
France's Dembele says no room for sentiment for Messi

FIFA to 'revisit' plan to scrap four-team groups: Infantino

 $F_{\text{to introduce three-team}}^{\text{IFA looks set to revise plans}}$ groups for the 2026 World Cup, world football chief Gianni Infantino said yesterday.

FIFA had previously indicated that the 2026 finals, which will expand to 48 teams from 32, would see countries divided into 16 groups of three during the first round.

Under that format, the top two teams in each group would advance to a 32-team knockout tournament.

However, FIFA president Infantino said the thrilling success of the existing first-round format at the 2022 World Cup -- where teams were divided into traditional groups of four -- had prompted a rethink.
