His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa issued Royal Decree (77) of 2024, amending some provisions of Royal Decree (78) of 2021, regarding the restructuring of the executive body of the Supreme Council for Environment (SCE), based on a proposal by the Deputy Prime Minister and following approval of the Cabinet.

HM the King also issued Decree (78) of 2024, appointing a director general for wildlife protection at the Supreme Council for Environment's Executive Body, based on a proposal by Deputy Prime Minister, and following the approval of the Cabinet.

New edict issued to restructure EDB

Under Article (I), the EDB is restructured under the chairmanship of the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, with the following members: HH Shaikh Abdullah bin Hamad Al Khalifa, HH Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, HH Shaikh Isa bin Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Deputy Prime Minister, HE Shaikh Khalid bin Abdulla Al Khalifa, the Minister of Finance and National Economy, the Minister of Labour, the CEO of the Economic Development Board, the Minister of Industry and Commerce, and the Governor of the Central Bank of Bahrain.

Non-oil sector poised to sustain economic boom

Bahrain's economy is shifting gears, moving from oil dependence to a broader, diversified path.

With the World Bank forecasting a 3.5% growth rate for 2024, the non-oil sector is set to surpass the oil industry, driven by advancements in manufacturing, construction, and government services.

While hydrocarbon revenues remain essential, Bahrain's future hinges on maintaining this diversification amid fluctuating

energy prices and fiscal pressures.

The non-oil sector's growth is projected at approximately 3.4% annually, driven by progress in key areas.

Targets

Economic targets for 2023 and 2024 appear achievable, largely due to ongoing efforts to diversify and control spending.

In the first three quarters of 2023, Bahrain's economy grew by 2%, with non-oil sectors expanding by 3.1%.

The current account surplus hit \$2 billion, or 6.4% of GDP.

She underlined that the Authority is committed to deepening its understanding of the Chinese market's requirements through strategic marketing campaigns, partnerships and the development of customised travel experiences aligned with the expectations of Chinese visitors.

Businessman jailed for circulating counterfeit US dollar bills in Bahrain



● Five years in prison

A Bahraini businessman has been sentenced to five years in prison and fined for introducing counterfeit US dollar bills into the country.

The defendant was found guilty of deliberately bringing forged currency into Bahrain with the intent to circulate it.

According to court documents, the businessman entered Bahrain with counterfeit \$500 bills and proceeded to the duty-free shop at Bahrain International Airport.

He purchased five perfumes worth \$750 and then bought cigarettes for \$200, using the counterfeit currency.

Suspicious

The cashier became suspicious and alerted airport security. Airport security officials, after being notified by the duty-free shop manager, identified the suspect through his travel documents used during the purchase.

The businessman also at-

tempted to use the counterfeit bills at a pharmacy within the airport, further solidifying the evidence against him.

During the proceedings, the defendant stated, "I had no idea the money was counterfeit. I trusted the source from which I obtained it."

He added, "I deeply regret my actions and the trouble they have caused. I never intended to harm anyone or disrupt the economy."

Deliberate actions

The High Criminal Court, in its ruling, considered the defendant's deliberate actions in introducing the counterfeit currency and his attempt to circulate it within the country.

The court also ordered the confiscation of the counterfeit currency and other items seized from the defendant.

"The circulation of counterfeit currency undermines the integrity of our financial system and poses a serious threat to the economy," the ruling stated. "Such actions will not be tolerated, and the judiciary will impose strict penalties to deter future offenses."

'Incompatible with education'

Court upholds dismissal of government school teacher convicted of harassment

The High Administrative Court has upheld the dismissal of a government school teacher after rejecting her appeal against a decision, following charges of harassing another woman for 11 years.

The Ministry of Education terminated her employment following her conviction. However, she appealed the Ministry's decision before the High Administrative Court.

The court ruled that the teacher's continued employment would be "incompatible with the nature of her work," particularly in the education sector as she is serving

as a teacher.

This decision is rooted in the Civil Service Law, which mandates the dismissal of public servants convicted of felonies or crimes that compromise their honour or integrity and limit their freedom.

She argued that her dismissal was unjust, pointing to her positive performance evaluations and letters of appreciation from colleagues.



However, the court emphasised the necessity for high moral standards within the education sector.

Role models

"The education profession requires individuals who can serve as positive role models and nurture young minds," the court stated.

The conviction for harass-

ment, considered morally reprehensible, justified her dismissal.

The court further noted that maintaining the integrity of the education system is paramount.

Consequently, it ordered the teacher to bear the legal costs associated with the lawsuit, reinforcing the principle that those in educational roles must uphold the highest ethical standards.

Dental technician guilty of forging credentials

A 51-year-old Asian dental technician has been sentenced to two years in prison and will be deported after being found guilty of using forged credentials to obtain his license in Bahrain.

The defendant, who had been working as a dental technician in Bahrain since 2007, was found guilty of submitting forged academic certificates to the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) in 2006.

He had conspired with a friend in his home country to obtain a fake university diploma, claiming to have received a degree in dental technology.

This deception allowed him to secure a dental technician license, which he renewed annually until 2022 when the forgery was discovered following an anonymous tip.

Email

The NHRA received an email in April-May 2022 from a person with the same nationality

as the defendant, alleging that his dental technician certificate was fraudulent.

The NHRA, upon verification with a specialised company, confirmed the authenticity of the documents was fraudulent.

Investigations revealed that the defendant had submitted forged certificates to the NHRA in 2006.

Based on these documents, he was granted a license to practice dentistry in 2007, which was renewed annually until May 13, 2022.

Confession

During the Public Prosecution's investigation, the defendant confessed to the charges.

He admitted that to obtain a dental technician license, a university degree was required.

In 2004-2005, he conspired with a friend in his home country to obtain a fake university certificate.

He filled out a form with false information, claiming to have received a diploma in dental technology from a university.

Doctor's appeal against sentence adjourned

The High Appeals Court has adjourned the appeal of a doctor sentenced to 10 years in prison for drug trafficking.

The court has scheduled the next hearing for September 23 to facilitate the transfer of the appellant from prison.

The doctor, along with another defendant, was initially sentenced to 10 years imprisonment and a fine of BD5,000 each by the lower court.

The case originated from information received by the police regarding a suspicious vehicle in Riffa.

The driver of the vehicle

was observed placing items in a sewage pipe belonging to a residence.

Investigations revealed the vehicle belonged to the third defendant, who was subsequently apprehended and searched with a warrant from the Public Prosecution.

Filipino motorcyclist dies in accident

A motorcyclist died in a tragic accident near Mina Salman early Friday morning.

The victim, Ronald De Guzman Fernandes, 43, was a Filipino expatriate.

He was riding with seven

fellow bikers from the Pinoy Riders Group Bahrain (PRGB) during a planned ride.

Fernandes lost control of his bike and crashed into a pick-up truck.

A witness told that oil on the road may have caused the accident.

Jailed for forging car documents and theft

The High Criminal Court has sentenced a repeat offender to three years in prison for forging car registration documents and selling a vehicle without the owner's knowledge.

The court also ordered the confiscation of the forged documents.

The case involved a father who had agreed to sell his daughter's car for BD2,500.

The defendant, a known car dealer, received a BD200 deposit and was given the car's original registration papers and the owner's ID card.

However, the father later discovered that the defendant had transferred ownership of the car without his daughter's consent.

A witness, a car broker, testified that he had dealt with the defendant in the past and had become aware of his fraudulent

activities. The defendant had presented the broker with the car's registration papers and the owner's ID card, along with a forged transfer of ownership form bearing the owner's signature.

The broker, unaware of the forgery, completed the buyer's information and submitted the documents to the General Directorate of Traffic, resulting in the transfer of ownership.

Digital dilemma

Tempers flare at Northern Municipal Council over Budaiya service application building

A heated argument broke out during yesterday's Northern Municipal Council meeting over the closure of the service application building in Budaiya.

Council President Shubbar Al Wadaei and Council Member Abdullah Mubarak clashed after Mubarak and Mohammed Saad Al Dosari called for the building's reopening.

They argued that the closure affects citizens adversely, particularly the elderly and disabled, who find digital systems and frequent data updates challenging.

Mubarak and Al Dosari argued that the closure forces vulnerable groups to face dif-

ficult digital transitions and frequent updates, calling for the removal of the data update requirement.

Mubarak also accused the municipalities of not cooperating with the council.

The debate soon escalated

into a quarrel where Al Wadaei told both Al Dosari and Mubarak, "You are both copies of the same thing," which angered Mubarak.

He repeatedly said, "Respect yourself," and warned, "If you say it again, there will be con-

sequences," leading Al Wadaei to instruct that the recording be stopped.

Other council members intervened to end the dispute, but Mubarak remained firm, stating, "I know he meant something else with his words."

Indian Ambassador attends fourth THMC Connect

His Excellency Mr. Vinod K. Jacob, Ambassador of India to the Kingdom of Bahrain, attended the 4th edition of the event titled THMC Connect organised by the Thattai Hindu Merchants Community in Bahrain on 14 September.

In his remarks on the occasion, Ambassador Jacob congratulated the THMC under the leadership of its President, Mr. Mukesh Kavalani, for contributing to the economic prosperity of Bahrain, towards strengthening India-Bahrain economic relations and also bringing a global and cosmopolitan outlook to the THMC.

Ambassador Jacob recalled that since the successful state visit of Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi to Bahrain in August 2019, two way cumulative investments has risen by 40 percent to currently stand at \$1.6 billion.

For the one year period of Q1 2023 to Q1 2024, Indian investment into Bahrain was of the order of \$200 million, representing a 15 percent increase and making India the sixth largest investor into Bahrain. The robust investment co-

operation has been complemented by a healthy growth of bilateral trade with the trade gap shrinking to a mere \$80 million last year.

According to Government of India trade statistics, India-Bahrain trade reached \$1.73 billion in the period April 2023 to March 2024.

Ambassador Jacob reiterated his commitment to strengthening India-Bahrain bilateral relations with the help of Indian and Bahraini business circles including the THMC in the years to come.

New swimming centre planned for people with disabilities

A swimming centre for people with disabilities is under consideration by the Municipalities Affairs ministry, with a plan to link it to Karzakan Beach, already known for its accessible facilities.

Council member Mohamed Saad Al Dosari proposed the addition of a ramp to further improve access to the beach.

Should this initiative prove successful, similar enhancements could be applied to other beaches, including those in Budaiya and Malkiya.

Proposals

The project is expected to start in the coming months, fully funded by the ministry, which is seeking proposals from firms through The Tender Board.

Al Dosari revealed the proposal dates back to 2018, drawing inspiration from nations such as Turkey, where accessible public spaces are commonplace.

Al Dosari also pressed for Budaiya Beach to be prioritised for future accessibility upgrades.

Accessible parking

The ministry's statement to the council also outlined intentions to provide accessible parking to assist individuals with disabilities, ensuring that the beach is welcoming to all.

Once the beach is operational, the Ministry will review the project's effectiveness and ex-

plore the possibility of extending such facilities based on compliance and available funding.

The Ministry stressed its aim to incorporate accessibility into various development projects, such as parks, gardens, and beaches, to meet the diverse needs of the community.

Initiative

Speaking to The Daily Tribune, Al Dosari emphasised that "This initiative recognises the

vital role disabled people play in society and seeks to ensure they have equal opportunities."

Specialised services will be provided to meet their needs, offering support tailored to their circumstances.

Inclusivity remains central to Bahrain's policies, with the government determined to improve the welfare of its disabled population, while working to dismantle barriers and fight discrimination.

Partial lunar eclipse to grace Bahrain skies tomorrow

Bahrain will witness a partial lunar eclipse tomorrow, according to Bahraini astronomer Mohammed Al Asfoor.

The event will coincide with the full moon of the month of Rabi' al-Awwal 1446 AH, also known as the "Harvest Moon," as the moon reaches its perigee, the closest point in its elliptical orbit to Earth.

At a distance of approximately 357,000 kilometers, the "super-moon" will appear 14% larger and 30% brighter than when it is at its apogee, the farthest point from Earth.

The Harvest Moon is the full moon closest to the autumnal

equinox, which falls on September 22nd, 2024, marking the end of summer and the official beginning of autumn.

The partial eclipse will begin at 3:41am, local time in Bahrain, as the moon enters the Earth's penumbra, causing a slight dimming of its light.

Earth's umbra

At 5:12am, the moon will enter the Earth's umbra, resulting in a partial eclipse where approximately 3% of the moon's surface will be obscured.

However, due to the moon setting at 5:27am, Bahrain residents will only be able to observe the initial stages of the eclipse.

The duration of the partial eclipse visible in Bahrain will be

just 15 minutes.

Small portion

While Bahrain will only witness a small portion of the eclipse, other regions, including Western Asia, Europe, Africa, and most parts of North and South America, will be able to observe the partial eclipse in varying degrees.

Eastern Russia, East Asia,

Australia, New Zealand, parts of Antarctica, and Northwest North America will be outside the eclipse's path.

Al Asfoor explained that a lunar eclipse occurs when the Earth passes directly between the sun and the moon, casting its shadow on the moon.

This natural phenomenon is a celestial spectacle that has fascinated humans for centuries.

Alba explores potential business combination with Saudi Maaden

The Board of Directors of Aluminium Bahrain (Alba) approved during its meeting yesterday for Alba to enter into a non-binding agreement with Saudi Arabian Mining Company (Maaden) to commence due diligence towards a potential business combination involving segments of Maaden's aluminium strategic business unit.

This potential combination will reshape the global aluminium industry, positioning the merged entity as one of the largest aluminium producers worldwide. This partnership will create a larger, vertically integrated global champion with significant synergies offering advantages such as expanded production capacity; enhanced global presence; improved ESG performance; greater energy security; and significant shareholder value creation.

Alba's Chairman of the Board, Khalid Al Rumaihi, stated: "The

potential partnership accelerates Alba's growth strategy, creating a global champion and cementing our position as the largest regional aluminium producer."

Adding further, Ma'aden Chief Executive Officer, Bob Wilt, said: "By bringing together two of the region's most experienced players in the sector, we are setting the stage for stronger economic growth, enhanced job creation, and increased aluminium production capacity."

During the due diligence period, both companies will ex-

change information and evaluate the strategic and financial benefits of a business combination. There is no assurance that these discussions will lead to a definitive agreement or a completed transaction. As part of the discussions on the non-binding agreement, Alba and Ma'aden discussed, among other things, the potential transaction structure for implementing their proposed business combination and the potential cross-listing of Alba on the Saudi Exchange.

Subject to regulatory approvals (including, without

limitation, the Central Bank of Bahrain), corporate approvals, confirmatory due diligence, and valuation assessments, the proposed structure would involve Ma'aden making an in-kind contribution. This would include Ma'aden contributing the entire share capital of two of its subsidiaries, Ma'aden Aluminium Company (MAC) and Ma'aden Bauxite and Alumina Company (MBAC), along with contractual rights concerning the marketing and sale of products produced by MAC, to Alba. In exchange, Alba would issue new shares to be allotted to Ma'aden.

Alba and Ma'aden have also agreed to discuss the cross-listing of Alba on the Saudi Exchange during the next phase of the proposed business combination. Alba emphasises that the transaction is subject to, without limitation, confirmatory due diligence, receipt of all corporate (board and shareholder) and regulatory approvals and signing of definitive agreements.

News in brief

The first Palestinian ambassador to Spain presented his credentials on Monday to Spanish King Felipe VI after Madrid in May formally recognised a Palestinian state. The head of state welcomed Housni Abdel Wahed to the royal palace in Madrid for the traditional ceremony for newly appointed foreign ambassadors to Spain, according to images published by the royal palace on social network X. Wahed had been the head of the Palestinian diplomatic mission in Madrid since 2022 and he enjoyed a similar status to that of an ambassador but he officially changed rank after Spain along with Ireland and Norway formally recognised a Palestinian state comprising the Gaza Strip and the West Bank. The three countries said at the time they hoped their decision would spur other European countries to follow suit and accelerate efforts towards securing a ceasefire in Israel's war against Hamas in Gaza.



First Palestinian ambassador to Spain submits credentials

Eight migrants died on Sunday when their overcrowded vessel capsized while trying to cross the Channel from France to England, French authorities said, less than two weeks after the deadliest such disaster this year. The latest tragedy means 46 migrants have lost their lives attempting to reach British shores so far this year, a regional official said, up from 12 in 2023. The French and British governments have sought for years to stop the flow of migrants, who pay smugglers thousands of euros per head for the passage on overloaded rubber dinghies. Regional prefect Jacques Billant said the incident happened at around 1:00 am (2300 GMT on Saturday) off the coast of the northern town of Ambleteuse.



The trial of a Frenchman accused of recruiting strangers to rape his heavily sedated wife was suspended on Monday after he failed to show up in court due to ill health. The presiding judge had adjourned the trial of Dominique Pelicot until Monday after the accused was excused from attending proceedings for most of last week because of his deteriorating health. But his lawyer told AFP that Pelicot, 71, was still not well enough to attend. "He will not be there today," Beatrice Zavarro said, unless "he is taken by force" from his cell. She said Pelicot was suffering from "a clot in the bladder" and the beginning of a kidney infection. "I have been advised that Mr Pelicot has refused his extraction" from his cell, presiding judge Roger Arata said. After a short deliberation, Arata suspended proceedings for the rest of the day pending examinations of Pelicot by medical experts.

The post came as a surprise, even from the provocative Donald Trump: "I HATE TAYLOR SWIFT!" the former president said Sunday. Though the all-caps post on his Truth Social website came without accompanying commentary or explanation, the context was clear. On Tuesday, just minutes after a debate with Vice President Kamala Harris that Republican Trump was widely seen as losing, the superstar singer/songwriter posted a message on Instagram saying she would be voting for his Democratic rival, calling Harris a "steady-handed, gifted leader." Celebrity endorsements rarely carry enormous weight, but the hugely popular Swift is seen as being in a class of her own, with more than 400 million followers on Instagram, TikTok and other social media platforms -- 10 million of whom "liked" her Instagram post. "Going after Taylor Swift is a genuinely bad campaign



Israel pounds Gaza as Hamas vows to keep up fight

Gaza medics and rescuers yesterday said Israeli strikes on several homes killed at least 18 people, as Hamas claimed it had ample resources to sustain its fight nearly a year into the war. The latest strikes came as Israeli Defence Minister Yoav Gallant warned that prospects for a halt in fighting with Hezbollah militants along the Lebanon border were dimming, yet again raising fears of a wider regional conflagration. Senior Hamas official Osama Hamdan told AFP during an interview in Istanbul on Sunday: "The resistance has a high ability to continue."

"There were martyrs and there were sacrifices... but in return there was an accumulation of experiences and the recruitment of new generations into the resistance." His comments came less than a week after Gallant told journalists that Hamas, whose October 7 attack triggered the war, "no longer exists" as a military formation in Gaza. Deadly fighting raged on in the Gaza Strip on Monday, with survivors seen searching through the debris of crushed buildings following a strike on the Nuseirat refugee camp in central Gaza. Ten people were killed and 15 others were wounded when an air strike hit the home of the Al-Qassas family in Nuseirat on Monday morning, a medic at Al-Awda hospital, where the bodies were brought, told AFP. "My house was hit while we were sleeping without any prior warning. There are many martyrs, among them the sons of my family and my little grandsons," said Rashed al-Qassas, a surviving family member. Gaza's civil defence agency said six Palestinians were killed in a similar air strike during the night on a house belonging to the Basal family in Gaza City's Zeitun neighbourhood, a regular target of Israeli military raids since the war began. Two people were killed in another overnight air strike in Rafah that targeted a house belonging to the Abu Shaar family, the agency said. Japan's elderly population hits record high

The number of people in Japan aged 65 or older hit a record high of 36.25 million this year, government data shows, as the country contends with one of the world's fastest-ageing societies. The elderly now account for 29.3 percent of Japan's total population, also a new high, according to data released by the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications on Sunday. The ministry said the proportion of elderly residents put Japan at the top of the list of 200 countries and regions with a population of over 100,000. Italy, Portugal, Greece, Finland, Germany and Croatia represented Europe in the top 10, with rates of over 20 percent. South Korea stood at 19.3 percent and China 14.7 percent. Japan is facing a steadily worsening population crisis, as its ex-



panding elderly population leads to soaring medical and welfare costs, with a shrinking labour force to pay for it. The country's overall population shrank by 595,000 to 124 million, according to previous government data. Sunday's data showed that 9.14 million elderly people were employed in 2023, also a record. They represent 13.5 percent of the total workforce -- or one employee in seven. The Japanese government has attempted to slow the decline and ageing of its population with meaningful success.

Secret Service 'needs more help' after apparent Trump assassination bid: Biden

President Joe Biden said Monday that the US Secret Service needs more personnel to perform its duties after a second apparent assassination attempt against Republican election candidate Donald Trump. "One thing I want to make clear, the (secret) service needs more help, and I think the Congress should respond to their needs," Biden told reporters at the White House. "I think we may need more personnel." Biden added that "thank God the president's OK" following Sunday's incident in which the



US President Joe Biden Secret Service opened fire on a gunman, who was later arrested, at Trump's golf course in Florida.

Storm Boris unleashes central Europe flooding, toll hits 15

Flooding sparked by Storm Boris in central Europe has burst dams, knocked out power and killed at least 15 people, authorities said yesterday as some communities were cut off for four days into the disaster. High winds and unusually heavy rainfall have hit swathes of Austria, the Czech Republic, Hungary, Romania and Slovakia since Friday. "I have lived here for 16 years, and I have never seen such flooding," Judith Dickson, who lives in Austria's Sankt Poelten city, told the national broadcaster ORF. Experts say climate change caused by greenhouse gas emissions generated by human activities is increasing the frequency and intensity of extreme weather events such as torrential rains and floods. The rains from Boris have flooded streets and submerged entire neighbourhoods in some places, while shutting down public transport and electricity in others. Parts of Austria have been inundated since Thursday by

"Compared to 2013 the amount of water was almost three times bigger. It was hard to handle that kind of fury of nature," Prime Minister Marcel Ciolacu told reporters on Monday. Hungary has deployed more than 350 soldiers to reinforce flood barriers as the Danube and rivers along its basin are expected to surge.

Bebinca strongest typhoon to hit Shanghai since 1949: state media

The strongest storm to hit Shanghai in over 70 years made landfall yesterday, state media reported, with flights cancelled and highways closed as Typhoon Bebinca lashed the city with strong winds and torrential rains. A red alert is in place, and some coastal residents have been evacuated, city authorities said. The typhoon landed early Monday morning in the coastal area of Lingang New City, in Pudong to the city's east, the China Meteorological Administration said. It was the strongest storm to hit Shanghai since Typhoon Gloria in 1949, state broadcaster CCTV said shortly after Bebinca made landfall.

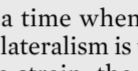
3D Printed Architecture is Bahrain's Future

The Construction industry in Bahrain is projected to grow from USD 8.96 Billion in 2023 to USD 12.56 Billion by 2032, exhibiting a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 4.30% during the forecast period of 2024 - 2032. The 3D printing technology can create complex and intricate shapes with incredible speed and accuracy, this can prove to be a boon for the architects as it will save time and manpower both. Additionally, the island nation's objective of reducing carbon footprint will also receive a boost with 3D printing technology as sustainable materials, such as recycled plastic or biodegradable materials, can be used extensively and creatively. The 3D printing technology can also usher in a new design era as it can aid in the development of strategies that incorporate curves, angles, and intricate details, leading to visually stunning and functional structures. The eco-friendly 3D printing technology can be accelerated in Bahrain with help of the mobile 3D printing machines which enable print structures on-site, reducing transportation and assembly costs. As these technological advancements continue, 3D printing technology can revolutionize the way buildings and infrastructure are designed and constructed. For instance, the 3D printing technology for concrete holds immense potential to address the sustainability challenges faced by the modern building and construction sector, presenting exciting opportunities for innovative design possibilities. Additionally, 3D printing technology also provides unparalleled possibilities for customisation of buildings. This can help clients to break free from the usual template designs and explore new ones for their buildings. Since 3D printing technology-based construction is yet to assume large scale proportions and use, Bahrain can play a pivotal role in scaling up this technology for large scale applications and projects and in the process set up a global benchmark in sustainable construction. As a first step, more progress through research can be enabled by Bahrain in developing newer materials with improved properties, sustainability, and cost-effectiveness for different applications. This can help gradually change the environmental signature of the buildings in Bahrain and contribute towards creating a green skyline for the nation. 3D printed buildings are the future of architecture that can help Bahrain conserve environment and reduce carbon footprint.

'Shogun' smashes Emmys record as 'Hacks' and 'Baby Reindeer' shine

Japanese historical epic 'Shogun' wins best drama, breaks records with 18 statuettes

- First non-English-language winner for best drama series
- Hiroyuki Sanada becomes first Japanese actor to win Emmy
- 'Hacks' surprises with best comedy series win
- 'Baby Reindeer' takes best limited series

Japan-set historical epic "Shogun" smashed all-time records and was named best drama at television's Emmy Awards on Sunday, as "Hacks" and "Baby Reindeer" racked up big wins at the glitzy gala in Los Angeles.

"Shogun," the tale of warring dynasties in feudal Japan, ended the night with an astounding 18 statuettes, becoming the first ever non-English-language winner of the highly coveted award for best drama series.

The previous record for any season of a television show was 13.

"It was an East-meets-West dream project, with respect," said veteran leading man Hiroyuki Sanada, who became the first Japanese actor to win an Emmy.

Anna Sawai followed him onto the Emmys stage minutes later with a best actress win, before the cast and producers of "Shogun" returned for the overall best drama series award.

The series from Disney-owned FX, based on James Clavell's historical fiction, had led the nominations with 25 overall.

Shot in Canada, it features a primarily Japanese cast and subtitles. Showrunner Justin Marks thanked producers for

commissioning "a very expensive, subtitled, Japanese period piece, whose central climax revolves around a poetry competition."

"Shogun is a show about translation -- not what is lost, but what is found, when you do safety meetings in two languages, and you learn not to walk on tatami mats with your utility boots," he said.

It also won the Emmy for best directing of a drama series, in addition to the 14 won in minor categories at a separate gala last weekend.

Mini-series "John Adams" won 13 Emmys in 2008. "Game of Thrones" had held the record for dramas at 12.

'Hacks' surprise

This was the second Emmys gala this year, after crippling twin strikes in Hollywood last year bumped the 2023 ceremony to January.

In the night's biggest surprise, the final award for best comedy series went to "Hacks."

The show -- starring Jean Smart as a diva comedienne who repeatedly locks horns with her dysfunctional millennial assistant -- fended off previous winner and hot favorite "The Bear."

Smart claimed her third lead actress Emmy for her role, quipping: "I appreciate this, because I just don't get enough attention."

"The Bear" still managed a

whopping 11 awards, including Jeremy Allen White and Ebon Moss-Bachrach as best lead and supporting actor.

Co-star Liza Colon-Zayas sprung a surprise by besting the likes of Meryl Streep ("Only Murders in the Building") to win best supporting actress.

"To all the Latinas who are looking at me, keep believing. And vote -- vote for your rights," she said, in one of several political notes at a gala taking place less than two months before the US presidential election.

The dark satire set in a Chicago restaurant dominated the last Emmys, despite controversy over whether it is actually a comedy.

Eugene Levy, hosting with his son Daniel, poked fun at the criticisms, insisting: "In the true spirit of 'The Bear,' we will not be making any jokes."

'Baby Reindeer'

Sunday's other big winner was Hiroyuki Sanada

played the stalker, won the Emmy for best supporting actress in a limited series.

'Shogun' rivals

"Shogun" dominated the drama sections as expected.

It was only the second non-English-language show to earn a best drama nomination, after South Korea's "Squid Game" two years ago.

But there were key prizes for rival shows.

The final season of Netflix's British royal saga drew a lukewarm response from critics, but Elizabeth Debicki won best supporting actress as Princess Diana.

Billy Crudup won best supporting actor in a drama for Apple's "The Morning Show."

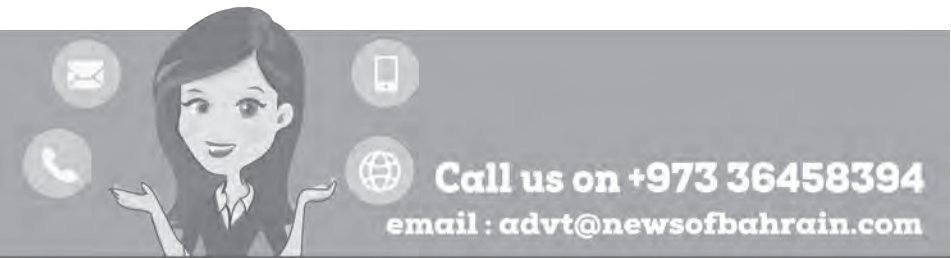

Man City fight to avoid sanctions as 'trial of the century' begins

Manchester City charged with 115 financial breaches, potentially facing severe penalties

- Manchester City could face severe sanctions, including expulsion
- City's financial practices under scrutiny since 2008 takeover
- Case expected to last 10 weeks; verdict likely in 2025

Manchester City will fight to avoid potential expulsion from the Premier League for financial breaches as sport's "trial of the century" began yesterday. Premier League champions City have been charged with 115 alleged breaches of the competition's financial regulations. City deny any wrongdoing and have said they have a "comprehensive body of irrefutable evidence" to clear their name. But if they are found guilty, they could face a range of punishments, including a severe points penalty or even be kicked out of the Premier League. Everton and Nottingham Forest were both hit by points deductions last season for single breaches of the league's profit and sustainability rules. With City winning eight league titles since 2012, includ-

ing six of the last seven, a guilty verdict could prompt a slew of compensation claims from rival top-flight clubs. City's financial affairs have come under regular scrutiny since their takeover by Sheikh Mansour's Abu Dhabi United Group in 2008. The hearing, which is not a court case, will be heard by an independent commission and could take 10 weeks to complete. City's legal team were photographed arriving at London's International Dispute Resolution Centre for the start of the hearing yesterday.

David Pannick from Blackstone Chambers, who is City's lead barrister, was seen on his way into the venue close to St Paul's Cathedral in central London. A verdict is not expected to be announced until 2025, with City likely to appeal if they are found guilty. Of the 115 charges, 80 are for breaches of the regulations between 2009 and 2018, while a further 35 relate to failing to cooperate with the Premier League's investigation. The root of suspicion comes from leaked documents published by German outlet Der

Spiegel back in 2018. Emails purportedly sent between City executives showed the club had allegedly inflated sponsorship revenue from Abu Dhabi state-controlled airline Etihad and telecoms firm Etisalat by disguising direct investment from the Abu Dhabi United Group as income. Other documents claimed to show off-the-books payments to then manager Roberto Mancini via consultancy fees from a club in Abu Dhabi. City have already defended

their position in one case after overturning a two-year ban from the Champions League by UEFA at the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) in 2020. CAS found most of the alleged breaches of overstating sponsorship revenue were either not established or "time-barred" because they fell outside the five-year statutory limit for prosecution. No such time limitation clause exists in the Premier League case, although City remain confident of avoiding sanctions. "I know what people are looking for, I know what they are expecting. I know it because I have read it for many years but I've said everyone is innocent until guilt is proven. So we will see," City manager Pep Guardiola said last week.

Van Dijk urges Liverpool to hit back after 'unacceptable' Forest loss

Virgil van Dijk has urged Liverpool to hit back after their "unacceptable" defeat against Nottingham Forest as the Reds prepare to start their Champions League campaign. Just days after their shock 1-0 loss to Forest in the Premier League, Arne Slot's side begin the new Champions League format with a trip to AC Milan on Tuesday. After winning the first three games of the Slot era, Liverpool were brought down by Forest at Anfield on Saturday. Liverpool captain Van Dijk wants the defeat to serve as fuel to beat Milan and quickly get their campaign back on track. "We have a very good group that really understand that it was unacceptable and are disappointed," the Dutch centre-back said. "We all know everyone can



do better and we have to show that on Tuesday and that is what we focus on. "We have been through losses and difficult moments together and I think we will stay calm and we will stay calm. "Hopefully if there are no injuries happening then rhythm is always a good thing. 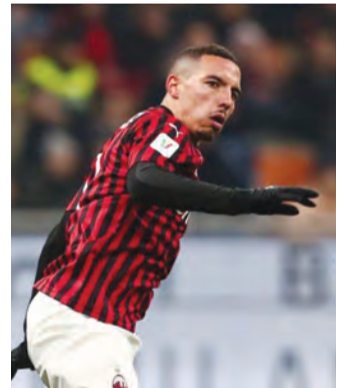
