around the world have once again supported the race."

He continued: "Last year was the first time the race was run with Group 3 status, and it saw three high-class horses fight out the finish. With the race now a key date in the international racing calendar, we firmly believe that the race will continue to progress through the grades with our ultimate goal to have Bahrain host its first international Group 1 race."

A maximum field of 14 will go to post.
