Gaza truce talks in Qatar

Qatar will host Gaza ceasefire talks today, sources close to the negotiations said, seeking a so far elusive agreement that the United States hopes would stop Iran striking Israel and avert a wider war.

US, Qatari and Egyptian mediators have invited Israel and Hamas for negotiations aimed at ending fighting that the health ministry in the Hamas-run Gaza Strip says has claimed nearly 40,000 lives in the Palestinian

territory.

The talks will be held in the Qatari capital Doha, a source close to Hamas and a second source close to the negotiations said yesterday, though it remained unclear if the Palestinian group - whose October 7 attack on Israel triggered the war - planned to participate.

According to a US source familiar with the Doha meeting, CIA director William Burns is scheduled to take part.

The office of Prime Minister Benja-

min Netanyahu told AFP the heads of Israel's Mossad spy agency and Shin Bet secret service would go to Doha.

On Tuesday, Netanyahu's office detailed Israel's conditions for a truce including "a veto on certain prisoners" being released from its jails.

Mediation efforts have repeatedly stalled since a week-long ceasefire in November - the only pause so far in the war - when dozens of hostages were released by Hamas fighters in exchange for Palestinian prisoners held in Israeli jails.

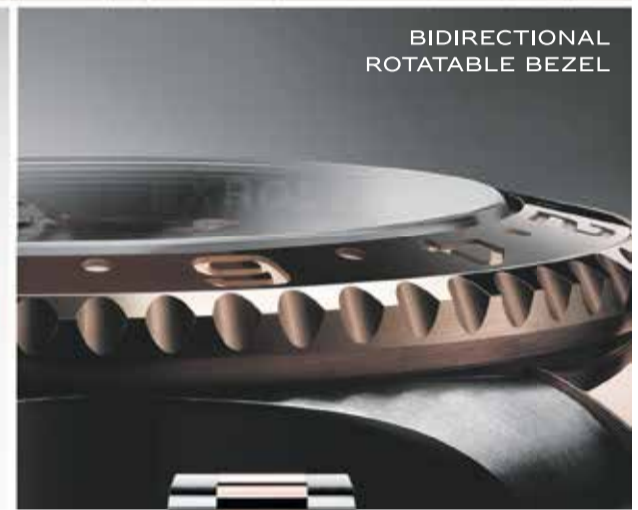

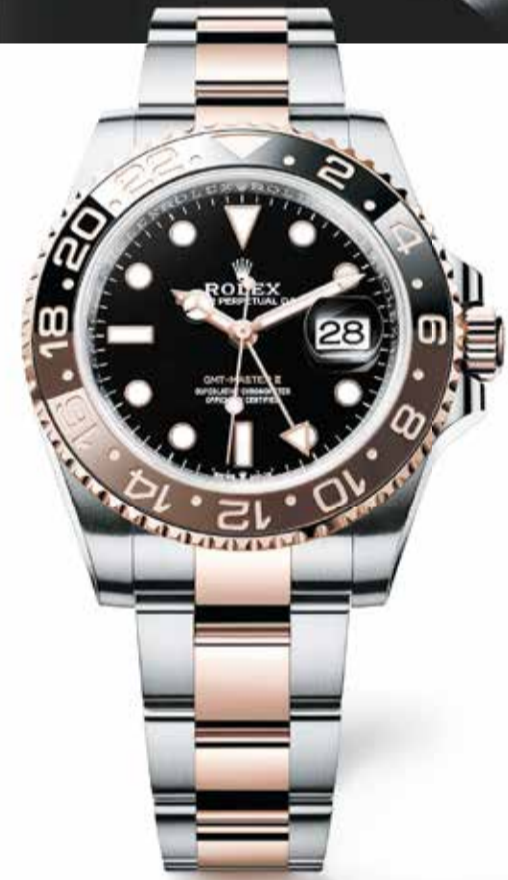

Wrongly accused

Two Asian women acquitted of practising dentistry without a licence

● **High Appeals Court overturns fines and deportation**

The High Appeals Court has acquitted two Asian women of the charge of practising dentistry without a license, overturning a previous ruling that fined them BD1,000 and ordered their deportation.

The court determined that the women were present in the dentist's office solely for cleaning purposes, which was their designated job at the medical centre.

Lawyer Shaikh Rashid Al Khalifa argued that the women were wrongly accused by the judicial police officer who filed the complaint, claiming they were practicing dentistry without a license.

The officer's claim was based on the women's statement that they were performing cleaning tasks in the dental department of the clinic and assisting the dentist.

The officer noted that the dentist had confirmed his assistant was on leave, leading to the conclusion that the women were illegally practising dentistry.

The prosecution charged the women with practising dentistry without a licence in Bahrain

during 2023, claiming they were operating without authorisation from the relevant authorities.

The lower criminal court initially found them guilty and imposed the aforementioned fine and deportation order.

Verdict

However, the defendant's lawyer appealed the verdict, arguing that the women did not commit any criminal act as defined by Article 22 of the Criminal Code.

This article states that a person cannot be punished for a crime unless their actions directly resulted in it, and that individuals are only accountable for their own actions, not those of others.

The lawyer further argued that the women did not perform any actions constituting the

crime in question and that all evidence supported this claim.

He pointed out that there was no confession or admission from the women acknowledging they were practicing dentistry without a license. Instead, they confirmed their role was solely cleaning.

Cleaning

Furthermore, witnesses testified that all dental assistants were licensed and that the women were only responsible for cleaning.

Their presence in the dentist's office was solely for this purpose.

He also argued that there was insufficient evidence to convict the women.

"The case lacked any technical or laboratory evidence or even witness testimonies con-

firming their involvement in the alleged offense," he stressed.

Duties

The lawyer emphasised that the women's presence in the medical centre was natural, as it was their workplace for cleaning duties.

"Their presence in the dentist's office alongside the dentist and assistant was for cleaning purposes and nothing more," he pointed out.

The court, after reviewing the evidence and arguments, ultimately accepted the lawyer's defense and acquitted the two women, clearing their names and preventing their deportation.

Labour Fund betrayal

Training institute owner faces verdict for defrauding Tamkeen with forged certificates

A training institute owner awaits a verdict after being accused of defrauding the Labour Fund, Tamkeen, by submitting forged training certificates.

The High Criminal Court is scheduled to deliver its decision on August 26th.

The defendant allegedly submitted falsified training certificates to claim support funds from Tamkeen, ultimately receiving a total of BD4,470.

During the court session, the defendant's lawyer pleaded for their client's innocence and requested the hearing of defense witnesses.

Meanwhile, the Public Prosecution, represented by the Deputy Chief Prosecutor of the Southern Governorate and a member of the Advocacy Unit, presented a comprehensive written and oral argument along with an electronic presentation showcasing the evidence.

The Public Prosecution

highlighted the forged certificates attributed to a training institute outside the Kingdom of Bahrain.

They presented a letter from Tamkeen confirming the disbursement of funds to the defendant's training institute, as well as a letter from the institute itself confirming the certificates' invalidity.

Furthermore, the testimonies of trainees confirmed their non-participation in the training course and revealed that their signatures on attendance records were obtained at the defendant's request.

The Public Prosecution further investigated the case by contacting the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA) to verify the entry and exit records of the trainees during the training period.

It was revealed that some trainees were outside Bahrain during the training course.

The Public Prosecution also pointed to inconsistencies in the defendant's statements during the investigation.

Bahrainis abroad can now register for by-election

Bahrainis citizens living abroad who are listed in the First Electoral Constituency in Muharraq can now register to vote in the upcoming by-election for the Council of Representatives either online through the election website or head over to their nearest embassy, consulate, or diplomatic mission.

Between 19 and 21 August 2024, Bahrain's diplomatic missions across the globe will be open for citizens to check and add their names to the voter list for the First Electoral District of Muharraq.

This ensures they will be eligible to cast their vote in the district where the election is taking place.

Ambassador Ibrahim Al Meslimani, who heads Consular



Services at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, assured that Bahrain's diplomatic missions are

ready to assist citizens at every stage of the by-election process, from verifying voter registration

to the actual election day and even preparing for a possible rerun, should it be needed.

Diplomatic mission

Every embassy, consulate, and diplomatic mission will form a committee, led by the ambassador or mission chief and two other officials.

These teams will handle the voting and counting in each country, ensuring that everything goes well.

Election Day is set for Tuesday, September 3, 2024, with a probable rerun on September 10.

The voting hours will be 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. local time.

The by-election will be run under the rules for voters outside Bahrain, as laid out in Resolution No. 65 of 2024, issued by HE Nawaf Al Maawda, the Minister of Justice, Islamic Affairs, and Waqf.

Man jailed for arson attempt

A 50-year-old man has been sentenced to three years in prison for attempting to set fire to a car.

The man, who mistakenly set fire to a different vehicle, was identified through security cameras and a glove found at the scene.

The High Criminal Court found the defendant guilty of arson and possession of cannabis.

The court considered his confession during the investigation, his history of drug use, and his mental health condition.

The incident occurred on March 30, 2024, when the victim discovered his car engulfed in flames.

He immediately called the police and reviewed security footage from his home, identifying the perpetrator as a man driving a specific car and wear-

ing a glove.

A witness corroborated the victim's account, stating that he had encountered the defendant earlier that day, who had inquired about the whereabouts of a specific individual.

Later that evening, the witness learned that the man he had spoken to had set fire to the victim's car.

The defendant confessed to the crime during the investigation, and the witness identified him from a photo lineup.

The report issued by the Directorate of Civil Defense confirmed the fire was intentionally set, and a psychiatric evaluation determined the defendant was responsible for his actions.

Drug tests revealed the presence of cannabis in his system. The defendant's lawyer, Reem Al Mahari, argued for leniency, citing her client's mental health condition, drug addiction, and lack of criminal history.

'Arsonist' spared jail, placed in psychiatric care

A 39-year-old woman accused of setting fire to her father's home has been spared imprisonment and instead placed in psychiatric care pending her recovery.

The High Criminal Court ruled in favour of the defendant, who was found to be mentally incompetent and therefore not responsible for her actions.

The incident occurred on

March 14th, when the defendant allegedly set fire to belongings in her room, endangering the lives and property of her family.

Her father, a 66-year-old man, reported that he had observed a change in his daughter's behaviour in the days leading up to the incident, characterised by erratic behaviour and shouting.

He further stated that he had tried to calm her down but was unsuccessful.

On the day of the fire, the defendant's sister alerted their father to smoke emanating from the defendant's room.

Upon entering the room, the father discovered a fire in the bathroom, with burning blankets and thick smoke filling the room.

He managed to extinguish the fire with water. The father stated that this was not the first time his daughter had started a fire.

New sewage network in Nabih Saleh

News in brief

◆ **Russian police have** detained a US citizen in Moscow for "violence" against a law enforcement officer, investigators said yesterday. "At night on August 12, 2024, a US citizen was brought to a Moscow police station in connection with his hooliganism," Russia's Investigative Committee said in a statement. "The suspect refused to provide his identity documents, after which he used violence against a law enforcement officer," it said. The statement said the man, who was not named, would be charged and investigators would ask a court that he be remanded in custody. The incident comes two weeks after the release of US reporter Evan Gershkovich, former US marine Paul Whelan and 14 others from Russian jails in the biggest East-West prisoner exchange since the Cold War.

◆ **Russia reintroduces ban on petrol exports till year end** announced yesterday that it was reintroducing a ban on petrol exports for another six months to "maintain a stable situation" on the domestic fuel market after major price hikes. The government said in a statement that it has "brought in a restriction on exports of petrol from September 1 to December 31, 2024". The measure is intended to keep prices stable "during a period of continued seasonal demand and planned repairs on oil refineries", the government said. Russia in March introduced a six-month ban on petrol exports, but then suspended it temporarily between May and July, saying the domestic market was saturated.

◆ **Japanese Prime Minister** Fumio Kishida announced Wednesday he will step aside next month, ending a three-year term plagued by low popularity ratings and a spluttering economy. The ruling Liberal Democratic Party, which has governed almost uninterrupted for decades, is due to hold a leadership contest next month, with the winner to become prime minister. Kishida said Wednesday he will not seek re-election as party chief. "In this (party) presidential election, it is necessary to show the people that the LDP is changing and the party is a new LDP," Kishida told reporters in Tokyo. "For this, transparent and open elections and free and vigorous debate are important. The most obvious first step to show that the LDP will change is for me to step aside," he said.

Ukrainian army 'moving further' into Russia, Zelensky says

President Volodymyr Zelensky said yesterday that Ukrainian troops are "moving further" into Russia, as Kyiv's biggest cross-border attack stretched into a second week.

The Ukrainian army entered Russia's Kursk region on August 6, capturing dozens of settlements in the biggest offensive by a foreign army on Russian soil since World War II.

"In the Kursk region, we are moving further. From one to two kilometres (0.6-1.2 miles) in different areas since the beginning of the day," Zelensky said on social media.

Interior Minister Igor Klymenko said Ukraine would create a "buffer zone" in the region to prevent Russian cross-border strikes.

"The creation of a buffer zone in the Kursk region is a step to protect our border communities from daily hostilities," he said.

The neighbouring Russian region of Belgorod declared its own state of emergency, as the governor warned the situation was "extremely difficult" due to Ukrainian shelling and drone attacks.

An AFP analysis of data provided by the Institute for the Study of War (ISW) indicat-

ed Ukrainian troops had advanced over an area of at least 800 square kilometres (310 square miles) of Russia as of Monday.

Russia said it had repelled Ukrainian attempts to push further into five areas of Kursk.

"The attempts by enemy mobile units using armoured equipment to break through deeper into Russian territory have been repelled," its defence ministry said.

Since launching its invasion in February 2022, Russia has captured territory in southern and eastern Ukraine and subjected Ukrainian cities to missile and drone barrages.

After re-capturing some lost territory in 2022, a long-awaited Ukrainian counter-offensive last year largely petered out.

Military, NATO bases in Germany stuck by security scares

A German military base was sealed off for several hours yesterday as authorities investigated suspected sabotage while a NATO airbase in the country faced an attempted trespassing incident, officials said.

The Bundeswehr base in Cologne-Wahn was locked down because of "a suspicion of an attempted intrusion and a suspicion of sabotage," defence ministry spokesman Colonel Arne Collatz told reporters in Berlin.

A hole was discovered in a fence near drinking water storage facilities, the military's territorial command said on X.

The perpetrators had not been found and the site's water was being checked as a precaution. The base re-opened later in the day, it added.

Der Spiegel magazine reported that soldiers and civilians on the Bundeswehr base had been advised not to drink the tap water over concerns that the water supply "may be contaminated". The Cologne-Wahn base, located near Cologne-Bonn airport, houses several military and civilian facilities of the German armed forces as well as aircraft used by Chancellor Olaf Scholz and his ministers for government travel.

The base is also an important hub for military support for Ukraine. Ukrainian soldiers regularly fly home from there,

via Poland, after receiving training in Germany, Spiegel added.

Security stepped up

A NATO base in the western German town of Geilenkirchen meanwhile faced an attempted trespassing incident late Tuesday, the military alliance said in a statement.

An individual attempted to enter the base but was stopped and sent away, a spokesman said, adding that a "routine" sweep of the site and people there was conducted afterwards. Police are investigating the incident.

Following the lockdown at the Cologne-Wahn base, the NATO site also increased its security level and conducted routine checks of its water supply but added it had no concerns with the safety of its supply.

The base was not sealed off

and continued operating at full capacity, the spokesman said.

The airbase is home to NATO AWACS reconnaissance aircraft.

Marcus Faber, a German lawmaker from the liberal FDP party and chairman of parliament's defence committee told Bild daily that with the two incidents coming so close together "one can assume that an enemy actor wants to demonstrate his sabotage skills".

Germany -- a key ally of Kyiv -- has been on high alert for sabotage and attacks on military facilities in the country in the wake of Moscow's 2022 invasion of Ukraine.

In April, investigators arrested two German-Russian men on suspicion of spying for Russia and planning attacks in Germany -- including on US army facilities -- to undermine military support for Ukraine.

India to host third Global South Summit

India will be hosting the third edition of the Global South Summit next month, around August 17. The summit, which will take place in virtual mode, will be chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi alongside the meetings at ministerial level. Currently, New Delhi is sending out invites, with sources in various global capitals confirming that they have received the invites.

The August 2024 edition of the summit will be the first such edition of the summit under Prime Minister Modi's third term in power.

Officially referred to as the 'Summit of the Global South', the first edition of the summit took place in January 2023 in the year of India's G20 presidency. India, by hosting this summit, plans to provide a plat-

form for countries of the Global South to share their perspectives, challenges, and priorities on a common platform.

The second edition of the summit took place in November 2023 after the New Delhi G20 leaders' summit in September.

The theme of the inaugural summit was 'Unity of Voice, Unity of Purpose', and the

theme of the second summit was 'Together, for Everyone's Growth, with Everyone's Trust'.

The summits have seen participation from over 120 countries and focus on issues such as climate change, sustainable development, global governance, and international cooperation. The ministerial sessions took place at the level of foreign ministers, education ministers, finance ministers, environment ministers, energy ministers, health ministers, and commerce/trade ministers.

The summits have seen key announcements from the Indian side.

These include PM Modi inaugurating the Global South Center of Excellence, known as 'Dakshin' -- meaning the South -- which will work as an interface for forging stronger collaboration between global south countries.

India's neighbourhood first policy

India's Neighbourhood First Policy is a reflection of the truism that neighbours are a primary foreign policy priority for any country.

India has historically committed its largest and best resources to its neighbourhood, be it economic, political or diplomatic. Today, India's Neighbourhood First Policy is the foundation of its global outreach.

Within the country, the Policy has helped to raise awareness about the importance of the neighbourhood, above all in the Government of India. Given the diverse nature of the country and cross-border linkages rooted in history and culture the Policy is paying dividends by promoting regional integration and advancing peace and stability.

The decision by Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi to invite the Heads of all neighbouring countries for his swearing-in ceremony on three successive occasions in 2014, 2019 and 2024 was unprecedented and repre-

sented an altogether new way of engaging with neighbours. The presence of the Leaders was a celebration of a common sub-continental identity. It was also a celebration of democracy.

India, by virtue of its size and resource endowments, is the partner of choice for its neighbours. India's aid programmes amounting to billions of dollars at highly concessional terms extend to all walks of life and all sectors. These range from hard infrastructure to skilling and education to disaster preparedness. They have impacted millions of beneficiaries and transformed the remotest regions in a sustained manner. Over time, the Neighbourhood First Policy has evolved into a well-knit and integrated system.

The Policy is rooted in the philosophy of 'vasudai-kutumbakam', or the world is but one family and the policy of 'sabkasaath, sab ka vikas sab ka vishvas'. It thereby embodies the principles of universality, equity and fairness. Apart from development, regional integration is a key objective. This is achieved by putting in place asymmetric and resilient connectivity involving people to people movement, air, rail, road links, energy pipelines and supply and value chains. Neighbours are given the first right of access to the Indian market, Indian educational institutions and Indian medical facilities.

The growth of the Indian economy serves as the engine of regional growth. It commits India to share its economic successes and enable neighbours to benefit from economies of scale. The Neighbourhood Policy is the embodiment of the principle of 'prosper thy neighbour'. The record shows that the economic performance of those who have moved faster with integration has been better than others. Conversely, those countries who have integrated more with India have better withstood external shocks.

India has come to the aid of its neighbours in times of difficulty such as during the Covid crisis or the energy and food price shocks after the Ukraine conflict, or even in time of natural disasters. Notable examples in the recent past include provision of urgent humanitarian aid to Afghanistan, economic bail out of Sri Lanka, supply of vaccines and essential commodities to Bangladesh and budgetary support to the Maldives immediately after the pandemic. India is thus not only a first responder but also a safety net for its neighbours.

The Policy is characterized by country specific targeted interventions rather than a one size fits all approach. Focus on building mutually beneficial bilateral partnerships lies at the heart of the Policy. Where necessary, mechanisms have been put in place to promote sub-regional cooperation. A sub-regional power grid is taking shape between Nepal, Bhutan and Bangladesh passing through Indian territory.

It is recognized that peace and security are indispensable conditions for progress. The Policy is geared to be sensitive to and respect each other's sovereignty and

security concerns. The philosophy is that security is mutual and not a zero-sum game, whether it relates to terrorism or climate change. Capacity building is a key means to achieving security for all.

In recent years, the vision of the neighbourhood has extended to regions beyond the sub-continent. These include the Indian Ocean Region, West Asia and the Gulf States, Central Asia and East Asia. These regions are given priority in allocation of resources and attention so as to rebuild the linkages that existed in the pre-colonial era and to shape new ones. India's influence and imprint in this wider geography is growing rapidly.

For reasons of its own making, Pakistan has remained an outlier in the sub-continent's integration process. China, which also shares a long border with India, has to come to terms with a rising India and needs to abandon the policy of trying to contain India in its neighbourhood.

India's Neighbourhood First Policy is ambitious and bold. It is neither dogmatic nor doctrinaire. It is successful because it is responsive and sensitive to the needs of the times.

Rwanda signs deal with US nuclear firm for mini-reactors

Rwanda said it signed yesterday an agreement with a US company to further develop nuclear energy by constructing mini-reactors in the East African country.

Under the memorandum of understanding, Nano Nuclear Energy Inc will provide technical assistance, training and education, as well as build an unspecified number of small modular reactors (SMRs) and microreactors, the Rwanda Atomic Energy Board (RAEB) said. Construction of the SMRs and microreactors would take place in the "next few years", Nano Nuclear CEO James Walker told a press conference in Rwanda, foreseeing a "very smooth path towards a very developed civil nuclear programme".

"In Rwanda you have small communities with a few thousand people that doesn't justify a big reactor system, but you could put a microreactor there and it could serve up to 3,000 people for 20 years without need for refuelling."

SMRs produce roughly a third of the power generated by traditional reactors, according to the International Atomic Energy

Agency, but can be mass-produced and then transported to their locations.

Rwanda, a country of about 13 million people, currently generates about 51 percent of its electricity from thermal sources, followed by hydro-power at around 44 percent and around four percent from solar power.

The deal aims to ensure that Rwanda has a "robust ability to maintain a self-sustaining domestic nuclear energy industry", RAEB said.

The MoU follows a deal Kigali reached with Canadian-German start-up Dual Fluid last year to build a nuclear reactor, expected to be operational in 2026.



ni nuclear reactors, also known as small modular reactors (SMRs), are designed to be more flexible and scalable compared to traditional large reactors. They can generate up to 300 megawatts of electricity, making them suitable for smaller grids or remote locations.

Global oil demand growth slowing: IEA

Global oil demand growth slowed in the second quarter of the year, primarily due to softer construction and industrial activity in China, the International Energy Agency said Tuesday.

“Demand is set to rise by less than 1 mbd (million barrels per day) in both 2024 and 2025,” said the IEA in its monthly oil report.

That growth rate is far slower than last year’s 2.1 mbd increase and slower than pre-pandemic expansion.

The IEA expects global consumption to come in at 103.06 mbd in 2024, up from 102.09 mbd last year and 100.6 mbd in 2019.

Europe will be the only continent to see a drop in overall demand, with the Americas rising only marginally.

Demand will continue to expand space in the Asia-Pacific region, including in China, according to the IEA.

Yet the IEA noted Chinese oil demand fell in June for the third consecutive month, primarily due to weaker demand for gasoil (diesel) and naphtha, products used by the construction and manufacturing industries.

The IEA noted that the rising number of trucks running on natural gas or batteries was also eroding demand for diesel. “Chinese oil demand growth has gone into reverse due to a slowdown in construction and manufacturing, rapidly accelerating deployment of vehicles powered by alternative fuels and comparison to a stronger post-reopening baseline,” said the Paris-based IEA, which advises oil-consuming nations on energy policy.

It noted that sales of electric cars have also been strong, citing data from the China Passenger Car Association showing that they accounted for more than 50 percent of sales in July, and are up by third for the first half of the year.

SpaceX plans first manned mission over Earth’s poles

SpaceX is aiming to break new barriers in polar exploration with the first manned space mission over the Earth’s poles -- a private flight commanded by a crypto entrepreneur later this year, the company said Tuesday.

The mission, dubbed “Fram2” after a 19th century polar expedition schooner, is due to last between three to five days, and was purchased by Chun Wang, a wealthy bitcoin pioneer who founded f2pool and stakefish, for an undisclosed amount.

He will be joined by three polar experts: Norwegian filmmaker Jannicke Mikkelsen, German robotics researcher Rabea Rogge, and Australian

polar adventurer Eric Philips. It is the latest foray by the aerospace industry into private space tourism, growing fast in the United States in recent years.

“From mission proposal, planning, trajectory design, to crew selection, everything has been done by the customer,” Wang, reportedly born and raised in China but now a Maltese citizen, said in a post on X.

“A new chapter in space exploration is unfolding before our eyes,” he said.



The mission will use a SpaceX Dragon capsule equipped with an observation dome. The craft will fly at an altitude of between 265 and 280 miles (425 and 450 kilometers), according to SpaceX, owned by mercurial billionaire Elon Musk. The crew plans to conduct research including taking the first X-ray images in space and studying an aurora-like light phenomenon, according to SpaceX.

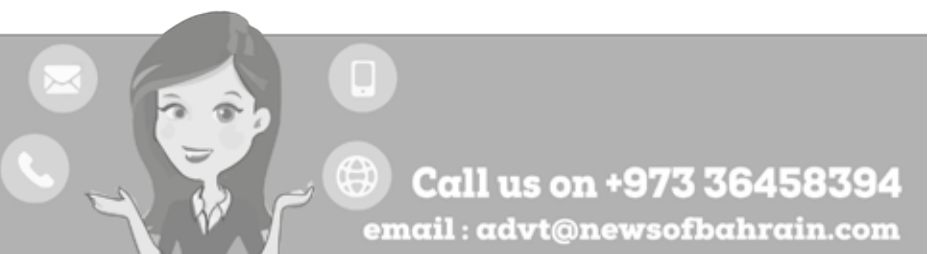

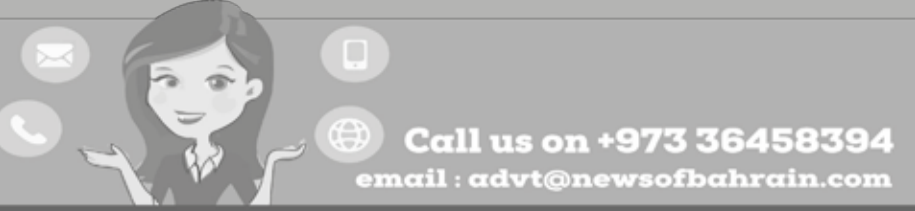

City's title grip under threat

Manchester City's dominance challenged by off-field issues and strengthening rivals

- **Guardiola's future at Man City uncertain**
- **City faces 115 Premier League charges hearing**
- **Arsenal emerges as strong title contender**
- **Liverpool adapts to post-Klopp era**
- **Top clubs compete fiercely for Champions League spots**

Manchester City's grip on the Premier League title has reached an unprecedented four years but off-field doubts surround the English champions ahead of the new season.

Pep Guardiola turned City into the dominant force in English football with six Premier League titles in the past seven seasons.

Guardiola, though, is entering the final year of his contract and the City boss has offered no guarantees that he plans to extend his stay at the Etihad Stadium to a decade.

"Nine years today in the same club is an eternity," Guardiola said during pre-season. "I want to be sure it's the right decision. Not just for me, for the club, for

the players."

Another cloud hangs over City's title defence, with the long-awaited hearing into 115 Premier League charges for alleged breaches of financial rules expected to take place before the end of the year.

City have vehemently denied any wrongdoing over the allegations, some of which date back to 2009.

However, if they are found guilty, they could face severe sanctions.

Everton and Nottingham Forest received points deductions last season for breaches of profit and sustainability rules (PSR), with Leicester set to face similar consequences this season.

The need to meet those regulations and a summer of both

European Championship and Copa America action have been blamed for an unusually slow start to the transfer window from Premier League clubs.

City have only added Brazilian winger Savinho and appear weaker for the impending sale of Julian Alvarez to Atletico Madrid.

Arsenal the coming force?

Arsenal look the best-placed challengers to take City's crown after finishing second in each of the past two seasons.

The 89 points amassed by Mikel Arteta's men last season is only surpassed in the Gunners' history by the unbeaten "Invincibles", who won Arsenal's last Premier League title in 2003/04.

Italian defender Riccardo

Calafiori is Arsenal's only major close-season signing to date, strengthening what was the best defence in the league last season.

But the Gunners are the coming force in the English game.

Arteta's squad was the third youngest in the league last season and features a host of stars such as William Saliba, Bukayo Saka and Gabriel Martinelli yet to hit their peak years.

"I see Arsenal playing at the same level as last season," Guardiola said. "They are on fire. Every year it looks like they are more and more difficult."

Liverpool ran City and Arsenal close for the majority of last season before a dip in form cost them a glorious finish to Jurgen Klopp's reign.

Arne Slot has been given the

daunting task of replacing the charismatic Klopp, who won the Premier League and Champions League during his time at Liverpool.

The former Feyenoord boss needs a fast start to ensure there is no hangover from Klopp's departure and resounding friendly victories over Arsenal, Manchester United and Sevilla were a step in the right direction.

"We both like the fans to come into the stadium and see a team that plays with a lot of energy, that plays good football," said Slot on the similarities between his and Klopp's style.

Manchester United manager Erik ten Hag survived an internal review into his position after their worst-ever Premier League finish of eighth.

Ten Hag held onto his job largely thanks to a shock FA Cup final win against Manchester City last season.

The Dutch boss has been backed by United co-owner Jim Ratcliffe, with the signings of Leny Yoro -- who will miss the first three months of the season due to injury -- and Joshua Zirkzee expected to be followed by a swoop for Bayern Munich defenders Matthijs de Ligt and Noussair Mazraoui.

But United face stiff competition to try and get back into the Champions League.

Chelsea are also under new management after Enzo Maresca replaced Mauricio Pochettino, who departed Stamford Bridge after only one season.

However, Maresca inherits a chaotic situation with more than 50 players on Chelsea's books after another free-spending window snapping up young talent from around the globe.

Newcastle and Tottenham will expect to improve after missing out on the top four last season, while Aston Villa have strengthened ahead of their first Champions League campaign since 1982-83.

At the other end of the table, Ipswich, Leicester and Southampton are hoping to avoid the fate of the three promoted sides last season who all failed to beat the drop.

Ipswich are back in the top-flight for the first time in 22 years and face a baptism of fire at home to Liverpool on the opening weekend.

Crew ousts Messi-less defending champ Miami in Leagues Cup

Diego Rossi's two second-half goals launched the reigning MLS champion Columbus Crew over defending champion Inter Miami 3-2 to reach the Leagues Cup quarter-finals on Tuesday.

The Uruguayan forward lifted the host Crew level in the 69th minute and netted the decider in the 80th to dethrone Miami, this season's overall MLS season leader.

Miami star Lionel Messi did not play, as he was still sidelined with a right ankle injury suffered a month ago in Argentina's Copa America final win over Colombia.

With the victory, the Crew will play host to a Saturday quarter-final against New York City, who won 2-1 over Tigres.

Paraguayan midfielder Matias Rojas gave Inter Miami a 1-0 lead in the 10th minute

and compatriot Diego Gomez doubled the margin with a goal in the 62nd before US striker Christian Ramirez answered for the Crew in the 67th, setting the stage for Rossi's winning brace.

Manchester United have signed Matthijs de Ligt and Noussair Mazraoui from Bayern Munich, the Premier League club announced Tuesday.

Fees for the pair were not disclosed by the English giants, but British media reports estimated the duo had arrived at Old Trafford for a combined £60 million (\$77 million, 70 million euros).

Netherlands defender De Ligt, 25, will now join up again with United manager Erik ten Hag, having played under him at Dutch side Ajax, after agreeing a five-year contract with the option of another year.

India names Morne Morkel as new bowling coach

Morkel, a strapping quickie, has 544 international wickets to his name.

While he was formidable across formats -- South Africa's leading wicket-taker in the 2015 World Cup -- Test cricket was his forte.

He picked up 309 scalps in the 86 Tests he played during his 12-year-long career.

India will host Bangladesh in their next outing in September, followed by another home series against New Zealand.

Later in the year, the team will travel to Australia.

Ligue 1 faces post-Mbappe era challenges

● **French football grapples with TV deal woes and PSG's uncertain dominance**

While France basks in the glow of the dazzling Paris Olympics, French football is trying to shake off a hangover from its own disastrous summer as the first Ligue 1 season of the post-Kylian Mbappe era begins this weekend.

A year after the departures of Lionel Messi and Neymar, Mbappe left Paris Saint-Germain too, signing for Real Madrid after eight and a half years in Ligue 1.

Nobody was surprised to see Mbappe finally move on, and he has left behind a league in disarray after the fiasco surrounding the sale of its broadcast rights.

The French league (LFP) only confirmed a couple of weeks ahead of the season starting that it had agreed a new domestic television deal for the next five years.

Its negotiating power weakened by the collapse of the relationship with its long-time partner, pay-TV giant Canal Plus, the LFP finally signed a contract with British streaming platform DAZN and Qatar's beIN Sports for the knockdown price of 500 million (\$548m) euros annually.

International rights have increased to a reported 160 million euros annually, but the domestic deal is a considerable drop from the 624 million euros previously.

It is a sobering outcome for the LFP, whose president Vincent Labrune hoped to reach one

billion euros a year in broadcast revenue.

Any challengers for PSG?

"We had to find the best solution for the clubs, in terms of exposure and cash flow," admitted Jean-Pierre Caillot of Reims, one of Ligue 1's most prominent presidents.

"It is obviously not the result we imagined at the beginning, but it allows us to not compromise the future."

The new deal leaves Ligue 1 further behind Europe's other leading domestic leagues than

previously in terms of broadcast income.

The crisis goes on after the collapse of a 780 million-euro deal with Spanish company Mediapro months after it came into effect in 2020.

That was what led to Labrune reaching a deal with CVC Capital Partners, which saw the private equity firm offer 1.5 billion euros in exchange for a permanent 13 percent cut of the LFP's commercial income.

The new broadcast deal was pilloried by John Textor, the American owner of Olympique Lyonnais.

"Signing a long-term contract with traditional distribution models is looking backwards, when we should be looking forwards," he said.

The upshot of all this could be a less competitive Ligue 1, in a land-

scape which has seen PSG win 10 of the last 12 titles.

But how Luis Enrique's team cope without Mbappe, who scored 44 goals last season, will be fascinating.

There has been no glamorous new signing to replace Mbappe.

Not yet anyway. But the Parisians have still spent money, including up to 70 million euros on Portugal midfielder Joao Neves from Benfica.

In Ousmane Dembele, Bradley Kylian Mbappe

Barcola, Randal Kolo Muani and Warren Zaire-Emery they retain other French international stars.

Bordeaux's demise

The hope for the neutral has to be that France's other leading clubs can push PSG further this time.

The arrival of former Brighton coach Roberto De Zerbi could give Marseille a boost after they failed to qualify for Europe last season.

"I live off passion and emotions. This team has always been different," De Zerbi said at his unveiling.

Monaco, runners-up last season, and Lyon should be stronger, but Brest are unlikely to repeat their incredible performance in the last campaign, especially with Champions League football now too.

Nothing symbolises French football's financial plight quite like the collapse of Bordeaux, the six-time champions who have gone into receivership.

The former club of Alain Giresse, Jean Tigana and Zinedine Zidane were in Ligue 2 last season but have renounced their professional status and look set to restart in the fourth tier.
