### Held for illegal crab fishing in protected waters

Seventy kilograms of crabs, caught illegally in protected waters using gargoor traps, have led to the arrest of two Asian men.

The suspects are now facing charges in the Minor Criminal Court.

The Public Prosecution has completed its investigations into the case, which originated from a report filed by the Coast Guard Command.

The suspects were apprehended while placing gargoor traps in a marine protected area, with the substantial crab haul seized as evidence.

### 34 left dead in Israeli air strike

Gaza's civil defence agency said an Israeli air strike killed at least 34 people including children yesterday, with dozens more feared buried under the rubble in the Palestinian territory's north. The Israeli military told AFP its forces had conducted overnight strikes on targets in the Beit Lahia area, sending Palestinians fleeing, according to AFP TV footage. Civil defence spokesman Mahmud Bassal told AFP that 34 bodies had been pulled from the rubble of the bombed five-storey residential building in Beit Lahia, "including children and women", revising an earlier toll of 30 dead.

Seven people were wounded, he said. AFP images showed men covered in dust scrambling to reach people under the rubble.

# Gender equality, women empowerment 'on hold'

Shura Council votes to uphold law limiting expat wives' business rights amid calls for reform

A contentious 37-year-old law requiring Bahraini husbands' approval for their expat wives' business ventures survived a Shura Council vote yesterday, with the chairman's tie-breaking decision ensuring the rule remains in place despite growing calls for reform to reflect Bahrain's modern economic vision.

The rule permits husbands to prevent or revoke their wives' ability to trade.

Supporters of its repeal argued the restriction clashes with Bahrain's progress on gender equality and economic development.

"This law has been in place for nearly four decades and no longer suits Bahrain's economic aspirations," said Khalid Al Maskati, Chairman of the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee. "It is time foreign wives were allowed to contribute freely to the economy without unnecessary interference."

The debate over the proposal revealed stark divisions among council members.

## Repeal

Lina Habib Qassim spoke passionately in support of the repeal.

"Bahrain's women have gone beyond empowerment and are now leaders in their fields. It is unfair to keep rules that stop them from trading equally, even if they happen to be foreign wives," she said.

Opponents questioned the relevance of the proposal.

Ali Al Shehabi argued, "Foreign wives come to Bahrain as spouses, not business owners. Economic programmes should focus on supporting Bahraini women."

## Complications

He also warned of potential complications.

"Removing this rule risks creating conflicts with the countries these foreign wives origi-

nally come from," he added. Ali Al Aradi felt the law was being misrepresented.

"The current law does not stop foreign wives from working or engaging in business in Bahrain. The restrictions are tied to agreements within the marriage, not imposed by the state," he explained.

## Findings

He also criticised the committee's findings.

"The report doesn't provide enough evidence to justify this change. It should be reconsidered," he said, calling for the proposal to be withdrawn for further review.

Dr Ahmed Al Oraiyed questioned the need for change.

"What problem is this trying to solve?" he asked. "There are no reports of foreign wives facing difficulties under the current system. Many Bahrainis married to foreign women operate businesses without any trouble."

## Concerns

man of the Shura Council, echoed these concerns, raising doubts about the quality of the committee's report.

"The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee is known for its thorough reports, but that cannot be said for this one," he remarked.

While recognising the good intentions behind the proposal, Al Saleh defended the inclusion of Article 14 in the law.

"This provision was not added without thought. Those who drafted it provided clear reasoning for its purpose," he said.

## Consequences

He also warned of unintended consequences.

"Rather than advancing fairness for women, this change risks undermining their rights. It is a matter that needs deeper consideration," he stressed.

Minister of Parliamentary Affairs HE Ghanim Al Buainain added a legal perspective, emphasising that Bahrain's laws on civil and commercial matters involving foreign elements are clear.

"The law governing the legal capacity and personal status

of individuals is determined by the state to which they belong," he explained. "This principle is reflected in Article 14, and there is no issue of discrimination between men and women when it comes to engaging in trade or requiring consent."

## Example

Buainain also pointed to Article 22 of the UAE's laws, which the committee referenced in their proposal, as an example.

"The UAE law allows non-citizens to engage in trade, but only under specific conditions and

within limits set by the Cabinet based on recommendations from the Minister of Economy," he said.

He called for the proposal to be sent back to the committee for further review, suggesting that related laws, such as Bahrain's Civil and Commercial Procedures Law, also be considered.

"There are several issues with this proposal that need to be addressed in depth," he concluded.

## Fairness

Second Deputy Chairperson Dr Jihad Al Fadhel linked the discussion to broader efforts in Bahrain to ensure fairness in financial and legal matters.

"Islamic law has always protected financial independence for both men and women, and Bahrain has built on this foundation to advance equality," she said.

Dr Al Fadhel also pointed to examples from other countries.

"We've seen this change implemented elsewhere, and Bahrain has often led in adopting forward-thinking reforms," she added.

## Caution

Jamal Fakhro, First Deputy Chairman, urged caution.

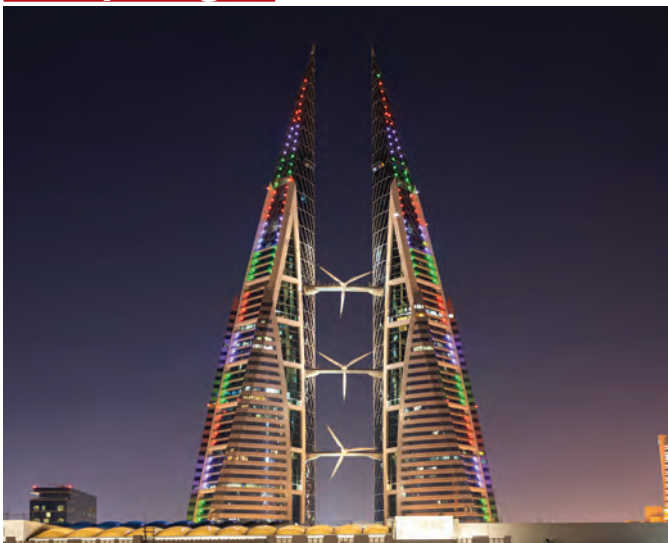
"This is just the beginning of the discussion. If the proposal moves forward, it will return to us after the government has addressed the details and clarified any outstanding questions," he said.

## Inclusion

While the proposal was rejected, it has revived discussions about Bahrain's legal framework and how well it aligns with the kingdom's aspirations for progress and inclusivity.

"We cannot let outdated laws hold us back," said Al Maskati. "Article 15 remains in place, setting conditions for business registration, but it is clear that Bahrain must continue refining its legal framework to match the realities of today's economy."

# Healthcare reform

Shura Council approves law capping late health licence renewal fines at 25%

Fines for late licence renewals are on course to be capped at 25 per cent under a law passed by the Shura Council yesterday, replacing the current double-penalty system. The law also allows Bahrainis in fields such as laboratory sciences to open clinics, a privilege previously limited to medical doctors. The changes aim to give more Bahrainis the opportunity to contribute to the health sector while easing financial pressures on professionals. Under the new system, fines for late renewals will be applied gradually, starting at 25 per cent, rather than leaping to double the renewal fee at once. The proposal was spearheaded by Dr Ebtessam Al Dallal, Ja-

mal Fakhro, Dr Jehad Al Fadhel, Dalal Al Zayed, and Dr Jameela Salman.

**Approach**

Dr Ahmed Al Orayed praised Bahrain's forward-thinking approach to healthcare, recalling reforms in the 1990s that allowed doctors to establish clinics outside Salmaniya Medical Complex.

He noted how the late Prime Minister supported these efforts with affordable electricity and water rates.

However, Al Orayed criticised the current system of fines and charges, warning that higher costs would inevitably burden patients.

He urged the government to ease restrictions on clinics rather than adding financial strain.

**Reform**

Dr Al Dallal stressed the urgency of reform, pointing to the closure of three major hospitals in 2024 as a stark reminder of the need for investment and rare

specialisations.

"This law focuses on rare specialisations identified by the National Health Regulatory Authority, ensuring hospitals remain viable and attract critical investment," she said.

Non-Bahrainis will also be permitted to establish clinics in rare fields under the amended Article 5, provided their expertise is licensed.

**Notice**

Additionally, Article 28 requires health institutions to be given three months' notice before penalties are applied for missing renewal deadlines.

Dr Hani Al Sa'ati echoed concerns about Bahraini clinics struggling under pressure from foreign-owned businesses, stating, "Over 40 health institutions have shut down in the past two years because of unfair competition."

He questioned why private hospitals rely on foreign general practitioners when qualified Bahrainis are available.

**Improvements**

Al Sa'ati also called for improvements in medical training, highlighting that some universities fail to provide the necessary internship year, forcing families to send students abroad to complete their education.

The National Health Regulatory Authority, the Ministry of Health, and the Supreme Council of Health backed the proposed law but cautioned that limiting licences to Bahrainis in some areas could have economic consequences.

They called for further review to balance local benefits with broader implications for the health sector.

## Funding future

Push to raise BD600,000 budget for Northern Municipal Council projects

A plan to increase the Towns And Villages Development's budget to BD600,000 and tackle the issue of abandoned houses was the focus of a meeting between MPs and the Northern Municipal Council.

Held in Parliament, the discussions aimed to address funding shortfalls and improve services for the Northern region.

The meeting was led by Northern Municipal Council Chairman Dr Sayeed Shubber Al Wadaei, with Deputy Speaker AbdulNabi Salman, Vice Chairwoman Zaina Jassim, and several MPs and council members in attendance.

**Collaboration**

Dr Al Wadaei welcomed the collaboration, saying it creates opportunities to address the region's most pressing needs.

He called for MP support to secure the increased budget, which would cover maintenance, restoration, and the installation of barriers.

The council raised the issue of abandoned homes, propos-

ing an amendment to Article 18 of the Building Regulation Law to address a legislative gap.

**Restoration**

A detailed report outlining pending restoration requests and proposed solutions will be shared with MPs for further action.

Additional funding was also requested for the Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities (BACA) to preserve homes over 50 years old, classified as heritage sites.

The attendees agreed to arrange meetings with the Ministers of Works and Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture to discuss the region's project priorities.

**Challenges**

A press conference was proposed to outline the Northern region's challenges and set out the council's and MPs' shared vision for addressing them.

Dr Al Wadaei described the discussions as an important step towards stronger cooperation with MPs, with the aim of improving services and infrastructure for the Northern region's residents.

Russia yesterday pummelled Ukraine with a "massive" aerial barrage of missiles and drones, killing at least nine people across the country in the largest attack in months that Kyiv called "hellish." Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky said Moscow launched 120 missiles and almost 100 drones, targeting Kyiv as well as southern, central and far-western corners of the country. Civilians were killed in the Mykolaiv, Lviv, Kherson, Dnipropetrovsk and Odesa regions. "A hellish night," the spokesman for Ukraine's airforce Yuriy Ignat said on social media, saying Kyiv downed "144 targets." The strikes caused massive power cuts across the country, with fears of a precarious winter to come. Officials in Kyiv called it one of the biggest attacks in the almost three-year long Russian invasion. "A massive attack on our country," Zelensky said.

President Joe Biden is using a historic trip to the Amazon yesterday to highlight that US bilateral climate financing increased to \$11 billion this year, meeting a pledge he made. "The fight against climate change has been a defining cause of President Biden's leadership and presidency," the White House said in a statement ahead of Biden touching down in the Brazilian city of Manaus, in the Amazon. Biden is making his last swing through South America before handing over the presidency to Donald Trump -- a climate-change skeptic. The first sitting US president to make a trip to the vast tropical rainforest, Biden is to meet with Brazilian Indigenous leaders and sign a declaration making November 17 an International Conservation Day.

Saudi Arabia will be hosting the sixth UN World Data Forum, to be held in Riyadh in 2026. The announcement was made at the conclusion of the fifth UN World Data Forum, which took place in Medellin, Colombia. The forum gathered representatives from 193 UN member states. The HLG-PCCB announced Saudi Arabia's selection by majority vote after evaluating competing countries' bids and assessing their hosting capabilities. The forum serves as a platform for addressing challenges in the global data and statistics system and fostering collaboration among policymakers and experts. It highlights the critical importance of data and statistics while promoting increased cooperation across diverse data systems.

Pope Francis for the first time tackled claims of Israel's ongoing "genocide" of Palestinians in Gaza in a forthcoming book, urging further investigation into whether Israel's actions meet the definition.

Titled "Hope Never Disappears. Pilgrims Towards a Better World", the book includes his latest and most forthright intervention into the more than year-long war sparked by Hamas's October 7 attack on Israel.

"According to some experts, what is happening in Gaza has the characteristics of genocide," the pontiff wrote in extracts published on Sunday in Italy's La Stampa daily.

"This should be studied carefully to determine whether (the situation) corresponds to the technical definition formulated by jurists and international organisations," he added.

The Argentine pontiff has frequently deplored the number of victims of Israel's operations in Gaza, with the territory's Hamas-run health ministry putting the toll at least 43,846 people, most of them civilians.

But his call for a probe marks the first time he has publicly used the term genocide -- without endorsing it -- in the context of Israeli military operations in the Palestinian territory.

On Thursday, a United Nations Special Committee judged Israel's conduct of warfare in Gaza "consistent with the characteristics of genocide", accusing the country of "using starvation as a method of war".

Its conclusions have already been condemned by Israel's key backer the United States.

It is, however, not the first time that Israel has been the subject of genocide accusations since the start of the war.

Israel slams UN committee's Gaza genocide claims as 'false'

Israel condemned the United Nations for what it described as "anti-Israel fabrications" after a UN committee said its warfare in Gaza is consistent with the characteristics of genocide.

"The UN is breaking its own record when it comes to biased reports, singling-out Israel and anti-Israel fabrications," the foreign ministry said late on Saturday.

The UN special committee said in a report that Israel was "intentionally causing death, starvation and serious injury" in the Gaza Strip, accusing it of "using starvation as a method of war".

But the ministry dismissed the accusations as "false claims". "The... report is an appalling example of the transformation of the UN into an organisation

which is used as a pawn by terrorists who attack civilians in a democratic state," it said in a statement shared by spokesman Oren Marmorstein on X.

The UN committee had said "through its siege over Gaza, obstruction of humanitarian aid, alongside targeted attacks and killing of civilians and aid workers, despite repeated UN appeals, binding orders from the International Court of Justice and resolutions of the Security Council, Israel is intentionally causing death, starvation and serious injury".

Israel's foreign ministry, however, insisted its "activities are directed solely at dismantling Hamas's terror capabilities". The United States, Israel's biggest supporter, rejected the UN committee's charges, which it said were "unfounded".

India and Nigeria renew ties as Modi visits

India's Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Nigeria's President Bola Tinubu met to renew what they called the "strategic partnership" between the giants of Asia and Africa yesterday.

Nigeria's capital Abuja was Modi's first stop in a tour that will take the Indian premier on to the G20 summit in Brazil, and to Guyana.

The visit was billed by New Delhi as a meeting of the largest democracy in the world and the largest in Africa, "natural partners" as both push for a more central role in world affairs.

Modi was welcomed to the Nigerian presidency by a military pipe band and honour guard, before entering closed door talks with Tinubu and senior officials at his Aso Rock residence.

"Our cooperation is very strong and there are many new possibilities as well for us to take our cooperation forward," Modi said in preliminary remarks as talks got underway. "As we just said, we have always worked together to address challenges such as terrorism, separatism, piracy and drug trafficking."

Tinubu conferred on Modi the Nigerian honour Grand Commander of the Order of Niger, congratulated him on India's democratic credentials and pledged to work together on the "basis of mutual respect and a shared mission".

Photos posted on Modi's account showed him arriving late Saturday at Abuja airport to be welcomed by Nigerian officials and a cheering crowd from the country's 60,000-strong Indian community.

Biden visits the Amazon, the jungle that nearly finished Roosevelt

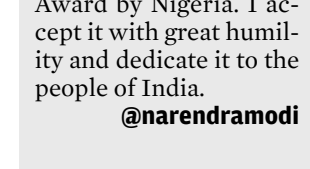

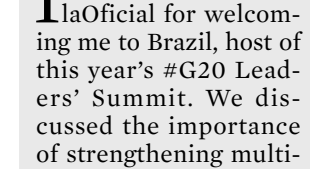

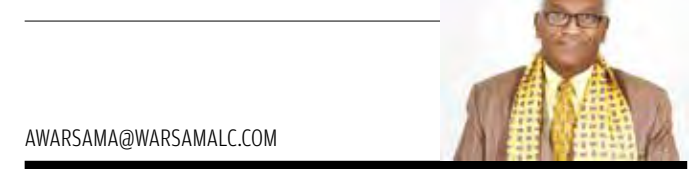

Fixed & Floating charges

It is important to mention that a debenture is normally secured either by a fixed or floating charge or, ideally, by both. The fixed or floating charges are the normal legal or equitable mortgages, however, floating charges, in practice, are restricted to companies and are applicable with certain peculiarities. They are equitable charges on some or all of the present and future property of the company, subject to the company's power to deal with it in the ordinary course of business. Such a charge is, therefore, of a particularly valuable means whereby a business concern can raise money without removing any of its property from the business.

The charge remains floating and the property also remains liquid until some default is made and the debenture holder takes steps to enforce his security, or until winding up commences. When such instance occurs the charge "crystallizes" and is converted into a normal fixed charge on the assets of the company at the time of crystallization or which come into existence thereafter. Default alone will not suffice to crystallize the charge, the debenture holder must intervene to determine the license to the company to deal with the property, normally by appointing a receiver or by applying to the court to do so. But if the company is wound up, no intervention by the debenture holder is necessary, the floating charge automatically crystallizes because the license is subject to the implied condition that the company carries on business.

No particular form of words is necessary in order to create a floating charge, it suffices that the intention is shown, to impose a charge on property present and future, and also to allow the company to continue to deal with that property in the ordinary course of business, however, the expression "ordinary course of business" is construed widely to cover many situations. In any event, the company will be allowed to continue to buy and sell in the usual way, to pay its unsecured creditors, and even to grant mortgages on the same property unless it is otherwise provided.

A floating charge, will clearly be postponed to a later legal mortgage if that mortgagee had no notice of it. Moreover, it is important to say that, the floating charge will be invalid unless registered at the Companies Registry and registration constitutes notice to all. This is important due to the fact that the debenture holders have impliedly authorized the company to continue to deal with its assets notwithstanding the charge. Because of this authority the floating charge will be postponed to a later fixed charge whether legal or equitable, even if the later charge has notice of it. The company could not create another floating charge on the same assets ranking in priority to or pari passu with the original floating charge.

As per the Law of Commerce, in Bahrain, it is generally allowed for a commercial mortgage (pledge) to be taken over pooled movable assets held or acquired for the use of a business or income-producing activity (going concern) and not for sale.

This is similar to "Floating Charges" concept, as the pool is restricted to movable property of a long-term nature and of value to the operation of the business, specially inventory and fixed assets, which include movable tangibles such as trade fixtures, equipment, machinery, tools, furniture and legal intangibles such as company style (name), logos, goodwill, intellectual property, leases, etc. Herein, the pool is treated as a single movable security subject. The law in Bahrain provides that, where a mortgage is made on an appropriated property, the mortgage shall remain valid even when the mortgaged property has been replaced by property of the same kind and if the mortgaged property is ascertained, the mortgagor may replace it by other property provided that such replacement has been agreed upon in the contract of mortgage and provided that the creditor accepts the substitute without prejudice to the rights of third party.

1. **Farther from Potential Impact:** The middle seat is furthest from the sides of the car, offering added protection in side-impact collisions. This positioning minimizes the risk of injury from a direct hit.
2. **Airbag Safety:** The back seat is generally safer because it keeps your child away from front airbags. In a collision, air-

bags deploy with significant force, which can harm a small child. A rear-facing car seat should never be in the front seat due to the risk posed by airbags.

3. **Balanced Protection:** In the centre, your child has a more even distribution of force in the event of a crash. While the middle seat doesn't have the side support like the outboard seats (those next to the doors), it offers a buffer zone against impact.

However, not all vehicles have a middle seat suitable for car seats. Some cars have narrow or raised central sections that may not securely accommodate a car seat base. Always check your vehicle's manual to confirm if the middle seat can support a child car seat.

## Alternative: The Rear



Properly installed child safety seats can reduce the risk of fatal injury by up to 71% for infants and 54% for toddlers in car crashes. Despite this, studies show that up to 59% of car seats are installed incorrectly, which significantly reduces their effectiveness. Taking the time to ensure a correct installation can make a life-saving difference.

## Passenger Side (Behind the Front Passenger Seat)

If the middle isn't an option, the second safest spot is typically behind the front passenger seat. Here's why this location is often recommended:

1. **Ease of Access:** Being able to reach your child quickly is essential, especially in emergencies. The passenger side allows you to keep an eye on your child while driving and provides convenient access for buckling them in and out.

2. **Less Traffic Risk:** Parking on the street? The passenger side keeps your child away from oncoming traffic when you're parked, making it safer to get them in and out of the car.

## What About the Front Seat?

In general, experts and safety guidelines strongly advise against placing a child car seat in the front seat. Here's why:

1. **Airbag Danger:** Front airbags can be deadly to a child, especially when seated in a rear-facing seat. Even a forward-facing child may be at risk, as airbags are designed for adults and deploy with immense

force.

2. **Legal Restrictions:** Many regions have laws prohibiting children from sitting in the front seat, particularly those under 12 years old. Always adhere to local regulations regarding car seat placement.

## Rear-Facing or Forward-Facing: Does It Matter?

It's recommended that children remain in a rear-facing car seat for as long as possible, ideally until they outgrow the seat's height and weight limits. Rear-facing seats are designed to cradle your child's head, neck, and spine in the event of a collision, offering superior protection. When placing a rear-facing seat:

- Ensure it's tightly secured with the seatbelt or the ISOFIX system (known as LATCH in the United States).
  - Check the car seat's angle to prevent your child's head from falling forward.
  - Keep the car seat in the back seat—never in front.
- For older children in forward-facing

seats, the back seat remains the safest choice, with either the middle or the rear passenger side as the ideal locations.

## Tips for Proper Installation

1. **Read the Manuals:** It may seem tedious, but reading both your car's manual and the car seat's manual is crucial. These documents provide essential instructions on proper installation and weight/height limits.
2. **Use the Right Anchors:** Many cars come with ISOFIX/LATCH systems that simplify car seat installation. If using a seatbelt, ensure it's tightly secured with no slack. The car seat shouldn't move more than an inch side-to-side or front-to-back.
3. **Test the Angle:** Most rear-facing seats have an indicator to show if the seat is installed at the correct angle. Keeping this angle correct is vital for infant safety.
4. **Check Regularly:** Children grow quickly, and their car seat needs change over time. Make sure to periodically check the fit, ensuring that harness-

es are snug and at the correct height for your child's size.

## Common Mistakes to Avoid

1. **Loose Installation:** A loose car seat can fail in a crash. Always double-check that the seat is securely installed and doesn't shift.
2. **Incorrect Harness Position:** The harness should be snug against your child, with the chest clip at armpit level. Straps should lie flat without twisting.
3. **Using an Expired Car Seat:** Car seats have expiration dates due to material fatigue and evolving safety standards. Never use an expired car seat.

The safest spot for your child's car seat is a combination of vehicle design, type of seat, and proper installation. Remember, no matter where you decide to place the car seat, ensuring it's installed correctly is the key to your child's safety. 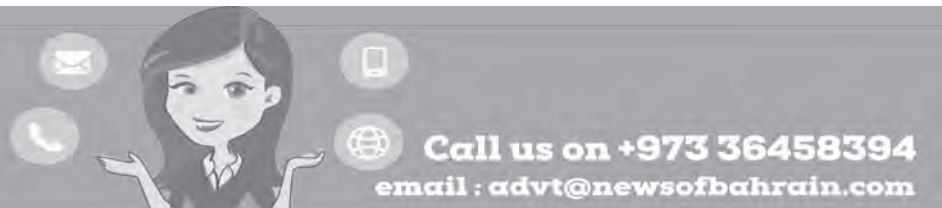

Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) hosted an action-packed third round of the 2024/2025 Bahrain Rotax MAX Challenge (BRMC) over the weekend at its world-class grassroots motorsport facility in Sakhir. The kingdom's top karters went head-to-head along the 1.414-kilometre track at Bahrain International Karting Circuit (BIKC). Victories were claimed by Tariq Soofi in the Micro MAX class, Shaikh Ahmed bin Saqer Al Khalifa in the Mini MAX, Nasser Nass in the Junior MAX, Mohammed Alhasan in the Senior MAX, and Abdulla Sajjad in the MAX DD2.

The event was organised by BIC and BIKC in collaboration with the Bahrain Motor Federation, Bahrain Karting Commission, and the Motorsport Marshals Club. At the conclusion of the championship, the winners will earn the fantastic opportunity to represent Bahrain at the prestigious Rotax MAX Challenge Grand Finals, one of the top annual karting events globally.

## Micro MAX

Young Tariq Soofi was in excellent form, leading from the start with a top performance in Free Practice and capturing pole in Qualifying. He secured a decisive win in the Pre-Final, then dominated the nine-lap Final with a total time of 9:18.967, finishing 11 seconds ahead of runner-up Rashid



Almahroos. Abdulaziz Alsarraf took the final podium position in third.

## Mini MAX

In the Mini MAX category, Leonard Bossi led the way in Free Practice, but Shaikh Ahmed bin Saqer Al Khalifa seized control from Qualifying and maintained his momentum through to the nine-lap Final. He secured victory with a time of 8:54.409, narrowly beating Jude Andrews to the finish by 0.650 seconds. Rayyan Najjar completed the top three, 8.025 seconds behind the leader.

## Junior MAX

The Junior MAX class saw intense competition, with Rashid Hilal narrowly beating Nasser Nass in Free Practice by five-hundredths of a second. In Qualifying, Leopold Juch edged out Nasser by seven-hundredths of a second. However, Nasser took control in the Pre-Final, finishing ahead of

Khaled Najjar, and kept his lead in the 15-lap Final, winning with a time of 13:51.965. Nasser's victory margin over Khaled was 5.788 seconds, while Leopold Juch claimed third, finishing 6.716 seconds behind the winner.

## Senior MAX

The Senior MAX category had the biggest field of the weekend, with 17 competitors battling for the top spot. Mohammed Alhasan was in dominant form from the start, setting the fastest time in Free Practice and taking pole in Qualifying. He continued his impressive run, winning the Pre-Final and securing a 15-lap Final victory in 13:33.980. Alhasan finished 4.926 seconds ahead of second-place finisher Tye Mejia, with Vedant Menon close behind in third, 5.125 seconds from the leader. Gracie Rose Grantham, Musaad Albasam, Yousif Alali, Rakan Alfayez, and Abdulla Alkhat-

er rounded out the top eight.

## MAX DD2

In the MAX DD2 class, Oliver Kruglov started strongly, topping the Free Practice times and securing pole position in Qualifying. He went on to win the Pre-Final, but was only able to complete two laps in the Final. Abdulla Sajjad capitalised on the opportunity, taking the win with a time of 13:28.177, finishing 4.627 seconds ahead of second-placed Raoul Sadi.

## Upcoming Events

The Bahrain Rotax MAX Challenge continues with its fourth round scheduled for 29 November, marking the final race of the calendar year. The series will resume in 2025 with round five on 11 January, followed by round six on 24 January. The seventh and penultimate round will take place on 8 February, leading up to the championship finale on 21 February.



The International Equestrian Federation (FEI) honoured His Highness Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Representative of His Majesty for Humanitarian Works and Youth Affairs and Captain of the Royal Endurance Team, for his global accomplishments as the only Arab rider to achieve such distinction in international endurance racing.
