'Supermoon' set to light up Bahrain's sky

Look up! Bahrain's skies will soon host the last 'supermoon' of 2024, bringing the moon closer than your average flight distance — just 357,000 kilometres away.

Astronomy researcher Mohammed Redha Al Asfour has revealed that this celestial spectacle will coincide with the full moon of Rabi' al-Thani 1446 AH, occurring tomorrow and on Friday.

Tomorrow, the moon will rise at 5:04pm, just ahead of sunset, before it sets at 6:26am the following morning, after dawn breaks.

The supermoon will appear larger and brighter than usual, especially compared to its position at apogee, when it sits farthest from our planet.

Al Asfour noted that the October full moon is known as the "Hunter's Moon," a name steeped in history from ancient tribes in North America and Europe.

Expatriate Housing: Health a Priority

Government sets stricter regulations on shared accommodation for foreign workers

Leasing of shared accommodation for expat workers will be regulated and monitored for compliance with health and safety standards, the Government informed the Council of Representatives yesterday.

This move aims to protect national heritage while ensuring the well-being of expatriates through more inspections and stricter health and safety standards in shared housing.

In a written response to MPs, the Government stated, "We are determined to regulate the leasing of shared accommodation for expat workers to ensure their safety and well-being."

To support this effort, a team has been set up in each governorate to inspect properties where

Chaired by the relevant governor, the team includes representatives from the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Labour, the Civil Defence Administration, and the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA).

These actions support Article 34 of the Constitution, which

aims to keep society safe.

In 2015, new rules were introduced to tackle human trafficking, building on commitments made in international agreements.

These rules include protections for victims and penalties, such as imprisonment and heavy fines for offenders.



Under Labour Law, employers must provide appropriate accommodation for expat workers that meets health and safety standards, ensuring gender separation and decent living conditions.

The government also points out that the Labour Law, enacted by Royal Decree No. 27 of 2014, prevents the employment of non-Bahraini workers with-

out a valid work permit.

Compliance

"The recent Cabinet Decision No. 1 of 2023 aims to regulate the housing of expat workers in the Capital Governorate, ensuring compliance with health and environmental requirements," the government added.

In summary, the government reaffirms its dedication to international obligations regarding the care of victims of human trafficking, providing essential support and helping them return to their home countries.

It stresses the need for community awareness in tackling this issue and calls for cooperation among all relevant groups.

Breaking 'tradition' as MPs' session goes unstreamed

In the first parliamentary session yesterday, following a procedural meeting that followed a four-month recess, the Council of Representatives did not live stream the session on its YouTube platform for the first time in years.

This marked a notable departure from previous sessions that were typically viewed live by thousands. Instead, a recorded video of the session was later posted on the Council's channel.

During the session, the Council discussed messages received from the government regarding

30 proposals.

A brief exchange took place at the beginning between Council Speaker Ahmed Al Musallam and newly elected member Abdul Wahid Qarata.

Request

Al Musallam denied Qarata's request to deliver an unlisted speech, despite Qarata's appeal to parliamentary traditions.

In his remarks, MP Dr Ali Al Nuaimi acknowledged the media's presence, stating, "I would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the presence of our media colleagues from the press and media on their journey with us in the first and

second rounds, as well as today in the third round. We assure them that the media sector and the press deserve a lot, and we stand with you in all circumstances."

The session was attended by HE Ghanim bin Fadhl Al Buainain, Minister of Parliamentary Affairs, Dr Mariam Adhbi Al Jalahma, Chief Executive Officer of Government Hospitals, and other officials from various government departments.

However, the selection of members for the five parliamentary committees did not take place during this session.

Surplus oil profits to cover deficit before tackling public debt

Government proposal aims to advance Kingdom's financial stability

Surplus oil revenues will be used to reduce Bahrain's BD681 million budget deficit for 2023 and 2024, with plans to lower public debt postponed, the Government announced.

This shift comes as the focus remains on addressing the shortfall, with any strategies for reducing public debt set aside for now.

This decision stems from a review of a proposal put forth by MPs to the Speaker of the Council of Representatives, Ahmed Al Musallam, which called for a definitive approach to minimising public debt.

Precedence

However, the Government determined that tackling

the deficit takes precedence, allocating BD520 million for 2023 and BD161 million for 2024.

Officials acknowledged that any further surpluses generated from the current budget could later be applied to debt reduction.

Moreover, ongoing initiatives under the Fiscal Balance Programme are designed to gradually decrease public debt and ensure long-term financial stability.

Operational costs

These efforts involve enhancing the efficiency of operational costs and boosting government revenues, with an aim to reduce public debt relative to GDP.

While recognising the Council's concerns, the government stressed that the aims of the proposal are being achieved through existing reforms.

Ministers confirmed their willingness to collaborate with the Council of Representatives to advance the nation's financial stability.

Faulty system delays pension payments for families

A BD4 million upgrade has left pensioners and grieving families in a state of confusion as a faulty system brings operations to a standstill.

During yesterday's meeting of the Council of Representatives, several MPs put forward a proposal that received unanimous support.

This proposal seeks to expedite the payment of retirement pensions for deceased individuals and tackle the backlog affecting beneficiaries of the Social Insurance Organisation (SIO).

The disruption has arisen from a malfunction in the e-system that the SIO depends on.

The explanatory memorandum accompanying the proposal outlines a pressing need to resolve the ongoing issues and prevent them from recurring.

Thousands of transactions relating to subscribers' pensions have been delayed, impacting payments to orphans, widows, and bereaved families, as well as transactions linked to replacement loans.

Old cars, new rules

Government rejects proposal to extend import age limit for used cars amidst rising vehicle numbers

The government has rejected a parliamentary proposal to extend the permissible import age for used vehicles from five to 10 years and waive registration fees for used cars.

The government cited concerns about the rapid increase in registered vehicles and its potential impact on public safety and the environment.

According to official statistics, the number of registered vehicles in Bahrain has risen significantly over the past decade.

In 2023, the total reached 749,376, a substantial increase from 545,155 in 2013.

This represents an annual growth rate of approximately 3.26%, with around 20,000 new vehicles registered each year.

Regulations

The government maintains that the current regulations,

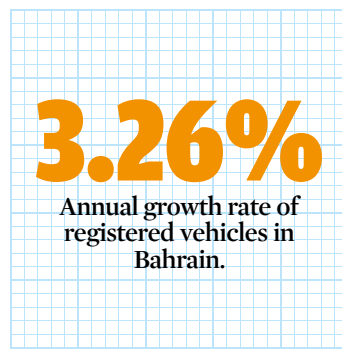

implemented through Decree No. (17) of 2021, strike a balance between the need for vehicle imports and the preservation of environmental safety and vehicle quality within the market.

Prior to this decree, the import of private cars, private transport vehicles, and motorcycles older than five years was prohibited.

The government's rejection of the proposed fee waiver for used car registration stems



from its belief that these fees are levied for a specific service benefiting a particular group of importers.

Waiving these fees, the government argues, would negatively impact public revenue and hinder its ability to provide essential services.

Furthermore, they contend that such a waiver would likely lead to an increase in the import of older, less safe vehicles, pos-

ing risks to public safety and the environment.

The government emphasised its commitment to finding solutions to manage the steadily increasing number of vehicles while protecting the public interest.

The rejection of the parliamentary proposal underscores the government's cautious approach to regulating the used car market in Bahrain.

Tawasul's e-platform receives major upgrades

The government has announced its approval of an urgent proposal from several members of parliament regarding improvements to the "Tawasul" electronic platform, stating that the proposed enhancements have been already implemented.

The government detailed a series of new features launched on the Tawasul platform.

These include an automated question: "Has your complaint or inquiry been addressed?"

If the complainant selects "no," the complaint is automat-



ically reopened.

A satisfaction survey has also been introduced to gauge the complainant's satisfaction with the response's comprehensiveness and the handling of their complaint.

To ensure quality responses, the government has implemented oversight mechanisms under the supervision of the

relevant minister and the Prime Minister's Office.

New evaluation criteria for government agencies using Tawasul have been developed, aiming for a minimum 70% complainant satisfaction rate.

Furthermore, the platform aims to limit complaint reopenings to less than 5% of cases and avoid forced closures in less than 5% of cases.

Automatic notifications are sent to the minister's office and the Prime Minister's Office if a complaint on Tawasul is reopened more than three times or if forced closure is implemented.

Two GCC nationals charged with murder

Deliberate car attack incident

Two GCC nationals have been charged with murder following a shocking incident in which they deliberately crashed their car into a group of people, resulting in one death and multiple injuries.

The High Criminal Court will hear the case, with the suspects facing charges of premeditated murder and attempted murder after the Public Prosecution received reports of the crash.

The car involved fled the scene.

Investigations revealed that

the collision was intentional, as confirmed by security footage.

Authorities discovered that the driver and another individual in the vehicle conspired to hit one of the victims due to a dispute.

Arrest warrant

One of the suspects has been arrested,



while the other is believed to have fled the country, leading to the issuance of an international arrest warrant.

Necessary examinations have been carried out, and a forensic doctor has been assigned to assess the deceased and the injured victims. Witness statements have also been taken.

Given the strong evidence against them, the Public Prosecution has ordered both suspects to be referred to the High Criminal Court, with a hearing scheduled for 20 October 2024.

Government rejects bill for foreigners in debt

The government has rejected a parliamentary bill that would prevent the deportation of foreign nationals after serving prison sentences unless all their debts to creditors in Bahrain are settled.

The government argues that the bill prioritises individual interests over the public good.

In a memorandum to the Council of Representatives, the government asserted that international law grants states the authority to regulate aspects of life within their territories to ensure security, justice, and welfare.

This includes controlling the entry and residence of foreigners and preventing the entry of those deemed undesirable.

The government emphasised the inherent right of a state to deport any foreigner posing a threat to security, order, public morals, public health, the national economy, or for other justifiable reasons.

The government highlighted that Bahraini law, specifically the Penal Code, includes provi-

sions for judicial deportation.

This discretionary power allows judges to order deportation if a foreigner is convicted of a crime and deemed a threat to security, order, or society.

Judicial deportation serves as a supplementary penalty, determined by the judge based on the presented evidence and the perceived danger posed by the convicted individual.

The government's rejection is based on the established legal principle that the public interest supersedes individual interests.

Interests

If these interests conflict, the public interest must prevail.

The government contends that the proposed bill would restrict the judge's authority to deport, even if a conviction and societal threat are established, solely to protect the rights of creditors.

This, the government argues, constitutes an unacceptable prioritisation of individual interests over the public good and represents an abuse of legislative power.

Bu Maher coastline designated as public area

The Muharraq Municipal Council's Services and Utilities Committee, chaired by Abdulqader Al Sayed and including members Saleh Buhazah, Fadhel Al Oud, and Dalal Al Muqahwi, has approved a key proposal submitted by the chairman of the council,

Abdulaziz Al Naar, to designate the Bu Maher coastline as a public area.

This initiative aims to enhance access for both Muharraq residents and the broader community. The committee directed the development of preliminary designs, and funding into the Ministry's coastal development plan.

Three Asian employees acquitted of embezzlement charges

The High Appeals Court has acquitted three Asian employees of embezzling BD18,000 worth of goods from their company's warehouse.

The Court overturned a lower court's ruling, accept-

ing the defendants' claims that they were coerced into signing statements and that company officials were aware of the inventory shortage months before filing a report. A complaint was filed by the company alleging a significant shortfall in its warehouse stock.

From Quran to Kitchen: A Zero-Waste Journey

How Dawoodi Bohra community is leading by example in Bahrain's fight against food waste

In a world grappling with rising food insecurity and environmental challenges, the Dawoodi Bohra community in Bahrain has emerged as a model of sustainability, guided by the timeless teachings of Islam. Through their innovative and dedicated 'Dana Committee', they have institutionalized the concept of zero food waste, integrating faith with environmental responsibility.

Asma Dawood, a community member, highlights that the roots of this philosophy can be traced back to Islamic scripture. "Islam has always emphasized the importance of food as a bounty from the Almighty. The Quran itself says, 'Eat and drink, but do not waste, indeed Allah abhors the wasteful' (7:31)." A Structured Approach to Sustainability

At the heart of the Dawoodi Bohra community's zero food waste initiative is the three-phased approach overseen by the Dana Committee. Khadija Sadriwala, a key volunteer, explains, "We work diligently to minimize waste at every stage - from planning meals to redi-

tributing leftovers."

Before any event, the committee uses RSVP apps and sheets to gauge attendance accurately, ensuring the right amount of food is prepared. During communal meals, committee members remind attendees to serve

themselves only what they can finish. And after every meal, any excess food is packaged hygienically and distributed to those in need, making sure nothing goes to waste.

This process is more than just logistical planning - it's a manifestation of the community's commitment to sustainability. "The message of zero food waste is reinforced constantly, not just at community events, but in our homes and religious spaces as well," adds Abid Barnuswala, another active volunteer.

A Decade of Progress

Though the principles of avoiding waste have long been ingrained in the community's teachings, Ebrahim Salman Pitawala shares that the formalization of the Dana Committee

began about a decade ago. "This initiative wasn't a reaction to global issues; it's always been a part of our faith. The committee was established to ensure that the principles we've always upheld are practiced more effectively across homes, mosques, and community centres."

This community-led effort has garnered positive responses, with many embracing the culture of mindful eating. "We've seen people, even those who used to enjoy large meals, becoming more conscious of their portions and food choices," says Murtaza Kaka, another member.

The Dana Committee works closely with labour camps, staff accommodations, and even the Bahrain Food Bank to distribute leftovers. 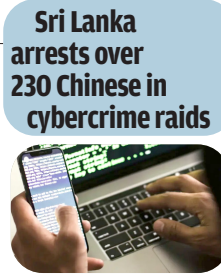

The survivor was named by RIA Novosti news agency as Mikhail Pichugin, while his brother Sergei, 49, and nephew Ilya, 15, died. Their bodies were on the boat.

UN peacekeepers to 'stay in all positions' in Lebanon

United Nations peacekeepers will stay in all positions in Lebanon despite Israeli calls for them to move amid intensifying fighting between Israel and Hezbollah.

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on Monday again called for the peacekeepers in southern Lebanon to move from certain areas close to Israel's border with Lebanon.

"The decision was made that UNIFIL would currently stay in all its positions in spite of the calls that were made by the Israel Defense Forces to vacate the positions that are in the vicinity of the Blue Line."

"I want to emphasize that this decision still remains," he said, adding that the plan was confirmed earlier Monday by Secretary-General Antonio Guterres.

Five peacekeepers were injured in a series of incidents last week, with the latest seeing the UN force accuse Israeli troops of breaking through a gate and entering one of their positions.

The UN Security Council for the first time unanimously voiced "strong concerns" Monday after the string of incidents.

Hezbollah threatens to attack targets across Israel

Hezbollah threatened yesterday to attack targets across Israel and said it would not be defeated by ongoing intense bombardment of its strongholds and leadership.

"Against the backdrop of ongoing hostilities along the Blue Line, the members of the Security Council expressed their strong concerns after several UNIFIL positions came under fire in the past days."

"Several peacekeepers have been wounded." In the statement, which did not single out Israel, the 15 council members "urged all parties to respect the safety and security of UNIFIL personnel and premises."

Under Security Council Resolution 1701, only UNIFIL's roughly 9,500 troops and Lebanon's army should be deployed in Lebanon's south.

targeted all of Lebanon, we have the right from a defensive position to target any place" in Israel, "whether the centre, the north or the south," he said. "I am telling the Israeli home front: the solution is a ceasefire," he added.

Lebanon's Prime Minister Najib Mikati told AFP that his country was ready to bolster its military presence in the south after any ceasefire, adding that Israeli troops were making brief cross-border incursions.

Security has been tightened in the country's only airport in Beirut "to remove any pretexts" for an Israeli attack, Mikati added.

Middle East 'conflagration' to top agenda at first EU-Gulf summit

Avoiding a "general conflagration" in the Middle East will be top of the agenda when European Union and Gulf leaders meet in Brussels this week.

Heads of state and government from six Gulf countries -- Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates -- are expected to attend the first summit on Wednesday with their EU counterparts in the Belgian capital.

Trade, energy and climate change are among issues on the table.

UN decries 'worst restrictions' on Gaza aid since start of war

Conflict-ravaged Gaza appears to be facing the worst restrictions on aid since the Israel-Hamas war began over a year ago, the UN said yesterday, lamenting the especially devastating impact on children.

"Day after day, the situation for children becomes worse than the day before," said James Elder, spokesman for the UN children's agency UNICEF.

Vast areas of Gaza have been devastated by Israel's retaliatory assault on the territory after the October 7 Hamas attack last year sparked the war.

And Israel has been intensifying operations in the north of the besieged Palestinian territory, where the UN has warned hundreds of thousands of people are trapped.

Despite a desperate need to increase the amount of aid going in, Elder lamented that aid access was worsening.

"August was the lowest amount of humanitarian aid that came into the Gaza Strip of any full month since the war broke out," he said.

There had been "several days in the last week (where) no commercial trucks whatsoever were allowed to come in," Elder added. "We see now what is probably the worst restrictions we've seen on humanitarian aid, ever."

Earlier in the year, amid warnings that the UN could declare a full-fledged famine in Gaza, Elder said there had been "a real push to have new routes and access points open".

But now, "we have seen an absolute reversal of that," he warned, adding that since May, "we've seen consistent entry points blocked".

Northern Gaza meanwhile "hasn't had food, any food aid at all coming in all of October", he added.

The dire lack of aid, coupled with the relentless strikes and the fact that around 85 percent of the Gaza Strip has been hit with some form of evacuation order, has made the territory "essentially unlivable", Elder said.

Polio vaccination campaign

Despite escalating Israeli military operations in certain areas, the second round of a polio vaccination campaign for hundreds of thousands of children began on Monday.

The vaccination drive began after the Gaza Strip confirmed its first case of polio in 25 years. Like the initial round, the second will be divided into three phases, helped by localised "humanitarian pauses" in the fighting.

Last week, the UN acknowledged that the second round would be "more complicated" than when the first doses were given last month.

The aim is to provide more than 590,000 children under the age of 10 with a second dose, with nearly 93,000 doses delivered in central Gaza on Monday alone, WHO spokesman Tarik Jasarevic told reporters.

"The vaccination went without major issues yesterday," he said, adding that he hoped the necessary humanitarian pauses would be observed throughout the territory.

India foreign minister lands in Pakistan

Indian Foreign Minister Subrahmanya Jaishankar arrived in Pakistan yesterday for a Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) summit, the first top Delhi diplomat to visit their neighbour in nearly a decade.

Jaishankar's plane landed just before 3:30 pm (0300 GMT) at an airbase near the capital Islamabad, a foreign office official said, as state TV showed him receiving a bouquet of flowers from a host delegation that did not include any senior ministers.

Indian government spokesman Randhir Jaiswal said this month the agenda of Jaishankar's visit would strictly follow the SCO schedule, which is due to discuss trade, humanitarian and social issues.

"The Indian foreign minister has not requested a bilateral meeting, nor have we extended an invitation to them," Pakistan Foreign Minister Ishaq Dar said on Sunday.

North Korea blows up roads connecting it to the South

North Korea blew up sections of the deeply symbolic roads and railways connecting it to the South yesterday, Seoul's military said, adding it had conducted a "counter-fire" operation in response.

Pyongyang's military last week vowed to permanently seal its southern border after spending months laying mines and building anti-tank barriers in the wake of leader Kim Jong Un declaring the South his country's "principal enemy".

The North also accused Seoul of using drones to drop anti-regime propaganda leaflets on the capital Pyongyang, with Kim convening a security meeting to direct a plan of "immediate military action" in response, state media reported Tuesday.

"North Korea has detonated parts of the Gyeongui and Donghae roads north of the Military Demarcation Line," the Joint Chiefs of Staff said Tuesday, referring to inter-Korean infrastructure that once connected the two countries.

Bomb hoax forces Air India plane to make emergency landing in Canada

The latest in a string of hoax bomb threats made to Indian airlines forced an Air India plane to make an emergency landing in Canada, the airline said yesterday.

The passenger aircraft, flying from India's capital New Delhi to Chicago, was the subject of "a security threat posted online" and as a "precautionary measure" has landed at Iqaluit Airport in Canada, Air India said.

The aircraft and passengers were being "re-screened as per the laid down security protocol," the company said.

"Air India notes that it, and other local airlines, have been subject to a number of threats in recent days," it added.

"Though all have subsequently been found to be hoaxes, as a

responsible airline operator all threats are taken seriously."

Indian media reported that an Air India flight from Mumbai to New York was diverted mid-air to New Delhi after a false alert on Monday.

Similar hoaxes were received by India's low-cost operator IndiGo regarding two flights that were to take off -- to Jeddah in Saudi Arabia, and to Muscat in Oman, according to Indian media.

Israel tells US will not hit Iran's nuclear or oil facilities: media

Washington, United States

Israel has assured the White House that a planned retaliatory attack on Iran won't target nuclear or oil facilities, US media reported Monday.

Israel has vowed to counterattack after Iran fired ballistic missiles at the country on October 1, launched in response to Israel's killing of Tehran-aligned militant leaders in the region, along with a general in Iran's Revolutionary Guards.

Citing unnamed US officials, the Washington Post said that Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu had reassured the White House that a counterstrike it is contemplating would target only military sites.

The Wall Street Journal, also citing US officials speaking on condition of anonymity, said the pledge came in a call between US President Joe Biden and Netanyahu last week, as well as in conversations in recent days between US Defense Secretary Lloyd Austin and his Israeli counterpart, Yoav Gallant. Biden has warned Israel against striking Iran's nuclear or oil facilities in order to avoid a further expansion of regional war and amid worries of a spike in global energy prices.

Italian PM Meloni says will visit Lebanon

Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni said yesterday she would visit Lebanon, where Italian troops are part of a UN mission that has accused Israeli forces of firing on peacekeepers.

"It is already planned that I will go to Lebanon," she told the Senate, without giving a date.

Foreign Minister Antonio Tajani will be heading to Israel and the Palestinian territories next week, Meloni added.

UNIFIL, a United Nations mission of about 9,500 troops of various nationalities created following Israel's 1978 invasion of Lebanon, has accused the Israeli military of "deliberately" firing on its positions.

Meloni, whose country is the second-biggest contributor of UNIFIL peacekeepers, has condemned the attacks several times.

Saudi eyes electric jets to reach Mecca, new resorts

AFP | Riyadh, Saudi Arabia

Saudi Arabia's flag carrier is turning to a cash-strapped German firm for electric jets to service routes to new luxury resorts and the holy city of Mecca, an official said.

The aircraft from Munich-based Lilium will provide direct links to hard-to-reach routes along the Red Sea coast and ferry Muslim pilgrims directly from Jeddah to Mecca, which does not have an airport, Saudia communications affairs manager Razan Shaker said.

"Our strategy is that it will help in bridging the locations and the cities that don't have an airport or that are maybe hard to go to," she told AFP on the sidelines of a logistics forum in Riyadh.

The plans include flying pilgrims to the iconic Fairmont Makkah Clock Royal Tower hotel, near Mecca's Grand Mosque, where "we're working on creating a helipad", she said.

In July Saudia announced it was buying 50 Lilium electric Vertical Take-Off and Landing (eVTOL) jets with options to purchase 50 more.

The airline is expected to start taking delivery of the Lilium jets, which seat four to six passengers and fly up to 175 kilometres (109 miles), in 2026.

The Saudia order was "the largest reported firm order of eVTOL aircraft by an airline that plans to operate the aircraft", a statement said at the time, adding that it "signals a substantial commitment to electric aviation".

Neither Saudia nor Lilium have disclosed the value of the

deal but Daniel Wiegand, Lilium's chief engineer for innovation, told AFP the aircraft typically goes for between \$7 million and \$9 million.

A filing last month by Lilium to the US Securities and Exchange Commission said the firm "requires additional capital immediately to continue to fund its ongoing operations" and that its "ability to continue as a going concern is highly dependent on our ability to obtain" a German government loan.

Lilium was also pursuing financing from private investors, Wiegand said, noting it was "no secret... that we are currently raising money".

Saudi Arabia aims to more than triple annual aviation traffic to 330 million passengers by the end of the decade as part of Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman's "Vision 2030" reform agenda to remake the petroleum-centred economy.

Transport Minister Saleh al-Jasser told AFP a planned new airport in Riyadh capable of accommodating 120 million passengers a year was "at the core of the aviation strategy", and officials have talked about a "massive expansion" of the Jeddah airport as well.

The company has unveiled a revamped version of its Uber Green service, now exclusively featuring all-electric vehicles. Previously, Uber Green offered both hybrid and fully electric options, but the shift to an EV-only model marks a significant step in the company's sustainability strategy.

To enhance user experience, Uber will introduce a feature allowing riders to prioritize EV rides whenever the estimated time of arrival (ETA) is only

slightly longer than that of a standard UberX.

The all-electric Uber Green service will launch in various

U.S. cities, including New York, Los Angeles, New Jersey, Orange County, Las Vegas, Palm Springs, San Diego, San Francisco, Phil-

adelphia, Denver, Phoenix, and Sacramento. Internationally, it will expand to cities such as Paris, France; Sydney and Mel-

bourne, Australia; and Auckland, New Zealand.

Uber's CEO, Dara Khosrowshahi, noted, "After launching Uber Green with hybrids and EVs worldwide, we now have enough EV drivers on our platform to offer an EV-only option in over 40 cities globally. Riders will be able to select an EV at a similar price to UberX." He added, "If you love the EV experience but occasionally face longer ETAs, the new feature will let you set your preference in the app. If an EV is nearby and the ETA is within a few minutes of an UberX, your ride will be on the way."

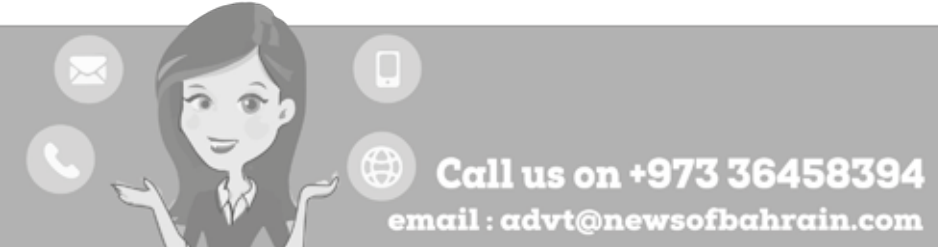
To encourage more drivers to switch to EVs, Uber plans to roll out an AI assistant next year in

the U.S. to help answer common questions about buying an EV. The assistant, powered by OpenAI's GPT-4, will provide recommendations on range, charging, and other considerations. Additionally, an EV mentorship program will connect experienced EV drivers with those considering the switch. "Going electric is a big decision, and drivers have many questions," Khosrowshahi said. 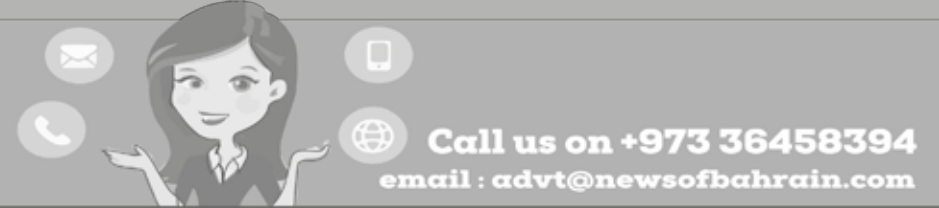

Tuchel 'in talks with FA' over England manager's job

Southgate stood down after England lost to Spain in the Euro 2024 final in July.

Sky Sports said the German, who left Bayern Munich at the end of last season, was in "pole position" to become Southgate's long-term replacement.

The Football Association declined to comment on the reports.

Bangladesh suspend Hathurusingha as coach after alleged assault

The Bangladesh Cricket Board said Tuesday it had suspended head coach Chandika Hathurusingha for misconduct including an alleged assault of a player.

Trinidadian former all-rounder Phil Simmons has been appointed stand-in coach and will take the team up until the ICC Champions Trophy, set for Pakistan in February 2025.

"You can't assault a national player physically," BCB president Faruque Ahmed said in announcing Hathurusingha's suspension, without giving details of the alleged incident.

There was no immediate response from Hathurusingha.

The 56-year-old former Sri Lanka batsman was hired in 2023 for a second time as head



coach, after a largely successful tenure with the side between 2014 and 2017.

The suspension follows Bangladesh's tour of India, where they lost both Tests and all three T20s.

Bangladesh next play South Africa at home, with the first of two Tests starting on October 21.

They travel to the United Arab Emirates for three ODIs against Afghanistan starting November 6.

India have 'fingers crossed' for Shami

India captain Rohit Sharma said yesterday that fast bowler Mohammed Shami suffered a recent setback on his return from injury, with the Australia Test series starting next month.

Shami last played for India at the 2023 50-over World Cup and is recovering from a foot injury as well as surgery on his Achilles tendon.

He faces a race against time with India travelling to Australia for a five-Test tour starting on November 22.

"We are keeping our fingers crossed, we want him to be 100 percent fit," Rohit said ahead of



the first of three Tests against New Zealand, starting in Bengaluru on Wednesday.

"More than anything else we don't want to bring an undercooked Shami to Australia," Ro-

hit added.

Shami has claimed 229 wickets in 64 Tests and been India's go-to wicket-taker with his swing and seam.

Newly appointed vice-cap-

tain Jasprit Bumrah will lead India's pace attack against New Zealand.

"He recently had a setback," Rohit revealed of Shami.

"He had a swelling in his knee, which was quite unusual while he was in the process of getting fit, getting close to 100 percent.

"That put him back in his recovery."

India are expected to take "travelling reserves" with them, including fast bowlers Harshit Rana, Mayank Yadav and Nitish Reddy.

Indian media suggest Rohit will miss the opener in Perth for personal reasons, meaning Bumrah would skipper the visitors.

Pakistan debutant Ghulam hits century to defy England in second Test

Kamran Ghulam hit a superb century on his debut to guide Pakistan to 259-5 on the opening day of the second Test against England in Multan on Tuesday.

The 29-year-old replaced out-of-form Babar Azam at number four and foiled England's aggressive bowling and fielding to score a brilliant 118.

At close, Mohammad Rizwan and Salman Agha were unbeaten with 37 and five respectively.

The day ended Ghulam's frustrating long wait for a place in the Pakistan team after he smashed a national record 1,249 runs in the 2020 season.

Ghulam led a fightback after Pakistan -- who won the toss and batted -- were struggling at 19-2 with England spinner Jack Leach striking twice in the first hour.

Ghulam added 149 for the defiant third wicket with Saim

Ayub, who hit a career-best 77, and another 65 for the fifth wicket with Rizwan.

He reached three figures with a boundary off spinner Joe Root, taking 280 minutes and becoming Pakistan's 12th batter to score a century in his first Test.

With just half an hour before

stumps, Ghulam was bowled by spinner Shoaib Bashir, ending a resolute 323-minute knock spiced with 11 fours and a six.

England employed a short mid-off and two mid-wicket fielders to get wickets but the Multan pitch -- the same used for the first Test -- gave very

little help to the spinners after some early promise.

Skipper Ben Stokes, one of two changes from England's thumping innings win in the first Test, bowled five overs and showed no signs of the hamstring injury that forced him to miss the first Test.

Matthew Potts ended Ayub's knock with a catch at short mid-off while Brydon Carse removed Saud Shakeel for four, the dismissals coming either side of the tea interval.

Leach has figures of 2-92 while Bashir, Carse and Potts have a wicket each.

Earlier, Abdullah Shafique was bowled by Leach for seven in the eighth over of the morning with the score on 15.

In his next over, the left-arm spinner had skipper Shan Masood caught low at short midwicket by Zak Crawley for three.

England lead the three-match series 1-0.

France to play Israel in Paris and allow fans in

The Nations League match between France and Israel, on November 14, will be played at the Stade de France and "will of course be open to the public", Paris police announced on Tuesday.

Israel has been at war with Palestinian Islamist movement Hamas since the latter staged the deadliest-ever attack on Israel on October 7 last year.

Since then, Israel's national team have played all their home games in Hungary. Their first away game in the Nations League, against Belgium, was also moved to Hungary and played behind closed doors in Debrecen after Brussels announced that it was "impossible to organise this very high-risk match".

The Belgian football federation (RBFA) said it could not

find a domestic alternative "given that in Belgium, no local administration deemed it possible to organise the Red Devils' home match against Israel".

Italy, however, decided it could host Monday's Nations League match against Israel in the northern city of Udine with fans in attendance.

The city was placed on high alert, with the area around the stadium cordoned off by barriers, extra security checks and an off-limits "red zone" created some 48 hours before kick-off.

But the drastically increased levels of security, including police brought in from neighbouring region and soldiers on the stadium roof, and blaring headlines in local media about a "bunker city" were out of step with the largely relaxed atmosphere around Udine.

Bahrain Stands Strong

Stalemate secures valuable point against Saudi Arabia at AFC World Cup Qualifiers

At King Abdullah Sports City, Bahrain held Saudi Arabia to a 0-0 draw, earning a valuable point in the AFC World Cup Qualifiers. Both teams had opportunities to break the deadlock, but Bahrain's disciplined defense, led by Waleed Al Hayam and Abdulla Al Khalassy, stood firm throughout the 90 minutes and the extended stoppage time.

Early Drama

The first half saw early drama when a VAR decision awarded Saudi Arabia a penalty in the 14th minute, after Abdulla Al Khalassy was adjudged to have fouled Marwan Al Sahafi in the box. Bahrain's number 1, Amine Benaddi, saved the penalty, denying Salem Al Dawsari's effort with a superb low dive to the right. This moment set the tone for Bahrain's gritty performance.

Bahrain Absorbs Saudi Pressure

Saudi Arabia dominated possession with 67%, while Bahrain held just 33%. The home side took 13 total shots, compared to Bahrain's 5, but only 2 of Saudi's attempts were on target, with Bahrain managing 1 shot on target. Bahrain's goalkeeper Benaddi made crucial saves, including a point-blank stop in the 79th minute from Abdullah Radif. Despite waves of pressure, Bahrain's defense remained composed, with Waleed Al Hayam and Sayed Dhiya making critical interventions to disrupt Saudi's attacking flow.

Second-Half Injuries Slow Bahrain's Momentum

Bahrain's forward momen-

tum was hindered by injuries, particularly in the second half. Sayed Hashim Isa was forced off injured in the 87th minute after Bahrain had used all their substitutions, leaving the team with 10 men for the remainder of the match. Hamad Al Shamsan also had to be replaced due to an injury earlier in the match.

Saudi Arabia's Last-Gasp Attempt

As the match entered stoppage time, Saudi Arabia pushed for a late winner. With 11 minutes of added time announced, the home side nearly found the breakthrough with a dangerous cross into the box in the dying moments. The chance went begging, and Saudi fans voiced their frustration, with calls for manager Roberto Mancini's departure growing louder.

On November 14, Bahrain will host China at 2pm. With Bah-

Mbappe 'investigated for rape' in Sweden: report

Kylian Mbappe is being investigated for rape by Swedish police, according to a newspaper report in Sweden following a visit by the Real Madrid star to Stockholm, which Mbappe denounced as "fake news".

After Swedish newspaper Aftonbladet reported that an alleged rape had been reported to police but did not say who was accused, Expressen newspaper said 25-year-old Mbappe was the suspect.

"According to information obtained by Expressen, police are investigating the star who is reasonably suspected of rape and sexual assault," the newspaper wrote.

Swedish law enforcement differentiate the level of suspicion as either reasonable or probable, with reasonable being the lower degree of suspicion.

Mbappe's entourage, when contacted by AFP, said it had no

knowledge of a legal complaint made against him.

The French international was not selected for his country's

latest round of Nations League matches, so visited the Swedish capital with a group of people last Thursday.

They dined at a restaurant before going to a nightclub, according to the Aftonbladet report. Mbappe and the group left Sweden on Friday.

The newspaper said a rape was committed "in Stockholm city centre", citing a formal complaint made to police on Saturday that it had seen.

Aftonbladet said the complaint was filed after the alleged victim had sought medical attention but did not say who was named in the accusation.

Later, Expressen reported that Mbappe was the suspect.

Mbappe himself claimed in a post on X, formerly known as Twitter, that there was a link between the Aftonbladet report and his hearing before a French league committee on Tuesday in his bitter dispute with his former club Paris Saint-Germain over what he says are unpaid wages.

Mbappe claims he is owed 55

million euros (\$60 million) by the Qatari-owned French champions.

"FAKE NEWS !!!!. It's becoming so predictable, on the eve of the hearing, as if by chance," Mbappe posted.

A prosecutor investigating the accusation told AFP: "A probe is under way into a crime that was reported on October 10 in the centre of Stockholm."

Stellar career

Mbappe joined Madrid this summer after seven years at PSG and has up until now stayed clear of scandal in his private life.

The forward, who is known for carefully managing his image through a close network of family, lawyers and spokespeople, has become one of the world's highest paid players after a stellar career that began when he was barely into his teens.

A 19-year-old Mbappe joined Pele as the only teenager to

score in a World Cup final when France beat Croatia 4-2 to win the 2018 edition and he was voted Best Young Player of the tournament.

Four years later in Qatar, he scored a hat-trick in the final against Argentina but finished on the losing side as Lionel Messi's side won in a penalty shootout.



Mbappe's entourage said in a statement to AFP on Monday that the accusations were "completely false and irresponsible" and added that "all necessary legal action will be taken to re-establish the truth".
