Kuwait finance minister steps down in latest political turmoil

The finance minister of Kuwait has resigned only three months after his appointment by the prime minister, state media said yesterday.

Manaf Al Hajeri's resignation comes against a backdrop of perpetual political turmoil in the only Gulf Arab state with a fully elected parliament.

The official KUNA news agency did not specify a reason for the resignation, and Al Hajeri was not immediately available to comment.

"A decree was issued in Kuwait accepting the resignation of Minister of Finance," the official Kuna news agency said.

UK Minister: Britain 'not Amazon' for **Ukraine weapons**

U^K Defence Secretary Ben Wallace sounded an off note in London's normally harmonious relationship with Kyiv yesterday, suggesting Ukraine should show more gratitude to its allies and griping Britain is not an "Amazon" for military supplies.

British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak denied that London was annoved by President Volodymyr Zelensky's lobbying at the NATO summit for more Western support.

Declaration of support as G7 vows long-term arms supplies to help Ukraine defeat Russia

krainian President Volodymyr Zelensky yesterday welcomed a commitment by G7 nations to support Ukraine for as long it takes to defeat Russia, insisting it was a step on the road to Kyiv eventually joining NATO.

"We will not waver," US President Joe Biden said in a speech in Vilnius aimed at showing resolve to Russia's President Vladimir Putin after meeting Zelensky at a NATO summit.

"Putin still doubts our staying power. He's still making a bad bet that the conviction and the unity among the United States and our allies and partners will break down."

Zelensky insisted that the leaders amounted to a "significant security victory" that he feated and peace restored.
