Zelensky wants 'diplomacy'

Ukrainian President Vo-lodymyr Zelensky said yesterday that Kyiv would like to end the war with Russia next vear through "diplomatic means", as both countries prepare for Donald Trump's return to the White House. February 2025 would mark the third anniversary of Moscow's invasion of Ukraine, with Russia's troops gaining ground in recent months against Kyiv's outmanned and outgunned soldiers.

An Israeli strike on neighbouring Syria earlier this week killed two Islamic Jihad leaders, the Palestinian group, which has fought alongside Hamas in Gaza, confirmed.

Hamas, Hezbollah and Islamic Jihad are all backed by Israel's arch-enemy Iran, which on Friday said it supported a swift end to the nearly two-month war in Lebanon.

Since September 23, Israel has escalated its bombing of targets in Lebanon, later sending in ground troops after almost a year of limited, cross-border exchanges of fire begun by Hezbollah fighters over the Gaza war.

Proposal 'impractical'

Tamkeen opposes parliamentary push for direct worker payments

amkeen has opposed a parliamentary proposal to transfer wage subsidies directly into workers' accounts, arguing it would disrupt oversight and weaken the efployment programme, which has so far benefited over 25,000 Bahrainis.

The plan, which aims to tackle salary delays and strengthen job security, will be debated and put to a vote next Tuesday in Parliament.

Tamkeen described the proposal as impractical, pointing to the challenges it would create in employer-employee relation-

"Employers bear the respon- reers in the private sector. sibility for managing attendance, job performance, and any wage deductions. Tamkeen cannot bypass this structure without risking the programme's goals," the organisation stated in a letter to Parliament.

Real estate firm ordered to pay BD8,305 in rent row

Months of missed rent pay-Lments have landed a real estate firm in court, where it has been ordered to pay BD8.305.

The High Civil Court delivered the judgment on 13 November, also directing the company to pay BD100 in lawyer fees and reimburse additional court and execution costs.

The dispute arose from a tenancy agreement signed in January 2022, with the plaintiffs leasing a flat to the company.

Lease

The lease was renewed in that BD100 were recoverable,

March 2024 for two years, setting quarterly rent payments at BD4,152.500.

However, the firm failed to pay rent for the period from March to September 2024, leading the plaintiffs to file the case in October.

The plaintiffs, represented by lawyer Zainab Ali Madan, submitted key evidence, including the original lease, the renewal agreement, and proof of legal fees amounting to BD500.





ike Tyson's controversial return to boxing ended in a one-sided defeat, with Youtuber-turned-prizefighter Jake Paul cruising to victory by unanimous decision against the heavyweight icon in Texas.

Tyson, 58, barely landed a punch during the eight-round bout at the AT&T Stadium in Arlington, with Paul winning by big margins on all three cards -- 80-72, 79-73 and 79-73.

Paul, 27, used his superior speed and movement to dominate the ageing Tyson with ease, and had the former undisputed heavyweight champion in trouble after landing a flurry of punches in the third round.

Yet the younger fighter was unable to land the knockout blow he had promised to deliver during Thursday's ill-tempered weigh-in, where Tyson slapped him across the face.

Tyson, however, looked every bit of his 58 years, managing to land only a handful of meaningful punches during the fight, watched by a live crowd of around 70,000 spectators with an estimated millions more tuning in around the world.

Final statistics showed Tyson connected with just 18 of threw some 278 punches and landed 78 of them.

Pogba's Juve contract terminated despite doping ban reduction

m aul}$ Pogba's Juventus career is over after the Serie A club announced that the France midfielder's contract had been terminated even though his doping ban was cut to 18 months on appeal.

Pogba will be able to return to competitive football in March after the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) chopped last month an initial four-year suspension handed down by the Italian anti-doping authority

But Juventus have decided to cut ties with the 31-year-old, whose return to Turin from Manchester United in 2022 was ruined by a string of problems on and off the pitch.

In a statement, Juve said that they and Pogba "have reached a mutual agreement for the termination of their contract as of 30 November, 2024".
