
If an individual gets tested for the virus, he/she must report the result via 'BeAware' application, said a statement issued by the ministry yesterday.

GCC ambassadors and US envoy 'alarmed' over dangers of Iran nuclear programme

 Tehran continues efforts to destabilise regional security through support of terrorist militias

London

▼ ulf ambassadors met with US envoy to Iran Robert Malley yesterday where they reiterated security concerns regarding the Iranian nuclear programme.

Ambassadors of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) states and permanent representatives to international organisations in Vienna met Malley on the sidelines of international negotiations to revive a 2015 Iran nuclear deal, which resumed last week in the Austrian capital.

During the meeting, which was hosted by Saudi Arabia's ambassador to Vienna, Malley and GCC ambassadors reviewed the latest developments in the

"We called attention to our concern regarding Iran's continuous efforts toward destabilisation of regional security through its support of terrorist militias," Ambassador Prince Abdullah bin Khalid bin Sultan said in a tweet following the meeting.

Iran loses vote at UN over unpaid dues

Eight countries that include Iran, Venezuela and Sudan have lost their right to vote at the United Nations because of unpaid

A total of 11 countries are behind in their payments, Secretary General Antonio Guterres said in a letter to the General Assembly.

Under the UN charter, a member country's right to vote is suspended when its arrears equal or exceed the amount of dues it should have paid over the preceding two years.

If the outstanding debt is deemed to be "due to conditions beyond the control of the member," the assembly may let that country continue to vote.





K Prime Minister Boris Johnson yesterday offered "heartfelt apologies" for attending a lockdown-breaching party held in his Downing Street garden, but deflected calls to resign as the opposition leader called him a "man without shame"

Breaking his silence over the latest of a slew of allegations regarding top-level misbehaviour, Johnson said he regarded the boozy get-together in May 2020 as a work event for Downing Street staff. The British media dubbed the affair "partygate".

He added that he did not appreciate how it would look to millions of Britons who were respecting Covid rules, even missing out on farewells to dying relatives.

"And to them and to this House I offer my heartfelt apologies,' Johnson told a stormy session of questions in the House of Commons.

Keir Starmer, leader of the main opposition Labour party, dismissed the apology as "worthless" and mocked Johnson for belatedly speaking out after "months of deceit and deception".

"Is he now going to do the decent thing and resign?" Starmer said, demanding the Conservative leader's head for the first time and arguing: "The prime minister's a

Wreck of Taiwan's most advanced fighter jet found after crash

Taiwanese rescuers yesterday located the wreckage of a F-16V jet that crashed into the sea a day before, less than two months after the island launched the first squadron of its most advanced fighters.

The jet disappeared from radar screens around half an hour after taking off for a routine training mission from its base in southwestern Taiwan on Tuesday.

The air force said the jet plunged into the sea with no sign of the 28-year-old pilot ejecting in time.

The national rescue centre said wreckage of fuselage had been found but there were no signs of the pilot following an all-night search involving multiple helicopters, coastguard vessels and over 60 officials.

The incident has dealt a blow to the new squadron of US-made F-16Vs that was commissioned in November as Taiwan upgraded its ageing fleet amid rising tensions with China.

The airforce has temporarily grounded its entire F16 fleet.

Djokovic admits 'errors' as he fights to avoid Australian deportation

ovak Djokovic yesterday admitted "errors" in his travel papers and for not isolating after a claimed coronavirus infection, as he battled to stay in Australia and fight for a record 21st Grand Slam.

The world number one said his team had offered fresh information to the Australian government, which is pondering whether to cancel his visa, again, and throw him out of the country.
