Full diplomatic relations will resume, he added.

Iran fires long-range missiles

Iran's Revolutionary Guards yesterday fired long-range ballistic missiles into the Indian Ocean on the second day of a military exercise.

"One of our most important defence policy goals is to use long-range ballistic missiles against enemy warships, including aircraft carriers and warships," state media quoted Guards commander Major General Hossein Salami as saying.

With these missiles, which have a range of 1,800 kilometres, he said, "we can now strike moving targets in the ocean."

US designates UAE, Bahrain as 'major strategic partners'

The United States has designated the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and Bahrain as its major strategic partners, the White House Press Secretary Kayleigh McEnany said.

"Today, we are announcing the designation of both the United Arab Emirates and the Kingdom of Bahrain as 'Major Security Partners' of the United States," McEnany said.

The designation is a status unique to the UAE and the Kingdom of Bahrain, she added. "It recognises our exceptional security partnership, exemplified by their hosting thousands of United States

soldiers, sailors, airmen, and marines, and the commitment of each country to countering violent extremism across the region. Most notably, both countries have participated in numerous United States-led coalitions over the past 30 years," McEnany said.

"Today's decision demonstrates a new level of partnership between the United States, the UAE, and Bahrain, and represents an enduring commitment to economic and security cooperation. It also reflects their extraordinary courage, determination, and leadership in entering into the Abraham Accords," the press secretary said.

Bahrain won't abandon its citizens: HM the King

HM the King holds phone call with Bahraini bodybuilding champ Sami Al-Haddad



Kingdom will help its citizens with "all support" and "care" required "wherever they are"

Bahrain is committed to serving all its citizens, no matter where they are, said His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, yesterday. "The state's effort is to serve all its citizens, HM the King said,

adding the Kingdom remains committed to this pledge. HM King Hamad made clear that the Kingdom will help its citizens with "all support" and "care" required "wherever they are."

HM, the King was holding a telephonic conversation with Bahraini bodybuilding champion Sami Al-Haddad. Al Haddad expressed utmost thanks to HM the King for the call, his noble directives, and

great interest in releasing Bahraini fishermen. He also extended thanks to HM the King for the care accorded to all Bahraini citizens. Al Haddad was among the three Bahrainis released by

Qatar from captivity following strong interventions by Bahrain.

Interior Ministry, as directed by the Cabinet chaired by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, took necessary measures to release Bahraini citizens detained by Qatar and facilitate their return to the Kingdom.

Al Haddad and his compatriots were arrested by the Qatari Coastal and Border Security on 8th January 2021, while on a fishing trip.

Al Haddad's arrest was also the third such incident reported in recent months.

Upon landing in Bahrain, Sami Ibrahim Al-Haddad, Muhammad Yusef Al-Dossary and Habib Abbas were given a warm reception by Muharraq Governor Salman bin Isa Bin Hindi Al Mannai. Later, in a statement to *ALAYam*, Habib Abbas described his days in Qatari prison as "harsh and painful".

Qatari officials, he said, behaved rudely, and, until the day of release, "I was not allowed to take a shower."

"I was not even allowed to change my clothes, as well," he told *ALAYam*.

"We were taken into custody by force under the pretext of us crossing their border, thought marine maps confirmed that our vessel was not."

"So, they confiscated the device as well."

“I was treated like a criminal or a smuggler, forgetting the fact that I am a gulf citizen.”

“I was also asked to remain mum when I reminded them that I was, indeed, a fisherman.”

“But thanks to His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister and His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, I know Bahrain does not abandon her children, whatever the circumstances are,” he said.

Amid the happiness, he, however, had no clue on how to support his family. The boat he had is still in the captivity of Qataris and is in Doha.

Interior Ministry early said Qatar had not released the boats, and Banooshs (traditional boats) captured, taking the number of captured vessels to 50 since the dispute began.

Meanwhile, Bahraini officials are mulling various options, including legal measures.

The General Department of Investigation and Criminal Evidence had said they would talk to Sami Ibrahim Al-Haddad, Muhammad Yusef Al-Dossary and Habib Abbas on the arrest.

Meanwhile, Bahrain had reopened its airspace to Qatar on 11th January 2021 according to a deal signed earlier this month. The accord ends a long-standing dispute in which Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, Bahrain and Egypt severed ties with Qatar in mid-2017. As of now, all four nations have resumed air links with Qatar.

Following trio’s release, Bahrain’s Ministry of Foreign Affairs said it considers the release of Bahraini citizens by Qatari authorities as a positive step towards addressing the unresolved issues between the two countries to enhance cooperation between the GCC states.

The ministry also called on Qatar to release the Asian sailors who are still in captivity, considering their humanitarian situations.

Meanwhile, the Bahrain Human Rights Group, the European Gulf Centre for Human Rights, the Bahrain Society for Human Rights Watch and a group of independent human rights activists strongly condemned Qatar for torturing Bahraini citizens.

The General Coordinator of the Four Organizations, Faisal Foulad, said the organisations will approach international bodies against Qatari behaviour.

Pfizer-BioNTec delays won’t affect ongoing inoculation: Ministry

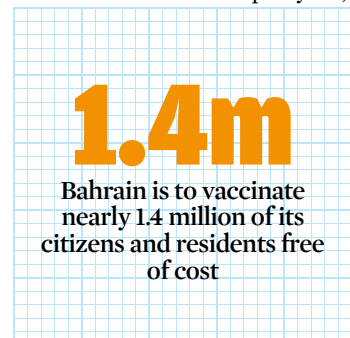
There will be a delay in the arrival of vaccines manufactured by Pfizer-BioNTec in Bahrain, said the Ministry of Health.

The ministry said the vaccine was scheduled to arrive this month but has been postponed to another date.

“This is due to delay in production and supply process from the manufacturer’s side,” the ministry statement said.

The pharmaceutical giant earlier said it is reducing the deliveries of its Covid vaccine to the UK and Europe, starting next week, while it upgrades its production capacity.

The upgrades, the company said, will allow it to produce 2 billion vaccine doses per year,

up from 1.3 billion currently. The US company has also warned that estimated volumes of doses delivered to each country “may need to be adjusted.”

Bahrain’s Health Ministry said that the rescheduling of the delivery of Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine doses will not disrupt the ongoing inoculation programme.

Bahrain aims to vaccinate all above 18 years of age at the rate of 5,000 people per day, which will be raised to 10,000 at a later stage. Vaccines will reach a total of 1.4 million people.

The vaccination is available free of charge to all citizens and residents.

The ministry also affirmed that delay will not affect “citizens and residents receiving the second dose of the vaccine.” There, however, is no confir-

mation available on the new delivery schedule.

The company, the ministry said, has informed countries that it has expanded its production and manufacturing of vaccines to cover global demands.

Bahrain was one of the first countries globally to order vaccines from Pfizer-BioNTech, in line with comprehensive national efforts to combat COVID-19.

Britain has ordered 30m doses of the Pfizer vaccine — enough to vaccinate 15m people — while the EU last week upped its order to 600m doses of the job. There is no information is available on the number of doses Bahrain has ordered.

Bahrain had also granted emergency-use authorisation for a Chinese vaccine made by Sinopharm.

10-day quarantine for Bahrain-UK travellers

Anyone flying into the United Kingdom, including from Bahrain, will have to remain in quarantine for up to 10 days, tweeted Bahrain embassy to the UK.

Britain is closing down all its travel corridors from Monday to “protect against the risk of as yet unidentified new strains” of Covid.

Travel corridors allowed people from countries with low numbers of Covid cases to come to the UK without having to quarantine on arrival.

As per the new guidelines, Bahrainis will have to show

proof of a negative COVID (PCR) test before setting off. The test may be taken up to 72 hours before the journey begins.

The UK had made clear that it will accept any test with at least 97% specificity and 80% sensitivity.

Those failing to comply will face a fine of a 500 pounds (around BD256), with border force officials carrying out spot checks.

However, BBC in a statement said, children under 11 are ex-

empted from checking.

Bahraini embassy requires all travellers to fill out a “passenger locator form” through a dedicated website of the British government.

“Filling out the form is mandatory for all visitors and residents of the United Kingdom,” the embassy tweeted.

Reportedly all travellers are required to provide their contact details and their UK address.

However, people arriving in England can reduce their quar-

Do not disclose banking data: Bahrain Association of Banks

Consumers should never disclose their personal or banking data in any way except when necessary and through reliable channels, said the Bahrain Association of Banks.

All should “realize the significance of preserving their personal and banking data” to avoid falling prey to cyber-attacks, said BAB.

The association further stressed the need to educate elderly-people who are not familiar with modern technologies on this critical issue and called on financial and banking institutions to employ the latest electronic data protection systems.

“We are coordinating with the banking and relevant bodies such as the Telecommunications Regulatory Authority to prevent fraud and impersonation, especially during the COVID-19 pandemic, in light of the increasing use of digital communication.”

Adnan Ahmed Yousif, the Chairman of the Board of Direc-

tors of the Bahrain Association of Banks, said the association is taking up the responsibility of holding awareness campaigns on preserving privacy.

“But it’s natural for cyber-attacks to increase, especially in light of the increasing reliance on digital channels to transfer money. Cybercriminals constantly develop their tools and fraudulent methods, in exchange for banks increasing layers of protection for their

networks and electronic systems,” Yousif warned.

Dr Waheed Al Qassim, the CEO of BAB, said they investigate complaints claiming that bank accounts were compromised. “But investigation finds that the user was lenient on preserving his data, or that he committed a mistake during transferring money or paying to another party.”

“One of the most crucial things that the users must avoid

is responding to phone calls and messages received through smartphone applications that claim to represent a bank and ask for any personal data,” he said.

“No bank will request any personal data through phone calls.”

Dr Al Qassim said the association is all set to launch a campaign to enhance awareness on data-confidentiality and secure financial transactions.

Tender board opens 77 bids received for 15 tenders

Preparations are ongoing for the Her Royal Highness Princess Sabeeka bint Ibrahim Al Khalifa Award to encourage productive families.

A tender for organising the award ceremony was opened recently by the Tender Board.

Seven companies are vying for the contract offered by the Ministry of Labour and Social Development. Bids range between BHD 20,580.000 to BHD 82,026.320.

Future Exhibitions & Conferences emerged as the lowest bidder and Orange Media Group OMG the highest.

The award is held annually at the local level and biennially at the Arab level.

No confirmation is available on the date of the award ceremony.

According to a BNA report, the labour and Social Development Ministry earlier announced extending the deadline to receive applications for the award, amid the coronavirus pandemic.

77 bids, 15 tenders

The new development came as the Tender Board, the independent regulatory body charged with overseeing government bidding opened 77 bids

received for 15 tenders by eight administrative bodies in the Kingdom.

The board also opened another tender by the Labour Ministry. It was for procuring consultancy and research services and received two bids. Rewaq Engineering's BHD 3,150 was the lowest bid and Socotec Gulf SPC's BHD 64,800.000 the highest bid.

The committee then opened a tender by the Ministry of Information Affairs for replacing a Vision Mixer Production Switcher Console System at its news centre. Two bids received for this tender. BHD 86,655.880 by BSS Trading was the lowest.

The committee also opened two

tenders for the Electricity and Water Authority.

The first was for maintaining speed control devices for medium voltage water pumps in water pumping stations at Al Dur station, Al Hidd station and Salmabad station manufactured by ABB and Siemens. The tender attracted three bids ranging from BHD 15,537.900 to BHD 41,958.000. ABB Electrical & Automation was the lowest bidder.

Water meter systems

EWA's second tender was for maintaining the water meter systems at Al Hidd Energy Production Company

for two years. Almoayyed Electrical & Instrumentation Systems' BHD 29,033.760 emerged as the lowest of the three bids.

Gulf Air

In the aviation sector, the committee opened two tenders for Gulf Air. The first was for the appointment of a freight forwarder in the United Kingdom and Ireland, for which received five bids. The second tender for the appointment of a freight travel agent in the Philippines attracted four bids. The third for purchasing Gulf Air's uniform shoes and safety shoes for staff received seven bids.

In the oil and gas sector, Bahrain Petroleum Company (Bapco) offered a contract for supplying groceries to Al-Awali Club, Al-Dar, Awali Hospital and Al-Refinery Restaurant. The three-year contract received four bids ranging from BHD 71,020.340 to BHD 395,008.540. Abdullatif Khalid Alaujan Food Stuff was the lowest bidder.

Finally, the committee opened a tender by Tatweer Petroleum for supplying Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for three years. The tender received 11 bids ranging from BHD 125,049.280 to BHD 258,248.660. Kavalani & Sons emerged as the lowest bidder.

Bahraini students excel in TIMSS

Bahraini students excelled in the TIMSS 2019 assessment tests, conducted for the fourth and eighth grade students in 64 countries and eighth benchmarking systems.

The Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study is an international assessment and research project designed to measure trends in mathematics and science achievement of the fourth-



and eighth-grade students, school and teacher practices related to instruction.

TIMSS 2019: TIMSS Mathematics—Fourth Grade, TIMSS Mathematics—Eighth Grade, TIMSS Science—Fourth Grade, and TIMSS Science—Eighth Grade.

In the fourth grade, Bahrain's scored 480 points in mathematics and 493 points in science. In the eighth grade, Bahrain scored 486 points in science and 481 points in

Mathematics.

Following Bahrain in the fourth and eighth grades were the United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Oman, Kuwait and Saudi Arabia. East Asian countries—Singapore, Chinese Taipei, Korea, Japan, and Hong Kong SAR—were the top performers.

Noura Jalal from Umm Kulthum Preparatory School for Girls ranked first in mathematics in the eighth grade (second preparatory), outperforming all students of this grade in public and

private schools, by bagging an achievement rate of 769, which far exceeds the international average.

When asked about her experience, Noura said: "The creative teaching of my teachers led me to this honourable achievement."

She added, "I won first place at the school level for the first year of middle school, and I got prepared to participate using the exercises explaining the pattern of questions and solving them."

Fixing methane leak lands top honour for two NSSA affiliates

Two affiliates of Bahrain's National Space Science Agency (NSSA) shined in the Microsoft Energy Core AI Academy Hackathon on "Hydrocarbon Release and Its Environmental Impact".

NSSA's affiliates, Aysha Al-Haram and Ahmed Bushlaibi, and their team members from the Khalifa University, clinched the third position in the hackathon which had world companies, researchers, space agencies and higher education institutions as participants.

The global competition was for finding new ways to harness machine learning techniques to identify methane emissions and leaks through satellite remote sensing data.

Bahrain team built an application to find the sources of a methane leak. They classified each detected reading as either a source or a consequence of another source. The team then separated these de-



tections from others to locate and fix the leak, more easily and cheaply. The team employed data from the Sentinel 5P, a satellite measuring the atmosphere above the Permian basin and Saudi Arabia, over ten days, the Khalifa University said.

The method involved satellite data pre-processing to

eliminate all data points that did not meet the requirements, tracking the source of the leakage by tracing points and clusters, and then using visualization techniques to indicate the source of the methane leak.

The team built a timeline to identify each cluster of data points that indicated methane and linked these clusters with their corresponding possible sources from past data. "Using this approach, they pinpointed the correct methane source using multiple parameters, like the concentration, distance and density of the gas," the University added.

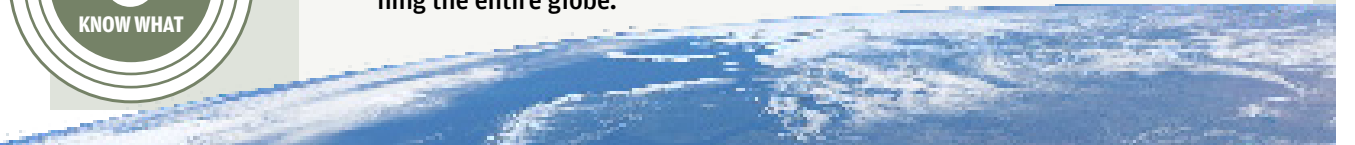

Emissions from the fossil fuel industry are one of the major sources of atmospheric methane. Gas leakages due to accidents in the oil and gas sector can release large amounts of methane within short periods of time. Although these emissions are very challenging to monitor, satellite measurement platforms offer a promising approach by regularly scanning the entire globe.

Trump directs govt to minimize procurement from China

In another action against China days before he leaves office, US President Donald Trump yesterday directed government departments to look at ways to minimize procurement of Chinese goods and services to reduce the risks from espionage, his national security adviser said.

In a statement, Robert O'Brien accused China of targeting the information systems of the US government for personnel records, military plans, and other data through cyber and other means.

"For this reason, the United States must take corresponding actions to protect American interests. We must adjust our regulations and policies and take other necessary actions to reduce the risk of PRC technical and human espionage activities directed at the Federal Government," he said, referring to the People's Republic of China.

He said Trump had directed government bodies to conduct reviews "to minimize the procurement of People's Republic of China (PRC) goods and services by the Federal Government."

O'Brien did not give examples of the procurement he

referred to, but a senior administration official said a key aim was to push back against Chinese attempts to infiltrate US IT networks.

"Anything having to do with Chinese companies that are going to have kit components in our network could potentially become a vulnerability that could be used to continue China's military-civil fusion strategy," the official said.

"If there's hardware, for example, that would make its way into our networks, that's the sort of stuff that could pose a

potential vulnerability."

The announcement comes less than a week before Trump leaves office to be succeeded by Democrat Joe Biden on Jan. 20. It was the latest in a series of steps targeting China, which analysts see as a bid to lock in a tough approach to Beijing.

Trump has pursued hard-line policies toward China on issues ranging from trade to espionage and the coronavirus. Relations plummeted to their worst level in decades when he ramped up rhetoric in his unsuccessful re-election campaign.

Emirates stops flights to major Australian cities

Emirates has suspended flights to Australia's three largest cities as the country further restricts international arrivals over fears of new virus strains.

The Dubai-based carrier was one of the last to maintain routes into and out of the country's east coast throughout most of the pandemic but on Friday evening told travellers a handful of planned flights next week would be the last.

"Due to operational reasons, Emirates flights to/from Sydney, Brisbane and Melbourne will be suspended until further notice," Emirates said on its website.

The airline will still run two flights a week to Perth, but the cuts are another barrier for tens of thousands of stranded Australians still attempting to return home.

Australia's borders have effectively been closed since March to curb the spread of the virus.

Azerbaijan remembers Black January tragedy

Thirty-one years have passed since January 20, 1990 events, which went down the history of Azerbaijani people as Bloody January tragedy. The atrocious act of terrorism committed in that day by military machine of the former Soviet Union against the people of Azerbaijan, will always remain as a black page in the history of civilization, and as one of the worst crimes against humanity.

Acting upon the orders of the USSR Communist Party leadership, 26 000 Soviet troops, heavily armed and equipped with military combat vehicles, attacked Baku to punish people rallying on the streets, protesting against violations of the territorial integrity of Azerbaijan and demanding freedom. As a result of punitive actions more than 145 civilians were killed and 700 wounded, hundreds of people were arrested and subjected to various forms of physical pressure. Among victims were children, women, young and old men and civilians of different nationalities in Baku.

The strong indignation and protest of the people of Azerbaijan was caused by the prejudiced and biased policy of the Communist Party and the Government of the Soviet Union towards the people of Azerbaijan. Soviet authorities' connivance at the Armenian expansionists, who claimed Nagorno-Karabakh, an integral part of Azerbaijan, had already allowed Armenia to forcibly expel more than 250.000 Azerbaijanis from Armenia in 1988-1989.

The next day, on January 21, 1990, Heydar Aliyev, National Leader of Azerbaijan, at the press conference for the representatives of foreign mass media, organized in the Permanent Mission of Azerbaijan in Moscow, condemned the aggression of Soviet leadership against Azerbaijan and its people. His statement became the first political assessment of Black January of 1990.

Helsinki Human Rights Watch has addressed how the Soviet brutal army intentionally crashed unarmed peaceful civilians under their tanks. According to its reports, "among the most heinous violations of human rights during the Baku incursions were the numerous attacks on medical personnel, ambulances and even hospitals".

The Wall Street Journal editorial of January 4, 1995 stressed that the Soviet leader Gorbachev chose to use violence against "independence-seeking Azerbaijan."

Black January has become the turning point in the history of modern Azerbaijan. The Soviet invasion failed to achieve its aim. The Azerbaijani people confronted the tragedy with strength and dignity. Every bullet that was fired splattered blood across the face of the Soviet regime, undermining the ideals of communism and totalitarianism. The heroism of the people of Azerbaijan on January 20, 1990, made the final collapse of the Soviet Union inevitable.

"Black January" is forever inscribed in the country history as a day of heroic struggle in the name of the freedom and territorial integrity of Azerbaijan. The day that led to serious losses and the killing of innocent people demonstrated the readiness for struggle, the pride of people who could not bear the policy of the USSR leadership treacherous towards Azerbaijan, raised their voice to gain freedom and on October 18, 1991 Azerbaijan regained its independence.

Today the victims of the Black January repose in Martyr's Alley in the capital city of Baku. They were among the first to sacrifice their lives for freedom. Those heroes will never be forgotten!

Therefore, every January 20 our nation pays tribute to those killed by the Soviet army in 1990. This is a very tragic and sad day for our people. It was a crime against humanity and a rare case where state used force on such a large scale against its own citizens. But it is also a time to reflect on the value and importance of the independence. Those killed on that day sacrificed their lives for the independence of Azerbaijan and it is our duty always remember and pay our respects to them. My hope is that perpetrators of this crime against humanity will be brought to justice.

Hunt for buried survivors after Indonesia quake

Rescuers scrambled to find buried survivors yesterday after a powerful earthquake on Indonesia's Sulawesi island killed dozens, injured hundreds and left more feared trapped in the rubble of collapsed buildings.

At least 45 people died after the 6.2-magnitude quake struck in the early hours of Friday, triggering panic among residents of the island, which was hit by a 2018 quake-tsunami disaster that killed thousands.

Dozens of bodies have been hauled from beneath crumpled buildings in Mamuju, a city of about 110,000 in West Sulawesi province, while others were killed south of the area after the quake struck.

"The latest data we have is 45" dead, said Arianto from the rescue agency in Mamuju, who like many Indonesians goes by one name.

The toll was up from 42 on

5.0 magnitude tremor was felt in the West Sulawesi districts of Mamuju and Majene yesterday but no damage or casualties were reported

Friday evening.

Authorities have not given a figure for the number of residents who could be trapped under levelled buildings, including a hospital that collapsed with more than a dozen patients and staff inside.

At least one hotel had partially collapsed, while the regional governor's office also suffered extensive damage.

About 15,000 residents have fled to temporary shelters and nearly 190 people were being treated for serious injuries, local authorities said.

India is prioritising nurses, doctors and other frontline workers, and Modi shed tears in his eyes as he addressed health workers via video conferencing.

"The disease separated people from their families, kept mothers away from their children, and those who died from their families," Modi said.

Trump to leave town early Wednesday before Biden inauguration

By the time Joe Biden is sworn in as the 46th US president Wednesday, his scandal-tainted predecessor Donald Trump will already be far away, having helicoptered out of the White House a last time earlier that morning, an official said.

Trump will be the first president in a century and a half to snub the inauguration of his successor.

An official who asked not to be identified said Trump would go to his Mar-a-Lago golf club in Florida, which is his legal residence and will become home after the White House.

He is expected to be out of town well before Biden is sworn in on the steps of the Capitol building at exactly noon.

After spending more than two months trying to overturn the results of the November election, pushing false conspiracy theories about fraud, Trump's presence had not been expected at the inauguration.

The final straw came on January 6 when Trump gathered a huge crowd of supporters on the National Mall and once more claimed that they had to fight to stop a fraudulent election. A mob then stormed Congress, halting proceedings underway to certify Biden's win.

For longer than anyone can re-

First in line are some 30 million health and other frontline workers, such as those in sanitation and security, followed by about 270 million people older than 50 or deemed high-risk because of pre-existing medical conditions.

The government has already bought 11 million doses of the AstraZeneca COVISHIELD shot, produced by the Serum Institute of India, and 5.5 million of Bharat Biotech's COVAXIN.

COVISHIELD is 72 per cent effective, according to the Indian drug regulator, while Bharat Biotech says COVAXIN's last-stage trial results are expected by March.

While nationalist politicians are cheering COVAXIN, some health experts consider it rushed, as the vaccine has only limited, "clinical-trial mode" approval.

In addition to efficacy concerns, the close monitoring required for its use will be a massive challenge.

The government is calling its immunisation campaign the biggest in the world and hopes around 300,600 people will be vaccinated on the first day - a first step in administering around 300 million people with two doses in the first six to eight months of the year.

the coronavirus, the highest number of infections after the United States, and more than 151,000 have died, though infection rate has come down from a peak in mid-September.

India is using the Oxford University/AstraZeneca vaccine and a government-backed vaccine developed by India's Bharat Biotech whose efficacy is not yet known. People will not be able to choose which of the vaccines - both of which are being produced locally - that they get.

Taliban kill 12 pro-govt militiamen in Afghanistan insider attack

Two Taliban fighters who had infiltrated a base of pro-government Afghan militiamen killed 12 of them, officials and the insurgent group said yesterday.

The night-time attack at a post manned by the militiamen occurred in the district of Ghorian in the western Herat province, the governor for the district Farhad Khademi said.

"Twelve pro-government militiamen were killed in the Taliban attack in Ghorian district last night," he said.

Herat provincial council member Mohammad Sardar Bahaduri confirmed the attack and said it was carried out by two Taliban fighters who had infiltrated the base. "The militiamen were dining when the attack happened," he said.

The Taliban also said two of its fighters had carried out the attack and then returned.

In a separate incident, a vehicle carrying policemen was struck by a roadside bomb in the centre of the Afghan capital Kabul, police spokesman Ferdaws Faramarz told reporters.

Uganda's Museveni declared winner of presidential poll

Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni won a decisive re-election victory yesterday, elections officials said, but his main rival Bobi Wine alleged widespread fraud and said citizens should reject the result.

Museveni won 5.85 million votes, or 58.6 per cent, while main opposition candidate Wine had 3.48 million votes

(34.8pc), the Electoral Commission said at a news conference on the final results from Thursday's election.

Earlier, Wine accused Museveni of fabricating the results and called the poll "the most fraudulent election in the history of Uganda". In a phone interview before the final results were announced, he urged citizens to reject the results.

US President Donald Trump received Morocco's highest award for his work in advancing a normalization deal between Israel and Morocco, a senior administration official said.

In a private Oval Office ceremony, Princess Lalla Joumala Alaoui, who is Morocco's ambassador to the United States, gave Trump the Order of Muhammad, an award given only to heads of state. It was a gift from Morocco's King Mohammed VI. White House senior adviser Jared Kushner and Middle East envoy Avi Berkowitz received other awards for their work on the Israel-Morocco deal, which was reached in December.

The Kushner team had been working on reaching more agreements between Israel and the Arab world. But time has run out and no more are expected before Trump's departure.

Biden elevates science post to cabinet level



◆ US President-elect Joe Biden announced he is upgrading the White House science advisor position to cabinet-level -- a sharp break from predecessor Donald Trump as America grapples with the pandemic. The former vice-president will have to grapple with a nation hard-hit by Covid-19: known infections have surpassed 23 million with almost 400,000 deaths recorded. Eric Lander, a geneticist who helped map the human genome, will head the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP) and advise Biden.

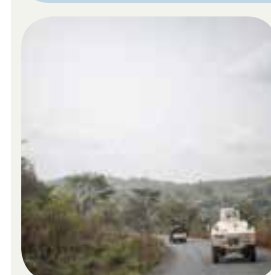
The National Rifle Association announced it was filing for bankruptcy protection from creditors and moving to Texas, in an apparent bid to dodge a corruption probe in New York.

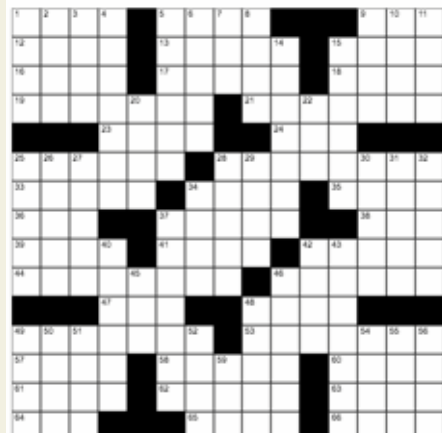

Joe Root completed his fourth double century for England yesterday but insisted it will mean nothing if his side cannot overcome a defiant Sri Lanka in the first Test.

The England captain made 228 of his team's 421 all out -- 26 runs short of his brilliant 254 career best against Pakistan at Old Trafford in 2016.

But Lahiru Thirimanne led Sri Lanka's stubborn resistance, hitting an unbeaten 75 while Kusal Perera made 62 as the home team reached 156-2 in their second innings.

After their disappointing 135 in the first innings, they need another 130 to reach England's total.

Root's 321 ball innings with a six and 18 fours dominated the day. It took less than an hour in the opening session to add the 32 runs to his overnight total.

He reached 200 with a four off Lasith Emuldeniya.

While the empty Covid-19-stricken stadium meant that only his teammates in the pavilion and a lone England fan watching from a nearby fort could applaud, the performance confirmed Root's return as a batsman after a

barren 2020 saw him fall to number 11 in the ICC rankings.

He had not reached three figures in a Test since his 226 in New Zealand in November 2019. Root also scored an unbeaten 200 against Sri Lanka at Lord's in 2014.

But he indicated his disappointment after seeing six wickets fall to Sri Lanka's bowlers in the morning session and then the struggle by his own attack.

Running out of partners, Root was the last man out, caught by Emuldeniya on the boundary as he went for a six off Dilruwan Perera.

He saw fast bowler Asitha Fernando take Jos Buttler (30) and Sam Curran (0) with successive balls.

In the next over Root hit his landmark four then Dom Bess was run out as the tourists suffered a bout of nerves.

Ancajas itching to unify world titles

Filipino Jerwin “Pretty Boy” Ancajas has yet to face a genuinely elite fighter in his eight successful defences of his world title.

So now the International Boxing Federation (IBF) super flyweight champion is determined to unify the world titles this year.

But first the 28-year-old Panabo City pride has to beat Mexican Jonathan Javier Rodriguez in a mandatory defence of his IBF belt this summer before he could think of a potential unification world super flyweight title showdown.

MP Promotion President Sean Gibbons said that he will discuss with the handlers of Japanese World Boxing Organization (WBO) super flyweight champion Kazuto Ioka (26-2 win-loss record with 15 knockouts) to set up the dream duel.

“First, our mandatory obligation with Rodriguez. Then Ioka. It's 1,000 percent we will negotiate that fight to happen,” Gibbons said. “Rodriguez's fight contract has been done for one year.”

Ancajas' camp is also looking at unifying the World Boxing Association (WBA) super flyweight belt held by Joshua Franco.

“That's what we've been waiting for,” said Ancajas (32-1-2 record with 22 knockouts), who is conditioning himself in Los Angeles, California, under the tutelage of his manager and trainer Joven Jimenez and sparring partner Jonas Sultan, while waiting for a fight from Top Rank.

Ancajas last fought in Puebla, Mexico in December 2019, a sixth-round TKO of Miguel Gonzalez, and has numerous options in the bag for a potential world title unification bout.

“We have to wait until we all get back by April or May,” said Arum, 89, referring to the Ancajas-Rodriguez bout. “We need to get rid of this pandemic first.”

But Arum explained that the Ancajas-Ioka bout needs to wait for a few months before it becomes a possibility.

“It can't be done for now. You can't get in Japan now because of COVID-19 and the Japanese people do not want to go outside Japan because they will undergo a 14-day quarantine when they come back,” added Arum, who is a close associate of Ioka's Japanese promoter, Akihiro Honda.

Fernandes hits back at Klopp over penalty claims

Manchester United midfielder Bruno Fernandes has told Liverpool boss Jurgen Klopp to stop moaning about the number of penalties given to Ole Gunnar Solskjaer's side.

United have been awarded 20 penalties in the Premier League since the start of last season, while title rivals Liverpool have had just 10.

Klopp highlighted the large amount of United spot-kicks after his side had two penalty appeals turned down in their recent 1-0 defeat at Southampton.

United manager Solskjaer responded by saying Klopp and other Premier League bosses were trying to influence referees not to give his team penalties.

Now Fernandes has joined the United backlash ahead of Sunday's crucial clash between the bitter rivals as the Portugal star said Klopp should quit complaining.

"You always see what people say, but I really don't care. I'm not focused on what they're saying. We have really quick players up front," said Fernandes, who has scored 14 penalties for United.

"Anthony Martial is one of the best players one against one in the box, Marcus Rashford is another one who is quick and has quick feet, who can take the ball away from the defender at any moment.

"It's normal that sometimes, because of that, they will be

tripped and will fall and they gain penalties.

That is already as many as Cristiano Ronaldo managed during his entire Old Trafford stay, but Fernandes wants the kind of team glory enjoyed by his Portugal team-mate.
