Weather depression to soak Bahrain

The Arabian Peninsula and L the Arabian Gulf will witness unstable weather patterns in the coming days influenced by a depression or low-pressure system, weather officials warn. During the past few days,

Bahrain was experiencing stable weather accompanied by north-westerly winds causing

temperatures to drop below the monthly average for January.

However, AlAvam, quoting unnamed sources at the Meteorological Department, said they expect cumulus rain clouds over the peninsula as the depression drags in the air from the surroundings.
