



Bahrain calls for Global action on Gaza ceasefire

Dr. Shaikh Abdullah bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for Political Affairs, called on the international community yesterday to take responsibility for de-escalating the situation in Gaza. He reiterated Bahrain's urgent call for a ceasefire, enhanced protection for civilians, and the facilitation of humanitarian aid.

Speaking at the ministerial coordination meeting in Madrid, Dr. Shaikh Abdullah highlighted the need to advance the two-state solution, resolve the ongoing conflict, and prepare for a high-level event at the 79th UN General Assembly. The meeting included key figures such as the Arab-Islamic Joint Ministerial Committee on Gaza, Arab League Secretary-General Ahmed Aboul Gheit, various European foreign ministers, and Josep Borrell, the EU High Representative for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy.

Dr. Shaikh Abdullah also advocated for support of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's initiative, endorsed by the 33rd Arab Summit, to host an international peace conference for the Middle East.

UNRWA says staffer killed in Israeli raid

The UN agency for Palestinian refugees said Friday one of its employees was killed this week during an Israeli raid in the occupied West Bank, the first such death in more than a decade. The agency, known as UNRWA, said the employee was "shot and killed on the roof of his home by a sniper", and that it was "the first time an UNRWA staff member has been killed in the West Bank in more than 10 years".

The incident took place in the Faraa refugee camp in the northern West Bank, the statement said.

US says new Apple AirPods can be hearing aids

Apple on Thursday got a green light from US regulators to add a feature that would let upcoming AirPods Pro ear pieces be used as hearing aids, potentially disrupting that market.

Earlier this week the company added AirPods Pro 2 to its lineup, touting a pending software upgrade that will let people test their hearing and then get assisted listening for everyday life as well as streaming online.

The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) on Thursday authorized the hearing aid feature for the devices, noting that a study showed users found them as beneficial as professionally fitted ones.

"Hearing loss is a significant public health issue impacting millions of Americans," said FDA acting director Michelle Tarver.

Apple's software "advances the availability, accessibility and acceptability of hearing support for adults with perceived mild to moderate hearing loss," Tarver added.

AirPods Pro 2 are priced at \$249, considerably lower than the average price of clinical-grade hearing aids, but those interested will need to adopt Apple's devices.

US finalises sharp tariff hikes on Chinese EVs, other goods

● **The US is imposing a 100% duty on electric vehicles and a 25% duty on EV batteries from China**

In two weeks' time, selling electric cars in the US will become a shocking affair for China. This means US consumers will have to shell out double the amount for purchasing already scarce Chinese-made electric vehicles.

The US is imposing a 100% duty on electric vehicles and a 25% duty on EV batteries from China, as announced in May. These steep tariff increases target key sectors including EVs, semiconductors, batteries, and solar cells—drawing a fiery response from Beijing.

It also comes ahead of November's presidential election, where both Democrats and Republicans are seeking to show a tough stance on China as competition between both countries intensifies.

"Today's finalized tariff increases will target the harmful policies and practices of the People's Republic of China that continue to impact American workers and businesses," said

Contemporary Amperex Technology Company Limited, or CATL, the Chinese manufacturer that is the world's largest producer of electric car batteries, said last month that it had developed a battery that could charge up enough in 10 minutes to allow a car to travel about 370 miles -- a major leap compared with the batteries used by established Western and Asian automakers, including Tesla.

US Trade Representative Katherine Tai in a statement.

Apart from tariff increases that take effect later this month including those on solar cells, the US Trade Representative's office confirmed that a 50% duty on semiconductors -- a sharp rise from before -- would start in 2025.

A 25% tariff on lithium-ion batteries that are non-EV take

place January 2026, said the USTR.

The tariff hikes on about \$18 billion worth of goods were taken after a review of levies imposed under then-president Donald Trump, which impacted some \$300 billion in goods from China. The moves this year impact both products already targeted by earlier Trump tariffs as well as additional ones.

But the Biden administration's moves go beyond tech for green energy, also impacting goods like cranes and medical products.

Tariffs on ship-to-shore cranes will rise to 25% this year, said the USTR.

But the final decision allows exclusions for Chinese cranes ordered before mid-May, if they are delivered before May 2026.

The move yesterday allows some reprieve to port operators, given that China dominates the industry while the United States works to rebuild its own capacity to produce port cranes.

Among medical products, the USTR said it would lift tariffs on medical face masks to 50% -- higher than a proposed level of at least 25%.

But it delayed the start of 50% tariffs to 2026, to give time for a shift away from Chinese sellers.

Levies would also impact items like medical gloves.

Yesterday, the US government also announced it would move to curb a surge in lower-value shipments entering without being subject to tariffs -- concerned about Chinese products entering with minimal scrutiny.

The trade rule is known as de minimis, and foreign shipments are eligible for exemption if the fair retail value of items imported is \$800 or less.

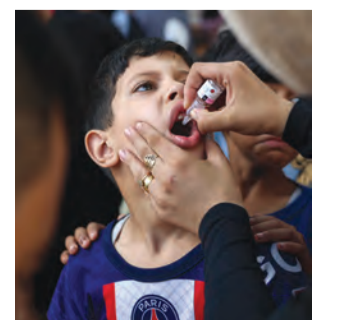
Gaza polio vaccination drive a 'massive success': WHO

The WHO chief hailed yesterday the success of the first phase of a giant polio vaccination campaign in war-ravaged Gaza after more than 560,000 children received a first dose.

"This is a massive success amidst a tragic daily reality of life across the Gaza Strip," Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus said on X, formerly Twitter.

Disease has spread with Gaza lying in ruins and the majority of its 2.4 million residents forced to flee their homes due to Israel's military assault -- often taking refuge in cramped and unsanitary conditions.

Fan dies during Al Shabab vs. Al Ahli Super Cup semifinal

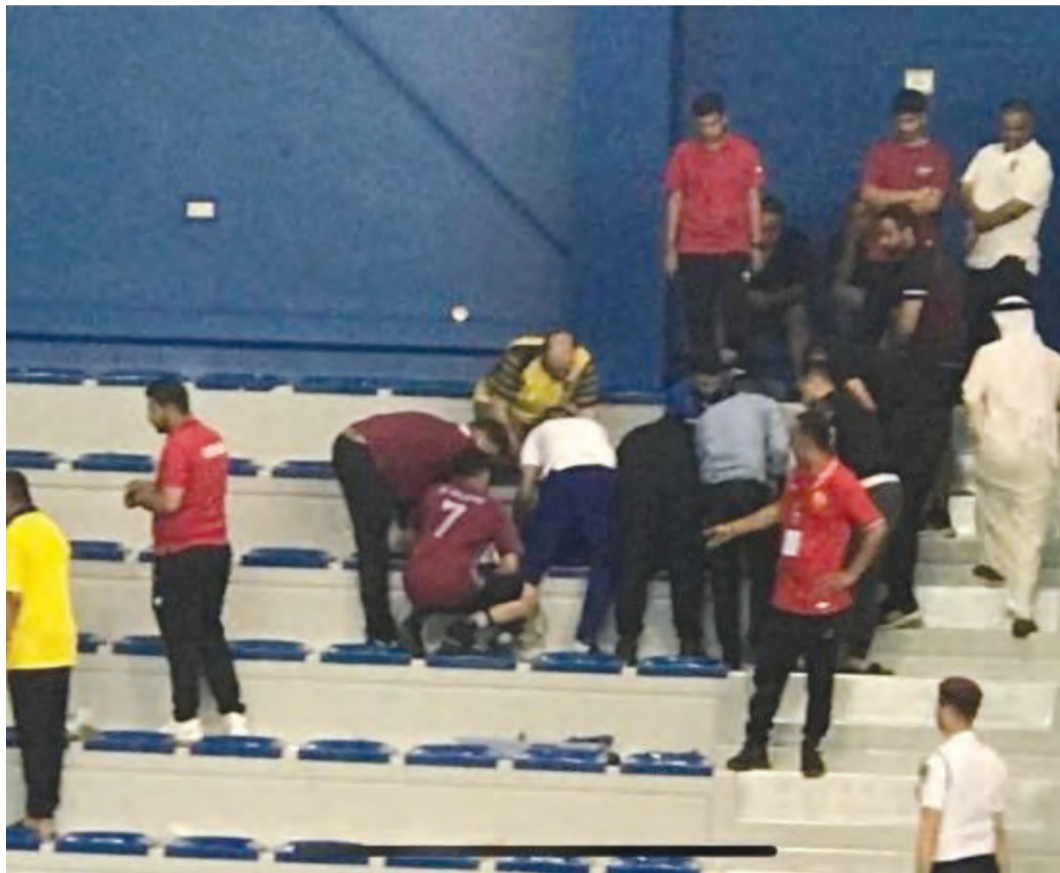

Kingdom urges immediate end to hostilities in Gaza

Bahrain has once again called for an immediate ceasefire in Gaza during recent talks with Palestinian officials. The discussions, led by Dr. Shaikh Abdullah bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for Political Affairs, concentrated on advancing the goals outlined in the "Bahrain Declaration" from the 33rd Arab Summit.

Dr. Mohammad Mustafa, the Prime Minister and Foreign Minister of Palestine, represented the Palestinian side in the meeting, which took place on the sidelines of the ministerial coordination meeting addressing the Gaza situation.

During the talks, Bahrain

explored several key issues, including enhancing civilian protection in Gaza, facilitating humanitarian aid, and promoting Bahrain's initiative to host an international peace conference for the Middle East. This conference aims to support the establishment of an independent Palestinian state with East Jerusalem as its capital, based on the two-state solution.

The meeting also included Shaikh Abdullah bin Ali Al Khalifa, Director-General of Bilateral Relations at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Meanwhile, the families of Palestinians killed in an air strike in the occupied West Bank city of Tubas held funerals on Friday after Israeli forces withdrew following their latest

raid in the territory. Violence in the Palestinian territory had already soared alongside the nearly 12-month-old war in Gaza but in late August Israel began large-scale raids that residents say marked an escalation.

A military statement said Israeli forces had "conducted a 48-hour counter-terrorism operation" in the areas of Tubas, Tamun and Faraa, killing "five armed terrorists" in an air strike and a sixth in "exchanges of fire" with "a terrorist that hurled explosive devices". Major Israeli operations in the West Bank are sometimes occurring "at a scale not witnessed in the last two decades," the United Nations human rights chief said this week.

Reckless driver, relentless battle

Disabled man wins BD8,500 in epic courtroom clash with insurance firm

- Court ordered the insurance company to pay BD8,500 plus 4% annual interest

- The insurance company claimed the driver had violated the policy, leading to a heated courtroom battle

- The court cited medical evidence of the victim's 15% permanent disability to justify the compensation

The High Civil Court delivered a decisive blow to an insurance company, ordering it to pay BD8,500, plus 4% annual interest and court expenses, to a man left with permanent disabilities after a tragic accident. The case unfolded after the insurance firm denied liability, leading to a fierce legal

battle.

The victim, a man in his thirties, had been left with life-altering injuries after a reckless driver jumped a red light and

crashed into his vehicle.

A court-appointed medical committee revealed the extent of the damage: tissue injuries to his left shoulder and elbow, a

fractured heel requiring surgery, and a 10cm scar on his left wrist, severely restricting its movement. The committee concluded that he had suffered a 15% per-

manent disability.

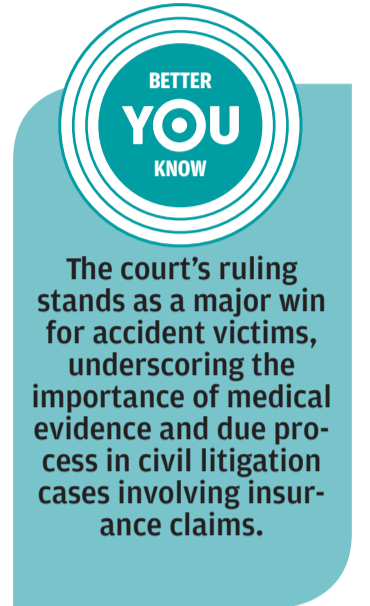
Initially, the victim had only requested BD1,000 in temporary compensation, with interest, while the case proceeded. However, after the criminal court found the reckless driver guilty and imposed a fine of BD1,000, the civil trial took another turn.

The insurance company stubbornly denied responsibility, arguing that the driver's actions violated the terms of the policy. But during cross-examination, the victim highlighted a crucial point—the driver had not appealed the criminal court's verdict.

Based on which, the victim increased his compensation claim to BD9,000, asserting that the accident had taken a toll on his physical health and ability to work.

The insurance company countered that the claim was excessive, but the victim stood his ground, even suggesting that the compensation should be doubled given the gravity of his injuries.

In the end, the judges sided with the victim. Armed with compelling medical evidence, they ruled that BD8,500 was a



fair compensation for his ordeal.

The court also imposed a 3% annual interest from the date of the claim and ordered the insurance company to cover the legal and medical committee fees, amounting to 90 Bahraini dinars.

This ruling, immediately enforceable, marked a significant victory for the victim, while the insurance company found itself facing both a hefty payout.

Three minutes of high-Octane drama

Heroic cop defuses tense standoff at gas station just in time

In a heart-stopping incident that has now gone viral, a police officer's quick thinking and calm demeanour defused what could have been a catastrophic situation at a gas station.

The dramatic video of the incident that appeared online, which has captivated netizens, shows the officer handling a highly dangerous scenario with remarkable poise.

The footage reveals a shirtless man, allegedly in a frenzied state, dousing the fuel station with gasoline while making threatening gestures.

As cars queued up, adding to the chaos, onlookers watched anxiously, fearing the worst.

With tensions rising by the second, the situation seemed perilously close to spiralling out of control.

For three minutes and 30 seconds, viewers are left on edge, holding their breath as the police officer attempts to de-escalate the situation. His approach is calm, measured, and deliberate—speaking softly to the man while assessing the unfolding danger.

According to Capital Police, the incident occurred two months ago, and the man, a 27-year-old, was reportedly in a delirious state during the confrontation. Authorities confirmed that the officer had tried every tactic to avoid provoking the suspect further, offering assistance and remaining patient.

Just when it seemed the situation might worsen, the video

captures the decisive moment: the officers swiftly move in, subduing the man before he can react. The quick intervention brought a collective sigh of relief from the crowd, ending the intense standoff safely.

Netizens have since lauded the officer's bravery and composure, with many calling it a textbook example of how to manage a volatile crisis.

Don't force parents to buy from 'exclusive' shops

Education ministry bans exclusive school supply sales, eases burden on parents

● Teachers can provide free guides or links for parents to print, but they cannot make them mandatory for students.

● The Ministry warns against unauthorized shops selling school-produced materials, pledging legal action against violators

In a move set to relieve parents across the Kingdom, schools have been officially banned from forcing families to purchase textbooks, revision guides, and other study materials from specific shops or stationery outlets.

The Education Ministry, in a bold new circular, also warned schools against selling these materials directly to students, cracking down on practices that

have long frustrated parents. Instead, teachers who create their own revision guides are now required to print and distribute them at no cost or simply provide a downloadable link for parents to print at home — entirely at their discretion.

Crucially, these booklets will remain optional, and the Ministry clarified that they will not influence student grades. "While these resources are helpful for daily revision, they should not be mandatory and must not impact student assessments, which will continue to follow the official curriculum," the circular emphasized. In a further warning, the Ministry revealed that some unauthorized shops have been producing and selling school materials without permission. It promised swift legal action against offenders, urging parents to steer clear of these materials.

Parents are also encouraged to report any schools violating these rules, with a dedicated whistleblowing email established at Whistleblowing@moe.gov.bh. The Ministry urged parents to include the name of the school and relevant staff involved in such incidents.

This latest action is seen as a step toward levelling the playing field for parents and easing the financial burden often associated with the back-to-school season.

Major upgrade planned for Prince Saud Al Faisal Highway

The Ministry of Works (MOW) is set to embark on a significant infrastructure upgrade with the appointment of a renowned international consultant for the development of Prince Saud Al Faisal Highway. The project will encompass Phase-1B and Phase-2 of the highway, alongside other key roadways, marking a major enhancement to Bahrain's transportation network.

According to the Tender Board document, the project has received bids from seven companies, all of which have been accepted. The bid amounts

range from BHD 3,780,507,500 to BHD 769,618,300. Among the bidders are Pan Arab Consulting Engineers, Egis International, and Parsons Global Services, along with several other firms.

The selected consultant will be responsible for conducting in-depth technical feasibility studies, creating concept and preliminary designs, and providing detailed design and tender assistance. A crucial component of the project includes designing a grade separator across the Shaikh Khalifa Bin Salman Causeway, aimed at easing traffic congestion, and planning footbridges at strategic

locations to improve pedestrian access.

In addition to the highway upgrades, the consultant will develop a Concept Masterplan for a new corniche north of Prince Saud Al Faisal Highway. This initiative will involve reclamation works to transform the area into a prominent recreational and scenic space, adding to Bahrain's public amenities.

This major undertaking is part of Bahrain's ongoing efforts to modernise its infrastructure and enhance urban spaces, reflecting a commitment to improving traffic flow, connectivity, and quality of life for its residents.

US and European stock markets extended gains, gold hit a record high and the dollar fell on Friday ahead of an expected US interest-rate cut next week.

More data this week suggesting the Federal Reserve was winning the battle against inflation provided an extra kick for global equities after recent drops caused by worries of a possible US recession.

Wall Street shares were up near midday deals while European markets closed in the green, a day after the European Central Bank cut its own rates for the second time this year as inflation cools.

Asia's main stock markets diverged as they closed out the week.

The price of gold struck an all-time high of \$2,583.45 per ounce, as lower interest rates

Investors are focused on the highly anticipated Fed meeting on Wednesday after data

this week showed US consumer inflation slowed more than expected in August to 2.5%.

Having slashed rates in the early months of the pandem-

ic, the Fed began hiking them in 2022 as inflation started to take hold, and they kept lifting until rates hit a two-decade high.

Now, with disinflation seem-

ingly kicking in and the labour market softening, decision-makers are tipped to start cutting again, with debate on whether it will be a 25 or 50-basis-point move.

"Fears that the Federal Reserve may have kept interest rates too high for too long, thereby risking an economic 'hard landing' have dissipated," said David Morrison, senior market analyst at financial services provider Trade Nation.

Markets had panicked last month after weak US jobs figures raised concerns that the world's economy could be heading towards recession.

Analysts said the odds of a 50-basis-point increase have risen this week.

"Gold is the ultimate inflation hedge, so it has received a boost from prospects of a 50bp rate cut from the Fed," said Kathleen Brooks, research director at XTB trading platform.

China to raise retirement age

China said yesterday it would gradually raise its statutory retirement age, as the country grapples with a looming demographic crisis and an ageing population.

Hundreds of millions of people in China are set to enter old age in the coming decades while the birth rate dwindles dramatically.

The national population fell in 2023 for the second year in a row, with policymakers and experts warning of severe impacts on the economy, healthcare and social welfare systems if action is not taken.

China's retirement age had not been raised for decades and had been among the lowest in the world.

State news agency Xinhua said top officials in Beijing had

retirement age will be extended "from the original 50 or 55 years to 55 and 58 years, respectively", depending on the type of job, Xinhua reported.

It said the retirement age would be gradually raised over 15 years from 2025, adding that from 2030, workers would need to make a minimum of 20 years of basic pension contributions instead of the current 15.

The new rules will allow Chinese people "to postpone retirement to an even later date if they reach an agreement with employers", Xinhua said.

They will take effect from January 1, 2025.

OpenAI releases reasoning AI with eye on safety, accuracy

ChatGPT creator OpenAI on Thursday released a new series of artificial intelligence models designed to spend more time thinking-- in hopes that generative AI chatbots provide more accurate and beneficial responses.

The new models, known as OpenAI o1-Preview, are designed to tackle complex tasks and solve more challenging problems in science, coding and mathematics-- something that earlier models have been criticized for failing to provide consistently.

Unlike their predecessors, these models have been

trained to refine their thinking processes, try different methods and recognize mistakes before they deploy a final answer.

The new release comes as OpenAI is raising funds that could see it valued around \$150 billion, which would make it one of the world's most valuable private companies.

Investors include Microsoft and Nvidia, and could also include a \$7 billion investment from MGX, a United Arab Emirates-backed investment fund, The Information reported. OpenAI CEO Sam Altman hailed the models as

"a new paradigm: AI that can do general-purpose complex reasoning."

UK to restrict junk food ads in childhood obesity fight

The UK will ban junk food advertising on the internet and daytime TV in a bid to tackle childhood obesity, sparking criticism on the political right over "nanny state" meddling.

The measure was included in the Labour manifesto that won Keir Starmer's Labour a resounding victory in July, and is due to be introduced on October 1, 2025, the government said Thursday.

The announcement came after Starmer promised wide-ranging reforms to the crisis-hit National Health Service (NHS), in particular by placing a greater emphasis on prevention.

Junior health minister Andrew Gwynne said in a written statement to parliament that more than one in five children in England are "overweight or



living with obesity by the time they start primary school" at age four or five. By the time they leave at aged

11, the figure is more than one third, he added.

"These restrictions will help protect children from being exposed to advertising of less healthy food and drinks, which evidence shows influences their dietary preferences from a young age," he said.

Advertising for foods that are too fatty, too sweet or too salty will be banned before 9:00 pm on television and completely online.

The ban was supported by the Conservative Party under Boris Johnson, who has talked about

his own struggles with weight gain, but was postponed to give manufacturers in the sector more time to adapt.

Others on the political right, however, criticised the move as an attack on individual freedom.

They included the Conservative-supporting Daily Mail, whose front-page headline Friday read "Nanny Starmer's ban on junk food ads 'to save NHS'".

"Keir Starmer ushered in a new era of the nanny state yesterday by unveiling plans for a pre-watershed ban on junk food advertising," it added.

The Labour government plans other interventions to ease the strain on the health system, such as banning high-sugar and caffeine energy drinks for under-16s.

Children's think-tank The Centre for Young Lives on Friday urged the government to "ignore 'Nanny State' critics and expand sugar taxes, ban (the) sale of energy drinks to under 16s, and roll out national supervised toothbrushing programme in schools."



In the UK, the term "junk food" was popularised by a 1972 BBC documentary called "The Junk Food Junkie," which highlighted the growing concerns about unhealthy eating habits and their impact on public health. This documentary played a significant role in raising awareness about the negative effects of processed and high-calorie foods, and it has since become a key reference point in discussions about diet and health in the UK

Ecuador prison chief killed, second this month: officials
The director of Ecuador's biggest prison was killed in an armed attack on Thursday, the second such killing in under two weeks in the Latin American country, the SNAI prison agency said. Maria Daniela Icaza, director of the infamous Litoral penitentiary in the port city Guayaquil died of injuries sustained "following an armed attack on the road" leading to the nearby town of Daule, the agency said. She died while being taken to hospital, the agency said in a WhatsApp message, adding that an official from the prison service who was travelling with her was injured in the incident. Ecuador's prisons are among the most dangerous in the world, and many have been taken over by drug gangs.

Japan scrambles fighter jets after Russian aircraft flew around the archipelago for the first time in five years, Tokyo said yesterday.
From Thursday morning to afternoon, the Russian Tu-142 aircraft flew from the sea between Japan and South Korea towards the southern Okinawa region, according to a defence ministry statement. They then travelled north over the Pacific Ocean and finished their journey off the northern island of Hokkaido, it added.

Spanish PM meets Venezuelan opposition figure amid tensions
Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez met Thursday with Venezuelan opposition candidate Edmundo Gonzalez Urrutia, who fled to Madrid over the weekend requesting asylum, as tensions mounted between Caracas and its former colonial ruler. The meeting came just hours after the head of Venezuela's parliament called for the suspension of ties with Madrid after Spanish lawmakers approved a non-binding motion urging Sanchez's government to recognise Gonzalez Urrutia as the "legitimate winner" of a July presidential election that gave strongman Nicolas Maduro a third six-year term.

Another rare Javan rhino calf spotted at Indonesia park

A new Javan rhino calf has been spotted in an Indonesian national park, the facility's head said yesterday, further boosting hopes for one of the world's most endangered mammals after two other sightings this year. The female calf, believed to be between three and five months old, was spotted in camera trap footage taken in May at Java's Ujung Kulon National Park, a find only made public Thursday by Indonesia's environment and forestry ministry. The mammal named Iris was seen walking with her mother, said Ardi Andono, head of the park. "This is positive news for the wider community that the Javan rhino is still sustainable," Ardi said yesterday. The park official said Iris, the third calf identified this year, was found after authorities deployed more than 100

camera traps across the national park in February. "We always use the assumption that every location has the same potential... to obtain the rhinos' photos," said Ardi. He said two more calves were spotted earlier this year at the park, which is the only habitat left for the critically endangered animal. After years of population decline, authorities believe there are 82 Javan rhinos left inside the 120,000-hectare sanctuary of lush rainforest and freshwater streams. The rhinos, which have folds of loose skin giving them the appearance of wearing armour plating, once numbered in the thousands across Southeast Asia but have been hard hit by rampant poaching and human encroachment. Activists have disputed official figures after authorities recently uncovered a poaching gang that claimed to have killed 26 rhinos since 2018.

Trump and Harris target key states

Presidential candidates ramp up campaigns in crucial swing states as election nears, neck-and-neck in polls

US presidential candidates Donald Trump and Kamala Harris head to key battleground states yesterday, each seeking an edge in a race where they are run-

ning neck-and-neck less than two months before voting day. Trump, 78, headed to Nevada, where his campaign says he will focus on delivering a message on the economy -- a key issue in this election, with US inflation slowing but still higher than most consumers are used to. Harris, 59, will be in perhaps the most crucial swing state, Pennsylvania, where earlier this week she debated Trump for the first time, landing several barbs that appeared to get under the Republican's skin. Voters will head to the polls on November 5, with both candidates in a dead heat according to most polls, including in the battleground states likely to decide the election under the United States' electoral college system.

Republican Trump, always an aggressive speaker, has turned up the heat on his rhetoric as Harris has closed the gap in recent weeks, taking aim at her with pointed insults and claiming

there is an ongoing "invasion" of migrants into the United States. At a rally in Arizona on Thursday, Trump called Harris a "lunatic" and accused the moderators of the debate earlier in the week of being biased against him. He also ruled out participating in another debate with the Democratic vice president. Hammering away at the key election issue of immigration, Trump repeated unfounded allegations against Haitian migrants in the Ohio town of Springfield, claiming they were eating residents' pets. If elected, the Republican candidate promised to fight illegal immigration with mass deportations, which drew chants of "USA! USA!" from his audience. In recent days, Trump has

frequently been seen with Laura Loomer, a radical right-wing activist who has been known to peddle unfounded conspiracy theories, including regarding the 9/11 terror attacks on the United States. She has hit out at Harris, whose mother is Indian, recently saying that in the event of the Democrat's victory, the White House would "smell like curry." "Turn the page" Harris has, so far, not responded to her rival's personal attacks. When Trump brought up the false story about pets being eaten by migrants in their televised debate on Tuesday, she responded by shaking her head disbelievingly. On Thursday, Harris delivered her well-honed stump speech in

North Carolina, another key battleground in the election. "It's time to turn the page" on Trump, she said, promising to defend the US middle class and women's reproductive rights. Harris entered the race unexpectedly after US President Joe Biden dropped out in July, following a disastrous performance in a televised debate against Trump. On Thursday, she insisted that she remained "the underdog" in the race. "We know ours will be a very tight race until the very end. We are the underdog. Let's be clear about that," she said. In a race that is neck-and-neck, the election is likely to come down to a few tens of thousands of undecided voters in battleground states.

North Korea releases images of uranium enrichment facility for first time

North Korea released images of its uranium enrichment facility for the first time yesterday, showing leader Kim Jong Un touring it as he called for more centrifuges to boost his nuclear arsenal. The country, which conducted its first nuclear test in 2006 and is under rafts of UN sanctions for its banned weapons programmes, has never publicly disclosed details of its uranium enrichment facility. Such facilities produce highly-enriched uranium -- which

is needed to produce nuclear warheads -- by spinning the material in centrifuges at high speeds. Kim toured the Nuclear Weapons Institute and the "production base of weapon-grade nuclear materials," the official Korean Central News Agency reported, without giving the location of the facility or the date of the visit. Kim "stressed the need to further augment the number of centrifuges in order to exponentially increase the nuclear

Myanmar battles Yagi floods as Vietnam begins clear-up

Hundreds of villagers in Myanmar waded or swam through chin-high waters, fleeing severe floods around the remote capital Naypyidaw yesterday, while Vietnam began clearing up after deadly Typhoon Yagi. People in parts of Vietnam, Laos, Thailand and Myanmar have been battling floods and landslides in the wake of Typhoon Yagi, which dumped a colossal deluge of rain when it hit the region last weekend. The overall death toll across the four countries stands at nearly 300, including 233 in Vietnam, but with many people missing it is expected to rise. More than 235,000 people have been forced from their homes in Myanmar, the junta said yesterday, piling further misery on the country hit by conflict since the military seized power in 2021.

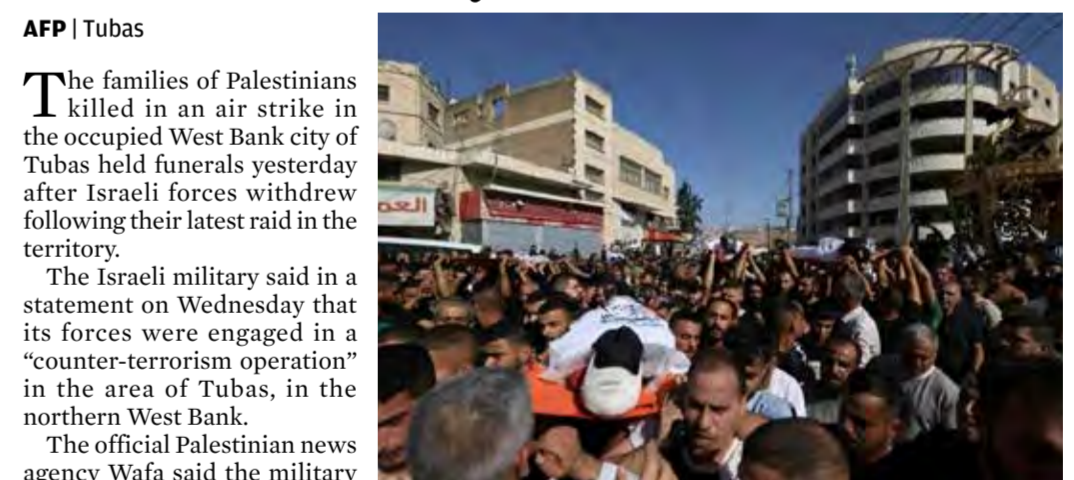
Spain hosts meeting on Israel-Palestinian two-state solution

Ministers from Islamic and European countries along with the European Union's foreign affairs chief gathered in Madrid yesterday to discuss how to advance a two-state solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. "Together, we want to identify the concrete actions that will enable us to make progress towards this objective," Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez wrote on social network X. "The international community must take a decisive step towards a just and lasting peace in the Middle East" Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez at the foreign ministry in central Madrid, hosted by his top diplomat Jose Manuel Albares. In attendance were Palestinian Prime Minister Mohammad Mustafa and the foreign ministers of Egypt, Jordan, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and Turkey -- all members of the Arab-Islamic Contact Group for Gaza -- as well as the heads of the Arab League and the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation. The European Union was represented by its foreign affairs chief Josep Borrell as well as the foreign ministers of Ireland, Norway and Slovenia in addition to Spain. "The implementation of the two-state solution is the only way to ensure a just and lasting peace in the region through the peaceful and secure coexistence of the state of Palestine and the state of Israel," Albares told a news conference. Asked about Israel's absence from the meeting, he said the country had not been invited because it belonged "neither to the group of Europeans nor to the Arab-Islamic contact group" but stressed he would be "delighted" if Israel took part in discussions on the two-state solution.

Raided West Bank city holds funerals after Israeli army withdraws

The families of Palestinians killed in an air strike in the occupied West Bank city of Tubas held funerals yesterday after Israeli forces withdrew following their latest raid in the territory. The Israeli military said in a statement on Wednesday that its forces were engaged in a "counter-terrorism operation" in the area of Tubas, in the northern West Bank. The official Palestinian news agency Wafa said the military withdrew Thursday evening, allowing the funerals to go ahead. The four men buried in Tubas yesterday were killed in an air strike at dawn on Wednesday, the Palestinian Red Crescent Society said. A fifth fatality from the same strike was buried yesterday in Tamoun, in the northern

IDF claims strike in Gaza kills multiple Hamas fighters

The Israeli Air Force (IAF), guided by intelligence from the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) and Israel Security Agency (ISA), carried out a targeted strike on Wednesday in central Gaza's Nuseirat area. The operation is claimed to have focused on a command center situated within a compound that previously served as the Al Jaouni School. According to IDF claims, the strike eliminated several Hamas members, including prominent figures involved in recent hostilities. Among the dead are individuals identified as UNRWA employees. Notable individuals killed in the strike include Muhammad Adnan Abu Zayd, claimed to be a Hamas operative and UNRWA employee responsible for mortar attacks, and Yasser Ibrahim Abu Sharar, claimed to be another Hamas member with ties to the UN agency. The operation comes amid escalating tensions, with claims that some of those killed participated in the October 7 attacks.

He already holds the most wins by a rap artist, and with 67 total nominations he is the second most nominated artist, only behind Madonna with 71.

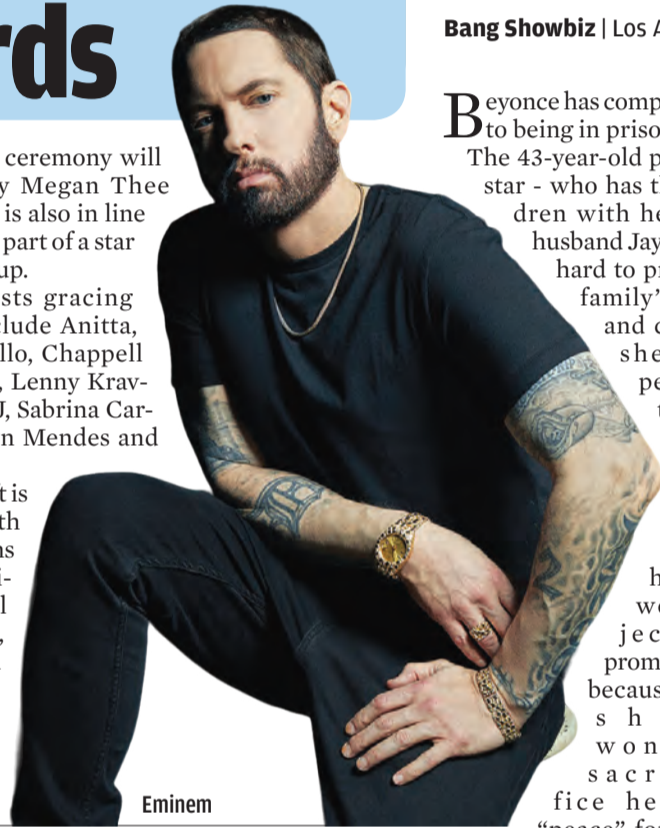

Justin Timberlake agrees plea deal following June arrest

Justin Timberlake has agreed a plea deal in his driving while intoxicated (DWI) case.

The 43-year-old pop star was arrested in Sag Harbor, New York, in June for allegedly driving while under the influence but his lawyer and prosecutors have reportedly reached an agreement that will see the initial charge dropped and the 'Mirrors' hitmaker accepting punishment for Driving While Ability Impaired instead.

Sources told TMZ Justin will be required to pay a \$300 to \$500 fine for the offence - which is not classed as drunk driving - and the exact amount will be set by a judge during a hearing on Friday (13.09.24), when the plea deal is officially before the court.

However, the 'Social Network' actor will

still have his driver's license suspended in New York, a standard year-long punishment after he refused to submit to a Breathalyzer test when he was pulled over by police.

During a previous hearing, Justin's attorney, Edward Burke Jr, denied the allegation and asked for the case to be dismissed outright, alleging that errors were made by the arresting officer.

Before his arrest, the singer enjoyed a meal with friends in The Hamptons.

Can Arsenal cope?

Arsenal have already blinked first in the title race to fall two points behind Manchester City and Liverpool.

The Gunners were held 1-1 at home by Brighton last time out after Declan Rice was harshly sent-off early in the second half.

Rice is therefore suspended for Sunday's north London derby to compound injury woes for Mikel Arteta.

Captain Martin Odegaard is expected to miss three weeks due to an ankle injury picked up on international duty with Norway.

New signing Mikel Merino

Erik ten Hag

is also absent from the Arsenal midfield with a shoulder injury.

However, there was some good news for Arsenal as Arteta signed a new three-year deal on Thursday.

"Together with the players and everyone at the club, we are looking forward to the coming years, with our supporters, who have emotionally transformed the club and the team," said the Spaniard.

Arteta has led Arsenal to second-place finishes in each of the past two seasons but he must come up with a masterplan to avoid leaving his side with an early mountain to climb in the title race.

A trip to the Tottenham Hotspur stadium kicks off a daunting run of three tough away games in eight days.

Afghanistan-New Zealand Test abandoned without ball being bowled

The one-off Test between Afghanistan and New Zealand was washed out yesterday after five days of rain, just the eighth Test in history to be abandoned without a ball being bowled.

Afghanistan's adopted home ground at Greater Noida, on New Delhi's outskirts, has been hit by persistent rain over the past fortnight, forcing officials

to call the match off without even staging the toss.

However, there were also question marks about the venue, which was hosting its first-ever Test and has only basic drainage and facilities.

Despite some sunshine on day one and two -- and increasingly desperate ground staff using electric fans -- the outfield remained soaked.

Afghanistan, who have

been a force in white-ball cricket and hammered New Zealand at the T20 World Cup in June, are unable to host international matches because of the security situation at home.

"To try and play Test matches at this time of the year is tricky," Afghanistan coach Jonathan Trott told reporters, referring to Indian monsoon season.

Leclerc bounces back from crash to top practice times for Azerbaijan GP

Ferrari driver recovers from early crash to lead second free practice session in Baku

● Leclerc outpaces Perez by 0.006 seconds

● Hamilton third for Mercedes, 0.066 off pace

● Verstappen, quickest in first practice, finishes sixth

● Ollie Bearman impresses, finishing tenth for Haas

Charles Leclerc recovered from a crash early in the day to top the times for Ferrari ahead of Red Bull's Sergio Perez in yesterday's second free practice on a day of incidents and accidents at the Azerbaijan Grand Prix.

Leclerc, who has taken pole three times before on the tricky Baku street circuit, had gone off early in opening practice, hitting the barriers at Turn 15 and his car incurring damage to the front right section.

He was unhurt and the Ferrari mechanics fixed the damage although he needed to pit early in second practice to fit a new power steering system.

This produced the odd sight of the Ferrari team forming a wall of bodies – like a team defending a football free-kick – to block vision of Leclerc's car as it was repaired.

He returned to clock a best lap in one minute and 43.484 seconds to outpace Perez, a two-time winner in Baku, by 0.006 seconds with seven-time champion Lewis Hamilton third for Mercedes, 0.066 off the pace.

Carlos Sainz was fourth in the second Ferrari ahead of McLaren's Oscar Piastri and three-time champion and

series leader Max Verstappen, who was quickest in opening practice, in the second Red Bull.

His title rival Lando Norris struggled for a clear lap and was only 17th in the second McLaren, his best lap undone when he came upon Pierre Gasly's Alpine and had to abort.

"I'm sorry," said Gasly. "I had a prob-

lem with the battery."

Lance Stroll was seventh for Aston Martin ahead of Haas's Nico Hulkenberg and George Russell in the second Mercedes, who had an inter-session engine change.

Behind them in tenth came young Briton Ollie Bearman in the second Haas.

The 19-year-old, who finished seventh on his F1 debut for Ferrari in Saudi Arabia as a replacement for Sainz, is racing in Baku in place of the suspended Kevin Magnussen whose seat he will take full-time next season.

After an overcast opening session, second practice began in warm conditions which continued to cause problems for the drivers.

Leclerc reported steering problems, following an escape road excursion, and Sainz skimmed the barriers while Verstappen slid to a halt at Turn Five to avoid hitting a wall, later complaining about visibility problems with the setting sun.

Russell was detained at Mercedes as the team changed his engine. When he rejoined the session he was soon recalled to the pits due to an unidentified issue.

Mbappe, Vinicius unaffected by criticism: Madrid coach

Real Madrid coach Carlo Ancelotti said strikers Kylian Mbappe and Vinicius Junior were not letting critics weigh them down after an underwhelming start to the season.

New arrival Mbappe netted a brace in his last outing for the club following three La Liga games without a goal, while Vinicius has one strike in the opening four matches.

"They don't seem affected to me, they are training well, happy. Kylian is progressing each day," Ancelotti told a news conference yesterday.

"Many forget they started pre-season in the middle of August... they didn't have

a pre-season, they have improved their fitness with games. They seem very well to me, and happy."

French superstar Mbappe joined Madrid at the end of his Paris Saint-Germain contract this summer and Ancelotti is

still working out how to get the best from the forward, who like Vinicius, prefers to drift in from the left.

Thus far Mbappe has started in the middle with Vinicius in his preferred position, but the Brazilian has lacked spark.

"(Vinicius is) not at his best but he's still very important for us," continued Ancelotti.

"The last thing I'm worried about is the state of Vinicius, he always works well, it's just a question of time before he's at his best.

"When a player is not 100 percent, the important thing is that he gives all he can."

Real Madrid face Real Sociedad on Saturday in La Liga ahead of their first Champions League match this season, against Stuttgart at home on Tuesday.

Guardiola 'happy' Man City hearing finally set to start

Manchester City manager Pep Guardiola said he is pleased that the club's long-awaited hearing into 115 charges brought by the Premier League is set to start on Monday.

City face 80 breaches of financial rules between 2009 and 2018, plus a further 35 of failing to cooperate with a Premier League investigation.

The English champions stand accused of failing to provide accurate financial information between 2009 and 2018, including revenue from sponsors and salary details of managers and players.

City have vehemently denied

any wrongdoing and Guardiola has backed his superiors when pressed about the charges in the past.

"Start soon, and hopefully finish soon," Guardiola said of the hearing at his pre-match press conference yesterday ahead of Brentford's trip to the Etihad. "I am looking forward to the decision.

"I'm happy it's starting on Monday. I know there will be more rumours, new specialists about the sentences.

"We're going to see. I know what people are looking forward to, what they expect. I know what I read for many, many years. Everybody is innocent until guilt is proven. So we'll see."

Messi set to return after two-month lay off

Lionel Messi is set to return to action with his club Inter Miami on Saturday after spending over two months out with an ankle injury, Miami coach Gerardo Martino said yesterday.

"Yes, he is fine," Martino said before Lionel Messi

Inter Miami, who lead the Eastern Conference and are top of the overall standings, host the Philadelphia Union on Saturday.

Messi injured his right ankle dur-

ing the final of the Copa America on July 14 when he helped Argentina to victory over Colombia.

He has missed eight MLS games for his club and this month's World Cup qualifiers for his country.
