 ${f B}$ ahrain welcomed yesterday the appointment of Dr Sultan Ahmed Al-Jaber, the UAE minister, as President-Designate of the 28th Conference of the Parties (COP28).

COP28 will be hosted by the UAE at Expo City Dubai from November 30 to December 12, 2023.

Dr Al-Jaber, the UAE Minister of Industry and Advanced Technology and Special Envoy for Climate Change, was named by UAE President HH Shaikh Mohammed bin Zayed.

Welcoming, Dr Mohammed Mubarak bin Daina, Bahrain's Oil and Environment Minister and Special Envoy for Climate Affairs, expressed confidence in the UAE's ability to host COP28 and its accompanying events.
