Push for one-year cap on building permit freezes

A one-year cap on freezing building permits has been put forward in Parliament, aimed at clearing the bureaucratic delays that have stalled planning and building.

MP Hassan Ibrahim's proposal asks the government to act faster on planning, stopping frozen permits from leaving landowners in a state of uncertainty for lengthy periods.

The proposal comes as many real estate owners voice their anger, saying delays have left their buildings languishing while they wait on government decisions.

Israeli demolitions in east Jerusalem prompt concern

Israel has demolished buildings in an area of annexed east Jerusalem located near some of the city's most important holy sites, prompting concern from Palestinian residents, activists and foreign governments.

"They are trying to break us," said Fakhri Abu Diab, a resident of Silwan neighbourhood where Israeli police forces on Wednesday demolished a cultural centre and a protest encampment, citing unauthorised construction.

They were located in Silwan's Al-Bustan area, near Jerusalem's Old City that is home to multiple religious sites, and where Israeli settler activity has intensified in recent years.

Iran 'behavioral change' sought

The United States said yesterday it wanted action rather than words by Iran on its nuclear program, after President Masoud Pezeshkian promised to resolve doubts.

"Ultimately, what we want to see from Iran is actual behavioral change and action, not just signs of something or indications of something," said State Department spokesman Vedant Patel.

Moonbound Kingdom

Bahrain's National Space Science Agency to Make Historic Lunar Landing in Partnership with UAE's Mohammed Bin Rashid Space Centre

Bahrain's journey into deep space took a historic step forward yesterday with the announcement that the National Space Science Agency (NSSA) will send its first payload to the Moon.

This announcement was made yesterday during the second day of the Bahrain International Airshow 2024.

This milestone mission, in collaboration with the United Arab Emirates' Mohammed Bin Rashid Space Centre (MBRSC), is part of the Emirates Lunar Mission, showcasing a shared Arab vision for space exploration and technological progress.

As part of the mission, Bahrain will contribute high-tech navigation cameras, developed by NSSA, that are designed to endure the Moon's harsh environment.

These cameras will play a vital role in the rover's navigation, allowing ground control to map the lunar surface, analyze soil samples, and monitor the rover's movement.

This payload marks Bahrain's first physical presence on the lunar surface, further aligning the nation's goals with the Artemis Accords for future Moon exploration and human missions.

Dr. Mohamed Ibrahim Al-Aseeri, CEO of NSSA, called the collaboration a "significant scientific achievement" and praised the mission's importance for both Bahrain's national advancement and the Arab region's growing presence in global space research.

"This mission reflects the high level of expertise within Bahrain's workforce, demonstrating our engineers' readiness to contribute at an international level," Dr. Al-Aseeri remarked.

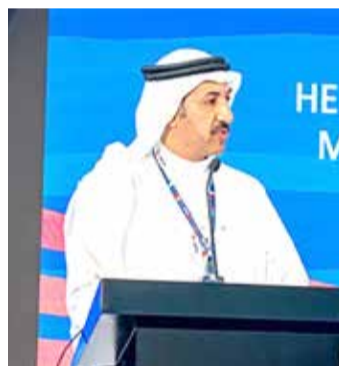

MPs propose law for annual pension increases

For retirees' welfare

A group of MPs, led by MP Khalid Buanq, have proposed a new law to guarantee the funding of annual increases to pensions under any retirement or insurance scheme.

The proposal aims to ensure these increases until surpluses are achieved in both the Social Insurance Organisation (SIO) and the Military Retirement Fund.

The proposed amendment would add a new clause (8) to paragraph (j) of Article (8) of Decree-Law No. (78) of 2006 concerning unemployment insurance.

This clause would mandate the funding of annual pension increases until both funds reach a surplus, while respecting clause (h) of the same article.

The explanatory memorandum accompanying the proposal emphasizes the importance of annual pension increases for maintaining a decent standard of living for

retirees, particularly in light of inflation and rising living costs.

The MPs argue that the proposal strengthens social solidarity and ensures the financial and social stability of retirees, aligning with the principles of the Bahraini Constitution.

The memorandum outlines the proposal's objectives: improving the living standards of retirees, guaranteeing annual increases to ensure a dignified life, and enhancing the financial sustainability of the retirement system by utilising surpluses from the unemployment insurance fund.

Healthier future

Proposal to 'exclusively' reserve healthcare ownership for Bahrainis up for debate

A proposal to make private healthcare ownership in Bahrain exclusive to Bahraini nationals is set for debate in the Shura Council on Sunday.

This initiative, backed by the Services Committee under Dr Jameela Al Salman, also introduces a new penalty system for delayed licence renewals, aimed at tightening regulatory oversight.

The plan, which is supported by fellow committee members Dr Ebtessam Al Dallal and Jamal Fakhro, seeks to strengthen Bahraini participation in the healthcare sector by granting sole ownership rights to citizens, with exceptions only for specialised foreign experts.

Local engagement

The proposal outlines that only Bahrainis would have the right to own clinics, medical centres, and other healthcare facilities, enhancing local engagement within the sector.

Over recent months, the committee has been in consultation with health regulators, the Su-

preme Council of Health, and private health groups, all of whom provided feedback on the proposal.

While generally supportive, these groups suggested further study to evaluate the potential impact on Bahrain's healthcare landscape.

Care standards

Data provided by the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) highlights the proposal's objectives: encouraging Bahraini ownership while maintaining care standards.

One key feature of the proposal is a revised penalty structure for late licence renewals.

Under this scheme, fines would start at 25 per cent of the renewal fee if payment is overdue by 30 days, with monthly increases over a three-month period. Licences unpaid after this period would face cancellation, reinforcing the proposal's regulatory aims.

Both the Ministry of Health and the Supreme Council of Health have endorsed the plan as a means to promote Bahraini ownership of medical practices.

Local jobs

Private health organisations, including the Private Hospitals Association, have largely welcomed the proposal, recognising its potential to create local jobs.

However, they have urged a degree of flexibility in the licence renewal process, proposing options to renew licences for periods ranging from one to three years and suggesting the possibility of fine waivers in specific cases.

With committee support, the proposal now moves forward to Sunday's council debate, where its implications for Bahrain's healthcare sector will be closely examined.

Empowering change

Shura Council proposal aims to lift business restrictions for married expatriate women

Married expatriate women in Bahrain may soon be able to run businesses without needing their husbands' permission, as a proposal to repeal an outdated law will be reviewed in the Shura Council this Sunday.

The initiative seeks to abolish Article 14 of Bahrain's Commercial Law, which currently requires foreign married women to obtain their husbands' consent to engage in trade.

Under the existing law, husbands can object to or withdraw consent at any time, imposing unnecessary restrictions on women who wish to start or manage a business.

The proposed change, backed by the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee, aims to remove these barriers and create a more equitable business environment.

This proposal aligns with Bahrain's commitment to international conventions on gender equality.

In 2002, Bahrain joined the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW) through Decree-Law No. 5, affirming equality between men

and women in fundamental rights and freedoms across political, economic, social, cultural, and civil domains.

Abolishing Article 14 would harmonise national legislation with Bahrain's policy of non-discrimination in commercial activities.

It is consistent with Decree-Law No. 27 of 2015 regard-

ing the Commercial Register, which ensures that both men and women have equal opportunities to engage in commerce, provided they are registered and licensed according to the law.

The move also reflects changes in regional legislation, such as the United Arab Emirates' Federal Decree-Law No. 50 of 2022, which amended previous

laws concerning the ability of married foreign women to engage in trade.

Proposal

Amid Bahrain's economic openness and efforts to provide a safe and attractive investment environment, the proposal aims to enhance legal frameworks for women's economic empow-



the proposal aims to enhance legal frameworks for women's economic empowerment without discriminatory conditions that hinder economic equality between genders.

It seeks to protect women's financial and commercial rights and interests.

The proposal will be debated in the Shura Council and could be approved in upcoming sessions.

If passed, it will allow women to pursue commercial ventures without unnecessary obstacles, supporting Bahrain's goal of being a more inclusive and competitive market.

'Vanishing act': UK Magic Circle seeks disappearing woman

Britain's Magic Circle has launched an appeal to track down a woman it expelled over three decades ago for posing as a man to gain admittance to the formerly male-only magicians' society.

The London-based international magic organisation now wants to apologise to Sophie Lloyd who was ejected in 1991 for "masquerading as a male".

Lloyd, who had posed as Raymond Lloyd for 18 months, unmasked herself as a woman when the organisation voted to admit women in 1991.

But members angered at her "deliberate deception", went ahead with her expulsion.

Efforts to locate Lloyd, also thought to use the name Sue, have so far drawn a blank.

"Has she vanished? Who knows what the reason is that we haven't found her but right now the vanishing act is still very much a mystery," Laura London, the first female chair of the Magic Circle, said.

UN accuses Israel of genocide in Gaza

UN committee accuses Israel of using starvation as warfare method, causing mass civilian casualties

UN committee says Israel's actions in Gaza consistent with genocide

Report documents decimation of essential services, environmental harm

Concerns raised over AI-assisted targeting systems with minimal oversight

Israel's warfare in Gaza is consistent with the characteristics of genocide, a special UN committee said yesterday, accusing the country of "using starvation as a method of war".

The United Nations Special Committee pointed to "mass civilian casualties and life-threatening conditions intentionally imposed on Palestinians", in a fresh report covering the period from Hamas's deadly October 7 attack in Israel last year through to July.

"Through its siege over Gaza, obstruction of humanitarian aid, alongside targeted attacks and killing of civilians and aid workers, despite repeated UN appeals, binding orders from the International Court of Justice and resolu-

tions of the Security Council, Israel is intentionally causing death, starvation and serious injury," it said in a statement.

Israel's warfare practices in Gaza "are consistent with the characteristics of genocide", said the committee, which has for decades been investigating Israeli practices affecting rights in the occupied Palestinian territories.

Israel, it charged, was "using starvation as a method of war and inflicting collective punishment on the Palestinian population".

A UN-backed assessment at the weekend warned that famine was imminent in northern Gaza.

Yesterday's report documented how Israel's extensive bombing campaign in Gaza had decimated essential services and unleashed

an environmental catastrophe with lasting health impacts.

By February this year, Israeli forces had used more than 25,000 tonnes of explosives across the Gaza Strip, "equivalent to two nuclear bombs", the report pointed out.

AI-assisted targeting

"By destroying vital water,



The UN Special Committee estimated that Israeli forces had used over 25,000 tons of explosives across the Gaza Strip since the start of the conflict, which it described as being "equivalent to two nuclear bombs" in terms of the scale of destruction

43,700 people have been killed since the war began, according to the health ministry in the Hamas-run territory.

The staggering number of deaths raised serious concerns, it said, about Israel's use of artificial intelligence-enhanced targeting systems in its military operations.

"The Israeli military's use of AI-assisted targeting, with minimal human oversight, combined with heavy bombs, underscores Israel's disregard of its obligation to distinguish between civilians and combatants and take adequate safeguards to prevent civilian deaths," it said.

The committee said it was "deeply alarmed by the unprecedented destruction of civilian infrastructure and the high death toll in Gaza", where more than

Yesterday, the 55-year-old said he expected "a strong majority" in parliament to press ahead with his platform.

"We believe that this is a crucial election that will mark a turning point in Sri Lanka," Dissanayake told reporters after casting his ballot a polling

station in the capital. "At this election, the NPP expects a mandate for a very strong majority in parliament," he said referring to the National People's Power coalition in which his JVP, or the People's Liberation Front (JVP) is the main constituent.

Police said the nine-hour voting period passed without any incidents of violence, unlike most ballots of recent years, but three election workers including a police constable had died due to illness while on duty.

Voter turnout figures were

not immediately available but election officials said participation appeared to be less than presidential polls, when nearly 80 percent of Sri Lanka's eligible voters cast a ballot.

"I expect a new country, a new government that is friendly towards the people," 70-year-old pensioner Milton Gankandage, who was among the first to vote in Colombo's Wellawatte district, told AFP.

"Previous rulers deceived us. We need a new set of rulers who will develop the country," Dissanayake had been an MP for nearly 25 years and was briefly an agriculture minister but his NPP coalition held just three seats in the outgoing assembly.

He stormed to the presidency after successfully distancing himself from establishment politicians blamed for steering the country to its worst economic crisis in 2022.

His JVP party led two insurrections in 1971 and 1987, leading to at least 80,000 deaths, but Dissanayake was sworn in after an election described as one of the island nation's most peaceful.

University academic Sivalogadasan, who goes by one name, said Dissanayake needed more time to deliver his promises.

COP29 host tries to calm waters after diplomatic turmoil

Host Azerbaijan tried to bring down the diplomatic temperature in Baku yesterday after a French minister cancelled her trip to the UN climate talks and Argentina withdrew its delegation.

While negotiators work behind closed doors at the COP29 talks to trash out a climate finance deal, the spotlight has been largely stolen by diplomatic turmoil.

France's Environment Minister Agnes Pannier-Runacher said Wednesday she would not

travel to Baku after Azerbaijan's Paris of colonial "crimes" and President Ilham Aliyev accused "human rights violations" in its

overseas territories.

Pannier-Runacher called his speech "unacceptable... and beneath the dignity of the presidency of the COP."

It was also a "flagrant violation of the code of conduct" for running United Nations climate talks, she added.

Attempting to calm the waters yesterday, COP29 lead negotiator Yalchin Rafiyev insisted that Azerbaijan had fostered "an inclusive process".

"We have opened our doors to everybody to come to engage in very constructive, fruitful discussions," he told reporters.

Scientists say world's largest coral found near Solomon Islands

Scientists say they have found the world's largest coral near the Pacific's Solomon Islands, announcing yesterday a major discovery "pulsing with life and colour".

The coral is so immense that researchers sailing the crystal waters of the Solomon archipelago initially thought they had stumbled across a hulking shipwreck.

"Just when we think there is nothing left to discover on planet earth, we find a massive coral made of nearly one billion little polyps, pulsing with life and colour," marine ecologist Enric Sala said.

The standalone structure had been growing for some 300 years, the researchers said, formed from a "complex network" of tiny coral polyps. It was distinct from a coral reef, which is made from many distinct coral colonies, they ex-

plained. Measuring 34 metres wide (111 feet) and 32 metres long (104 feet), the team said the "mega coral" was three times bigger than the previous record holder -- a coral dubbed "Big Momma" in American Samoa.

"While Big Momma looked like a huge scoop of ice cream plopped down on the reef, this newly discovered coral is as if the ice cream started to melt, spreading forever along the seafloor," said lead scientist Molly Timmers.

It was longer than a blue whale and was thought to be "so colossal" that it could "be seen from space".

Thousands flee as Typhoon Usagi hits north Philippines

Typhoon Usagi slammed into the Philippines' already disaster-ravaged north yesterday, as authorities rushed to evacuate thousands of people from flood-prone areas.

The fifth storm to strike the country in just three weeks, Usagi made landfall in the town of Baggao in Cagayan province at 0530 GMT, packing winds of 175 kilometres (109 miles) an hour, the national weather service said.

The brutal wave of weather disasters has already killed 159 people and prompted the United Nations to request \$32.9 million in aid for the worst-affected regions.

The national weather agency

had initially raised its highest storm alert, but downgraded to its second-highest as Usagi made landfall.

It weakened to 165 kilometres an hour as it ploughed north to the municipality of Gonzaga and open waters beyond it.

Baggao police said no casualties or substantial damage were immediately reported, while 28 residents of a village were evacuated amid concern it would get flooded.

"It was weaker than we expected," a relieved police officer, Karen Ibarra, told AFP by phone.

President Ferdinand Marcos, visiting storm-affected areas to urge emergency cash aid, urged residents to comply with evacuation orders.

London mayor says Trump attacks due to his ethnicity and religion

London Mayor Sadiq Khan has accused Donald Trump of repeatedly criticising him because of his "ethnicity" and Muslim faith, in comments likely to renew his long-running feud with the US president-elect.

The pair became embroiled in an extraordinary war of words during Trump's first presidency, initially sparked by Khan speaking out against a US travel ban on people from certain Muslim countries.

Trump then accused Khan -- the first Muslim mayor of a Western capital when he was first elected in 2016 -- of doing a "very bad job on terrorism" and called him a "stone cold loser" and "very dumb".

The mayor in turn allowed an unflattering blimp of Trump dressed as a baby in a nappy to fly above protests in Parliament Square during his 2018 visit to Britain.

Speaking on a podcast re-

corded before Trump's re-election on November 5 and released earlier this week, Khan, a son of Pakistani immigrants to Britain, said he viewed the past targeting of him as "incredibly personal".

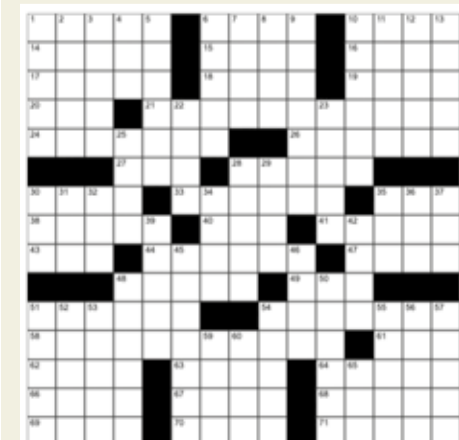

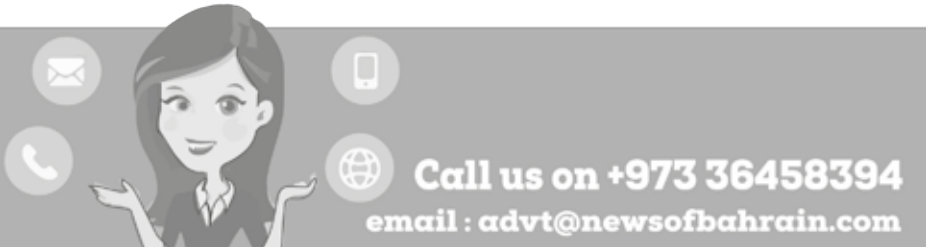

Bahrain's World Cup dreams were in delicate balance yesterday at the Bahrain National Stadium, with the crowd primed for celebration after a hard-fought match.

In the 87th minute, Ali Haram appeared to seal the 3 points with a perfectly timed strike off a cross from Abdulwahab AlMalood, sparking hope that Bahrain would leapfrog to second place in Group C.

Yet, in a shocking twist, VAR ruled Haram's goal offside. Moments later, China seized their chance in the dying moments, netting the match-winning goal



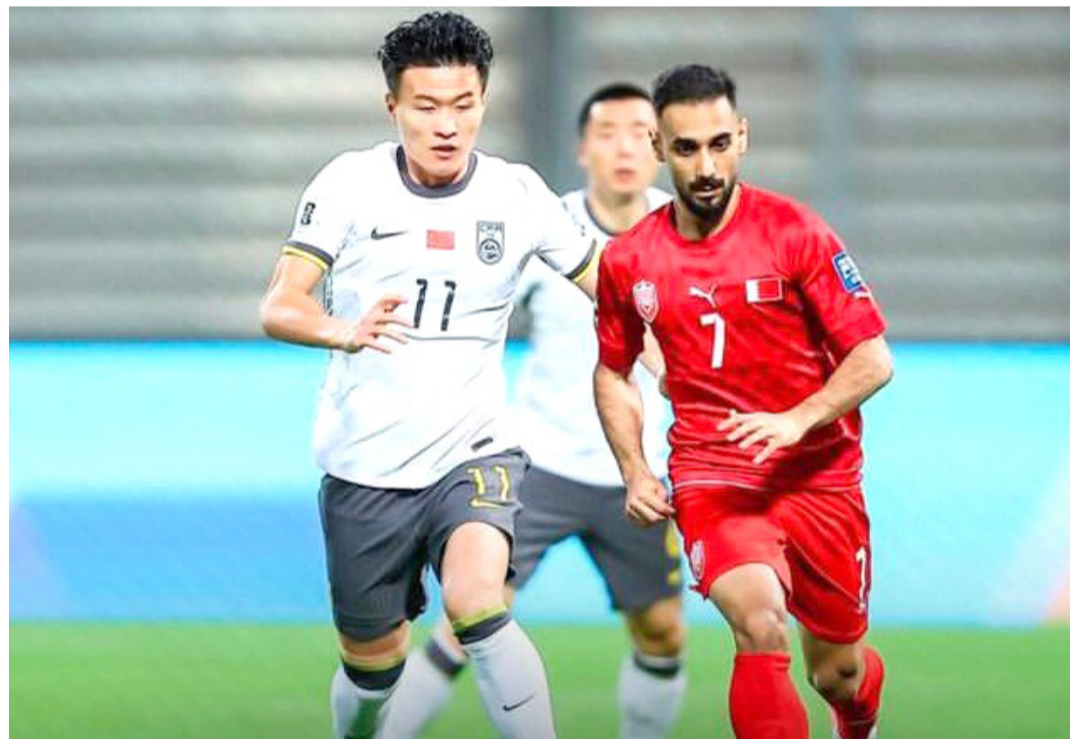
Bahrain's disallowed goal shifted them from a potential second in Group C to a disheartening fifth

to turn Bahrain's elation into despair.

China's Stunning Equalizer and Bahrain's Collapse

The game's closing moments turned brutal for Bahrain. In the 90+3 mark, Zhang Yuning's equalizer stunned the Bahraini faithful, just as victory seemed within reach.

To rub salt into the wounds, Waleed Al Hayam received a red card at the 90+8 mark, giving China an advantage as they pressed mercilessly. Bahrain's hopes unraveled entirely as China's last-minute push clinched a 1-0 win, leaving Bahrain's qualification hopes in dire straits.

Group C Standings and Implications

As the final whistle blew, Bahrain found themselves slipping not to second, but to fifth place in Group C—a staggering

blow to their World Cup aspirations. The updated standings saw Japan leading with 10 points, while Australia, Saudi Arabia, and China each sat on 6, Bahrain on 5, and Indonesia at the bottom with 3. A chance to

climb to second had evaporated, leaving Bahrain on the brink of despair.

Saudi Arabia vs Australia Stalemate

In another Group C match,

Saudi Arabia and Australia played out a 0-0 draw in Melbourne, a result that adds even more pressure on Bahrain's upcoming match. Australia now shares second place with Saudi Arabia and China, keeping the standings tight. Indonesia will host Japan at 3PM today in Jakarta.

Bahrain's Chance for Redemption

The journey isn't over for Bahrain, but their margin for error has dwindled. Bahrain will look to regroup and refocus as they prepare to host Australia at the Bahrain National Stadium on December 19.

While Bahrain famously defeated Australia on their home turf in the Gold Coast this past September, that win now feels like a distant memory. Football can be a cruel game, but the next match promises a chance at redemption. The bitter memory of yesterday's defeat will linger, fueling the desire for a comeback.

Shortly after, Bahrain will have to shift their focus to the Gulf Cup, starting on December 22.
