The six-month trial set to begin in the coming weeks will send blood samples from Guy's Hospitalin south London to a lab via drones, cutting transport time from over 30 minutes to less than two minutes, according to project researchers.

The pilot project will help "improve patient outcomes and deliver significant environmental benefits", according to Sophie O'Sullivan, director of future of flight at watchdog the Civil Aviation Authority, which is regulating the trial.

A test last month found that drone delivery did not damage the quality of the blood

The blood samples pilot will be run with healthcare logistics company Apian and drone delivery company Wing.

Apian is also part of a National Health Service (NHS) programme delivering critical medical supplies to hospitals using drones, as well as a separate trial in Irish capital Dublin.
