Bahrainis overseas yesterday cast their votes in the second round of the 2022 parliamentary and municipal elections.

They again exercised their constitutional duty to choose their parliamentary representatives for their respective constituencies.

The runoff polls included 34 constituencies, which were not decided in the first round. Voting started at 8am and concluded at 8pm as per the local time of the city in which the embassy, consulate or diplomatic mission is based.

They were held at 37 Bahraini diplomatic headquarters abroad as per the same procedures which were impiemented in the first round.

'New war' looms

Russia's biggest missile barrage crosses into Poland during strike on Ukraine

Russian missile barrage on the Ukrainian power grid sent the war spilling over into neighbouring countries yesterday, hitting Nato member Poland and cutting electricity to much of Moldova.

It was Russia's biggest barrage yet, and some of the missiles crossed into Poland, where two people were killed, according to a US official. It marked the first time in the war that Russian weapons have come down on a Nato country.
