# Bahrainis to take over 'gradually'

MPs propose two-year employment contract limits for expats in public sector

● Cap on foreign hires to reduce number of jobless citizens

Expats in Bahrain's public sector could face strict two-year contract limits, as MPs push for a bold new hiring policy to prioritise local talent and address rising job concerns for Bahrainis.

A proposal to amend Article 11 of the Civil Service Law aims to restrict foreign workers' contracts to two years, focusing on a gradual hand-over of public sector roles to Bahrainis.

Currently, the law allows non-Bahrainis to fill roles temporarily if no qualified local candidate is available, but under the new proposal, expat contracts would end after two years, during which Bahrainis would be trained to take over.

Duty

MPs behind this proposal emphasise the importance of 'public service as a duty held

chiefly for citizens', a principle grounded in Article 16 of the Constitution.

Mohammed Al Olaiwi, Jaleela Al Sayed, and three other MPs introduced the amendment, which seeks to ensure that Bahrainis can step confidently into public roles, either by learning from foreign workers or through specialist training.

"This proposal introduces a clear limit on contract terms," the MPs said in an explanatory note. "It ensures Bahrainis are trained and ready to take over within two years."

Responsibility

The plan also assigns the Civil Service Bureau responsibility for setting guidelines on foreign hires, making sure they align with national aims.

The MPs argue that a cap on foreign hires would help speed up the development of a skilled Bahraini workforce, reducing dependence on expatriates in public roles.

They further noted the wider benefits, saying the change could "help to address unemployment, reduce the number of job seekers, and provide Bahrainis

nis with greater stability in their careers."

Stability

By prioritising citizens for public roles, they believe the government can build social and economic stability, ultimately benefiting the broader economy.

The proposal has now

been forwarded to the parliamentary committee for review and will be debated in Parliament.

If passed, the two-year cap on foreign public sector contracts could mark a major change in Bahrain's approach to public hiring, putting Bahraini talent firmly at the forefront.

**National Tree Week**

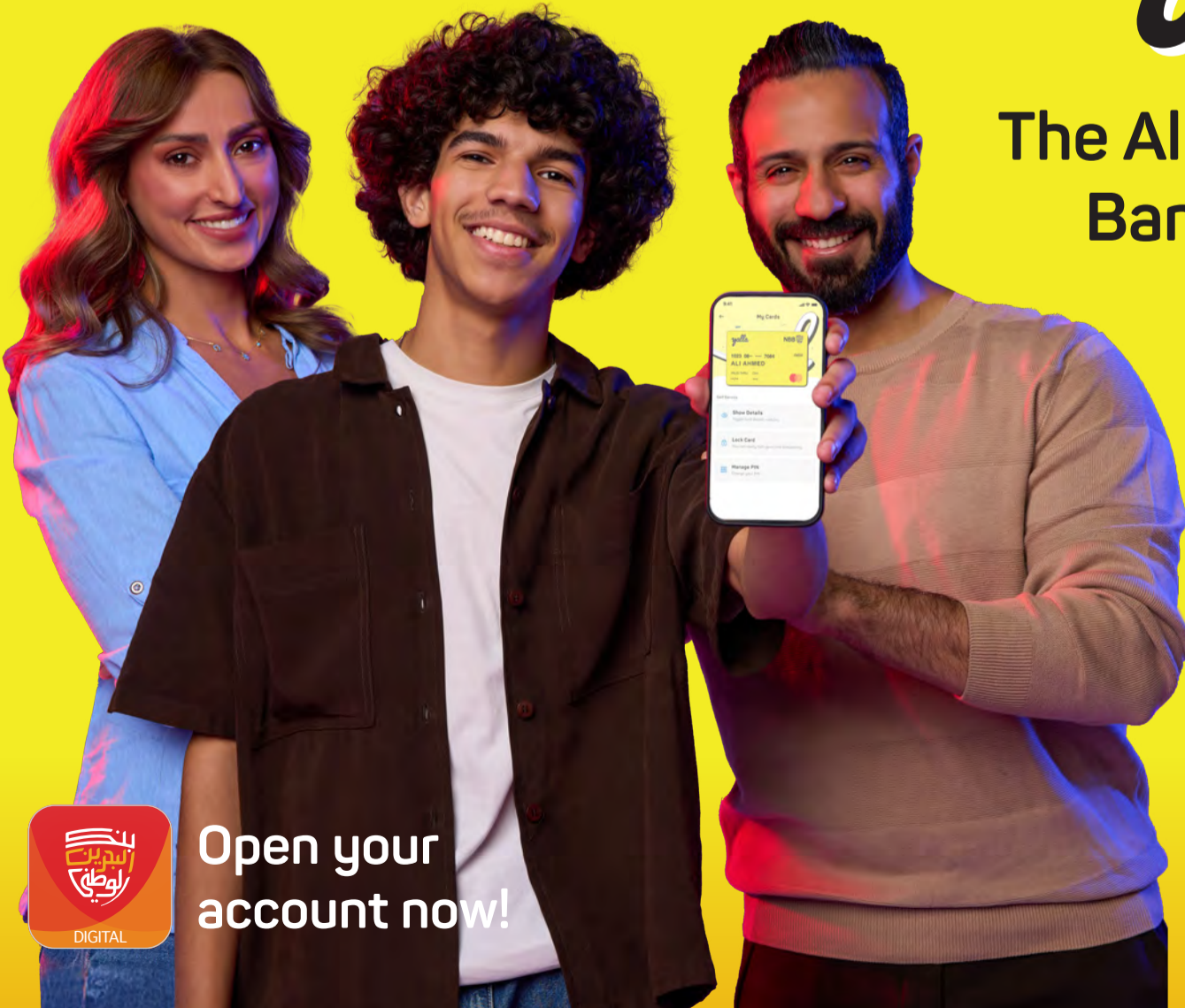

# Younger voices

Legislators push to lower Bahrainis' voting age from 20 to 18 ahead of 2026 elections

Legislators are pushing to lower the voting age from 20 to 18 ahead of the parliamentary elections scheduled for 2026, with a formal debate set for upcoming sessions.

The move aims to bring young Bahrainis into the political process, with nearly two-thirds of the population now under 35, offering a new voice to a generation eager to weigh in on the policies that shape their lives.

This proposal, designed to engage young Bahrainis in decision-making, is supported by Shura Council members Dalal Jassim Al Zayed, Sabika Khalifa Al Fadhlah, and three others.

Advocates argue that Bahrain's youth are prepared for this responsibility with the awareness and sense of duty it requires.

As reported by The Daily Tribune on 23rd September, nearly two-thirds of Bahrain's people are now under 35.

## Surge

This youthful surge suggests a society driven by new ideas and energy, ready to take on more active roles in areas such as work, trade, and social issues.

For young people stepping into the workforce, having a say in decisions that guide job growth isn't just a preference — it's essential.

This move comes as Bahrain's democratic process sees more active involvement, with a strong 73 per cent voter turnout

in recent elections.

Proponents of the change believe lowering the voting age is a logical next step, allowing young people to influence decisions that shape their lives.

"Bahrain's changing democratic values have shown us that young people have what it takes," the plan notes, reflecting a growing belief that youth can play an important part.

Moreover, with many young Bahrainis on the brink of setting up their own homes, voting on housing and urban planning would allow them to influence affordable living options.

Lowering the voting age isn't just about giving young people a voice — it's about allowing them to shape a future that suits them, where they can settle, grow, and lead.

The plan aligns with current Bahraini laws that set 18 as the age of responsibility.

At this age, Bahrainis can already form groups, take on leading roles, and even start businesses.

They are also allowed to apply

for driving licences, supporting the view that they are ready to take on serious duties.

The plan also echoes His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's focus on young people, who has called for greater attention and support for Bahrain's youth.

"This is a step towards involving young people as true partners in Bahrain's growth," the proposal explanatory note reads, following HM the King's recent remarks at the start of the new parliamentary session, where he stressed the importance of developing youth skills and strengths.

## Societies

Japan and South Korea recently lowered their voting ages from 20 to 18, both aiming to give younger voices a place in steering their societies.

Japan made the change in 2015, responding to concerns over low youth turnout and an ageing population.

South Korea followed in 2019, encouraged by strong public

support and pressure from youth groups.

Both nations saw this shift as a way to bring young people into the fold and reinforce their say in governance.

If passed, the rule would place Bahrain alongside other countries in the region, like Egypt and Jordan, where 18-year-olds already have the right to vote.

The plan argues that if young people are trusted with driving, they should also be trusted to choose their leaders.

"If 18-year-olds are trusted to drive, they're surely ready to choose leaders who will stand up for them," it reads.

Giving 18-year-olds the vote would also instil a sense of duty and pride in their communities, encouraging them to take an active role in directing the way forward.

## Drivers of change

The push mirrors a changing Bahrain, where young people are seen not just as future voices, but as present drivers of change, ready to make their mark.

With young people making up a large part of the population, supporters say this change would give them a stronger voice in the issues that impact them, building a sense of responsibility and care for their society from an early age.

The plan has two main parts: one formally lowers the voting age to 18, and the other sets out how this change will be put in place.

## Wording issues delay Timeshare Law approval

Clarity

Disagreements over specific wording held up the approval of Bahrain's draft timeshare law in the Shura Council yesterday, as members sought clearer terms to protect consumers in the tourism sector.

With only 12 out of 36 articles approved, fears were raised that vague language could allow foreign firms to exploit legal gaps.

Crafted by the government and approved by the Council of Representatives in May, the draft law aims to support Bahrain's tourism sector by targeting 14.1 million visitors by 2026.

Dr Jihad Al Fadhel, Second Deputy Chairman of the Shura Council, supports the draft's purpose but warns that ambiguous wording might damage Bahrain's standing in international tourism.

## Strict penalties

The draft law imposes strict penalties for breaches, including fines up to BD50,000 and possible jail time for unlicensed or dishonest practices.

It also limits advertising to licensed projects, aiming to protect buyers from misleading claims.

Dalal Al Zayed, Chair of the Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee, stressed that putting the law into action would "make sure units are used safely and well, giving Bahrain an edge on the world stage".

She added that it would also lift the local economy by drawing tourists who would visit the kingdom's markets, restaurants, and other spots.

Shura Council member Ali Al Aradi remarked that some original language from the government provided more clarity than certain adjustments made by the Services Committee.

Al Aradi noted that the draft has the potential to bring Bahrain's tourism rules up to date, commending the cooperation between legislative and executive bodies.

Dr Noufal Ghurbal, head of Legal Advisors, explained that preambles in laws typically avoid specifics, as such matters are generally managed by courts.

The draft law clarifies roles such as the 'Timeshare Activity Manager' and defines the 'Time-Share Period' to ensure that shared property use is clearly marked, reducing potential disputes.

## Positive step

Tourism Minister Fatima Al Sairafi described the draft as a positive step for Bahrain's tourism, noting a 45 per cent rise in overnight visitors in the first half of 2024 compared to 2019.

She suggested the law could contribute to further growth, complementing the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority's work.

The Services Committee, chaired by Jameela Al Salman, supports the law as a way to strengthen trust in Bahrain's holiday units, covering areas from licensing to consumer rights. It includes buyer protections, such as a cooling-off period and inheritance rights for timeshares.

## Couple guilty for carjacking vehicle using gas cylinder

A 46-year-old man and his 32-year-old female accomplice have been sentenced to five years in prison for carjacking a vehicle in East Riffa, using a gas cylinder and lighter to threaten the occupants.

The High Appeals Court upheld the original verdict, also ordering the confiscation of the gas cylinder.

The couple were charged with robbery under duress.

Prosecutors alleged that the man threatened the victim, a woman, and her daughter with the gas cylinder and lighter, forcing them from their car before fleeing the scene.

The initial hearing at the High Criminal Court saw the defendants plead not guilty.

According to witness testimony, the incident unfolded in the East Riffa market.

## Shop

The victim's husband had briefly left his wife and daughter in the car while he visited a shop.

Upon hearing a commotion, he witnessed the defendants stealing the vehicle, which belonged to his mother.

His wife recounted how the man threatened to detonate the car with the gas cylinder and lighter if they didn't leave.

After the carjacking, the defendants fled, leaving the gas cylinder behind on the roadside.

## Account

Another witness corroborated the account, stating they saw the defendants maneuvering the gas cylinder towards a parked car before forcing the occupants out and stealing the vehicle.

The gas cylinder was subsequently abandoned.

A police officer testified that investigations identified the defendants, who confessed to the crime after their arrest.

Security camera footage confirmed the incident, and it was revealed that the male defendant had prior convictions for theft.

## Fraud and embezzlement case

The High Criminal Court commenced the trial of a 55-year-old Asian travel agent accused of issuing fraudulent tickets and embezzling BD6,000 from a travel compa-

ny. The court has scheduled November 17th to appoint a lawyer for the defendant and levied a BD50 fine on the previously assigned lawyer for non-attendance at the previous hearing.

## Two Asians on trial for 'forced labour'

The High Criminal Court has begun hearing a case against two Asian nationals accused of forcing a female employee into labour and allowing customers to harass her at a restaurant.

The court has scheduled a hearing for November 17th to summon the victim.

The Public Prosecution has charged the first defendant, a 35-year-old businessman, and the second defendant, a 25-year-old supervisor, both Asian nationals, with exploiting the victim in 2024.

The charges allege that they received, transported, and housed the victim under duress and threats of violence, exploiting her vulnerability to force her



into unpaid labour with excessively long working hours and no days off.

## Unsuitable

The conditions were described as unsuitable for the nature of the work, with the victim being forced to interact with

customers who were permitted to harass her.

The second defendant is further charged with stealing the victim's passport, a breach of trust.

According to the victim's testimony, she arrived in Bahrain on a tourist visa arranged by

the second defendant to work as a waitress. Her compensation was to be commission-based, earned from customer interactions.

## Commission

She stated that her work involved interacting with customers, attracting them by allowing them to hold her hand and contact her by phone to increase her commission.

After expressing her refusal to work under these conditions, the second defendant allegedly shouted at her, physically assaulted her, and confiscated her phone.

The victim managed to escape the apartment. Two additional victims have corroborated this account.

News in brief

◆ Saudi Arabia's top military official arrived in Tehran yesterday for talks with Iranian officials, state media reported. In a rare high-level meeting since the countries restored ties last year. Fayyad al-Ruwaili, chief of staff of the Saudi armed forces, met his Iranian counterpart "General Mohammad Bagheri at the Iranian Armed Forces General Staff Headquarters" in the capital, the official news agency IRNA reported. "The development of defence diplomacy and the expansion of bilateral cooperation are among the main topics of this meeting," it added. The Fars news agency said that at the meeting, Bagheri noted increased security cooperation between the two countries. "We would like the Saudi navy to join Iranian naval exercises next year, either as participants or observers," Fars quoted Bagheri as saying. Iraqi National Security Adviser Qassem al-Araji was also expected in Tehran to meet senior officials, Iranian news agency Tasnim reported.



Saudi army chief in Iran on rare visit

◆ The chief of the United Nations' nuclear watchdog, Rafael Grossi, will visit Iran in days for talks with senior officials, Iranian state media reported yesterday. "The director general of the International Atomic Energy Agency will arrive in Iran on Wednesday ... at the official invitation of the Islamic Republic of Iran," the official IRNA news agency reported. Grossi will meet Iranian officials on Thursday, the agency added. The IAEA confirmed Grossi's visit to Iran this week, without specifying the date in a post on X. It said the visit would include talks with Iran's foreign minister Abbas Araghchi. The agency also quoted Grossi as calling for "substantive progress" on a March 2023 deal that had outlined basic cooperation, including on safeguards and monitoring.

◆ UN atomic watchdog chief to arrive in Iran Wednesday: state media



◆ Russian President Vladimir Putin has signed off on a landmark defence pact with North Korea, a deal that comes amid reports that Pyongyang has despatched thousands of troops to fight against Ukraine. Putin struck the deal during a visit to North Korea in June, but it had to pass through Russia's parliament and signed by the Kremlin leader to come into force. The Kremlin published the signed law ratifying the treaty on its website on Saturday evening. The agreement formalises months of deepening security cooperation between the two nations, which were Communist allies throughout the Cold War. North Korea has become one of the most vocal and important backers of Russia's full-scale offensive on Ukraine. The deal obligates both states to provide military assistance "without delay" in the case of an attack on the other.

Arab, Muslim leaders fly to Saudi for talks on Mideast wars

Arab and Muslim leaders have begun arriving in Saudi Arabia for a summit scheduled for today that will focus on Israel's wars in Gaza and Lebanon, Saudi state media said. The Saudi foreign ministry announced the summit in late October during the first meeting of an "international alliance" pushing for a two-state solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. Attendees will "discuss the continued Israeli aggression on the Palestinian territories and the Lebanese Republic, and the current developments in the region," the official Saudi Press Agency said on Sunday. It comes one year after a similar gathering in Riyadh of the Cairo-based Arab League and the Jeddah-based Organ-

isation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) during which leaders condemned Israeli forces' actions in Gaza as "barbaric". The Saudi state-affiliated Al-Ekhabriya news channel broadcast footage on Sunday of Nigerian President Bola Tinubu and Lebanese Prime Minister Najib Mikati landing in Riyadh. Pakistani Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif was also scheduled to attend, the Pakistani foreign ministry said last week, adding that he planned to call for "an immediate end to the genocide in Gaza" and the "immediate cessation of the ongoing Israeli adventurism in the region". The 57-member OIC and 22-member Arab League include countries which recognise Israel and those firmly opposed to its regional integration.

Israel PM says okayed Lebanon pager attacks

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said yesterday he okayed a deadly September attack on Hezbollah communications devices which exploded in Lebanon, the first time Israel has admitted involvement.

Hezbollah had previously blamed its arch-foe for the blasts that dealt a major blow to the Iran-backed militant group, and vowed revenge. "Netanyahu confirmed Sunday that he greenlighted the pager operation in Lebanon," his spokesman Omer Dostri told AFP of the attacks.

Hand-held devices used by Hezbollah operatives detonated two days in a row in supermarkets, on streets and at funerals in mid-September. They killed nearly 40 people and wounded nearly 3,000, and preceded Israel's military operation in Lebanon.

Hezbollah began low intensity strikes on Israel in support of Hamas following its ally's October 7, 2023 attack on Israel which triggered the Gaza war. Strikes have intensified since war broke out in Lebanon in late September, when Israel escalated its air campaign against Hezbollah and later sent ground troops into south Lebanon.

US warplanes attack Iran-backed Huthi targets in Yemen: Pentagon

US warplanes staged multiple strikes yesterday night on Iran-backed Huthi advanced weapons storage facilities in Yemen, the Pentagon said. The facilities contained various weapons used to target

Deadly strikes on Gaza, Lebanon as Israel faces aid deadline

Israeli air strikes killed dozens of people in Lebanon and Gaza yesterday, rescuers and authorities said, ahead of a US deadline for improved aid delivery to the Palestinian territory. Rescuers in the Gaza Strip

said 13 children were among 30 people killed by Israeli strikes in the territory's north. The first strike early Sunday hit a house in Jabalia, killing at least 25 people including 13 children and injuring more than 30, Gaza's civil defence agency said. At around 6:00 am, "there

was a very huge explosion" at the Alouh family home, said relative Abdullah al-Najjar. "When we arrived here, all the bodies were torn apart," the distraught man added. After the strike in Jabalia, Israel's military said it hit "infrastructure" in which militants were operating and "posed a

threat" to troops in the area. "Prior to the strike, numerous steps were taken to mitigate the risk of harming civilians," a military spokesman said. Another strike on the Sabra neighbourhood of Gaza City killed five people, the civil defence agency said.

military and civilian vessels navigating international waters throughout the Red Sea and Gulf of Aden, according to information provided to AFP by the Pentagon.

The Huthi-run Al Masirah television network reported three American and British raids that targeted the capital Sanaa's southern Al Sabeen district. "Eyewitnesses said they heard intense flying, along with explosions in different parts of the capital Sanaa," Al Masirah said. The rebels say the strikes,

which have disrupted maritime traffic in a globally important waterway, target vessels linked to Israel and are intended to signal solidarity with Palestinians during the Gaza war. The attacks have seriously disrupted the Red Sea route

which carries 12 percent of global trade. In more than 100 Huthi attacks over nearly a year, four sailors have been killed and two ships have sunk, while one vessel and its crew remain detained since being hijacked last November.

Trump completes swing state sweep by taking Arizona

Donald Trump won the state of Arizona in this week's US presidential election, US TV networks projected on Saturday, completing the



Arizona swung red in the final result of the US presidential election, bringing president-elect Donald Trump to 312 electoral votes, well past the 270 needed for victory, while Democratic Vice President Kamala Harris lagged behind at 226

Republican's sweep of all seven swing states. After four days of counting in the southwest state with a large Hispanic population, CNN and NBC projected Trump had obtained its 11 electoral votes as he defeated Vice President Kamala Harris. Outgoing President Joe Biden scored a narrow but crucial victory in Arizona in 2020 that

condemned Trump to defeat after his first term in office. The scale and strength of Trump's comeback, which also saw the real estate tycoon win the popular vote by a margin of around four million votes, has sent shockwaves through the defeated Democratic Party. The Republicans have already regained control of the Senate and look well set to re-

tain a majority in the House of Representatives thanks to support from white working class voters and a large share of Hispanics. CNN has called Republican victories for 213 seats in the House, with 218 needed for a majority in the lower chamber. The networks' figures show Democrats on 205 seats, although senior party figures are still hoping they can pull off a slim victory that would significantly curtail Trump's powers. NBC sees the Republicans with 212 seats so far, and 204 for the Democrats. The other six swing states won by Trump in the presidential race are Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, Michigan, North Carolina, Nevada and Georgia. Biden's meeting with Trump will take place in the Oval Office, the White House said Saturday, with the clock ticking down to the ex-president's return to power.

Taiwan's commitment to climate action

Climate change has greatly affected countries around the world. As a member of the international community, Taiwan also faces serious challenges in this area. In recent years, we have witnessed the most severe drought in a century, intense rainfall, and devastating typhoons. President Lai Ching-te is promoting five key strategies for a net-zero transition. This involves initiating a second energy transition; accelerating development of renewable energy sources such as geothermal, hydrogen, biomass, and ocean energy; advancing a twin digital and green transformation of our industries, and shaping net-zero lifestyles. We are thus pressing toward a fair transition that leaves no one behind.

In June, Taiwan established the National Climate Change Committee under the Office of the President to address climate governance and international cooperation from the perspective of national development. The committee is focused on seven areas: pathways to net-zero, diverse green energy and carbon reduction technologies, the twin green and digital transformation, sustainable green lifestyles, a fair transition, green sustainable finance, and a sustainable homeland and adaptive resilience. The committee allows for better communication of the government's climate change response, accelerates policy implementation, and enhances public participation.

Taiwan is taking many steps to address climate change. In a demonstration of commitment to emissions reduction, it has incorporated the 2050 net-zero emissions target into the Climate Change Response Act. Meanwhile, legislation has been completed to establish a carbon fee system, similar to a global carbon tax, that will take effect in 2025. Companies will begin trial reporting in the middle of 2025 at an initial standard rate of approximately US\$10 per ton of carbon dioxide equivalent (tCO2e). The rate will be subjected to phased increases based on recommendations from the Carbon Fee Rate Review Committee and, by 2030, reach a level that mirrors international standards of between US\$40 and US\$60 per tCO2e. Taiwan has also pledged to launch an emissions trading system in the next four years that will further integrate it with global markets. These policies align with Article 6 of the Paris Agreement, which encourages international collaboration on climate action through market mechanisms such as carbon pricing to reach more ambitious climate goals.

The carbon fee is just the first step in Taiwan's carbon pricing system. Following on this, Taiwan will launch three major funds to stimulate development of green industries. The Green Growth Fund of NT\$10 billion will be established to encourage the growth of emerging domestic net-zero industries. Funding from the insurance and financial sectors will support the Green Finance Innovation Fund for long-term investments in energy-saving, net-zero, and resource-circular industries. Finally, the Taiwan Net-Zero Fund will work to meet domestic and international carbon reduction goals by partnering with domestic emissions-intensive industries, venture capital firms, and financial institutions to assess and invest in various carbon reduction technologies. This fund will also bring Taiwan's leading companies into global carbon reduction strategies, accelerate net-zero initiatives, and attract greater green investment. Such moves will enhance Taiwan's international competitiveness, are in line with Article 9 of the Paris Agreement, which calls for developed countries to mobilize climate finance from diverse sources, and will lay a solid foundation for Taiwan's sustainable development.

In terms of adaptation, Taiwan released its latest National Climate Change Science Report in May. This report provides foundational scientific data for local governments and ministries for use in short- and medium-term adaptation planning. It addresses the development of early-warning mechanisms and system monitoring to improve urban environmental resilience. A multilevel disaster prevention system will be established that incorporates disaster prediction, response, and recovery measures to enhance disaster response capabilities and build a nation that is resilient thanks to integrated disaster prevention, adaptation, and net-zero goals. This aligns with Article 7 of the Paris Agreement, which calls on all parties to promote and implement adaptation policies. Taiwan will continue to use early-warning systems and monitoring measures to refine national adaptation policies.

As a major economy and a hub for technological innovation, Taiwan's capabilities in renewable energy, climate adaptation, and low-carbon technological innovation can be of great help to global climate governance. Innovation and implementation will be critical drivers of climate action. With the advent of carbon pricing and the promotion of related innovative technologies, Taiwan will participate in global climate action through enhanced domestic policies and systems. We hope the international community will recognize that Taiwan is willing and able to contribute to global climate change efforts.

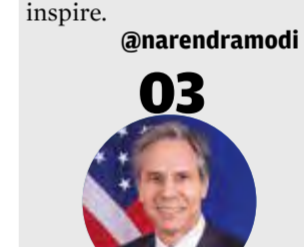

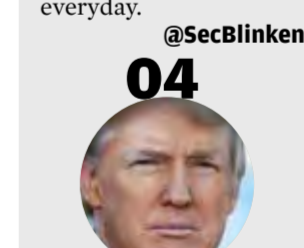

# Audi drives into China's EV future with new brand

German luxury carmaker Audi has introduced a new electric vehicle (EV) brand tailored for the Chinese market. Named simply "AUDI," this new brand results from a joint venture with Audi's long-standing Chinese partner, SAIC Motor Corporation.

The AUDI brand aims to cater specifically to younger, tech-savvy Chinese EV buyers. As part of the brand's launch,

Audi revealed its first concept vehicle, the AUDI E, an electric estate designed to appeal to these consumers.

According to reports, the Audi-SAIC joint venture will leverage Audi's design and engineering expertise, while SAIC brings rapid development and local market insights. Impressively, the first AUDI model was developed in just 18 months—half the usual timeline for a traditional Audi model.

Gernot Dollner, CEO of Audi, noted that this partnership

with SAIC establishes a strong base for "a new generation of advanced, intelligent vehicles, exclusive to China." He added, "Our joint platform enables us to address a promising yet challenging segment with state-of-the-art connected vehicles."

The AUDI E estate concept departs from Audi's signature four-ring emblem. Measuring 4,870 mm in length, 1,990 mm in width, and 1,460 mm in height, with a 2,950 mm wheelbase, the estate provides a spacious cabin.

Key features include four-wheel steering, air suspension, a single free-standing curved touch-screen, and individual seating for all four passengers.

The AUDI E is built on an 800V architecture with dual electric motors that deliver a combined output of 754 BHP and 800 Nm of torque. Equipped with a large 100 kWh battery pack, it offers a range of up to 435 miles (700 km) on a single charge (CLTC cycle). Fast-charging capability allows a 300 km range boost in just 10 minutes.

## Harley-Davidson's LiveWire unveils electric maxi-scooter

Harley-Davidson's electric sub-brand, LiveWire, has introduced its first electric maxi-scooter.

The new maxi-scooter is powered by LiveWire's S2 Arrow powertrain, initially launched on the LiveWire S2 Del Mar electric motorcycle. This powertrain integrates the structural battery, electric motor, and control hardware, using the same platform as LiveWire's electric motorcycle lineup.

LiveWire has also partnered with Taiwanese scooter manufacturer KYMCO for this pro-

Concept images of the LiveWire maxi-scooter have received positive reactions, and the new models are expected to debut in the first half of 2026.

## Renault set to relaunch 3rd Gen Duster in India

Renault is preparing to relaunch its popular Duster SUV in India, with the third-generation model set to hit the market next year. 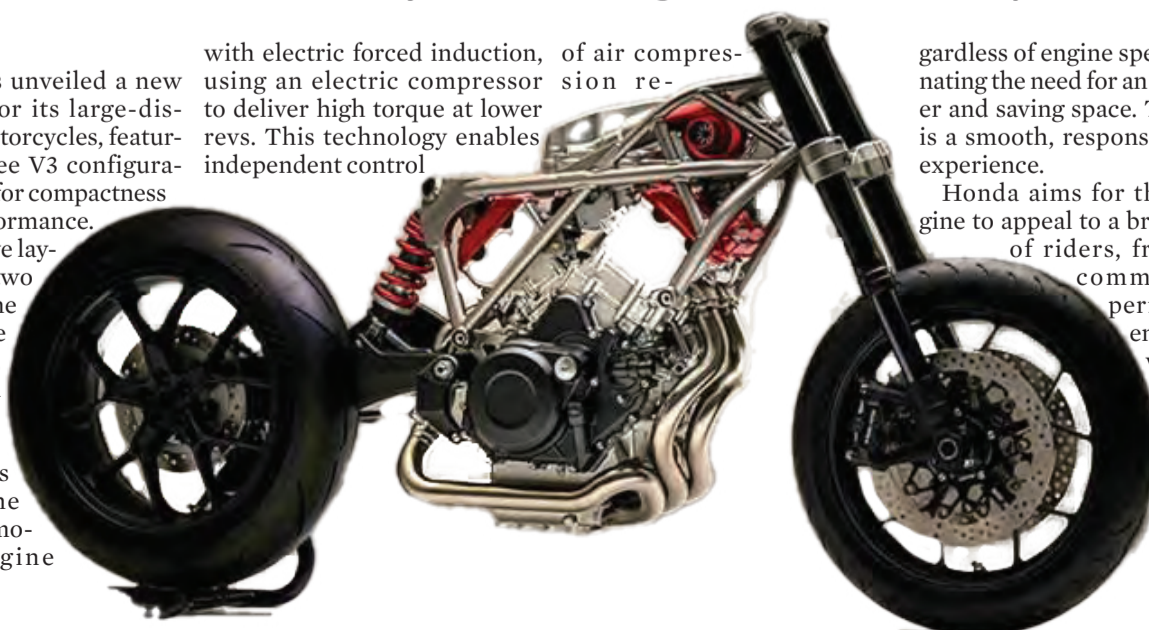
Honda's V3 is also the world's first motorcycle engine

with electric forced induction, using an electric compressor to deliver high torque at lower revs. This technology enables independent control

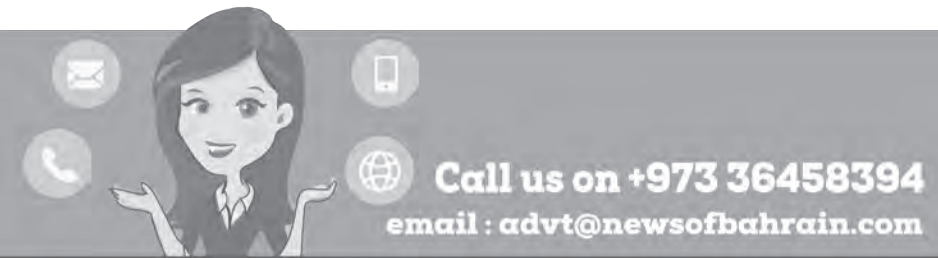
of air compression re-

Manchester United signed off Ruud van Nistelrooy's temporary stint in charge with a 3-0 win over Leicester on Sunday as Ipswich stunned Tottenham 2-1 for their first Premier League victory in 22 years.

Third-placed Nottingham Forest's fine run came to an end in a 3-1 home defeat to Newcastle.

Arsenal are aiming to kick-start their faltering title challenge later away at London rivals Chelsea.

Ruben Amorim will be in charge for the first time when United return from the international break.

But Van Nistelrooy was able to hand over the reins with a four-game unbeaten run since stepping up to replace the sacked Erik ten Hag.

Bruno Fernandes marked his 250th United appearance in style by smashing in his fourth goal in four games after a neat interchange of passes with Amad Diallo.

Fernandes' burst into the box also created the second goal as his glancing touch deflected off Leicester defender Victor Kris-

Arsenal and Chelsea both start the day 10 points behind leaders Liverpool and in desperate need of a win if they are to challenge for the title.
