Major upgrade for Sh. Zayed Highway; tender launched

 $\mathbf{S}^{ ext{h. Zayed Highway (Bu-quwah Interchange)}}$ is to get a major upgrade, for which the Works Ministry has launched a tender.

The tender says the ministry plans to widen and extend the highway.

Accordingly, the ministry intends to build a new bridge linking Salmabad and Buquwah across Sh. Isa Bin Salman Highway, a loop slip road for traffic coming from Salmabad to Jasra and a second loop allowing traffic from Buquwah to Manama

The two envelop tender offers a contract duration of 104 weeks.

The current tender is for appointing a contractor to implement the new public square, says BACA





"Pearling, Testimony of an Island Economy" is a serial nomination consisting of 15 property components: three vast oyster beds located in the northern territorial waters of Bahrain, one seashore site at the southern tip of Bahrain's Muharraq Island. and nine clusters of historic buildings consisting of seventeen architectural structures embedded in the urban fabric of Muharraq city. Taken together, the fifteen individual sites reflect the final expression and last remaining - and thus outstanding - example of a cultural tradition that dominated the Arabian Gulf from prehistory to the early 20th century.
