

Saudi Arabia wins bid to host Fifa World Cup 2034



Riyadh

The International Federation of Association Football (Fifa) announced yesterday that Saudi Arabia has won the bid to host the Fifa World Cup 2034.

The announcement was made during Fifa's extraordinary general assembly meeting, held virtually.

Saudi Arabia will become the first country in history to solely host the largest edition of the World Cup, featuring 48 national teams competing across five cities. This follows Fifa's earlier

approval of the expanded tournament format.

The Kingdom formally submitted its bid for the tournament in July under the slogan "Growing. Together" outlining ambitious plans to host matches across 15 stadiums in five cities: Riyadh, Jeddah, Al Khobar, Abha, and NEOM, with an additional 10 hosting sites across the country.

These results reflect the provisional reconciliation of the data related to the application forms received.

The transaction comprised an offering of 38,181,818 shares at BD0.236 per share representing 35% of the company's total issued post-IPO share capital.

The IPO generated total demand of over 99 million shares or over BD23 million between both the professional and retail tranches.

The IPO is structured with 70% of the shares on offer allocated to professional investors (i.e., those applying for 1.5 million shares or more), while 30% of the shares have been allocated to retail investors (i.e., those applying for less than 1.5 million shares).

Applications for professional investors represented over 300% of the shares earmarked for this category, and applications for retail investors represented over 130% of the shares in the retail category.

The original fraud case involved the man posing as a faith healer who conned a Bahraini couple out of their wife's jewelry, two cars, a piece of land, and over BD100,000 in cash.
