Royal leadership vows to sustain Bahrain progress

15 left dead in Israeli strike on school shelter

Gaza's civil defence agency said Israeli shelling late yesterday had killed at least 15 people at a school serving as a shelter for displaced Palestinians in central Gaza's Nuseirat camp.

The vast majority of the besieged Gaza Strip's 2.4 million people have been displaced at least once by the war, sparked by Hamas's October 7 attack on Israel, with many seeking shelter in school buildings.

"The Al-Mufti school was bombarded with a large volley of Israeli artillery, resulting in an initial death toll of 15 martyrs, including children, women and entire families, and 50 wounded," said Mahmud Bassal, spokesman for the agency.

"This school shelters hundreds of displaced people from different families, including some from Gaza, the south, and various parts of the Gaza Strip."

Renewing a Nation

His Majesty King Hamad lays the outline for the Kingdom's future in key address

Shaping Bahraini national identity for a new era was the focus of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's address to parliament yesterday, as he opened the new legislative session and emphasised the balance between openness and security.

The event unfolded at the Isa Cultural Centre and drew the attendance of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

As HM the King arrived, he was received warmly by the Speaker of the Representatives Council, Ahmed bin Salman Al Musallam, and the Chairman of the Shura Council, Ali bin Saleh Al Saleh.

Following the national anthem, a recitation from the Holy Quran set a solemn tone for the proceedings.

In his address, HM King Hamad stated: "With God's blessing, we begin the third session of the National Assembly in its sixth term, marking a new phase in parliamentary life. Your esteemed council strives to uphold constitutional traditions and enhance the legislative process in line with our national interests."

National interests

Council of Representatives resumes session; newly elected MP Abdulwahid Qarata sworn in to office

The Council of Representatives resumed its latest session yesterday, with intense competition for key committee leadership roles adding a layer of intrigue to the proceedings.

Newly elected MP Abdulwahid Qarata quietly took his oath of office, stepping in for Mohammed Al Hussaini, who lost his seat in July due to dual citizenship.

The Financial and Economic Affairs, Foreign Affairs, and Services committees are central to this power struggle, as several MPs seek control.

Leadership

While Mahmood Fardan and Mohammed Al Balushi are expected to take the reins of the Legislative and Public Utilities committees, respectively, elections for the remaining committees are highly contested.

The Financial, Foreign Affairs, and Services committees are particularly desirable, with considerable competition brewing.

Speaker Ahmed Al Musallam, during the initial 20-minute procedural meeting of the sixth legislative term, expressed gratitude to His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa for opening the session and setting the agenda for parliamentary work.

All members were present except Mohsen Al Asbool.

The Council approved a statement expressing optimism for the months ahead.

Al Musallam regarded HM the King's address as a guide for the Council of Representatives, steering the formulation of legislation that supports sustainable development.

Focus

Proposal aims to equalise social insurance benefits

The Speaker of the House of Representatives, Ahmed Al Musallam, has referred a draft law to the Services Committee aimed at equalising social insurance benefits between the private and public sectors concerning replacement loans.

The proposal seeks to allow retirees from both sectors to qualify for a replacement loan every two years.

Currently, public sector retirees can renew their replacement loan every two years from the date of their last replacement.

In contrast, private sector retirees face a longer waiting period, as they can only renew their loan two years after paying off the last installment of their previous loan, which many consider excessive.

The conditions for replacement differ significantly between the two sectors.

Replacement

In the private sector, according to Decision No. 1 of 2002 concerning the conditions and situations of replacement, it states: "A pensioner may not

apply for a replacement again until at least two years have passed since the payment of the last installment of the previous replacement."

Conversely, Article 78 of Law No. 13 of 1975 concerning the organization of pensions and retirement benefits for government employees specifies that "replacement may only occur once every two years from the date of the last replacement," enabling public sector retirees to benefit more frequently.

The proposal's explanatory memorandum highlights that private sector retirees currently do not enjoy the same level of access to this insurance service as their public sector counterparts.

Social protection

The goal of the proposal is to achieve necessary social protection for citizens, equalise the benefits for retirees from both sectors, and contribute to improving the living standards of Bahraini citizens.

Additionally, it aims to enhance the income of the Social Insurance Organization through the interest generated from replacement loans.

3rd Cityscape Bahrain set for next month

Grandmother granted custody of granddaughters

The High Appeals Sharia Court has restored the custody rights of a grandmother (the mother of their mother) over her two granddaughters, prioritizing the best interests of the children.

This decision comes after the court found that the children's mother, who had lost custody, was living in a separate residence.

The case details reveal that the grandmother gained custody of the children after the mother was deemed unfit.

However, she was taken by surprise when the children's father and his mother (their grandmother) filed a lawsuit seeking to revoke her custody.

They argued that the children were initially placed in the grandmother's care while their mother resided with her after being released from prison, which formed the basis of their claim.

In an earlier ruling, the lower court awarded custody to the father's mother, citing the mother's loss of custody due to her unfitness and the grandmother's (the mother of their mother) acknowledgment of the mother living with her at that time.

However, the court found no evidence to support this assertion.

Sarah Ibrahim, the grandmother's (the mother of their mother) attorney, stated that her client contested the lower court's ruling, clarifying that the mother now lives in a separate home.

BD29,000 compensation for traffic accident victim

The High Civil Court has awarded BD29,000 in compensation to an Asian man who suffered a 50% permanent disability after a leg amputation resulting from a traffic accident.

The compensation covers both the victim and his family.

According to the victim's lawyer, Zahraa Al Widaei, the accident occurred in September 2023 in the Tashan area.

The defendant, while reversing his vehicle without due care, collided with the plaintiff, who



was stopped behind another car.

The impact caused the plaintiff to become trapped between two vehicles, resulting in severe injuries including fractures and a severed femoral vein.

Surgical intervention necessitated the amputation of his right leg. Medical boards assessed the resulting permanent disability at 50%.

Ms Al Widaei explained that the plaintiff and his family were entitled to pursue compensation directly from the insurance

company under the Compulsory Insurance Law No. 3 of 1987 (amended by Law No. 7 of 1996).

The court considered the criminal court's findings regarding the defendant's negligence, which established the basis for both criminal and civil liability.

The court also accepted the medical board's assessment of the plaintiff's injuries and the causal link between the defendant's negligence and the resulting harm.

The plaintiff initially sought BD30,000 in compensation.

News in brief

◆ **US President Joe Biden** is expected to visit Germany next week, a government source said Sunday, after a previously planned trip was cancelled due to Hurricane Milton. "He's coming to Berlin on Friday" for a one-day visit, the source said. According to German media reports Biden will meet German Chancellor Olaf Scholz and President Frank-Walter Steinmeier, with the conflicts in Ukraine and the Middle East expected to be high on his agenda. Biden's original visit to Germany was to have taken place between October 10 and 12 and to have included a four-way summit with Scholz, French President Emmanuel Macron and British Prime Minister Keir Starmer. He had also planned to travel to Angola immediately afterwards as part of a series of valedictory international trips in the final months of his presidency, after he withdrew from the race in July.



Biden expected to visit Germany on Friday: govt source

◆ **Russia yesterday** said it has captured another east Ukrainian village as it closes on the important city of Pokrovsk, where its forces have been advancing for weeks. Russian troops have moved westwards in the Donetsk region for months, with Kyiv saying this weekend that the situation was "very difficult." Moscow's defence ministry said its forces have now taken Mykhailivka, at the gates of the town of Selydove, and south of Pokrovsk. Selydove has been badly damaged by months of shelling and seen most of its population flee. Russia has been trying to capture Pokrovsk - a mining town that was home to some 60,000 people before Moscow launched its offensive. It has been claiming east Ukrainian villages for months.

◆ **Taiwan said it was** "on alert" as it detected a Chinese aircraft carrier group to its south on Sunday, days after the United States warned Beijing against taking "provocative" actions on the self-ruled island. US State Secretary Antony Blinken warned China on Friday against taking action in response to a speech by Taiwanese President Lai Ching-te during the island's National Day celebrations. China has ramped up military activity around Taiwan in recent years, sending in warplanes and other military aircraft while Chinese ships maintain a near-constant presence around its waters. Taiwan's defence ministry said Sunday that a Chinese Liaoning aircraft carrier group had entered the Bashi Channel, a waterway that separates the island from the Philippines, "and is likely to proceed into the western Pacific".

◆ **Senior politician in India's** financial capital Mumbai was shot dead on Saturday, weeks ahead of key state elections, with police probing the role of a notorious crime gang. Baba Siddique, 66, a local lawmaker and former minister in Maharashtra state, was shot multiple times in the chest outside his son's residence in Mumbai, Indian media reported. "The incident will be thoroughly investigated and strict action will be taken against the attackers," Pawar said in a statement. "The mastermind behind the attack will also be traced." Maharashtra's deputy chief minister Ajit Pawar, from the same party as Siddique, said he was "shocked" by the "cowardly attack". The Hindustan Times newspaper reported that two suspected attackers had been arrested, and police were searching for another. Broadcaster NDTV said the two suspects claimed they were part of a gang run by Lawrence Bishnoi, who is in jail accused of running a crime gang that has carried out multiple killings. The shooting comes just weeks after Siddique's security detail was upgraded after he received death threats, and ahead of elections slated for later this year. UN peacekeepers in Lebanon said Israeli tanks broke through a gate to enter a Blue Helmet position in Lebanon Sunday, after blocking their movement the previous day. "At around 4:30 am (0130 GMT), while peacekeepers were in shelters, two IDF (Israeli military) Merkava tanks destroyed the position's main gate and forcibly entered the position" in the Ramia area of southern Lebanon, the UNIFIL peacekeeping mission said. "They requested multiple times that the base turn out its lights. The tanks left about 45 minutes later after UNIFIL pro-

tested through our liaison mechanism." A little over two hours later, peacekeepers reported "the firing of several rounds 100 metres (yards) north, which emitted smoke". "Despite putting on protective masks, 15 peacekeepers suffered effects, including skin irritation and gastrointestinal reactions, after the smoke entered the camp," it said, adding they were receiving treatment. On Saturday, Israeli soldiers "stopped a critical UNIFIL logistical movement near Mais al-Jabal, denying it passage", the force said, referring to an area in south Lebanon. UNIFIL asked for explanations from the Israeli army over what it said were violations against their force. "We have requested an explanation from the IDF from these shocking violations," UNIFIL said. "For the fourth time in as many days, we remind the IDF and all actors of their obligations to ensure the safety and security of UN personnel." A UNIFIL spokesman told AFP on Saturday that the mission would stay in place despite five of its peacekeepers being wounded and damage to their facilities in the war between Israel and Lebanese militant group Hezbollah. UNIFIL said Israeli tank fire on Thursday caused two Indonesian peacekeepers to fall off a watch tower in Naqura.

Red Cross says strike injured paramedics on rescue mission

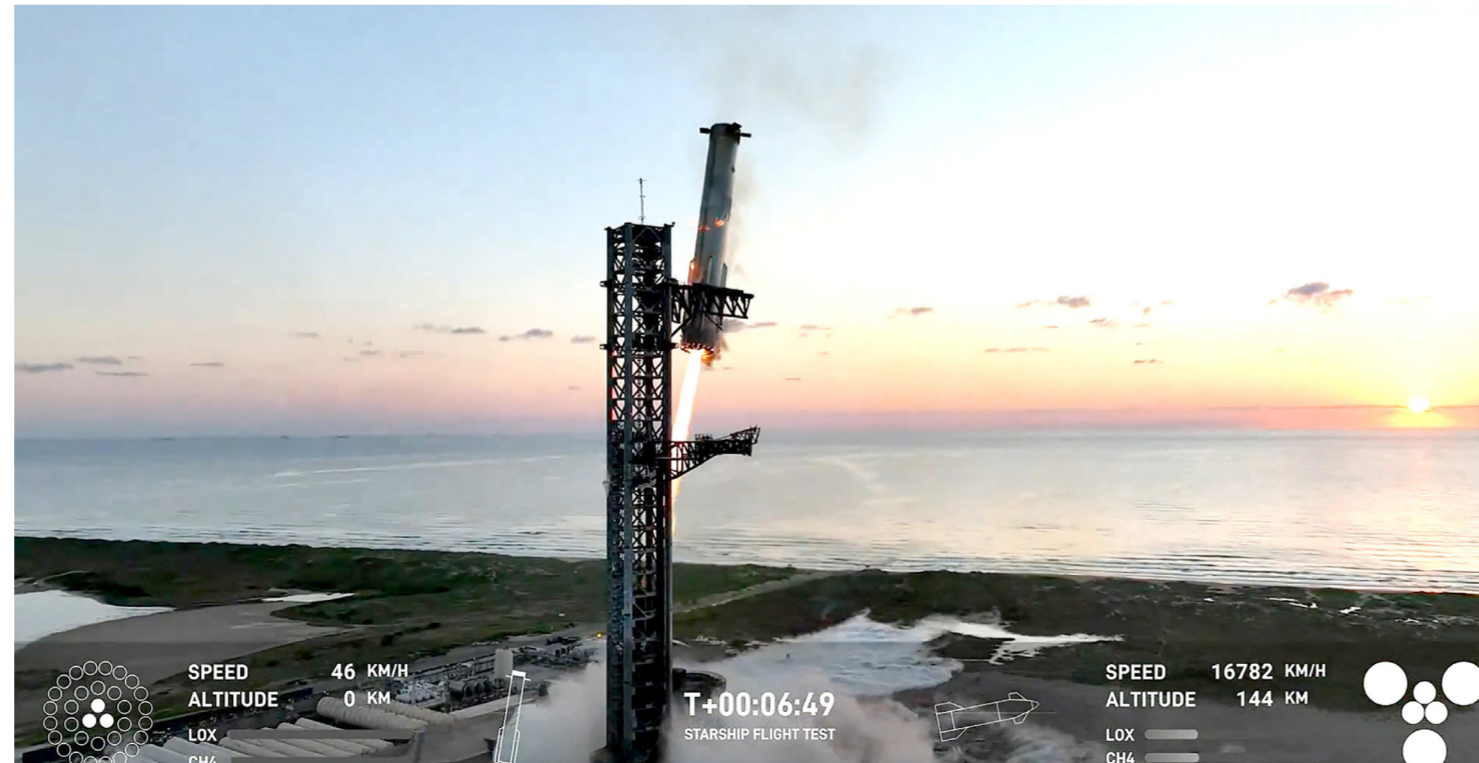

The Lebanese Red Cross said its paramedics were hit by a strike on Sunday while attending the site of an earlier attack in the south, leaving them lightly injured. "Following the air strike on a house in Sirbin... Lebanese Red Cross ambulance teams were dispatched to the scene in coordination with" UN peacekeepers, the Red Cross said in a statement. "As the team was searching for casualties to rescue, the house was hit for a second time resulting in concussions to the volunteers and damage to the two ambulances," it said, adding the paramedics had sustained light injuries. In another development, Israel's Defence Minister Yoav Gallant yesterday vowed to prevent Hezbollah from returning to fighting positions along the border, even after the Israeli military withdraws from the area. Hezbollah said its fighters had engaged in "violent clashes" for nearly an hour on Sunday at a Lebanese border village, as incursions increased two weeks into Israel's ground operation. Iran FM says 'no red lines' Iran's top diplomat said Sunday there would be "no red lines" in defending the country's people and interests, but efforts would continue to "contain an all-out war in our region". "While we have made tremendous efforts in recent days to contain an all-out war in our region, I say it clearly that we have no red lines in defending our people and interests," Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi posted on X. The Israeli military on Sunday called on residents of more than 20 villages in south Lebanon to evacuate their homes, as troops expanded their ground operations against Hezbollah across the border.

In a first, SpaceX 'catches' megarocket booster after test flight

SpaceX successfully "caught" the first-stage booster of its Starship megarocket yesterday as it returned to the launch pad after a test flight, a world first in the company's quest for rapid reusability. The "super heavy booster" had blasted off attached to the Starship rocket minutes earlier, then made a picture-perfect controlled return to the same pad in Texas, where a pair of huge mechanical "chopsticks" reached out from the launch tower to bring the slowly descending booster to a halt, according to a livestream from Elon Musk's SpaceX company. "Folks, this is a day for the engineering history books," a SpaceX spokesperson said in a voiceover on the company's livestream, after the booster was safely in the tower's grasp and company staffers had erupted in cheers. "The tower has caught the rocket!!" SpaceX founder Musk posted on X. Liftoff occurred at 7:25 am (1225 GMT) in clear weather. While the booster returned to the launchpad, the upper stage of Starship was due to splash down in the Indian Ocean within the

hour. During its last flight in June, SpaceX achieved its first successful splashdown with Starship, a prototype spaceship that Musk hopes will one day carry humans to Mars. NASA is also keenly awaiting a modified version of Starship to act as a lander vehicle for crewed flights to the Moon under the Artemis program later this decade. SpaceX said its engineers have "spent years preparing and months testing for the booster catch attempt, with technicians pouring tens of thousands of hours into building the infrastructure to maximize our chances for success." Teams were monitoring to

ensure "thousands" of criteria were met both on the vehicle and at the tower before any attempt to return the Super Heavy booster. Had the conditions not been satisfied, the booster would have been redirected for a splashdown in the Gulf of Mexico, as in previous tests. Instead, having been given the green light, the returning booster decelerated from supersonic speeds and the powerful "chopstick arms" embraced it. "Fail fast, learn fast" The large mechanical arms, called "Mechazilla" by Musk, have generated considerable excitement among space enthusiasts. Starship stands 397 feet (121 meters) tall with both stages combined -- about 90 feet taller than the Statue of Liberty. Its Super Heavy booster, which is 233 feet tall, produces 16.7 million pounds (74.3 Meganewtons) of thrust, about twice as powerful as the Saturn V rockets used during the Apollo missions. "SpaceX's 'fail fast, learn fast' strategy of rapid iterative testing, even when its rockets blow up spectacularly, has ultimately accelerated development and contributed to the company's success. Founded only in 2002, it quickly leapfrogged aerospace industry giants and is now the world leader in orbital launches, besides providing the only US spaceship currently certified to carry astronauts. It has also created the world's biggest internet satellite constellation -- invaluable in disaster and war zones. But its founding vision of making humanity a multiplanetary species is increasingly at risk of being overshadowed by Musk's embrace of Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump and his alignment with right-wing politics. In recent weeks, the company has openly sparred with the Federal Aviation Administration over launch licensing and alleged violations, with Musk accusing the agency of overreach and calling for its chief, Michael Whitaker, to resign. "He's trying to position himself for minimal regulatory interference with SpaceX once Donald Trump becomes president," said Mark Hass, a marketing expert and professor at Arizona State University. "But it's a calculated gamble if things go the other way."

Acquisitions and mergers (A&Ms)

Business activities, sometimes face extreme difficulties as pandemics, lockouts, Gov. restrictions, lack of logistics and many others. Such instances may affect business or hold it at stand. This de facto situation puts some businesses on the verge of collapse. There is urgent need for brave positive actions to maintain the status quo of your entities. Stretching hands and working together could open a room for survival and sustainability.

Consolidation and amalgamation of companies is a good possible opportunity to face difficulties. As a rule, this could take place either by the process of acquisition or otherwise by merger-ship. There were good examples for acquisition in Bahrain, in the banking sector, as legally approved by CBB and without affecting the trading rules governing fair competition. Consolidation by acquisition shall be effective through certain formalities to be taken in application. The first step is to adopt a resolution to order dissolution of the company and accordingly its non-existence as a legal entity. This is required, so as to pave the way for the new company to be incorporated. The company, to be part in consolidation process, shall take all necessary steps for the valuation of its net assets according to the provisions in the law and to be followed as in cases regarding the valuation of shares in kind. The acquiring company should adopt a resolution that orders for increasing its capital in accordance with the result of the valuation of the acquired company. That is to say, to increase its capital to absorb the valuation of the newly joining company.

The increase in the capital of the acquiring company shall be distributed among the partners and or shareholders proportionately to their equity shareholding. This, of course, includes all existing partners and or shareholders. If the stocks of the company were represented by shares and two years have expired from the incorporation of the acquiring company, these shares could be negotiated immediately after their issue. A number of shares or stocks shall be allocated to each consolidating /amalgamating company equal to its share in the capital of the new company. These shares shall be distributed between partners and or shareholders in each of the consolidating / amalgamating companies proportionately to their shares therein.

There are certain legal procedures that should be followed before the intended consolidation takes place. Such as, the consolidation becomes effective only after three months from the date of registration in the commercial register. The concerned companies, in consultation with the competent authorities, shall publish a notice in newspapers to the public informing them about the consolidation. This is so as to give any one the right to come forward and give their objections, if any? The creditors of the consolidated company may, by registered letter, within the said period give their objection to the consolidation. In such instances the consolidation process shall be suspended unless the creditor (or creditors) waives their objection. The court, in case of dispute, could overrule the objections raised by any creditor or otherwise the company should settle the debt if it was due, or it should provide sufficient guarantees for the settlement of such debts in the future, provided that the creditors accept such arrangement.

In case any person does not appear in time to present his objection, during the specified period, the consolidation shall be considered final and the new company shall replace the non-existing companies in all their rights and liabilities. Suppose someone appears after the specified time, I think this should not affect the validity of the consolidation, however, the new management should settle the issues raised by him. Normally the consolidation process takes time and the two concerned companies should discuss in details all matters regarding the goodwill of each company, all issues related to the assets and liabilities of each company, the new business name or logo to be adopted by the new company and the names of persons to manage the new company.

All such issues should be discussed in details and agreed upon before the final declaration of the "new" consolidation and formation of a new company. Such good practical legal steps could greatly help in strengthening & streamlining the livelihood of many companies to the benefit of strong capable institutions.

Musk's robotaxi before 2027

Elon Musk on Thursday unveiled what he said was a robotaxi capable of self-driving, predicting it would be available by 2027 -- about a decade after he first promised an autonomous vehicle.

The Tesla CEO said the fully electric car -- which has no steering wheel or pedals --

would be priced under \$30,000, would be charged wirelessly with inductive technology and would be "10 to 20 times safer" than human-driven cars.

"You can think of the car in an autonomous world as being like just a little lounge," he told a crowd at the Warner Brothers Studio lot near Los Angeles.

"You're just sitting in a comfortable little lounge, and you can do whatever you want while you're in this comfortable little lounge, and when you get out, you will be at your destination."

Few details were given about the vehicle, whose gullwing doors are reminiscent of the DeLorean made famous by the "Back to the Future" films, but Musk said Tesla already had 50 of them.

He said the company was expecting to begin "fully autonomous, unsupervised" driving in Texas and California next year with existing models, and then move on to production of what he called the "cybercab".

"I tend to be a little optimistic with time frames, but in 2026, so yeah, before 2027. Let me put it that way."

Robovan and Optimus robot

The evening, which started almost an hour late, was heavy on sunny visions of the future, but light on specifics.

But it also showcased a mass passenger vehicle that Musk called "The Robovan."

The vehicle, which looks like an enormous moving toaster, has no steering wheel, pedals or driver.

It can seat up to 20 people or could be converted to carry goods, Musk said.

He gave no details about production or any timeline.

Musk also brought out dancing humanoid robots called Optimus that he said would one day be able to do menial tasks, as well as offer friendship.

"I think this will be the biggest product ever of any kind," he said, adding that he expected the robot to retail for \$20,000 to \$30,000.

He gave no timeline on this, either, and it was not clear from the livestream what the robot's capabilities were, although it was shown walking amongst audience members, handing out plaques and serving drinks.

Trump

Musk's bullish pronouncements and dedicated fanbase have helped build Tesla into one of the world's most valuable companies.

Thursday night's robotaxi reveal was a long time coming.

Musk first said in 2016 a fully automated car was two years away; a year later he was touting a vehicle by 2019 so clever that customers would be able to sleep while it drove them around.

But as many automakers have found, self-driving is tricky.

While lots of cars nowadays have limited automation, theoretically allowing the driver to cede some of the boring bits of driving to an onboard computer, the person behind the wheel still has to pay attention and jump in if the car does something unpredictable.

That's because computers, unlike people, are not very good at reacting to unexpected events or situations they have never seen before.

Other companies, such

as Google's Waymo and General Motors' Cruise, have operated heavily regulated and limited pilot robotaxi programs for a few years already.

Anything Tesla tries to put on the road will face the same kind of regulatory hurdles, as well as skepticism from the general public, many of whom have never seen a car without a driver.

Immediate reaction to the reveals was mixed.

"Delusional nonsense from a liar who has been promising a robotaxi every year for a decade," wrote user @goodandnormal on X.

Others on the platform were more enthusiastic, with some predicting that Tesla's share price will soar when US markets open.

"Tesla self-driving 'Robovan.' The future looks promising," wrote @CollinsEbot1.

Toyota returns to Formula 1 with Haas F1 Team

Toyota has announced its return to Formula 1 through a new technical partnership with the Haas F1 team, which takes effect immediately.

Now is not the right time for electric supercars, says Lambo CTO

Toyota invests \$500 million in flying electric taxis

According to media reports, Toyota is said to be betting big on electric taxis for the future. The Japanese car giant is recently said to have earmarked \$500 million towards Joby Aviation, taking its total investment in the eVTOL company to nearly \$900 million.

Joby, a California-based company is in the process of developing an electrical Vertical Take-Off & Landing (eVTOL) vehicle. The company is already said to have delivered its first eVTOL to the US Air Force last year, as part of its contract with the US Department of Defense.

The company even recently conducted an exhibition flight to highlight its use for the public in partnership with US Delta Airlines.

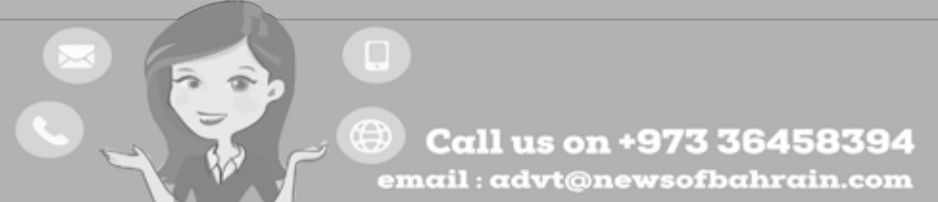

Chepngetich shatters women's marathon world record

Ruth Chepngetich of Kenya obliterated the women's world record by almost two minutes Sunday as she won the Chicago Marathon in 2:09:56, taking inspiration from the late Kelvin Kiptum.

The 30-year-old Chepngetich, who became the first three-time women's winner of the Chicago race, broke the previous world record of 2:11:53 set by Ethiopia's Tigst Assefa last year in Berlin.

"I feel so great, I'm proud of myself. This is my dream that has come true," said Chepngetich, the 2019 world marathon champion.

"I've fought a lot, thinking about the world record and I have fulfilled it."

Chepngetich, who also won in Chicago in 2021 and 2022,

dedicated her latest victory to Kiptum, who set the men's world record at last year's race just four months before he died in a car accident at the age of 24.

"The world record has come back to Kenya, and I dedicate this world record to Kelvin Kiptum," said Chepngetich. Runners observed a moment's silence on the start line in honour of Kiptum. Organisers also

handed out stickers displaying Kiptum's record-breaking time of 2:00:35 for the 50,000 participants to put on their race bibs.

Korir triumphs in men's race

John Korir of Kenya won his first major marathon title after running a personal best of 2:02:44 in the men's race.

The 27-year-old Korir finished ahead of Ethiopia's Mohamed Esa (2:04:39) and another Kenyan, Amos Kipruto (2:04:50).

Korir was part of a seven-man group at the head of the course 30 kilometres in before he hit the accelerator and shed his rivals following a relatively conservative start.

Four of the top five were Kenyans, with Vincent Ngetich and Daniel Ebenyo finishing off the podium.

Bahrain Victorious aim for a strong finish to 2024 in Guangxi

The 2024 Gree Tour of Guangxi, which runs from Tuesday to Sunday next week promises to be an exciting finale to the WorldTour season for both riders and spectators. Set against the stunning landscapes and rich cultural backdrop of the Southern China region, the race has evolved from its sprint-centric past to now also feature opportunities for classic riders and puncheurs. With a revamped course, this year promises to be more unpredictable and dynamic than ever.

Bahrain Victorious will look to end the season on a high, with Torstein Træen leading the charge as the team's General Classification (GC) contender. He will be supported by Finlay Pickering and Robert Stannard, who will play vital supporting roles. For the flat finishes, Matevž Govekar, currently in top form, will spearhead the team's efforts, backed by Alberto



Bruttomesso and Dušan Rajović as alternatives. The experienced Lukasz Wiśniowski will be key both in lead-outs and as all-round support, ensuring the team is equipped for every possible scenario. The team's goals are clear: a stage victory and a top 5 finish in the overall standings.

The race kicks off with a circuit around Fangchenggang, a coastal city near the Vietnamese border. The short, sharp climbs on this stage are unlikely to trouble the sprinters, and

offer a chance to shake off the effects of the long journey. The following day also suits the fast men, although they will need to navigate a punchy Category 3 climb at the 148km mark before reaching the finish in Jingxi.

Stage 3 is the longest of the race at 214km, with the rolling terrain in the second half likely to reduce the size of the peloton. Despite this, a reduced bunch sprint is still likely. Friday presents the best opportunity for breakaway specialists, especially if the sprinters' teams

fail to keep the time gaps under control.

Stage 5 is the Tour of Guangxi's signature stage, finishing at the Nongla Scenic Area. The 3.3km climb at an average gradient of 6.6%, with a maximum slope of 13.5%, is likely to be decisive for the general classification. Finally, the race concludes with five laps of a circuit around Nanning, the capital of Guangxi, with another chance for the sprinters to shine.

Bahrain Victorious' lead sports director, Gorazd Štangelj, concludes: "The stages are different from last year, and riders who are still motivated at this point in the season will have an advantage. We see this race as an opportunity to win stages and continue to grow. We aim to fight for stage victories and a top-5 finish in the GC. The intermediate sprints will be key, as time bonuses could play a significant role. Our riders have clear roles, but there's also room for individual ambitions."

Sinner wins Shanghai Masters to deny Djokovic 100th career title

World number one Jannik Sinner defeated 24-time Grand Slam champion Novak Djokovic 7-6 (7/4), 6-3 on Sunday to win the Shanghai Masters.

Sinner took a crucial break in the fourth game of the second set to defeat the Serb in 1hr 37min and deny him a 100th career singles title.

"He was just too good today, too strong, too fast," Djokovic said after the match.

Sinner said it was a "very special day", saluting his opponent as a "legend" who kept playing "incredible tennis... year after year".

In a nod to former Djokovic rival Roger Federer, who was watching from the stands, the 23-year-old joked: "There are legends everywhere, I just try to keep up a little bit."

Facing off before an impassioned crowd, neither player blinked in the first set, unable to break the other's serve.

Sinner quickly took control in the tiebreak, breaking Djokovic's serve on the first point and going 5-1 up.

The Serb steadied himself but then netted a volley to bring up set point at 6-3.

Sinner failed to convert initially but didn't miss the second time behind serve.

The next key moment came in the fourth game of the second set when Sinner was up 40-15 on Djokovic's serve.

Djokovic saved one break point with a fiery ace but couldn't stop a superb forehand down the line from Sinner that saw him pull ahead.

All that remained was for the

Italian to hold his nerve, hitting an ace to finish the match and claim the title.

'Tough year'

Sinner's victory is the latest triumph in a formidable season, in which he has won two Grand Slams and retained the top spot in the rankings since June.

But it is also a year that has seen him embroiled in controversy after he twice tested positive for a banned steroid in

March.

In August, the International Tennis Integrity Agency accepted Sinner's explanation that the drug entered his system unintentionally when his physiotherapist used a spray containing it to treat a cut, then provided massage and sports therapy to the player.

However, the World Anti-Doping Agency said last month it would appeal against the decision to clear him of

wrongdoing and was seeking a ban of up to two years.

That news came as Sinner was contesting the China Open, where he lost in the final to Spain's Carlos Alcaraz, who was also watching from the stands on Sunday.

"This year has been very tough for me... At points I lost a little bit of smile," Sinner said on Sunday.

"It's never easy to play in these kind of circumstances.

"I feel like I'm strong when I go on the court trying to not think about it... When I wake up I try to focus on every single (match or practice) I do, but then of course I have moments when I think about it which is not comfortable," he said.

'Deserved' win

Djokovic said Sinner played "the big points better" and "deserved to win".

The 37-year-old said that

getting a 100th title was "not a live-or-die type of goal", but he would keep trying.

Djokovic became the last man standing from tennis' golden era after Rafael Nadal announced his retirement this week and said that, despite the loss, he was pleased with his performance in Shanghai.

"I played pretty good, which gives me, I guess, a reason to believe that I can still play with these guys that are the best in the world at this level," he said.

"As long as that's the case, I guess I'll still feel the need to keep on competing and the motivation to be out there."



Jannik Sinner before becoming a professional tennis player, was a highly skilled skier. Growing up in the Italian Alps, he was one of the top junior skiers in his age group in Italy. He eventually chose to focus on tennis at the age of 13, a relatively late start compared to many top players, yet he quickly rose through the ranks to become one of the most promising young talents in the sport.

High stakes in Jeddah: Bahrain, Saudi clash for World Cup survival

Bahrain faces a major test as they prepare to take on Saudi Arabia at King Abdullah Sports City in Jeddah, with both teams desperate to reignite their campaigns after recent setbacks. Tomorrow's match looks set to be massive, as it could shape their fate in the AFC 2026 World Cup qualifiers. Kickoff is at 9PM local time.

Saudi Arabia, currently third in the group, have had an inconsistent start to their qualification campaign. They've managed just one win from three matches, alongside a draw and a loss. Their most recent setback came in a 2-0 defeat to Japan, with Daichi Kamada and Koki Ogawa finding the net in Jeddah. It was a tough blow for the Saudis, who struggled to keep pace with Japan's high-intensity. However, unlike Bahrain, Saudi Arabia are no strangers to the world stage, having qualified for multiple World Cups and famously defeating reigning champions

Argentina in the group stages of Qatar 2022.

Bahrain will have to take their neighbors and rivals very seriously, as Saudi Arabia remains a formidable opponent, particularly on home soil. Yet, the cracks exposed by Japan could give Bahrain a potential blueprint to follow.

Qualification Hopes in the Balance

For Bahrain, the situation is similarly precarious. Their frustration piled up with a disappointing 2-2 draw with Indonesia, where they missed key chances that could have turned the match in their favor. Heading into that fixture, Bahrain had set their sights on nothing less than three points, but the result left them with more questions than answers.

To make matters worse, Bahrain suffered a heavy 5-0 loss to Japan in their previous home fixture, leaving them trailing Saudi Arabia in the group standings, primarily due to a worse goal difference. Bahrain's de-

fense will need to tighten up if they have any chance of securing a result in Jeddah and keeping their World Cup dream alive.

In a bright spot for the team, FIFA's official website highlighted Mohammed Marhoon's sensational freekick against Indonesia, bringing some positive attention to the squad ahead of tomorrow night.

5,000 Bahraini Fans Set to Travel

Adding to the atmosphere, around 5,000 Bahraini fans are expected to fill their section of the 62,000-seat King Abdullah Sports City Stadium.

A Test of Resilience

As both teams step onto the pitch in Jeddah, they'll be well aware of the stakes. Bahrain, eager gain a foothold in Group C, will face a Saudi side looking to prove that their defeat against Japan was just a blip. With plenty of matches still to go in the group, there's all to play for, but time is running out.
