

The Directorate confirmed that the extradition was carried out after an international alert was issued based on an arrest warrant from Bahrain's Public Prosecution.



The decree, published in the official gazette, replaces the text of Articles No. (12), (20), and (45) in the table attached to Decree No. (196) of 2014 with the text specified in Table (1) attached to this decree.







Bahrain's visionary approach to prison reform: A model for global success



he recent reports in the press about Britain's crisis of prison overcrowding, and Prime Minister Keir Starm-L er's admission that he was unaware of the extent of the issue before assuming office, calling it a "catastrophe," highlight Bahrain's unique and forward-thinking vision in this area, which has even outpaced major countries like Britain.

This problem is not exclusive to Britain but is a global issue faced by many nations, where rising crime rates overwhelm the capacity of prisons. Bahrain, however, recognized this challenge early on and introduced a number of pioneering initiatives, ranging from open prisons and diverse corrective measures to the Royal Amnesty Decree, which has brought unparalleled peace, stability, and protection to the Bahraini society-benefits that cannot be measured in mere numbers.

I would like to shed light on the far-reaching positive impact of these initiatives in Bahrain, which have significantly reduced crime rates and contributed to comprehensive societal stability. This, in turn, has strengthened national loyalty, patriotism, and trust in the wise leadership of the Kingdom. Bahrain's Ministry of Interior and relevant authorities have prioritized reform and rehabilitation programs over mere punishment.

They implemented the Alternative Sentencing Program, which offers non-dangerous offenders the chance to serve sentences in ways that do not harm their reputation or well-being, while allowing them to remain with their families and maintain their livelihoods. Although I cannot delve into the full details of these alternative sentences in this brief article, I can at least highlight their profound impact.

Following this, the open prison system was introduced. We have witnessed the evolution of prison environments, providing convicted individuals time to reflect on their wrongdoings and observe the state's response to their crimes. They come to realize their mistakes, and many will never consider committing offenses against a nation that respected their humanity and offered them more than any ill-intentioned actors could have.

The problem arising out of rising temperatures is more pronounced for the nations in the Middle East which are traditionally weather challenged aue to extreme temperatures and scanty rainfall

Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, the esteemed King of Bahrain. More than 1,500 prisoners have been released under these decrees in recent times, and the entire nation celebrated-not just the families of the released but even those unrelated to them. We all witnessed this on television and social media, where the entire Bahraini community joined in the joy of the royal pardons.

Many in European countries may view themselves as advanced and developed, and indeed they are-but races of speed and horsemanship often begin with certain runners or riders in the lead, only to end with completely different results. This is exactly what Bahrain has achieved: learning from global experiences, studying them, and extracting lessons, then enhancing and refining them to rise to the top of the podium. These may have been initial ideas put forth by others, but Bahrain's patriotic hands have passionately and carefully shaped them into solutions that ensure our society is stable, safe, and harmonious. I am confident that the Bahraini experience we live today will be studied tomorrow by those who seek to implement leading models in their own countries.
