The fourth edition of the Arab Artificial Intelligence Forum will be held today, under the patronage of His Highness Shaikh Khalid bin Hamad Al Khalifa, First Deputy Chairman of the Supreme Council for Youth and Sports (SCYS), Chairman of the General Sports Authority (GSA), and President of the Bahrain Olympic Committee (BOC). The event is held in collaboration with the GSA, the Ministry of Interior, and the Ministry of Youth Affairs, and will take place virtually until August 22.

The forum aims to inspire Bahraini, Arab, and international youth to explore opportunities in technology and AI and help them develop the skills needed to excel in these fields.

A wide range of participants from across the Arab world and other countries, featuring leading experts and organisations in technology and AI, will take part.

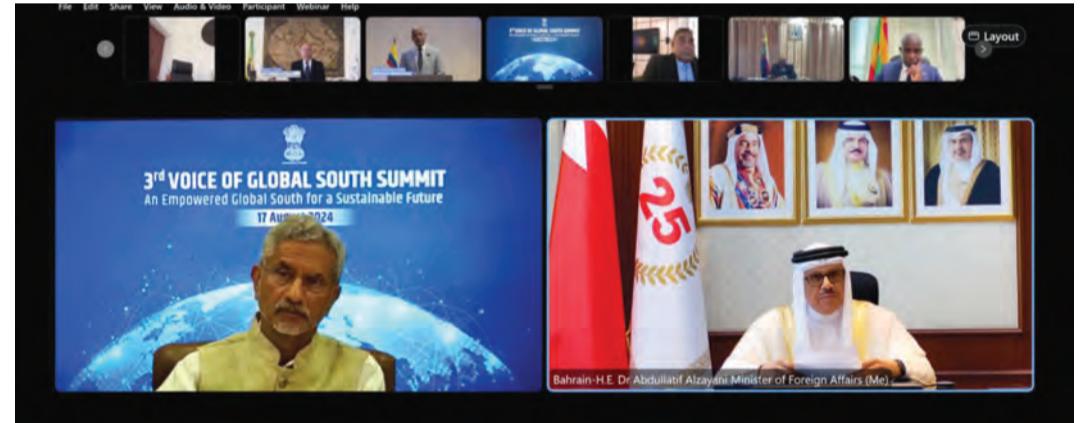

Israeli strike kills 15 Palestinian family members

Gaza's civil defence agency said an Israeli air strike in the early hours yesterday killed 15 members of a Palestinian family, including nine children and three women.

The strike hit the home of the Ajlah family in Al-Zawaida neighbourhood of central Gaza, civil defence spokesman Mahmud Bassal told AFP.

"The toll from the Israeli strike on the Ajlah family home and their warehouse in Al-Zawaida is 15 dead," Bassal said.

Bassal gave a list of those killed, including nine children and three women.

The Israeli military told AFP that during the night its forces had struck "terrorist infrastructure" in central Gaza from which rockets were being fired towards Israel.

"Reports were received that as a result of the strike, civilians in an adjacent structure were killed. The incident is under review," it said in a statement.

A witness said the strike took place shortly after midnight (2100 GMT Friday).

Easing concerns

Mpox contagious but 'curable,' says Bahraini doctor

Dr Ahmed Al Gharib, a specialist in internal medicine and a writer on health issues, has addressed concerns surrounding the Mpox, explaining that the virus is a contagious illness characterised by fever and a rash.

While it was originally discovered in monkeys, the name has since been changed to Mpox by the World Health Organisation in late 2022.

Dr Al Gharib highlighted the transmission routes of the virus, which can now spread from person to person through contact with the rash or bodily fluids.

He also emphasised that the virus can be transmitted through sexual activity or by touching contaminated surfaces or inhaling droplets from an infected individual.

At risk

Pregnant women are also at risk of transmitting the virus to their unborn child, he stated.

However, Dr Al Gharib reassured the public that most cases of Mpox resolve on their own within a few weeks.

He stressed the importance of following medical advice and taking necessary precautions, such as isolation, using anti-

Symptoms

Dr Al Gharib also advised frequent handwashing, sanitizing surfaces, and avoiding contact with individuals exhibiting symptoms.

He concluded his statement by urging the public to stay in-

formed and follow the latest guidelines issued by health authorities.

The doctor highlighted the role of health institutions in providing accurate information and resources to combat the spread of Mpox.

140,000 Bahrainis visited Qatar in 2023

Statistics released by the Qatar Tourism Authority revealed that 140,258 Bahraini citizens visited Doha last year, representing 3% of total tourist arrivals.

Meanwhile, the statistics showed that Saudi Arabia remains the top contributor of Qatar's tourism, making up 25% of the total number of international arrivals to Qatar. Kuwait, on the other hand, secured the second spot among Gulf coun-



tries, with 140,607 visitors recorded in 2023.

The data further indicates that the majority of Bahraini

visitors, around 86%, arrived in Qatar via land borders, while the remaining 14% traveled by air.

Overall, the breakdown of visitor arrival methods reveals that 55% came by air, 35% by land, and a mere 9% by sea.

Wedding disaster

Bride sues company for ruining her big day and causing significant financial losses and emotional hardship

A bride-to-be has sued a wedding planning company and its owner for breach of contract after they failed to deliver on their promises, leaving her with a ruined wedding day and significant financial losses.

The bride, represented by lawyer Bandar Shamal Al Dooseri, filed a lawsuit against the company, specialised in flowers and wedding arrangements, and its owner, seeking compensation and the rescission of the contract.

The lawsuit alleged that the bride had signed a contract with the company to arrange her wedding at a hotel, including decor, accessories, catering, hostesses, and a bridal suite.

She paid the full agreed-upon amount of BD8,000 and an additional BD920 for extra meals.

Obligations

However, the company failed to fulfill any of its obligations.

The bride discovered that the company had not booked the wedding hall and had completely disregarded the terms of the contract.

When she contacted the owner to address the issue, he ignored her calls and switched off his phone.

This left the bride in a desperate situation with guests arriving from overseas and no wedding venue.

She was forced to scramble for a last-minute alternative and cover the costs herself, causing significant financial and emotional hardship.

The court, after reviewing

the case, found that the company had indeed breached the contract and failed to fulfill its obligations.

Defense or justification

The defendant, who failed to appear in court, did not provide any defense or justification for their actions.

The court ruled in favor of the bride, rescinding the contract and ordering the company to repay the bride the full amount of BD10,920, along with 3% annual interest from the date of the claim until full repayment.

The court also ordered the company to cover the bride's legal fees and expenses.

Nurse's 16-year absence leads to legal battle and loss

A nurse who was absent from work for over 16 years has lost her legal battle to be reinstated or receive her due benefits.

The nurse, who had been in an accident during her absence, returned to the hospital and requested to be either retired due to her inability to perform her duties, or be provided with a suitable alternative position.

She also requested to be examined by a medical board to assess her fitness for work.

However, the hospital considered her to have resigned implicitly and terminated her employment.

The nurse filed a lawsuit demanding to be examined by a medical board, to have her employment record reviewed, and to have the hospital's decision

to deny her retirement due to unfitness overturned.

Employment

She also sought to have her employment terminated according to the provisions of Article 25 of Decree-Law No. (48) of 2010 concerning civil service.

The first instance court, after reviewing the medical report which stated the nurse was unable to work as a nurse but could perform office duties, ruled against the nurse.

The court found that the nurse's absence of over 16 years without any explanation constituted an implicit resignation, and therefore she had no legal standing to pursue the case.

Legal rights

The court also stated that the nurse needed to demonstrate a direct and personal interest in



the case to have her legal rights protected.

The nurse appealed the decision to the High Appeals Court, arguing that the lower court had misapplied the law.

She claimed that she had contacted the hospital to clarify her legal status but received no re-

sponse, which prompted her to file the lawsuit.

The High Appeals Court upheld the lower court's decision, stating that the nurse's absence for 16 years without any contact with the hospital was sufficient evidence of her intent to abandon her position.

Stage set for marine heritage competition

Plans are in full swing for the launch of the seventh edition of the Nasser bin Hamad Marine Heritage Season, which is set to kick off at the end of this month and will run for three months.

The organising committee will have a few sit-downs with the sub-teams to sort out the rules and conditions for each competition during the season.

Mr Ahmed Al Shamlan, Competitions Director for the Nasser bin Hamad Marine Heritage Sports Season, said that the Bahrain Inherited Traditional Sports Committee (Mawrooth) aims each year to bring in fresh aspects to the marine heritage contests to draw in more young Bahrainis and further the broader purpose of holding these events.

Al Shamlan revealed that two new competitions are lined up for this year's edition, including the heritage swimmer contest for open-water swimming, which will take



place over two rounds.

He added that this year's programme also includes a breath-holding competition, where participants will test their limits by staying underwater for as long as they can.

On top of that, there will be a traditional fishing competition (Haddaq), lasting a continuous 24 hours.

The traditional rowing races, featuring 30-foot heritage boats, will also be held in two rounds, culminating in the grand final for His Majesty the King's Cup, which will mark the end of the season.

Al Shamlan assured that the organising committee has liaised with the relevant authorities, whose support plays a key role in the success of the Nasser bin Hamad Marine Heritage Sports Season.

Gold prices in Bahrain climb to 10-year high

The global and Bahraini gold markets have witnessed a dramatic surge in prices, reaching levels not seen in over a decade.

The price of 21-karat gold has climbed to BD26,400 per gram, while 24-karat gold has reached approximately BD30, causing significant concern among both customers and traders.

A visit to the Dilmun Gate Gold Market by our sister newspaper Al Ayam revealed a market almost devoid of buyers.

Many customers are choosing to sell their gold jewelry to capitalise on the high prices rather than purchase new pieces.

"The surge in gold prices has significantly impacted buying activity," explained the owner of Esra Jewelry. "Many customers find it difficult to afford gold at its current price."

He added that customers are primarily selling their gold jewelry, taking advantage of the high prices, instead of purchasing new pieces.

Unstable situation

The owner of Sadaf Jewelry attributed the surge to the un-



stable situation in the region, including wars and political tensions. These factors have led to increased demand for gold as a safe haven for investment.

"The sharp rise in prices has discouraged many customers from purchasing," he stated. "This phenomenon negatively affects the market, as sales have significantly decreased. We expect this situation to continue if the unstable conditions persist."

Despite the current market downturn, gold remains a preferred choice for many investors, suggesting that demand may continue in the future.

Global problem

"We hope the global problem is resolved quickly so that the price of gold stabilizes as usual," said the shop owners.

Stability in global conditions would have a positive impact on local and international markets.

Dial for help

Bahrain emergency services respond to more than 16,000 calls in June 2024

Bahrain's emergency services handled a significant number of calls in June 2024, according to statistics published in the Ministry of Interior's security magazine.

The operations room received a total of 16,100 reports, with traffic-related incidents accounting for 29% of the total.

The General Directorate of Civil Defense reported receiving 1,300 calls in June, including 223 fire incidents, 689 requests for assistance, 98 traffic accidents, and 15 reports of fallen poles, trees, and signs.

The Coast Guard received 249 reports, including 83 for rescue and ship breakdowns, 15 for maritime accidents, and 151 for assistance.

The National Ambulance Service received 4,500 calls, including 374 for traffic accidents, 3,000 for medical emergencies, 710 for transfers from

private hospitals and health centers to emergency rooms, and 42 for fire incidents.

Operations room

The statistics also revealed that the operations room received 1,600 reports in June, with patrol units responding to 14% of these calls.

Traffic incidents accounted

for 29% of the calls, while security incidents made up only 4%.

The statistics further indicated that 9% of accidents resulted in fatalities, 48% resulted in serious injuries, and 43% resulted in minor injuries.

As of June 2024, there were approximately 760,645 licensed vehicles on the road in Bahrain.

The Bahrain Chess Academy team has left for the UAE to compete in the 30th Abu Dhabi International Chess Festival.

This event will see over 2,000 players from 76 nations take part.

The Academy's involvement forms part of the KHK Sports programme by the Khalid bin Hamad Sports Organisation, which supports a range of sports. This aligns with His

Highness Shaikh Khalid bin Hamad Al Khalifa's "Gold Generation" scheme.

The festival boasts 27 different tournaments with a total prize pool of AED450,000. It also marks the centenary of the International Chess Federation, founded in Paris in 1924.

Guiding the team is International Master Mohamed Tissir, an African champion and Olympic gold medalist in chess, who has been intensively preparing the

players over the past two months.

The "Gold Generation" team includes Hamza Mohamed, Abdullah Makki, and Mariam Mohamed in the Under-12 category, as well as Marwan Al Binali, Mohamed Taqi, Fares Qun'eir, and Youssef Mohamed in the Under-20 category. Wafa Yaqoub from Bahrain's women's national team will compete in the Women's category and is also set to join the Chess Olympiad in Budapest this September.

Building dreams and better future

Housing Ministry gears up for construction of 1,400 new social housing units in Salman City

The Ministry of Housing and Urban Planning is gearing up to build 1,400 new social housing units in Salman City.

The new units will be constructed on Islands 10 and 11, with the ministry already initiating consulting studies for the project.

The ministry's plan includes the construction of 720 social housing units on Island 11.

Gulf House Engineering has been appointed to conduct the consulting studies for supervision and management of this project.

Additionally, 682 social housing units will be built on Islands 10 and 11, with Salfo & Partners undertaking the consulting studies for this phase.

In parallel, the ministry is preparing to launch the first phase of construction for commercial markets and shops in Salman City in October.

This phase aims to provide essential commercial services in the city and will include 15 commercial shops. Ten of these shops will be located on Avenue 8307 in Block 583, behind Al Zahra Mosque.

Commercial shops

The second project will involve the construction of five commercial shops in Complex 580, located on the Salman City coastline. This location offers a sea view, and the design will feature a distinctive "X" shape.

The second phase, expected to begin in the second half of 2025, will include a general market with a rental area of 1,600 square meters

The market will feature sea-view restaurants, eight commercial shops, 19 vegetable and fish stalls, a green space in the middle of the market with integrated central air conditioning, and all necessary facilities, services, and parking spaces.

Hypermarket

Also in the second half of 2025, a large "hypermarket" with a total area of 2,500 square

meters will be built on a total land area of 6,500 square meters. This supermarket will be located on Avenue 92 in Block 583, adjacent to the Model Kindergarten.

These ambitious projects demonstrate the Ministry's commitment to improving the quality of life in Salman City by providing affordable housing, essential services, and commercial opportunities for residents.

New mosque to rise soon in Al-Malikiya

MP Hanan Fardan has confirmed that residents of Al-Malikiya Housing will soon benefit from the approval of the long-awaited Al-Abdah Mosque for daily prayers, as well as the establishment of commercial and service shops near the historic Prince Zaid Mosque by next year.

Fardan expressed her gratitude to the Minister of Housing, H.E. Amna Al-Rumaihi, and the Minister of Justice, Islamic Affairs, and Endowments, H.E. Nawaf Al-Maawda, for their responsiveness to the demands and aspirations of Al-Malikiya's residents.

US judge blocks Fox, ESPN and Warner Bros sports streamer

AUS federal judge on Friday temporarily blocked ESPN, Fox and Warner Bros Discovery from launching a joint sports streaming service as the question of whether the platform violates antitrust laws works through the courts.

Fubo, a sports streamer that brought the lawsuit in April, called the injunction a "victory."

ESPN, Warner Bros and Fox announced in February that they would create the new streaming service, called Venu Sports.

District Judge Margaret Gannett on Friday granted Fubo's request to block the launch in part because "Fubo is likely to be successful in proving its claims that the (venture) will violate this country's antitrust laws."

She also added that "Fubo and American consumers will face irreparable harm in the

absence of an injunction."

David Gandler, co-founder and CEO of Fubo, said in a statement that "today's ruling is a victory not only for Fubo but also for consumers."

"This decision will help ensure that consumers have access to a more competitive marketplace with multiple sports streaming options."

The three companies behind Venu Sports intend to appeal.

"We believe that Fubo's arguments are wrong on the facts and the law, and that Fubo has failed to prove it is legally entitled to a preliminary injunction," Disney-owned sports channel ESPN told AFP.

Germany to cut Ukraine military aid in 2025 budget: parliament source

Germany, the second largest contributor of aid to war-torn Ukraine, plans to halve its bilateral military aid to Kyiv in 2025, a parliamentary source told AFP on Saturday.

Instead the government of Chancellor Olaf Scholz will bank on money generated by frozen Russian assets to continue supporting Kyiv, and is not planning any "additional aid" to the four billion euros (\$4.4 billion) set aside in next year's budget.

This year aid from Berlin amounted to eight billion euros.

To compensate, Germany is counting on "the creation, within the framework of the G7 and the European Union, of a financial instrument using frozen Russian assets", said a separate source from inside the finance ministry.

The sources were confirming separate press reports, with the newspaper Frank-

furter Allgemeine Sonntagszeitung saying in its weekend edition that the move was part of an agreement between the chancellor, of the centre-left Social Democratic party, and the liberal Finance Minister Christian Lindner.

The 2025 budget has been the subject of fierce discussions between the government coalition of the liberal FDP party, the Greens and the Social Democrats.

The finance minister has asked his counterparts to make savings in order to respect a constitutional rule that aims to prevent the state from taking on too much debt.

Senegal's first satellite successfully launched

Senegal's first satellite has been successfully launched into orbit, President Bassirou Diomaye Faye said, adding the move marked a major step towards the West African country's "technological sovereignty".

The GAINDESAT-1A satellite was launched at 18:56 GMT Friday from the Vandenberg base in California, Faye wrote in a post on X late Friday.

"The result of five years of

hard work by our engineers and technicians, this advance marks a major step towards our technological sovereignty," Faye said.

"I would like to express my pride and gratitude to all those who made this project possible," he added.

Senegal's public broadcaster RTS said the satellite was designed and manufactured by Senegalese engineers, in partnership with the French Montpellier University Space Centre (CSUM).

◆ **Twenty medical students** on their way to an annual convention have been kidnapped in eastern Nigeria, police and university sources said yesterday. The Federation of Catholic Medical and Dental Students said in a statement released Saturday that the students were travelling to the convention in the city of Enugu when they were abducted on Thursday evening. Fortune Olaye, the secretary general of the Nigerian Medical Students' Association, said that 20 students from the Maiduguri and Jos universities and one doctor travelling with them had been kidnapped. He said there had been a ransom demand in return for their release. The students were abducted on the road near the town of Otukpo, less than 150 kilometres from Enugu, which is regularly the target of attacks and kidnappings.

◆ **A devastating flood** that hit a village in Nepal's Everest region was caused by a glacial lake outburst, local government officials and experts said yesterday. Climate change experts said it was a clear example of the "catastrophic impacts" increasing global temperatures were having on people who had done the least to contribute to the greenhouse gases driving it. At least 14 buildings, including seven homes, five hotels, one hostel and one clinic, were completely swept away by the flood that hit Thame village Friday afternoon. No deaths were reported, but the scale of the brown and muddy flood waters surging through the village of Thame was shocking, videos posted on social media by the local authorities showed.

◆ **Thailand's controversial** former prime minister Thaksin Shinawatra has been granted a royal pardon, his lawyer said yesterday, a day after his daughter became the kingdom's new premier. The 75-year-old billionaire is one of thousands granted amnesty by King Maha Vajiralongkorn in a gesture of clemency to mark his birthday. Thaksin was jailed for eight years on graft and abuse of power charges dating back to his time in power when he returned to the kingdom almost a year ago after 15 years of self-exile. But his sentence was cut to one year by the king and he was later released on parole because of his age and poor health. The amnesty was announced in the official Royal Gazette, and Thaksin's lawyer Winay Chatmontree said that the two-time premier benefited. "Thaksin Shinawatra is among those granted the royal pardon," he said on his personal Facebook account. "He will later receive a document from the prison saying he is a free man."

Indonesia celebrates Independence Day in future capital

Indonesia held scaled-back Independence Day celebrations in Nusantara yesterday as the government rushed to complete the future capital, which is slated to replace sinking and polluted Jakarta.

The \$32-billion megaproject on Borneo island was expected to officially become Indonesia's political capital on Saturday, but construction delays and funding problems forced President Joko Widodo to defer signing a presidential decree sealing the move.

Widodo, more popularly known as Jokowi, attended the ceremony in Nusantara with cabinet ministers and military brass as he sought to reassure potential investors of the project's viability before he leaves office after a decade in power.

He was the first president to attend a state ceremony in the unfinished capital.

But Jokowi did not address attendees at the celebration, which included a prayer and military parade, a day after he gave his final state of union address to parliament outlining his economic record but not mentioning the new capital.

His successor Prabowo Subianto, who will take office in October, also attended the ceremony in Nusantara.

Fewer than 2,000 others attended, however, as a lack of accommodation and ongoing construction forced the guest list to be slashed back from 8,000.

Around 125 firefighters tackle blaze at historic London art centre

Around 125 firefighters tackled a large blaze at London's historic Somerset House cultural centre yesterday, with flames leaping out from underneath its roof.

"Twenty fire engines and around 125 firefighters are now responding to the fire at Somerset House. Crews are continuing to work at bringing the fire in the building's roof under control," the London Fire Brigade posted on X, formerly Twitter.

The official X account of the Renaissance building, which opened in 1796, said that "owing to a fire in one small part of Somerset House, the site is currently closed."

It added that "all staff and public are safe."

The complex is home to the Courtauld Gallery, which houses priceless paintings, including Vincent van Gogh's

"Self-Portrait with Bandaged Ear."

Other footage taken from central London showed thick plumes of smoke rising above the building, which stretches for around 180 metres along the banks of the River Thames.

The courtyard of the grand building hosts music gigs in the summer and a popular ice rink in the winter, appearing in the 2003 film "Love Actually". It has also appeared in two James Bond films, the 2008 movie "The Duchess", starring Keira Knightley and Ralph Fiennes, and Tim Burton's 1999 horror movie "Sleepy Hollow". The fire service said two 32-metre ladders had been sent to the scene to support firefighting operations. "The entire site at Somerset House is now closed to the public whilst we tackle the fire. Traffic in the surrounding area will be impacted as crews respond," it added.

WHO seeks mpox vaccine production surge

The World Health Organization on Friday urged manufacturers to ramp up production of mpox vaccines to rein in the spread of a more dangerous strain of the virus.

The WHO on Wednesday declared the mpox surge a public health emergency of international concern -- its highest alert level -- with Clade 1b cases soaring in the Democratic Republic of Congo and spreading beyond its borders.

"We do need the manufacturers to really scale up so that we've got access to many, many more vaccines," WHO spokeswoman Margaret Harris told reporters.

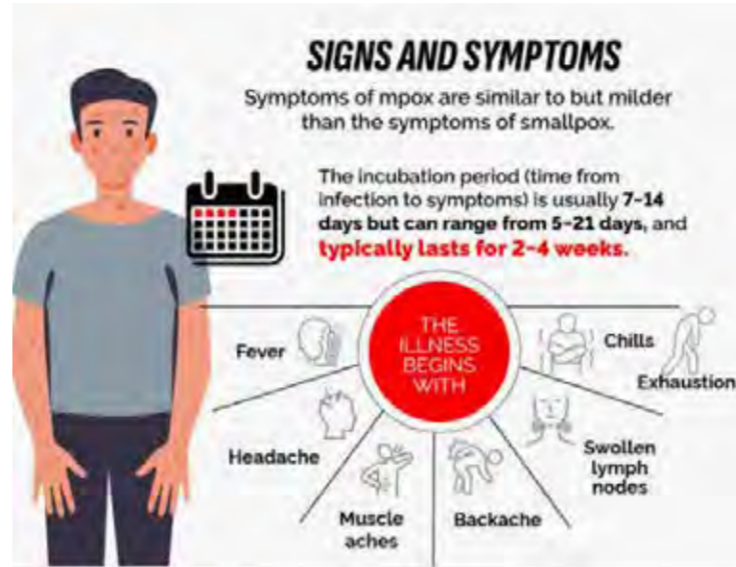
The WHO is asking countries with mpox vaccine stockpiles to donate them to countries with ongoing outbreaks.

Two mpox vaccines have been used in recent years -- MVA-BN, produced by Danish drugmaker Bavarian Nordic, and Japan's LC16.

Harris said there were 500,000 MVA-BN doses in stock, while an additional 2.4 million doses could be produced quickly, if there was a commitment from buyers.

For 2025, an additional 10 million doses could be produced, upon a firm procurement request.

"LC16 is a vaccine that is not commercialised but produced on behalf of the government of Japan. There is a considerable stockpile of this vaccine," Harris added, saying the WHO was working with Tokyo to facilitate donations.



The Risks and Prevention of Mpox

Mpox, formerly known as monkeypox, is a viral disease caused by the monkeypox virus, which is part of the same family of viruses as smallpox. The disease is typically characterized by a rash that progresses to pustules, along with symptoms such as fever, headache, muscle aches, swollen lymph nodes, and fatigue.

Key Facts About Mpox:

- **Transmission:** Mpox can spread from animals to humans (zoonotic transmission) and also from human to human. It is primarily transmitted through direct contact with the blood, bodily fluids, or skin lesions of infected animals or humans. It can also be spread through respiratory droplets during prolonged face-to-face contact.

- **Symptoms:** After an incubation period of 5-21 days, the initial symptoms often include fever, headache, muscle aches, and exhaustion. Within a few days after the fever, a rash typically develops, often starting on the face and then spreading to other parts of the body.

- **Severity:** The severity of mpox can vary. While most cases are mild and self-limiting, severe cases can occur, especially in individuals with weakened immune

systems. Complications can include pneumonia, secondary bacterial infections, and, in rare cases, death.

- **Prevention and Treatment:** Preventive measures include avoiding contact with potentially infected animals or people, practicing good hygiene, and using personal protective equipment (PPE) when necessary. There is no specific treatment for mpox, but antiviral drugs and vaccines used for smallpox may offer some protection and be used in cases of mpox outbreaks.

The name change from monkeypox to mpox was part of an effort to reduce stigma and inaccuracies associated with the disease's name. The World Health Organization (WHO) has been involved in these renaming efforts.

Modi calls for Global South unity at virtual summit

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi has urged the nations of the Global South to unite and support each other as a collective strength. In his opening address at the 3rd Voice of the Global South virtual summit yesterday, Modi expressed concern over the current global uncertainty and the challenges it presents.

He underscored that, while the world is still grappling with the aftermath of COVID-19, ongoing conflicts have further complicated the developmental progress of Global South nations. Modi emphasized the pressing issues these countries face, including climate change, health security, food security, and energy security.

The Prime Minister also highlighted the persistent threats of terrorism, extremism, and separatism, alongside the emerging economic and social challenges posed by the technology divide. He reassured that India is committed to sharing its experiences and capabilities with all Global South countries, focusing on promoting trade, inclusive development, progress on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), and women-led development.

Modi pointed out the recent advancements in Global South cooperation, particularly in infrastructure, digital, and energy connectivity. Under Mission LIFE, New Delhi is prioritizing rooftop solar and renewable power generation, both within India and in partner countries. He also



mentioned India's efforts to connect various Global South nations through the Unified Payments Interface (UPI).

Significant progress has been made in education, capacity building, and skill development in partnership with Global South nations, Modi noted. He introduced the Global South Youth Diplomat Forum and the South Excellence Centre, which focuses on capacity building, skilling, and knowledge sharing.

Praising the role of Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI) in fostering inclusive growth, the Prime Minister highlighted the establishment of the Global DPI Depository during India's G20 Presidency as the first multilateral consensus on DPI. India has also set up a Social Impact Fund to accelerate DPI progress in the Global South, with an initial contribution of 25 million dollars.

For health security, Modi re-

iterated India's commitment to the mission of "One World-One Health" and the vision of "Arogya Maitri." He noted that New Delhi has upheld this partnership by collaborating on healthcare projects in Africa and Pacific Island countries.

In times of humanitarian crises, India has acted as a first responder, providing assistance to friendly nations, Modi said. Concluding the summit, he expressed confidence that the discussions will advance the goals set by Global South nations and proposed a Comprehensive Global Development Compact, drawing on India's own development journey and experiences.

To further strengthen trade promotion activities, Modi announced that India will provide a 2.5 million dollar fund and contribute 1 million dollars for capacity building in trade policy and negotiations.

Let's plan a 'healthy' school year

Midway through August is always the time we begin to see the 'Back To School' sale banners in shops. Although schools open only by September first week, there are a lot of things needed to prep for the new academic term. New books to be bought and covered in protective brown paper, new stationery, new computers in many cases, as children graduate to higher classes where they get to work more on laptops. On top of this we have school fees and transportation fees for school buses if your child goes to a private school or uses private transport. All in all, it is an expensive time for families, especially when more than one child is to be equipped for the school year.

In all this commercial flurry, I believe that we are missing out on two very important matters to make sure our children are fully ready for school: that is, a full check on their mental and physical health. Now I know parents will wonder why they should put their child through such tests, especially when they seem healthy.

But one of the main causes of being unable to perform brightly in class are weak eyesight and hearing. Further, so many very intelligent students find school overwhelming because of problems processing the knowledge. They may need special help because of dyslexia or may be on the spectrum of autism - all these can be identified and parents and teachers can use new and tested methods to help these students.

Here are two messages: first, the authorities in the health and education ministries must mandate annual health checks for all students. If executives can have this covered by their corporations, why not children who are our Kingdom's future?

Health centres must be equipped to conduct a package of children's tests: eyes, ears, dental and basic physical plus blood test for anaemia and sickle cell on a case-by-case basis. In addition, let the children meet a mental wellness counsellor and get equipped for the stress of school life with bullies and peer pressure to handle.

And parents, this is for you: in your enthusiasm to buy new laptops and books for the kids, do not ignore their health. Grades may rise and fall but health is everything.

Hamas official dismisses 'illusion' that truce nearer

A senior Hamas official yesterday dismissed optimistic talk by US President Joe Biden that a Gaza truce is nearer after negotiations in the Gulf emirate of Qatar.

"To say that we are getting close to a deal is an illusion," Hamas political bureau member Sami Abu Zuhri told AFP. "We are not facing a deal or real negotiations, but rather the imposing of American diktats."

He was responding to Biden's comment on Friday that, "We are closer than we have ever been."

Biden spoke after two days of talks in Qatar where Washington tried to bridge differences between Israel and Palestinian Hamas. The two sides have been at war for more than 10 months in the Gaza Strip.

Previous optimism during months of on-off truce talks has so far proven futile.

But the stakes have significantly risen since the killings in quick succession in late July of Fuad Shukur, a top operations chief of Lebanon's Iran-backed Hezbollah movement, and Hamas political chief Ismail Haniyeh.

Their deaths led to vows of vengeance from Hezbollah, Iran and other Tehran-backed groups in the region which blamed Israel.

In an effort to avert a broader

conflict, Western and Arab diplomats have been shuttling around the Middle East to push for a Gaza deal which they say could help avert a wider regional conflagration.

Biden's secretary of state, Antony Blinken, was to head on Saturday to Israel in a bid to finalise an agreement.

As efforts towards a truce continued, so did the killing on Saturday in Gaza and Lebanon.

Lebanon's health ministry said an Israeli air strike in southern

Lebanon killed 10 people including a Syrian woman and her two children.

The strike was among the deadliest in southern Lebanon since the onset of near-daily exchanges of fire between Israel and Hezbollah following the start of the Gaza war in October.

Israel's military said it struck a Hezbollah weapons storage facility.

In Hamas-run Gaza, civil defence rescuers said an Israeli air strike killed 15 people from a sin-

Lamborghini unveils Temerario super car

A High-Performance Hybrid Supercar Successor to the Huracan

Lamborghini has unveiled the all-new 'Temerario' supercar, the successor to the iconic Huracan.

Dubbed an HPEV (High-Performance Electrified Vehicle) by Lamborghini, the Temerario features an all-new powertrain, replacing the Huracan's naturally aspirated V10 with a freshly engineered 4.0-litre twin-turbocharged V8. This engine is paired with a plug-in hybrid system, including three electric motors, one of which is an axial-flux motor integrated into the 8-speed dual-clutch automatic gearbox.

The combined power output of this advanced setup is an impressive 920 BHP, with the V8 engine alone delivering 789 BHP and 729 Nm of torque. The electric motors contribute an additional 148



BHP and 300 Nm, propelling the Temerario from 0 to 62 mph (0-100 km/h) in just 2.7 seconds, with a top speed of 211 mph (339.5 km/h). A 3.8 kWh lithium-ion battery pack powers the hybrid system and can be fully charged in 30 minutes using a 7 kW AC charging port, though Lamborghini has not specified an EV-only range.

Design-wise, the Temerario blends elements from the outgoing Huracan with its larger sibling, the Revuelto.

It features sleek headlights with hexagonal LED DRLs on the front bumpers and a staggered wheel setup with 20-inch front and 21-inch rear alloys. Lamborghini offers forged and carbon fibre wheel options. A prominent vent in front of the rear wheels enhances downforce by 103% compared to the Huracan EVO. At the rear, the Temerario continues the hexagonal theme with its LED tail

lights.

The supercar is also available with the Alлегgerita lightweight package, which adds a larger rear wing, a unique bumper design, and carbon fibre rims, boosting downforce by 158% compared to the Huracan EVO and reducing weight by 25 kg.

Inside, the Temerario continues the hexagonal motif with a 12.3-inch digital instrument cluster, an 8.4-inch vertical infotainment screen, and a 9.1-inch touchscreen display for the passenger. The 3-spoke steering wheel appears to be carried over from the Revuelto.

Lamborghini has yet to announce the pricing for the Temerario, which is expected to hit international markets later this year or in early 2025.



BMW rolls out new M5 touring



High-Performance Wagon returns after a decade

BMW has unveiled the new M5 Touring, the station wagon version of the latest-generation M5.

This marks the third iteration of the M5 Wagon and the first in over a decade, with the previous model being the E61 generation from 2010. The new M5 Touring made its debut at the ongoing Monterey Car Week in California, USA.

While based on the latest M5 sedan, the M5 Touring features



distinct design elements, including a raked roofline, flared wheel arches, and slightly larger proportions. Inside, the M5 Touring mirrors the standard M5, with the exception of additional cargo space behind the

rear seats, offering up to 1,630 liters of luggage capacity when the seats are folded down.

Despite its station wagon form, the M5 Touring retains the performance credentials of its sedan counterpart. Weigh-

ing in at around 2.5 tonnes, it is powered by a V8 plug-in hybrid powertrain that produces 727 BHP and 1000 Nm of torque. BMW claims that the M5 Touring can accelerate from 0-100 km/h in just 3.6 seconds and reach a top speed of 304 km/h. It also offers an EV-only driving range of up to 68 km.

The BMW M5 Touring will compete directly with rivals such as the Audi RS6 Avant and the Mercedes-AMG C63 S E Performance.

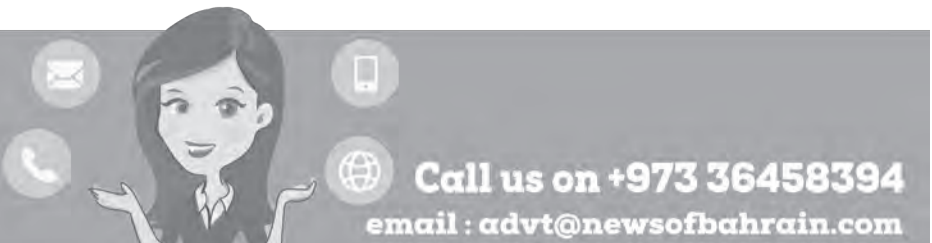

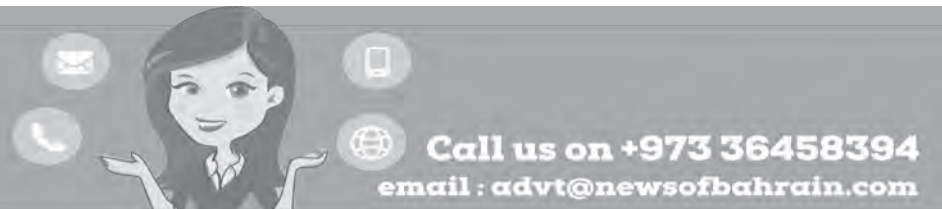

HH Shaikh Nasser Crowned Hungarian Champion

Shaikh Nasser received the first-place trophy from Orshidia Maihok of the Hungarian Equestrian Federation, alongside David from the Hungarian Federation, marking a successful outing for the Royal Endurance Team as they gear up for the World Championships.



Bagnaia outpaces Martin to win 'incredible' Austrian MotoGP sprint

Italian Ducati rider Francesco Bagnaia raced clear to win an "incredible" Austrian MotoGP sprint yesterday and overtake Jorge Martin at the top of the championship standings.

Spaniard Martin of Ducati-Pramac finished second, while compatriot Aleix Espargaro of Aprilia completed the podium.

The reigning two-time MotoGP champion Bagnaia started the grid in second place and completed the 14 laps in 20 minutes 59.768 seconds, 4.673sec faster than Martin.

The Turin-born rider now sits top of the championship standings, but is tied on 250 points with Martin.

"Incredible, but the most incredible thing we did is the best lap time during the battle, a 1:28.7, that's two-tenths lower than the pole position time last year," said 27-year-old Bagnaia of his third sprint win of the season.

"The fight was intense and our pace was incredible... I'm very happy."

Pole-sitter Martin was hit with a penalty early in the sprint after he was unable to get his bike turned in time at turn two of the second lap and was forced through the short-cut.

"It was a difficult race for

sure," said the 26-year-old from Madrid.

"I think it would have been a much better show without the long lap penalty because I had something left to try, I was really close to Pecco (Bagnaia). The first two laps were amazing, I really enjoyed that."

Enea Bastianini, fresh off a sprint-GP double at the British MotoGP, finished fourth on his

Ducati and KTM's Australian rider Jack Miller raced through in fifth place.

Italian Franco Morbidelli (Ducati-Pramac), South African Brad Binder (KTM) and Marco Bezzecchi of Italy (Ducati-VR46) came in sixth, seventh and eighth respectively.

And the top 10 was rounded off by Spaniards Pol Espargaro (KTM) and Pedro Acosta (Gas-

Gas-Tech3).

Six-time world champion Marc Marquez started third but slid off his Ducati-Gresini bike with five laps to go and did not finish.

In Sunday's Grand Prix, Martin will seek to reclaim his championship lead when he again starts on pole after setting a new lap record at the Red Bull Ring earlier in qualifying.

"We as a team made a big change at half-time because we came out totally different to how we had come out in the first half," said the former Feyenoord boss.

"Second half, we won more duels, we won more second balls and we played more balls in behind because if the other team takes the risk of playing one-v-one and you have the likes of Luis Diaz, Mo Salah and Diogo Jota then use them, play the balls in behind."

Angry Alcaraz out after 'worst match' while Sinner wins in walkover

Carlos Alcaraz let loose his frustrations with a violent racquet smash in a 4-6, 7-6 (7/5), 6-4 defeat on Friday at the ATP and WTA Cincinnati Open that he called the "worst match" of his career.

The reigning Roland Garros and Wimbledon champion could not match the wily skills of 37-year-old French opponent Gael Monfils, two decades in the game and a threat to any young gun.

"It was the worst match that I ever played in my career," Alcaraz said. "I couldn't play."

"I don't know what happened. Honestly, I couldn't, I couldn't control myself. I couldn't be better. It was impossible to win, and that's all."

The Spaniard added: "I came here thinking I'm going to feel good. I'm going to put in a good tennis, because I know how to play on this court."

Alcaraz said he had never before broken a racquet in anger but this match was the exception.

The ATP number three and 2023 Cincinnati runner-up heads to the US Open starting a week from Monday without a hardcourt win and only one second-round summer cement match in his legs.

"It's really difficult to find some goodstuffs from this match -- I want to forget it and try to move on to New York," he said.

"I'll try to practice well, to get used to those courts. And I will forget this match."

Monfils then started a third-round catch-up match only hours after his victory, but ran out of puff as Holger Rune scraped out a 3-6, 6-3, 6-4 comeback victory.

While frustrated second seed Alcaraz was fuming at his form and occasionally screaming at his team, world number one Jan-nik Sinner celebrated a quiet 23rd birthday, with fate handing him a present in the form of a walkover.

The Italian advanced effortlessly into the quarters when Australian opponent Jordan Thompson withdrew before their match with a rib injury.

Sinner next gets a rematch of last week's quarter-final in Canada, which he lost to Andrey Rublev. The Russian finished a rain-delayed match over Brandon Nakashima 7-6 (7/5), 6-1.

Third seed Alexander Zverev advanced into the last eight over Spain's Pablo Carreno Busta 7-5, 7-6 (8/6).

Number five Hubert Hurkacz continued his quick return from July knee surgery with a 6-3, 3-6, 6-1 defeat of Italy's Flavio Cobolli.

The poor run of form for seventh seed Casper Ruud continued as the Norwegian went down 6-3, 6-1 to Felix Auger-Aliassime in 68 minutes, with the Canadian sending down 14 aces.

No.1 Swiatek cruises

Women's top seed Iga Swiatek defeated Marta Kostyuk for the second time this season, powering into the quarter-finals 6-2, 6-2.

The Pole backed up her win over the Ukrainian at Indian Wells last March and now stands 3-0 in the rivalry without the loss of a set.

Top-ranked Swiatek was able to finish off victory efficiently after struggling through three sets in the previous round to defeat Varvara Gracheva.

Swiatek secured the opening set in 31 minutes and was untroubled as she rolled through the second.

"I'm happy that I kept my intensity, in the first match, it got a little bit down," Swiatek said. "But I was ready in every game."

"I'm happy I was solid. I was disciplined with all the things that I wanted to take care of."

Three-time semi-finalist and third seed Aryna Sabalenka beat Monfils's wife, Elina Svitolina, 7-5, 6-2 for her fourth quarter-final here.

Sixth seed Jessica Pegula won a delayed second-round match over 2023 runner-up Karolina Muchova 5-7, 6-4, 6-2.

Pegula's second win of the day was a 6-2, 6-3 triumph

over US compatriot Taylor Townsend to reach a quarter-final against former US Open finalist Leylah Fernandez.

Mother-of-two Caroline Wozniacki lost to Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova 7-5, 6-4.

Olympic champion Zheng Qinwen beat Poland's Magdalena Frech 6-1, 7-5, but then lost a third-round match to Pavlyuchenkova 7-5, 6-1.

Teen Mirra Andreeva beat Italy's Wimbledon finalist Jasmine Paolini 3-6, 6-3, 6-2.
